again a battle <u>10\_2SA\_21\_18</u># And it came to pass after this, that there was again a battle with the Philistines at Gob: then Sibbechai the Hushathite slew Saph, which [was] of the sons of the giant.

again a battle <u>10\_28A\_21\_19</u># And there was again a battle in Gob with the Philistines, where Elhanan the son of Jaareoregim, a Bethlehemite, slew [the brother of] Goliath the Gittite, the staff of whose spear [was] like a weaver's beam.

again a captain <u>12\_2KI\_01\_13</u># And he sent again a captain of the third fifty with his fifty. And the third captain of fifty went up, and came and fell on his knees before Elijah, and besought him, and said unto him, O man of God, I pray thee, let my life, and the life of these fifty thy servants, be precious in thy sight.

again a little <u>43\_JOH\_16\_16</u> # A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father.

Again a new <u>62\_1JO\_02\_08</u># Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth.

again Abraham took 01\_GEN\_25\_01 # Then again Abraham took a wife, and her name [was] Keturah.

again according to <u>14\_2CH\_32\_25</u># But Hezekiah rendered not again according to the benefit [done] unto him; for his heart was lifted up: therefore there was wrath upon him, and upon Judah and Jerusalem.

again according to <u>21\_ECC\_01\_06</u># The wind goeth toward the south, and turneth about unto the north; it whirleth about continually, and the wind returneth again according to his circuits.

Again also he <u>12\_2KI\_01\_11</u># Again also he sent unto him another captain of fifty with his fifty. And he answered and said unto him, O man of God, thus hath the king said, Come down quickly.

again and came <u>09\_1SA\_25\_12</u># So David's young men turned their way, and went again, and came and

told him all those sayings.

again and cast <u>26\_EZE\_05\_04</u># Then take of them again, and cast them into the midst of the fire, and burn them in the fire; [for] thereof shall a fire come forth into all the house of Israel.

again and communed <u>01\_GEN\_42\_24</u> # And he turned himself about from them, and wept; and returned to them again, and communed with them, and took from them Simeon, and bound him before their eyes.

again and lay <u>12\_2KI\_04\_29</u># Then he said to Gehazi, Gird up thy loins, and take my staff in thine hand, and go thy way: if thou meet any man, salute him not; and if any salute thee, answer him not again: and lay my staff upon the face of the child.

again and looked <u>38\_ZEC\_02\_01</u># I lifted up mine eyes again, and looked, and behold a man with a measuring line in his hand.

again and my <u>18\_JOB\_29\_22</u> # After my words they spake not again; and my speech dropped upon them.

again and Orpah <u>08\_RUT\_01\_14</u> # And they lifted up their voice, and wept again: and Orpah kissed her mother in law; but Ruth clave unto her.

again and waked <u>38\_ZEC\_04\_01</u># And the angel that talked with me came again, and waked me, as a man that is wakened out of his sleep,

again and walk <u>02\_EXO\_21\_19</u># If he rise again, and walk abroad upon his staff, then shall he that smote [him] be quit: only he shall pay [for] the loss of his time, and shall cause [him] to be thoroughly healed.

again and was <u>42\_LUK\_15\_32</u> # It was meet that we should make merry, and be glad: for this thy brother was dead, and is alive again; and was lost, and is found.

again and went <u>07\_JUD\_08\_33</u> # And it came to pass, as soon as Gideon was dead, that the children of Israel turned again, and went a whoring after Baalim, and made Baalberith their god.

again and your <u>43\_JOH\_16\_22</u> # And ye now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you.

again and your <u>42\_LUK\_06\_35</u> # But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing

again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and [to] the evil.

again Andrew and <u>43\_JOH\_12\_22</u># Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.

again another roll <u>24\_JER\_36\_28</u> # Take thee again another roll, and write in it all the former words that were in the first roll, which Jehoiakim the king of Judah hath burned.

again another scripture <u>43\_JOH\_19\_37</u> # And again another scripture saith, They shall look on him whom they pierced.

again another vessel <u>24\_JER\_18\_04</u> # And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter: so he made it again another vessel, as seemed good to the potter to make [it].

again any more <u>12\_2KI\_24\_07</u> # And the king of Egypt came not again any more out of his land: for the king of Babylon had taken from the river of Egypt unto the river Euphrates all that pertained to the king of Egypt.

again any more <u>30\_AMO\_07\_13</u># But prophesy not again any more at Bethel: for it [is] the king's chapel, and it [is] the king's court.

again as it <u>06\_JOS\_14\_07</u># Forty years old [was] I when Moses the servant of the LORD sent me from Kadeshbarnea to espy out the land; and I brought him word again as [it was] in mine heart.

again as the <u>04\_NUM\_22\_08</u> # And he said unto them, Lodge here this night, and I will bring you word again, as the LORD shall speak unto me: and the princes of Moab abode with Balaam.

again at that <u>07\_JUD\_21\_14</u> # And Benjamin came again at that time; and they gave them wives which they had saved alive of the women of Jabeshgilead: and yet so they sufficed them not.

again at the <u>43\_JOH\_06\_39</u># And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

again bare his <u>01\_GEN\_04\_02</u> # And she again bare his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.

again be adorned <u>24\_JER\_31\_04</u> # Again I will build thee, and thou shalt be built, O virgin of Israel: thou shalt again be adorned with thy tabrets, and shalt go forth in the dances of them that make merry.

again because he <u>09\_18A\_20\_17</u># And Jonathan caused David to swear again, because he loved him: for he loved him as he loved his own soul.

again because he <u>10\_2SA\_03\_11</u># And he could not answer Abner a word again, because he feared him.

again before many <u>66\_REV\_10\_11</u># And he said unto me, Thou must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.

again before the 17\_EST\_08\_03 # And Esther spake yet again before the king, and fell down at his feet, and

besought him with tears to put away the mischief of Haman the Agagite, and his device that he had devised against the Jews.

again before the <u>04\_NUM\_17\_10</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Bring Aaron's rod again before the testimony, to be kept for a token against the rebels; and thou shalt quite take away their murmurings from me, that they die not.

again before thee <u>16\_NEH\_09\_28</u> # But after they had rest, they did evil again before thee: therefore leftest thou them in the hand of their enemies, so that they had the dominion over them: yet when they returned, and cried unto thee, thou heardest [them] from heaven; and many times didst thou deliver them according to thy mercies;

again but that <u>05\_DEU\_15\_03</u># Of a foreigner thou mayest exact [it again]: but [that] which is thine with thy brother thine hand shall release;

again but the <u>20\_PRO\_24\_16</u># For a just [man] falleth seven times, and riseth up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief.

again but the <u>19\_PSA\_37\_21</u># The wicked borroweth, and payeth not again: but the righteous showeth mercy, and giveth.

again buy us <u>01\_GEN\_43\_02</u># And it came to pass, when they had eaten up the corn which they had brought out of Egypt, their father said unto them, Go again, buy us a little food.

again conceived and <u>01\_GEN\_38\_05</u># And she yet again conceived, and bare a son; and called his name Shelah: and he was at Chezib, when she bare him.

again covering the <u>39\_MAL\_02\_13</u># And this have ye done again, covering the altar of the LORD with tears, with weeping, and with crying out, insomuch that he regardeth not the offering any more, or receiveth [it] with good will at your hand.

again even so <u>52\_1TH\_04\_14</u> # For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

again every man <u>24\_JER\_12\_15</u># And it shall come to pass, after that I have plucked them out I will return, and have compassion on them, and will bring them again, every man to his heritage, and every man

to his land.

again feed and <u>01\_GEN\_30\_31</u># And he said, What shall I give thee? And Jacob said, Thou shalt not give me any thing: if thou wilt do this thing for me, I will again feed [and] keep thy flock.

again for him <u>09\_1SA\_27\_04</u> # And it was told Saul that David was fled to Gath: and he sought no more again for him.

again of many <u>42\_LUK\_02\_34</u> # And Simeon blessed them, and said unto Mary his mother, Behold, this [child] is set for the fall and rising again of many in Israel; and for a sign which shall be spoken against;

again of the <u>11\_1KI\_13\_33</u># After this thing Jeroboam returned not from his evil way, but made again of the lowest of the people priests of the high places: whosoever would, he consecrated him, and he became [one] of the priests of the high places.

again of the <u>26\_EZE\_07\_07</u># The morning is come unto thee, O thou that dwellest in the land: the time is come, the day of trouble [is] near, and not the sounding again of the mountains.

again of the <u>41\_MAR\_10\_10</u> # And in the house his disciples asked him again of the same [matter].

again of this <u>44\_ACT\_17\_32</u> # And when they heard of the resurrection of the dead, some mocked: and others said, We will hear thee again of this [matter].

again rejoice over <u>05\_DEU\_30\_09</u># And the LORD thy God will make thee plenteous in every work of thine hand, in the fruit of thy body, and in the fruit of thy cattle, and in the fruit of thy land, for good: for the LORD will again rejoice over thee for good, as he rejoiced over thy fathers:

again saith the <u>26\_EZE\_26\_21</u> # I will make thee a terror, and thou [shalt be] no [more]: though thou be sought for, yet shalt thou never be found again, saith the Lord GOD.

again Samuel And 09\_1SA\_03\_06 # And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel arose and went

to Eli, and said, Here [am] I; for thou didst call me. And he answered, I called not, my son; lie down again.

again saw no <u>44\_ACT\_13\_37</u> # But he, whom God raised again, saw no corruption.

again saying All <u>14\_2CH\_34\_16</u># And Shaphan carried the book to the king, and brought the king word back again, saying, All that was committed to thy servants, they do [it].

again saying Answerest <u>41\_MAR\_15\_04</u> # And Pilate asked him again, saying, Answerest thou nothing? behold how many things they witness against thee.

again saying Not <u>43\_JOH\_18\_40</u># Then cried they all again, saying, Not this man, but Barabbas. Now Barabbas was a robber.

again saying Sirs <u>44\_ACT\_07\_26</u> # And the next day he showed himself unto them as they strove, and would have set them at one again, saying, Sirs, ye are brethren; why do ye wrong one to another?

again take root <u>12\_2KI\_19\_30</u> # And the remnant that is escaped of the house of Judah shall yet again take

Again the kingdom <u>40 MAT\_13\_47</u> # Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto a net, that was cast into the sea, and gathered of every kind:

again The Lord <u>46\_1CO\_03\_20</u> # And again, The Lord knoweth the thoughts of the wise, that they are vain.

again The Lord <u>58\_HEB\_10\_30</u># For we know him that hath said, Vengeance [belongeth] unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people.

again the men <u>07\_JUD\_20\_41</u> # And when the men of Israel turned again, the men of Benjamin were amazed: for they saw that evil was come upon them.

Again the next <u>43\_JOH\_01\_35</u> # Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples;

again the Pharisees <u>43\_JOH\_09\_15</u> # Then again the Pharisees also asked him how he had received his sight. He said unto them, He put clay upon mine eyes, and I washed, and do see.

again the price <u>03\_LEV\_25\_51</u># If [there be] yet many years [behind], according unto them he shall give again the price of his redemption out of the money that he was bought for.

again till they <u>19\_PSA\_18\_37</u> # I have pursued mine enemies, and overtaken them: neither did I turn again till they were consumed.

again to Asahel <u>10\_2SA\_02\_22</u> # And Abner said again to Asahel, Turn thee aside from following me: wherefore should I smite thee to the ground? how then should I hold up my face to Joab thy brother?

again to battle <u>07\_JUD\_20\_23</u> # [And the children of Israel went up and wept before the LORD until even, and asked counsel of the LORD, saying, Shall I go up again to battle against the children of Benjamin my brother? And the LORD said, Go up against him.]

again to be <u>05\_DEU\_24\_04</u> # Her former husband, which sent her away, may not take her again to be his wife, after that she is defiled; for that [is] abomination before the LORD: and thou shalt not cause the land to sin, which the LORD thy God giveth thee [for] an inheritance.

again to commend <u>47\_2CO\_03\_01</u># Do we begin again to commend ourselves? or need we, as some [others], epistles of commendation to you, or [letters] of commendation from you?

again to cover <u>19\_PSA\_104\_09</u># Thou hast set a bound that they may not pass over; that they turn not again to cover the earth.

again to dwell <u>04\_NUM\_35\_32</u> # And ye shall take no satisfaction for him that is fled to the city of his refuge, that he should come again to dwell in the land, until the death of the priest.

again to every <u>48\_GAL\_05\_03</u># For I testify again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law.

again to fear <u>45\_ROM\_08\_15</u> # For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

again to fetch <u>05\_DEU\_24\_19</u> # When thou cuttest down thine harvest in thy field, and hast forgot a sheaf in the field, thou shalt not go again to fetch it: it shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow: that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hands.

again to fight <u>07\_JUD\_11\_09</u># And Jephthah said unto the elders of Gilead, If ye bring me home again to fight against the children of Ammon, and the LORD deliver them before me, shall I be your head?

again to folly <u>19\_PSA\_85\_08</u># I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his saints: but let them not turn again to folly.

again to Gilgal <u>12\_2KI\_04\_38</u># And Elisha came again to Gilgal: and [there was] a dearth in the land; and the sons of the prophets [were] sitting before him: and he said unto his servant, Set on the great pot, and seethe pottage for the sons of the prophets.

again to go <u>11\_1KI\_13\_17</u># For it was said to me by the word of the LORD, Thou shalt eat no bread nor drink water there, nor turn again to go by the way that thou camest.

again to Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_20\_27</u> # Then they returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, and Jehoshaphat in the forefront of them, to go again to Jerusalem with joy; for the LORD had made them to rejoice over their enemies.

again to Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_33\_13</u> # And prayed unto him: and he was entreated of him, and heard his supplication, and brought him again to Jerusalem into his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD he [was] God.

again to Joab <u>10\_2SA\_18\_22</u> # Then said Ahimaaz the son of Zadok yet again to Joab, But howsoever, let me, I pray thee, also run after Cushi. And Joab said, Wherefore wilt thou run, my son, seeing that thou hast no tidings ready?

again to Joshua <u>06\_JOS\_18\_09</u># And the men went and passed through the land, and described it by cities

into seven parts in a book, and came [again] to Joshua to the host at Shiloh.

again to Lystra <u>44\_ACT\_14\_21</u> # And when they had preached the gospel to that city, and had taught many, they returned again to Lystra, and [to] Iconium, and Antioch,

again to me <u>11\_1KI\_12\_05</u># And he said unto them, Depart yet [for] three days, then come again to me. And the people departed.

again to me <u>09\_1SA\_23\_23</u># See therefore, and take knowledge of all the lurking places where he hideth himself, and come ye again to me with the certainty, and I will go with you: and it shall come to pass, if he be in the land, that I will search him out throughout all the thousands of Judah.

again to me <u>14\_2CH\_10\_12</u> # So Jeroboam and all the people came to Rehoboam on the third day, as the king bade, saying, Come again to me on the third day.

again to me 26\_EZE\_14\_12 # The word of the LORD came again to me, saying,

again to me <u>24\_JER\_03\_01</u> # They say, If a man put away his wife, and she go from him, and become another man's, shall he return unto her again? shall not that land be greatly polluted? but thou hast played the harlot with many lovers; yet return again to me, saith the LORD.

again to me <u>06\_JOS\_18\_04</u> # Give out from among you three men for [each] tribe: and I will send them, and they shall rise, and go through the land, and describe it according to the inheritance of them; and they shall come [again] to me.

again to me <u>06\_JOS\_18\_08</u> # And the men arose, and went away: and Joshua charged them that went to describe the land, saying, Go and walk through the land, and describe it, and come again to me, that I may here cast lots for you before the LORD in Shiloh.

again to the <u>17\_EST\_06\_12</u> # And Mordecai came again to the king's gate. But Haman hasted to his house mourning, and having his head covered.

again to the <u>48\_GAL\_04\_09</u> # But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?

again to the <u>43\_JOH\_21\_01</u> # After these things Jesus showed himself again to the disciples at the sea of Tiberias; and on this wise showed he [himself].

again to the <u>25\_LAM\_03\_40</u> # Let us search and try our ways, and turn again to the LORD.

again to the <u>42\_LUK\_04\_20</u># And he closed the book, and he gave [it] again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him.

again to the <u>19\_PSA\_107\_26</u># They mount up to the heaven, they go down again to the depths: their soul is melted because of trouble.

again to thee <u>11\_1KI\_08\_33</u># When thy people Israel be smitten down before the enemy, because they have sinned against thee, and shall turn again to thee, and confess thy name, and pray, and make supplication unto thee in this house:

again until Christ <u>48\_GAL\_04\_19</u># My little children, of whom I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you,

again until he <u>02\_EXO\_34\_35</u> # And the children of Israel saw the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face shone: and Moses put the veil upon his face again, until he went in to speak with him.

again until I <u>10\_2SA\_22\_38</u># I have pursued mine enemies, and destroyed them; and turned not again until I had consumed them.

again until the <u>66\_REV\_20\_05</u># But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This [is] the first resurrection.

again unto a <u>60\_1PE\_01\_03</u># Blessed [be] the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

again unto Ahaz 23\_ISA\_07\_10 # Moreover the LORD spake again unto Ahaz, saying,

again unto Balak <u>04\_NUM\_23\_16</u># And the LORD met Balaam, and put a word in his mouth, and said, Go again unto Balak, and say thus.

again unto Damascus <u>48\_GAL\_01\_17</u> # Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus.

again unto dust <u>18\_JOB\_34\_15</u># All flesh shall perish together, and man shall turn again unto dust.

again unto Pharaoh <u>02\_EXO\_10\_08</u> # And Moses and Aaron were brought again unto Pharaoh: and he said unto them, Go, serve the LORD your God: [but] who [are] they that shall go?

again unto Pihahiroth <u>04\_NUM\_33\_07</u># And they removed from Etham, and turned again unto Pihahiroth, which [is] before Baalzephon: and they pitched before Migdol.

again unto repentance <u>58\_HEB\_06\_06</u># If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put [him] to an open shame.

again unto the <u>11\_1KI\_08\_34</u># Then hear thou in heaven, and forgive the sin of thy people Israel, and bring them again unto the land which thou gavest unto their fathers.

again unto the <u>14\_2CH\_06\_25</u># Then hear thou from the heavens, and forgive the sin of thy people Israel, and bring them again unto the land which thou gavest to them and to their fathers.

again unto thee <u>01\_GEN\_44\_08</u># Behold, the money, which we found in our sacks' mouths, we brought again unto thee out of the land of Canaan: how then should we steal out of thy lord's house silver or gold?

again upon the <u>07\_JUD\_20\_48</u> # And the men of Israel turned again upon the children of Benjamin, and smote them with the edge of the sword, as well the men of [every] city, as the beast, and all that came to hand: also they set on fire all the cities that they came to.

again Verily verily <u>43\_JOH\_10\_07</u> # Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep.

again What did <u>43\_JOH\_09\_26</u> # Then said they to him again, What did he to thee? how opened he thine eyes?

again What sayest <u>43\_JOH\_09\_17</u> # They say unto the blind man again, What sayest thou of him, that he hath opened thine eyes? He said, He is a prophet.

Again When a <u>26\_EZE\_03\_20</u> # Again, When a righteous [man] doth turn from his righteousness, and commit iniquity, and I lay a stumblingblock before him, he shall die: because thou hast not given him warning, he shall die in his sin, and his righteousness which he hath done shall not be remembered; but his blood will I require at thine hand.

again when he <u>60\_1PE\_02\_23</u># Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed [himself] to him that judgeth righteously:

again when he <u>01\_GEN\_35\_09</u># And God appeared unto Jacob again, when he came out of Padanaram, and blessed him.

again when he <u>58\_HEB\_01\_06</u> # And again, when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him.

Again when I <u>26\_EZE\_33\_14</u> # Again, when I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; if he turn from his sin, and do that which is lawful and right;

again when the <u>05\_DEU\_24\_13</u># In any case thou shalt deliver him the pledge again when the sun goeth down, that he may sleep in his own raiment, and bless thee: and it shall be righteousness unto thee before the LORD thy God.

Again when the <u>26\_EZE\_18\_27</u> # Again, when the wicked [man] turneth away from his wickedness that he hath committed, and doeth that which is lawful and right, he shall save his soul alive.

again wherefore their <u>14\_2CH\_25\_10</u> # Then Amaziah separated them, [to wit], the army that was come to him out of Ephraim, to go home again: wherefore their anger was greatly kindled against Judah, and they returned home in great anger.

again wherein ye <u>50\_PHP\_04\_10</u> # But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly, that now at the last your care of me hath flourished again; wherein ye were also careful, but ye lacked opportunity.

again which be <u>58\_HEB\_05\_12</u># For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which [be] the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.

again which ye <u>14\_2CH\_28\_11</u> # Now hear me therefore, and deliver the captives again, which ye have taken captive of your brethren: for the fierce wrath of the LORD [is] upon you.

again who is <u>45\_ROM\_08\_34</u> # Who [is] he that condemneth? [It is] Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

again Whom seek <u>43\_JOH\_18\_07</u># Then asked he them again, Whom seek ye? And they said, Jesus of Nazareth.

again whom should <u>10\_2SA\_16\_19</u> # And again, whom should I serve? [should I] not [serve] in the presence of his son? as I have served in thy father's presence, so will I be in thy presence.

again will ye <u>43\_JOH\_09\_27</u> # He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear [it] again? will ye also be his disciples?

again with a <u>40\_MAT\_27\_50</u># Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost.

again with Israel <u>10\_2SA\_21\_15</u># Moreover the Philistines had yet war again with Israel; and David went down, and his servants with him, and fought against the Philistines: and David waxed faint.

again with joy <u>42\_LUK\_10\_17</u> # And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

again with me <u>09\_1SA\_15\_25</u># Now therefore, I pray thee, pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD.

again with me <u>09\_1SA\_15\_30</u># Then he said, I have sinned: [yet] honour me now, I pray thee, before the elders of my people, and before Israel, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD thy God.

again with rejoicing <u>19\_PSA\_126\_06</u># He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves [with him].

again with ships <u>05\_DEU\_28\_68</u># And the LORD shall bring thee into Egypt again with ships, by the way whereof I spake unto thee, Thou shalt see it no more again: and there ye shall be sold unto your enemies for bondmen and bondwomen, and no man shall buy [you].

again with the <u>13\_1CH\_20\_05</u># And there was war again with the Philistines; and Elhanan the son of Jair slew Lahmi the brother of Goliath the Gittite, whose spear staff [was] like a weaver's beam.

again with the <u>48\_GAL\_05\_01</u> # Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

Again ye have <u>40\_MAT\_05\_33</u># Again, ye have heard that it hath been said by them of old time, Thou shalt not forswear thyself, but shalt perform unto the Lord thine oaths:

again ye may <u>50\_PHP\_02\_28</u># I sent him therefore the more carefully, that, when ye see him again, ye may rejoice, and that I may be the less sorrowful.

again Zion 23\_ISA\_52\_08 # Thy watchmen shall lift up the voice; with the voice together shall they sing: for they shall see eye to eye, when the LORD shall bring again Zion.

again <u>11\_1KI\_02\_41</u># And it was told Solomon that Shimei had gone from Jerusalem to Gath, and was come again.

again <u>11\_1KI\_17\_21</u># And he stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul come into him again.

again <u>47\_2CO\_05\_15</u> # And [that] he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again.

again <u>12\_2KI\_04\_22</u> # And she called unto her husband, and said, Send me, I pray thee, one of the young men, and one of the asses, that I may run to the man of God, and come again.

again <u>12\_2KI\_09\_18</u># So there went one on horseback to meet him, and said, Thus saith the king, [Is it] peace? And Jehu said, What hast thou to do with peace? turn thee behind me. And the watchman told, saying, The messenger came to them, but he cometh not again.

again <u>12\_2KI\_22\_20</u># Behold therefore, I will gather thee unto thy fathers, and thou shalt be gathered into thy grave in peace; and thine eyes shall not see all the evil which I will bring upon this place. And they brought the king word again.

again <u>10\_2SA\_14\_21</u># And the king said unto Joab, Behold now, I have done this thing: go therefore, bring the young man Absalom again.

again <u>44\_ACT\_21\_06</u># And when we had taken our leave one of another, we took ship; and they returned home again.

again <u>30\_AMO\_08\_14</u> # They that swear by the sin of Samaria, and say, Thy god, O Dan, liveth; and, The manner of Beersheba liveth; even they shall fall, and never rise up again.

again <u>05\_DEU\_05\_30</u># Go say to them, Get you into your tents again.

again <u>05\_DEU\_13\_16</u># And thou shalt gather all the spoil of it into the midst of the street thereof, and shalt burn with fire the city, and all the spoil thereof every whit, for the LORD thy God: and it shall be an heap for ever; it shall not be built again.

again <u>05\_DEU\_22\_02</u># And if thy brother [be] not nigh unto thee, or if thou know him not, then thou shalt bring it unto thine own house, and it shall be with thee until thy brother seek after it, and thou shalt restore it to him again.

again <u>01\_GEN\_37\_22</u># And Reuben said unto them, Shed no blood, [but] cast him into this pit that [is] in the wilderness, and lay no hand upon him; that he might rid him out of their hands, to deliver him to his father again.

again <u>01\_GEN\_42\_37</u># And Reuben spake unto his father, saying, Slay my two sons, if I bring him not to thee: deliver him into my hand, and I will bring him to thee again.

again <u>01\_GEN\_50\_05</u># My father made me swear, saying, Lo, I die: in my grave which I have digged for me in the land of Canaan, there shalt thou bury me. Now therefore let me go up, I pray thee, and bury my father, and I will come again.

again <u>23\_ISA\_24\_20</u># The earth shall reel to and fro like a drunkard, and shall be removed like a cottage; and the transgression thereof shall be heavy upon it; and it shall fall, and not rise again.

again 23\_ISA\_51\_22 # Thus saith thy Lord the LORD, and thy God [that] pleadeth the cause of his people, Behold, I have taken out of thine hand the cup of trembling, [even] the dregs of the cup of my fury; thou shalt no more drink it again:

again <u>18\_JOB\_10\_09</u># Remember, I beseech thee, that thou hast made me as the clay; and wilt thou bring me into dust again?

again <u>18\_JOB\_12\_23</u> # He increaseth the nations, and destroyeth them: he enlargeth the nations, and straiteneth them [again].

again <u>43\_JOH\_03\_07</u> # Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

again <u>43\_JOH\_04\_13</u> # Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:

again <u>43\_JOH\_10\_17</u> # Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again.

again <u>43\_JOH\_11\_07</u># Then after that saith he to [his] disciples, Let us go into Judaea again.

again <u>43\_JOH\_11\_08</u># [His] disciples say unto him, Master, the Jews of late sought to stone thee; and goest thou thither again?

again <u>43\_JOH\_11\_23</u> # Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.

again <u>43\_JOH\_12\_28</u> # Father, glorify thy name. Then came there a voice from heaven, [saying], I have both glorified [it], and will glorify [it] again.

again <u>43\_JOH\_12\_39</u># Therefore they could not believe, because that Esaias said again,

again <u>06\_JOS\_22\_32</u># And Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest, and the princes, returned from the children of Reuben, and from the children of Gad, out of the land of Gilead, unto the land of Canaan, to the children of Israel, and brought them word again.

again <u>07\_JUD\_06\_18</u> # Depart not hence, I pray thee, until I come unto thee, and bring forth my present,

and set [it] before thee. And he said, I will tarry until thou come again.

again <u>07\_JUD\_19\_07</u># And when the man rose up to depart, his father in law urged him: therefore he lodged there again.

again <u>03\_LEV\_13\_07</u># But if the scab spread much abroad in the skin, after that he hath been seen of the priest for his cleansing, he shall be seen of the priest again:

again <u>40\_MAT\_07\_02</u># For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.

again <u>40\_MAT\_20\_19</u># And shall deliver him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to crucify [him]: and the third day he shall rise again.

again <u>40\_MAT\_27\_63</u># Saying, Sir, we remember that that deceiver said, while he was yet alive, After three days I will rise again.

again <u>04\_NUM\_12\_14</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, If her father had but spit in her face, should she not be ashamed seven days? let her be shut out from the camp seven days, and after that let her be received in [again].

again <u>50\_PHP\_01\_26</u># That your rejoicing may be more abundant in Jesus Christ for me by my coming to you again.

again <u>20\_PRO\_19\_17</u># He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the LORD; and that which he hath given will he pay him again.

again <u>20\_PRO\_19\_19</u># A man of great wrath shall suffer punishment: for if thou deliver [him], yet thou must do it again.

again <u>20\_PRO\_19\_24</u># A slothful [man] hideth his hand in [his] bosom, and will not so much as bring it to his mouth again.

again <u>20\_PRO\_23\_35</u># They have stricken me, [shalt thou say, and] I was not sick; they have beaten me, [and] I felt [it] not: when shall I awake? I will seek it yet again.

again <u>19\_PSA\_140\_10</u># Let burning coals fall upon them: let them be cast into the fire; into deep pits, that they rise not up again.

again <u>19\_PSA\_60\_01</u> # To the chief Musician upon Shushaneduth, Michtam of David, to teach; when he strove with Aramnaharaim and with Aramzobah, when Joab returned, and smote of Edom in the valley of salt twelve thousand. O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast scattered us, thou hast been displeased; O turn thyself to us again.

again <u>19\_PSA\_78\_39</u># For he remembered that they [were but] flesh; a wind that passeth away, and cometh not again.

again <u>45\_ROM\_11\_23</u># And they also, if they abide not still in unbelief, shall be grafted in: for God is able to graft them in again.

again <u>45\_ROM\_11\_35</u># Or who hath first given to him, and it shall be recompensed unto him again?

again <u>56\_TIT\_02\_09</u># [Exhort] servants to be obedient unto their own masters, [and] to please [them] well in all [things]; not answering again;

again <u>38\_ZEC\_02\_12</u># And the LORD shall inherit Judah his portion in the holy land, and shall choose Jerusalem again.

again <u>38\_ZEC\_10\_09</u># And I will sow them among the people: and they shall remember me in far countries; and they shall live with their children, and turn again.
