ado and weep <u>41_MAR_05_39</u> # And when he was come in, he saith unto them, Why make ye this ado, and weep? the damsel is not dead, but sleepeth.

Adonibezek fled and <u>07_JUD_01_06</u># But Adonibezek fled; and they pursued after him, and caught him, and cut off his thumbs and his great toes.

Adonibezek in Bezek <u>07_JUD_01_05</u> # And they found Adonibezek in Bezek: and they fought against him, and they slew the Canaanites and the Perizzites.

Adonibezek said Threescore <u>07_JUD_01_07</u> # And Adonibezek said, Threescore and ten kings, having their thumbs and their great toes cut off, gathered [their meat] under my table: as I have done, so God hath requited me. And they brought him to Jerusalem, and there he died.

Adonijah and all <u>11_1KI_01_41</u># And Adonijah and all the guests that [were] with him heard [it] as they had made an end of eating. And when Joab heard the sound of the trumpet, he said, Wherefore [is this] noise of the city being in an uproar?

Adonijah And the <u>11_1KI_02_19</u># Bathsheba therefore went unto king Solomon, to speak unto him for Adonijah. And the king rose up to meet her, and bowed himself unto her, and sat down on his throne, and caused a seat to be set for the king's mother; and she sat on his right hand.

Adonijah and Tobijah <u>14_2CH_17_08</u># And with them [he sent] Levites, [even] Shemaiah, and Nethaniah, and Zebadiah, and Asahel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehonathan, and Adonijah, and Tobijah, and Tobadonijah, Levites; and with them Elishama and Jehoram, priests.

Adonijah feared because <u>11_1KI_01_50</u># And Adonijah feared because of Solomon, and arose, and went, and caught hold on the horns of the altar.

Adonijah feareth king <u>11_1KI_01_51</u># And it was told Solomon, saying, Behold, Adonijah feareth king Solomon: for, lo, he hath caught hold on the horns of the altar, saying, Let king Solomon swear unto me to day that he will not slay his servant with the sword.

Adonijah have not <u>11_1KI_02_23</u># Then king Solomon sware by the LORD, saying, God do so to me, and more also, if Adonijah have not spoken this word against his own life.

Adonijah helped him <u>11_1KI_01_07</u># And he conferred with Joab the son of Zeruiah, and with Abiathar the priest: and they following Adonijah helped [him].

Adonijah reign <u>11_1KI_01_13</u># Go and get thee in unto king David, and say unto him, Didst not thou, my lord, O king, swear unto thine handmaid, saying, Assuredly Solomon thy son shall reign after me, and he shall sit upon my throne? why then doth Adonijah reign?

Adonijah reigneth and <u>11_1KI_01_18</u># And now, behold, Adonijah reigneth; and now, my lord the king, thou knowest [it] not:

Adonijah slew sheep <u>11_1KI_01_09</u># And Adonijah slew sheep and oxen and fat cattle by the stone of Zoheleth, which [is] by Enrogel, and called all his brethren the king's sons, and all the men of Judah the king's servants:

Adonijah the son <u>13_1CH_03_02</u># The third, Absalom the son of Maachah the daughter of Talmai king of Geshur: the fourth, Adonijah the son of Haggith:

Adonijah the son <u>11_1KI_01_05</u># Then Adonijah the son of Haggith exalted himself, saying, I will be king: and he prepared him chariots and horsemen, and fifty men to run before him.

Adonijah thy brother <u>11_1KI_02_21</u># And she said, Let Abishag the Shunammite be given to Adonijah thy brother to wife.

Adonikam whose names <u>15_EZR_08_13</u> # And of the last sons of Adonikam, whose names [are] these, Eliphelet, Jeiel, and Shemaiah, and with them threescore males.

Adoniram the son <u>11_1KI_04_06</u># And Ahishar [was] over the household: and Adoniram the son of Abda [was] over the tribute.

Adoniram was over <u>11_1KI_05_14</u># And he sent them to Lebanon, ten thousand a month by courses: a month they were in Lebanon, [and] two months at home: and Adoniram [was] over the levy.

adorned for her <u>66_REV_21_02</u> # And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

adorned themselves being <u>60_1PE_03_05</u> # For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:

ambassador is sent <u>24_JER_49_14</u> # I have heard a rumour from the LORD, and an ambassador is sent unto the heathen, [saying], Gather ye together, and come against her, and rise up to the battle.

ambassador is sent <u>31_OBA_01_01</u> # The vision of Obadiah. Thus saith the Lord GOD concerning Edom; We have heard a rumour from the LORD, and an ambassador is sent among the heathen, Arise ye, and let us rise up against her in battle.

shadow of the <u>23_ISA_38_08</u># Behold, I will bring again the shadow of the degrees, which is gone down in the sun dial of Ahaz, ten degrees backward. So the sun returned ten degrees, by which degrees it was gone down.

shadow of the <u>07_JUD_09_36</u> # And when Gaal saw the people, he said to Zebul, Behold, there come people down from the top of the mountains. And Zebul said unto him, Thou seest the shadow of the mountains as [if they were] men.

shadow of the <u>19_PSA_91_01</u># He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

shadow of things <u>51_COL_02_17</u># Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body [is] of Christ.

shadow of thy <u>19_PSA_17_08</u># Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings,

shadow of thy <u>19_PSA_36_07</u> # How excellent [is] thy lovingkindness, O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of thy wings.

shadow of thy <u>19_PSA_57_01</u># To the chief Musician, Altaschith, Michtam of David, when he fled from Saul in the cave. Be merciful unto me, O God, be merciful unto me: for my soul trusteth in thee: yea, in the shadow of thy wings will I make my refuge, until [these] calamities be overpast.

shadow of thy <u>19_PSA_63_07</u> # Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice.

shadow of turning <u>59_JAM_01_17</u># Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

Zadok that kept <u>26_EZE_44_15</u># But the priests the Levites, the sons of Zadok, that kept the charge of my sanctuary when the children of Israel went astray from me, they shall come near to me to minister unto me, and they shall stand before me to offer unto me the fat and the blood, saith the Lord GOD:

Zadok the priest <u>13_1CH_16_39</u> # And Zadok the priest, and his brethren the priests, before the tabernacle of the LORD in the high place that [was] at Gibeon,

Zadok the son <u>10_2SA_08_17</u> # And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, [were] the priests; and Seraiah [was] the scribe;

Zadok the son <u>15_EZR_07_02</u># The son of Shallum, the son of Zadok, the son of Ahitub,

Zadok the son <u>16_NEH_03_04</u> # And next unto them repaired Meremoth the son of Urijah, the son of Koz. And next unto them repaired Meshullam the son of Berechiah, the son of Meshezabeel. And next unto them repaired Zadok the son of Baana.

Zadok the son <u>16_NEH_03_29</u># After them repaired Zadok the son of Immer over against his house. After him repaired also Shemaiah the son of Shechaniah, the keeper of the east gate.

Zadok the son <u>16 NEH_11_11</u># Seraiah the son of Hilkiah, the son of Meshullam, the son of Zadok, the son of Meraioth, the son of Ahitub, [was] the ruler of the house of God.

Zadok therefore and <u>10_2SA_15_29</u># Zadok therefore and Abiathar carried the ark of God again to Jerusalem: and they tarried there.

Zadok to be <u>13_1CH_29_22</u> # And did eat and drink before the LORD on that day with great gladness. And they made Solomon the son of David king the second time, and anointed [him] unto the LORD [to be] the chief governor, and Zadok [to be] priest.
