synagogue Jairus by <u>41\_MAR\_05\_22</u> # And, behold, there cometh one of the rulers of the synagogue, Jairus by name; and when he saw him, he fell at his feet,

synagogue of Satan <u>66\_REV\_02\_09</u> # I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, [but thou art rich] and [I know] the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but [are] the synagogue of Satan.

synagogue of Satan <u>66\_REV\_03\_09</u> # Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.

synagogue of the 44\_ACT\_06\_09 # Then there arose certain of the synagogue, which is called [the synagogue] of the Libertines, and Cyrenians, and Alexandrians, and of them of Cilicia and of Asia,

synagogues being glorified 42\_LUK\_04\_15 # And he taught in their synagogues, being glorified of all.

synagogues every sabbath <u>44\_ACT\_15\_21</u># For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day.

synagogues nor in 44\_ACT\_24\_12 # And they neither found me in the temple disputing with any man, neither raising up the people, neither in the synagogues, nor in the city:

synagogues of God 19\_PSA\_74\_08 # They said in their hearts, Let us destroy them together: they have burned up all the synagogues of God in the land.

synagogues of the <u>44\_ACT\_13\_05</u># And when they were at Salamis, they preached the word of God in the synagogues of the Jews: and they had also John to [their] minister.

synagogues on the 42\_LUK\_13\_10 # And he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath.

synagogues that he <u>44\_ACT\_09\_20</u># And straightway he preached Christ in the synagogues, that he is the Son of God.

synagogues that if 44\_ACT\_09\_02 # And desired of him letters to Damascus to the synagogues, that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them bound unto Jerusalem.

synagogues throughout all <u>41\_MAR\_01\_39</u># And he preached in their synagogues throughout all Galilee, and cast out devils.
