

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Abraham a son <u>01\_GEN\_21\_02</u># For Sarah conceived, and bare Abraham a son in his old age, at the set time of which God had spoken to him.

Abraham Abraham and <u>01\_GEN\_22\_11</u># And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here [am] I.

Abraham afar off <u>42\_LUK\_16\_23</u> # And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.

Abraham and Abraham <u>01\_GEN\_18\_33</u> # And the LORD went his way, as soon as he had left communing with Abraham: and Abraham returned unto his place.

Abraham and blessed <u>58\_HEB\_07\_06</u> # But he whose descent is not counted from them received tithes of Abraham, and blessed him that had the promises.

Abraham and God <u>01\_GEN\_32\_09</u># And Jacob said, O God of my father Abraham, and God of my father Isaac, the LORD which saidst unto me, Return unto thy country, and to thy kindred, and I will deal well with thee:

Abraham and he <u>01\_GEN\_22\_01</u> # And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, [here] I [am].

Abraham and he <u>01\_GEN\_22\_11</u># And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here [am] I.

Abraham and he <u>01\_GEN\_26\_18</u># And Isaac digged again the wells of water, which they had digged in the days of Abraham his father; for the Philistines had stopped them after the death of Abraham: and he called their names after the names by which his father had called them.

Abraham and his <u>48\_GAL\_03\_16</u> # Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ.

Abraham and his 19\_PSA\_105\_09 # Which [covenant] he made with Abraham, and his oath unto Isaac;

Abraham And in <u>44\_ACT\_03\_25</u># Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed.

Abraham And Isaac <u>01\_GEN\_26\_01</u># And there was a famine in the land, beside the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. And Isaac went unto Abimelech king of the Philistines unto Gerar.

Abraham and Isaac <u>01\_GEN\_35\_12</u> # And the land which I gave Abraham and Isaac, to thee I will give it, and to thy seed after thee will I give the land.

Abraham and Isaac <u>01\_GEN\_35\_27</u> # And Jacob came unto Isaac his father unto Mamre, unto the city of Arbah, which [is] Hebron, where Abraham and Isaac sojourned.

Abraham and Isaac <u>01\_GEN\_48\_15</u># And he blessed Joseph, and said, God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac did walk, the God which fed me all my life long unto this day,

Abraham and Isaac <u>01 GEN 48 16 #</u> The Angel which redeemed me from all evil, bless the lads; and let my name be named on them, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.

Abraham and Isaac <u>42 LUK 13 28 #</u> There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you [yourselves] thrust out.

Abraham and Isaac 40 MAT 08 11 And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven.

Abraham and of 13\_1CH\_16\_16# [Even of the covenant] which he made with Abraham, and of his oath unto Isaac;

Abraham and of <u>44\_ACT\_03\_13</u># The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let [him] go.

Abraham and restored <u>01\_GEN\_20\_14</u># And Abimelech took sheep, and oxen, and menservants, and womenservants, and gave [them] unto Abraham, and restored him Sarah his wife.

Abraham and said <u>01\_GEN\_20\_09</u># Then Abimelech called Abraham, and said unto him, What hast thou done unto us? and what have I offended thee, that thou hast brought on me and on my kingdom a great sin? thou hast done deeds unto me that ought not to be done.

Abraham and said <u>01\_GEN\_22\_01</u> # And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, [here] I [am].

Abraham and Sarah <u>01\_GEN\_18\_11</u># Now Abraham and Sarah [were] old [and] well stricken in age; [and] it ceased to be with Sarah after the manner of women.

Abraham and Sarah <u>01\_GEN\_49\_31</u># There they buried Abraham and Sarah his wife; there they buried Isaac and Rebekah his wife; and there I buried Leah.

Abraham and sent <u>01\_GEN\_19\_29</u># And it came to pass, when God destroyed the cities of the plain, that God remembered Abraham, and sent Lot out of the midst of the overthrow, when he overthrew the cities in the which Lot dwelt.

Abraham and the 44\_ACT\_07\_32 # [Saying], I [am] the God of thy fathers, the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. Then Moses trembled, and durst not behold.

Abraham and the <u>01\_GEN\_31\_42</u># Except the God of my father, the God of Abraham, and the fear of Isaac, had been with me, surely thou hadst sent me away now empty. God hath seen mine affliction and the labour of my hands, and rebuked [thee] yesternight.

Abraham and the <u>01\_GEN\_31\_53</u> # The God of Abraham, and the God of Nahor, the God of their father, judge betwixt us. And Jacob sware by the fear of his father Isaac.

Abraham and the <u>06\_JOS\_24\_02</u># And Joshua said unto all the people, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Your fathers dwelt on the other side of the flood in old time, [even] Terah, the father of Abraham, and the father of Nachor: and they served other gods.

Abraham and the <u>42\_LUK\_20\_37</u># Now that the dead are raised, even Moses showed at the bush, when he calleth the Lord the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.

Abraham and the <u>41\_MAR\_12\_26</u># And as touching the dead, that they rise: have ye not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush God spake unto him, saying, I [am] the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?

Abraham and the 40 MAT 22 32 # I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.

Abraham and to 42\_LUK\_01\_55 # As he spake to our fathers, to Abraham, and to his seed for ever.

Abraham and whosoever <u>44\_ACT\_13\_26</u> # Men [and] brethren, children of the stock of Abraham, and whosoever among you feareth God, to you is the word of this salvation sent.

Abraham answered and <u>01\_GEN\_18\_27</u> # And Abraham answered and said, Behold now, I have taken upon me to speak unto the Lord, which [am but] dust and ashes:

Abraham are they <u>45\_ROM\_09\_07</u> # Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, [are they] all children: but, In Isaac shall thy seed be called.

Abraham As for <u>01\_GEN\_17\_15</u> # And God said unto Abraham, As for Sarai thy wife, thou shalt not call her name Sarai, but Sarah [shall] her name [be].

Abraham be ignorant 23 ISA 63 16 # Doubtless thou [art] our father, though Abraham be ignorant of us, and Israel acknowledge us not: thou, O LORD, [art] our father, our redeemer; thy name [is] from everlasting.

Abraham because he <u>58\_HEB\_06\_13</u> # For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself,

Abraham begat Isaac 13\_1CH\_01\_34 # And Abraham begat Isaac. The sons of Isaac; Esau and Israel.

Abraham begat Isaac <u>44\_ACT\_07\_08</u># And he gave him the covenant of circumcision: and so [Abraham] begat Isaac, and circumcised him the eighth day; and Isaac [begat] Jacob; and Jacob [begat] the twelve patriarchs.

Abraham begat Isaac <u>01\_GEN\_25\_19</u># And these [are] the generations of Isaac, Abraham's son: Abraham begat Isaac:

Abraham begat Isaac <u>40\_MAT\_01\_02</u># Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren;

Abraham believed God <u>48\_GAL\_03\_06</u># Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.

Abraham believed God <u>59\_JAM\_02\_23</u># And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.

Abraham believed God <u>45\_ROM\_04\_03</u># For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.

Abraham bought for 44\_ACT\_07\_16 # And were carried over into Sychem, and laid in the sepulchre that Abraham bought for a sum of money of the sons of Emmor [the father] of Sychem.

Abraham bought with <u>01\_GEN\_49\_30</u># In the cave that [is] in the field of Machpelah, which [is] before Mamre, in the land of Canaan, which Abraham bought with the field of Ephron the Hittite for a possession

of a buryingplace.

Abraham bought with <u>01\_GEN\_50\_13</u># For his sons carried him into the land of Canaan, and buried him in the cave of the field of Machpelah, which Abraham bought with the field for a possession of a buryingplace of Ephron the Hittite, before Mamre.

Abraham bowed down 01\_GEN\_23\_12 # And Abraham bowed down himself before the people of the land.

Abraham built an <u>01\_GEN\_22\_09</u># And they came to the place which God had told him of; and Abraham built an altar there, and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son, and laid him on the altar upon the wood.

Abraham buried and <u>01\_GEN\_25\_10</u># The field which Abraham purchased of the sons of Heth: there was Abraham buried, and Sarah his wife.

Abraham buried Sarah <u>01\_GEN\_23\_19</u># And after this, Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah before Mamre: the same [is] Hebron in the land of Canaan.

Abraham but if <u>42\_LUK\_16\_30</u> # And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent.

Abraham by promise <u>48\_GAL\_03\_18</u># For if the inheritance [be] of the law, [it is] no more of promise: but God gave [it] to Abraham by promise.

Abraham called the <u>01\_GEN\_21\_03</u># And Abraham called the name of his son that was born unto him, whom Sarah bare to him, Isaac.

Abraham called the <u>01\_GEN\_22\_14</u> # And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh: as it is said [to] this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.

Abraham calling him <u>60\_1PE\_03\_06</u> # Even as Sara obeyed Abraham, calling him lord: whose daughters ye are, as long as ye do well, and are not afraid with any amazement.

Abraham came to <u>01\_GEN\_23\_02</u> # And Sarah died in Kirjatharba; the same [is] Hebron in the land of Canaan: and Abraham came to mourn for Sarah, and to weep for her.

Abraham Cast out <u>01\_GEN\_21\_10</u># Wherefore she said unto Abraham, Cast out this bondwoman and her son: for the son of this bondwoman shall not be heir with my son, [even] with Isaac.

Abraham circumcised and <u>01\_GEN\_17\_26</u># In the selfsame day was Abraham circumcised, and Ishmael his son.

Abraham circumcised his <u>01\_GEN\_21\_04</u> # And Abraham circumcised his son Isaac being eight days old, as God had commanded him.

Abraham concerning the 23\_ISA\_29\_22 # Therefore thus saith the LORD, who redeemed Abraham, concerning the house of Jacob, Jacob shall not now be ashamed, neither shall his face now wax pale.

Abraham drew near <u>01\_GEN\_18\_23</u> # And Abraham drew near, and said, Wilt thou also destroy the righteous with the wicked?

Abraham dwelt at <u>01\_GEN\_22\_19</u># So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.

Abraham fell upon 01\_GEN\_17\_17 # Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart,

Shall [a child] be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear?

Abraham for a <u>01\_GEN\_17\_05</u># Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee.

Abraham for a <u>01\_GEN\_23\_18</u># Unto Abraham for a possession in the presence of the children of Heth, before all that went in at the gate of his city.

Abraham for a <u>01\_GEN\_23\_20</u> # And the field, and the cave that [is] therein, were made sure unto Abraham for a possession of a buryingplace by the sons of Heth.

Abraham for righteousness 45\_ROM\_04\_09 # [Cometh] this blessedness then upon the circumcision [only], or upon the uncircumcision also? for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness.

Abraham for the 19 PSA 47 09 # The princes of the people are gathered together, [even] the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth [belong] unto God: he is greatly exalted.

Abraham from the <u>06\_JOS\_24\_03</u># And I took your father Abraham from the other side of the flood, and led him throughout all the land of Canaan, and multiplied his seed, and gave him Isaac.

Abraham gat up <u>01\_GEN\_19\_27</u># And Abraham gat up early in the morning to the place where he stood before the LORD:

Abraham gave a <u>58\_HEB\_07\_02</u> # To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace;

Abraham gave all 01\_GEN\_25\_05 # And Abraham gave all that he had unto Isaac.

Abraham gave gifts <u>01\_GEN\_25\_06</u> # But unto the sons of the concubines, which Abraham had, Abraham gave gifts, and sent them away from Isaac his son, while he yet lived, eastward, unto the east country.

Abraham gave the <u>58\_HEB\_07\_04</u># Now consider how great this man [was], unto whom even the patriarch Abraham gave the tenth of the spoils.

Abraham gave up <u>01\_GEN\_25\_08</u># Then Abraham gave up the ghost, and died in a good old age, an old man, and full [of years]; and was gathered to his people.

Abraham had Abraham <u>01\_GEN\_25\_06</u># But unto the sons of the concubines, which Abraham had, Abraham gave gifts, and sent them away from Isaac his son, while he yet lived, eastward, unto the east country.

Abraham had two <u>48\_GAL\_04\_22</u># For it is written, that Abraham had two sons, the one by a bondmaid, the other by a freewoman.

Abraham hastened into <u>01\_GEN\_18\_06</u># And Abraham hastened into the tent unto Sarah, and said, Make ready quickly three measures of fine meal, knead [it], and make cakes upon the hearth.

Abraham have mercy <u>42\_LUK\_16\_24</u> # And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.

Abraham hearkened unto <u>01\_GEN\_23\_16</u># And Abraham hearkened unto Ephron; and Abraham weighed to Ephron the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current [money] with the merchant.

Abraham his father <u>01\_GEN\_22\_07</u># And Isaac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here [am] I, my son. And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where [is] the lamb for a burnt offering?

Abraham his father <u>01\_GEN\_26\_15</u> # For all the wells which his father's servants had digged in the days of Abraham his father, the Philistines had stopped them, and filled them with earth.

Abraham his father <u>01\_GEN\_26\_18</u># And Isaac digged again the wells of water, which they had digged in the days of Abraham his father; for the Philistines had stopped them after the death of Abraham: and he called their names after the names by which his father had called them.

Abraham his master <u>01\_GEN\_24\_09</u> # And the servant put his hand under the thigh of Abraham his master, and sware to him concerning that matter.

Abraham his servant 19\_PSA\_105\_06 # O ye seed of Abraham his servant, ye children of Jacob his chosen.

Abraham his servant 19\_PSA\_105\_42 # For he remembered his holy promise, [and] Abraham his servant.

Abraham I pray <u>01\_GEN\_24\_12</u> # And he said, O LORD God of my master Abraham, I pray thee, send me good speed this day, and show kindness unto my master Abraham.

Abraham if now <u>01\_GEN\_24\_42</u># And I came this day unto the well, and said, O LORD God of my master Abraham, if now thou do prosper my way which I go:

Abraham in all <u>01\_GEN\_24\_01</u># And Abraham was old, [and] well stricken in age: and the LORD had blessed Abraham in all things.

Abraham in the <u>01\_GEN\_23\_10</u> # And Ephron dwelt among the children of Heth: and Ephron the Hittite answered Abraham in the audience of the children of Heth, [even] of all that went in at the gate of his city, saying,

Abraham is dead <u>43\_JOH\_08\_52</u> # Then said the Jews unto him, Now we know that thou hast a devil. Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and thou sayest, If a man keep my saying, he shall never taste of death.

Abraham is our <u>43\_JOH\_08\_39</u> # They answered and said unto him, Abraham is our father. Jesus saith unto them, If ye were Abraham's children, ye would do the works of Abraham.

Abraham Isaac and 13\_1CH\_01\_28 # The sons of Abraham; Isaac, and Ishmael.

Abraham Isaac and 13\_1CH\_29\_18 # O LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, our fathers, keep this for ever in the imagination of the thoughts of the heart of thy people, and prepare their heart unto thee:

Abraham Isaac and <a href="mailto:11\_1KI\_18\_36">11\_1KI\_18\_36</a># And it came to pass at [the time of] the offering of the [evening] sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou [art] God in Israel, and [that] I [am] thy servant, and [that] I have done all these things at thy word.

Abraham Isaac and 14\_2CH\_30\_06 # So the posts went with the letters from the king and his princes throughout all Israel and Judah, and according to the commandment of the king, saying, Ye children of Israel, turn again unto the LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, and he will return to the remnant of you, that are escaped out of the hand of the kings of Assyria.

Abraham Isaac and 12\_2KI\_13\_23 # And the LORD was gracious unto them, and had compassion on them, and had respect unto them, because of his covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not

destroy them, neither cast he them from his presence as yet.

Abraham Isaac and <u>05\_DEU\_01\_08</u># Behold, I have set the land before you: go in and possess the land which the LORD sware unto your fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give unto them and to their seed after them.

Abraham Isaac and <u>05\_DEU\_09\_05</u># Not for thy righteousness, or for the uprightness of thine heart, dost thou go to possess their land: but for the wickedness of these nations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee, and that he may perform the word which the LORD sware unto thy fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

Abraham Isaac and <u>05\_DEU\_09\_27</u># Remember thy servants, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; look not unto the stubbornness of this people, nor to their wickedness, nor to their sin:

Abraham Isaac and <u>02\_EXO\_32\_13</u> # Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, thy servants, to whom thou swarest by thine own self, and saidst unto them, I will multiply your seed as the stars of heaven, and all this land that I have spoken of will I give unto your seed, and they shall inherit [it] for ever.

Abraham Isaac and 24 JER\_33\_26 # Then will I cast away the seed of Jacob, and David my servant, [so] that I will not take [any] of his seed [to be] rulers over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: for I will cause their captivity to return, and have mercy on them.

Abraham journeyed from <u>01\_GEN\_20\_01</u> # And Abraham journeyed from thence toward the south country, and dwelled between Kadesh and Shur, and sojourned in Gerar.

Abraham Let it <u>01\_GEN\_21\_12</u># And God said unto Abraham, Let it not be grievous in thy sight because of the lad, and because of thy bondwoman; in all that Sarah hath said unto thee, hearken unto her voice; for in Isaac shall thy seed be called.

Abraham lifted up <u>01\_GEN\_22\_04</u># Then on the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes, and saw the place afar off.

Abraham lifted up <u>01\_GEN\_22\_13</u># And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind [him] a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

Abraham made a <u>01\_GEN\_21\_08</u># And the child grew, and was weaned: and Abraham made a great feast the [same] day that Isaac was weaned.

Abraham might come <u>48\_GAL\_03\_14</u> # That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Abraham mocking <u>01\_GEN\_21\_09</u># And Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, which she had born unto Abraham, mocking.

Abraham my friend 23 ISA 41 08 # But thou, Israel, [art] my servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, the seed of Abraham my friend.

Abraham obeyed my <u>01\_GEN\_26\_05</u> # Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws.

Abraham of Isaac <u>02\_EXO\_03\_16</u># Go, and gather the elders of Israel together, and say unto them, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, appeared unto me, saying, I have surely visited you, and [seen] that which is done to you in Egypt:

Abraham of the <u>45\_ROM\_11\_01</u># I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, [of] the tribe of Benjamin.

Abraham or to <u>45\_ROM\_04\_13</u> # For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, [was] not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.

Abraham our father <u>59\_JAM\_02\_21</u> # Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar?

Abraham our father <u>45\_ROM\_04\_01</u> # What shall we say then that Abraham our father, as pertaining to the flesh, hath found?

Abraham out of <u>01\_GEN\_22\_15</u># And the angel of the LORD called unto Abraham out of heaven the second time,

Abraham planted a <u>01\_GEN\_21\_33</u> # And [Abraham] planted a grove in Beersheba, and called there on the name of the LORD, the everlasting God.

Abraham prayed unto <u>01\_GEN\_20\_17</u> # So Abraham prayed unto God: and God healed Abimelech, and his wife, and his maidservants; and they bare [children].

Abraham purchased of <u>01\_GEN\_25\_10</u> # The field which Abraham purchased of the sons of Heth: there was Abraham buried, and Sarah his wife.

Abraham ran unto <u>01\_GEN\_18\_07</u># And Abraham ran unto the herd, and fetched a calf tender and good, and gave [it] unto a young man; and he hasted to dress it.

Abraham rejoiced to 43\_JOH\_08\_56 # Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw [it], and was glad.

Abraham reproved Abimelech <u>01\_GEN\_21\_25</u># And Abraham reproved Abimelech because of a well of water, which Abimelech's servants had violently taken away.

Abraham returned unto <u>01\_GEN\_18\_33</u> # And the LORD went his way, as soon as he had left communing with Abraham: and Abraham returned unto his place.

Abraham returned unto <u>01\_GEN\_22\_19</u># So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.

Abraham returning from <u>58\_HEB\_07\_01</u># For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him;

Abraham rose up <u>01\_GEN\_21\_14</u> # And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave [it] unto Hagar, putting [it] on her shoulder, and the child, and sent her away: and she departed, and wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba.

Abraham rose up <u>01\_GEN\_22\_03</u># And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him.

Abraham said Because <u>01\_GEN\_20\_11</u># And Abraham said, Because I thought, Surely the fear of God [is] not in this place; and they will slay me for my wife's sake.

Abraham said Son <u>42\_LUK\_16\_25</u> # But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented.

Abraham said unto 01\_GEN\_17\_18 # And Abraham said unto God, O that Ishmael might live before thee!

Abraham said unto <u>01\_GEN\_22\_05</u> # And Abraham said unto his young men, Abide ye here with the ass; and I and the lad will go yonder and worship, and come again to you.

Abraham said unto <u>01\_GEN\_24\_02</u># And Abraham said unto his eldest servant of his house, that ruled over all that he had, Put, I pray thee, thy hand under my thigh:

Abraham said unto <u>01\_GEN\_24\_06</u># And Abraham said unto him, Beware thou that thou bring not my son thither again.

Abraham saith unto 42\_LUK\_16\_29 # Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.

Abraham saying Behold <u>01\_GEN\_22\_20</u># And it came to pass after these things, that it was told Abraham, saying, Behold, Milcah, she hath also born children unto thy brother Nahor;

Abraham saying God <u>01\_GEN\_21\_22</u> # And it came to pass at that time, that Abimelech and Phichol the chief captain of his host spake unto Abraham, saying, God [is] with thee in all that thou doest:

Abraham set seven 01\_GEN\_21\_28 # And Abraham set seven ewe lambs of the flock by themselves.

Abraham shall surely <u>01\_GEN\_18\_18</u> # Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?

Abraham so am <u>47\_2CO\_11\_22</u># Are they Hebrews? so [am] I. Are they Israelites? so [am] I. Are they the seed of Abraham? so [am] I.

Abraham sojourned in 01\_GEN\_21\_34 # And Abraham sojourned in the Philistines' land many days.

Abraham stood up <u>01\_GEN\_23\_03</u># And Abraham stood up from before his dead, and spake unto the sons of Heth, saying,

Abraham stood up <u>01\_GEN\_23\_07</u> # And Abraham stood up, and bowed himself to the people of the land, [even] to the children of Heth.

Abraham stood yet <u>01\_GEN\_18\_22</u> # And the men turned their faces from thence, and went toward Sodom: but Abraham stood yet before the LORD.

Abraham was one <u>26 EZE 33 24 #</u> Son of man, they that inhabit those wastes of the land of Israel speak, saying, Abraham was one, and he inherited the land: but we [are] many; the land is given us for inheritance.

Abraham weighed to <u>01\_GEN\_23\_16</u># And Abraham hearkened unto Ephron; and Abraham weighed to Ephron the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current [money] with the merchant.

Abraham went and <u>01\_GEN\_22\_13</u># And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind [him] a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

Abraham when he <u>44\_ACT\_07\_02</u> # And he said, Men, brethren, and fathers, hearken; The God of glory appeared unto our father Abraham, when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Charran,

Abraham when he <u>58\_HEB\_11\_08</u># By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.

Abraham when he <u>58\_HEB\_11\_17</u># By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten [son].

Abraham Wherefore did <u>01\_GEN\_18\_13</u> # And the LORD said unto Abraham, Wherefore did Sarah laugh, saying, Shall I of a surety bear a child, which am old?

Abraham which had <u>01\_GEN\_24\_48</u># And I bowed down my head, and worshipped the LORD, and blessed the LORD God of my master Abraham, which had led me in the right way to take my master's brother's daughter unto his son.

Abraham which he <u>45\_ROM\_04\_12</u># And the father of circumcision to them who are not of the circumcision only, but who also walk in the steps of that faith of our father Abraham, which [he had] being [yet] uncircumcised.

Abraham which is <u>43\_JOH\_08\_53</u> # Art thou greater than our father Abraham, which is dead? and the prophets are dead: whom makest thou thyself?

Abraham which thou <u>33\_MIC\_07\_20</u> # Thou wilt perform the truth to Jacob, [and] the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.

Abraham which was 42\_LUK\_03\_34 # Which was [the son] of Jacob, which was [the son] of Isaac, which was [the son] of Abraham, which was [the son] of Thara, which was [the son] of Nachor,

Abraham who hath <u>01\_GEN\_24\_27</u># And he said, Blessed [be] the LORD God of my master Abraham, who hath not left destitute my master of his mercy and his truth: I [being] in the way, the LORD led me to the house of my master's brethren.

Abraham who is <u>45\_ROM\_04\_16</u> # Therefore [it is] of faith, that [it might be] by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

Abraham whom Satan 42\_LUK\_13\_16 # And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?

Abraham 01\_GEN\_17\_22 # And he left off talking with him, and God went up from Abraham.

Aha aha our 19\_PSA\_35\_21 # Yea, they opened their mouth wide against me, [and] said, Aha, aha, our eye hath seen [it].

Aha aha 19\_PSA\_40\_15 # Let them be desolate for a reward of their shame that say unto me, Aha, aha.

Aha aha 19\_PSA\_70\_03 # Let them be turned back for a reward of their shame that say, Aha, aha.

Aha even the <u>26\_EZE\_36\_02</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because the enemy hath said against you, Aha, even the ancient high places are ours in possession:

Aha I am 23\_ISA\_44\_16 # He burneth part thereof in the fire; with part thereof he eateth flesh; he roasteth roast, and is satisfied: yea, he warmeth [himself], and saith, Aha, I am warm, I have seen the fire:

aha our eye 19\_PSA\_35\_21 # Yea, they opened their mouth wide against me, [and] said, Aha, aha, our eye hath seen [it].

Aha she is <u>26\_EZE\_26\_02</u> # Son of man, because that Tyrus hath said against Jerusalem, Aha, she is broken [that was] the gates of the people: she is turned unto me: I shall be replenished, [now] she is laid waste:

aha 19\_PSA\_40\_15 # Let them be desolate for a reward of their shame that say unto me, Aha, aha.

aha 19\_PSA\_70\_03 # Let them be turned back for a reward of their shame that say, Aha, aha.

Ahab according to 12\_2KI\_10\_30 # And the LORD said unto Jehu, Because thou hast done well in executing [that which is] right in mine eyes, [and] hast done unto the house of Ahab according to all that [was] in mine heart, thy children of the fourth [generation] shall sit on the throne of Israel.

Ahab and all 11 1KI 22 39 # Now the rest of the acts of Ahab, and all that he did, and the ivory house which he made, and all the cities that he built, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Ahab and also 14\_2CH\_21\_13 # But hast walked in the way of the kings of Israel, and hast made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to go a whoring, like to the whoredoms of the house of Ahab, and also hast slain thy brethren of thy father's house, [which were] better than thyself:

Ahab Arise take 11\_1KI\_21\_15# And it came to pass, when Jezebel heard that Naboth was stoned, and was dead, that Jezebel said to Ahab, Arise, take possession of the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, which he refused to give thee for money: for Naboth is not alive, but dead.

Ahab As the <u>11\_1KI\_17\_01</u># And Elijah the Tishbite, [who was] of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, [As] the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.

Ahab at Jezreel <u>14\_2CH\_22\_06</u># And he returned to be healed in Jezreel because of the wounds which were given him at Ramah, when he fought with Hazael king of Syria. And Azariah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Jehoram the son of Ahab at Jezreel, because he was sick.

Ahab began Ahaziah 12 2KI 09 29 # And in the eleventh year of Joram the son of Ahab began Ahaziah to reign over Judah.

Ahab began to 11 1KI 22 51 # Ahaziah the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the seventeenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned two years over Israel.

Ahab began to 12 2KI 03 01 # Now Jehoram the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the eighteenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned twelve years.

Ahab called Obadiah 11\_1KI\_18\_03 # And Ahab called Obadiah, which [was] the governor of [his] house. [Now Obadiah feared the LORD greatly:

Ahab came into 11\_1KI\_21\_04# And Ahab came into his house heavy and displeased because of the word which Naboth the Jezreelite had spoken to him: for he had said, I will not give thee the inheritance of my fathers. And he laid him down upon his bed, and turned away his face, and would eat no bread.

Ahab did more 11\_1KI\_16\_33 # And Ahab made a grove; and Ahab did more to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger than all the kings of Israel that were before him.

Ahab for he 12 2KI 08 27 # And he walked in the way of the house of Ahab, and did evil in the sight of the LORD, as [did] the house of Ahab: for he [was] the son in law of the house of Ahab.

Ahab for his 14\_2CH\_22\_03 # He also walked in the ways of the house of Ahab: for his mother was his counsellor to do wickedly.

Ahab had seventy 12\_2KI\_10\_01 # And Ahab had seventy sons in Samaria. And Jehu wrote letters, and sent to Samaria, unto the rulers of Jezreel, to the elders, and to them that brought up Ahab's [children], saying,

Ahab heard that <u>11\_1KI\_21\_16</u># And it came to pass, when Ahab heard that Naboth was dead, that Ahab rose up to go down to the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, to take possession of it.

Ahab heard those 11\_1KI\_21\_27# And it came to pass, when Ahab heard those words, that he rent his clothes, and put sackcloth upon his flesh, and fasted, and lay in sackcloth, and went softly.

Ahab him that 11\_1KI\_21\_21# Behold, I will bring evil upon thee, and will take away thy posterity, and will cut off from Ahab him that pisseth against the wall, and him that is shut up and left in Israel,

Ahab the son 11 1KI 16 29 # And in the thirty and eighth year of Asa king of Judah began Ahab the son of Omri to reign over Israel: and Ahab the son of Omri reigned over Israel in Samaria twenty and two years.

Ahab unto Jehoshaphat 11\_1KI\_22\_49 # Then said Ahaziah the son of Ahab unto Jehoshaphat, Let my servants go with thy servants in the ships. But Jehoshaphat would not.

Ahab was dead 12\_2KI\_03\_05# But it came to pass, when Ahab was dead, that the king of Moab rebelled against the king of Israel.

Ahab was his 12\_2KI\_08\_18 # And he walked in the way of the kings of Israel, as did the house of Ahab: for the daughter of Ahab was his wife: and he did evil in the sight of the LORD.

Ahab <u>14\_2CH\_18\_01</u> # Now Jehoshaphat had riches and honour in abundance, and joined affinity with Ahab.

Ahab <u>14\_2CH\_22\_07</u># And the destruction of Ahaziah was of God by coming to Joram: for when he was come, he went out with Jehoram against Jehu the son of Nimshi, whom the LORD had anointed to cut off the house of Ahab.

Aharah the third 13\_1CH\_08\_01 # Now Benjamin begat Bela his firstborn, Ashbel the second, and Aharah the third,

Aharhel the son 13\_1CH\_04\_08 # And Coz begat Anub, and Zobebah, and the families of Aharhel the son of Harum.

Ahasai the son <u>16\_NEH\_11\_13</u># And his brethren, chief of the fathers, two hundred forty and two: and Amashai the son of Azareel, the son of Ahasai, the son of Meshillemoth, the son of Immer,

Ahasbai the son <u>10\_2SA\_23\_34</u># Eliphelet the son of Ahasbai, the son of the Maachathite, Eliam the son of Ahithophel the Gilonite,

Ahasuerus after that <u>17\_EST\_02\_12</u> # Now when every maid's turn was come to go in to king Ahasuerus, after that she had been twelve months, according to the manner of the women, [for so were the days of their purifications accomplished, [to wit], six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with sweet odours, and with [other] things for the purifying of the women;]

Ahasuerus and great <u>17\_EST\_10\_03</u># For Mordecai the Jew [was] next unto king Ahasuerus, and great among the Jews, and accepted of the multitude of his brethren, seeking the wealth of his people, and speaking peace to all his seed.

Ahasuerus and let <u>17\_EST\_01\_19</u># If it please the king, let there go a royal commandment from him, and let it be written among the laws of the Persians and the Medes, that it be not altered, That Vashti come no more before king Ahasuerus; and let the king give her royal estate unto another that is better than she.

Ahasuerus answered and <u>17\_EST\_07\_05</u># Then the king Ahasuerus answered and said unto Esther the queen, Who is he, and where is he, that durst presume in his heart to do so?

Ahasuerus both nigh <u>17\_EST\_09\_20</u> # And Mordecai wrote these things, and sent letters unto all the Jews that [were] in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus, [both] nigh and far,

Ahasuerus by the <u>17\_EST\_01\_15</u># What shall we do unto the queen Vashti according to law, because she hath not performed the commandment of the king Ahasuerus by the chamberlains?

Ahasuerus commanded Vashti <u>17\_EST\_01\_17</u># For [this] deed of the queen shall come abroad unto all women, so that they shall despise their husbands in their eyes, when it shall be reported, The king Ahasuerus commanded Vashti the queen to be brought in before him, but she came not.

Ahasuerus even the <u>17\_EST\_03\_06</u># And he thought scorn to lay hands on Mordecai alone; for they had showed him the people of Mordecai: wherefore Haman sought to destroy all the Jews that [were] throughout the whole kingdom of Ahasuerus, [even] the people of Mordecai.

Ahasuerus give the <u>17\_EST\_08\_01</u># On that day did the king Ahasuerus give the house of Haman the Jews' enemy unto Esther the queen. And Mordecai came before the king; for Esther had told what he [was] unto her.

Ahasuerus in the <u>15\_EZR\_04\_06</u># And in the reign of Ahasuerus, in the beginning of his reign, wrote they [unto him] an accusation against the inhabitants of Judah and Jerusalem.

Ahasuerus into his <u>17\_EST\_02\_16</u># So Esther was taken unto king Ahasuerus into his house royal in the tenth month, which [is] the month Tebeth, in the seventh year of his reign.

Ahasuerus laid a <a href="mailto:17\_EST\_10\_01">17\_EST\_10\_01</a> # And the king Ahasuerus laid a tribute upon the land, and [upon] the isles of the sea.

Ahasuerus name and <u>17\_EST\_08\_10</u> # And he wrote in the king Ahasuerus' name, and sealed [it] with the king's ring, and sent letters by posts on horseback, [and] riders on mules, camels, [and] young dromedaries:

Ahasuerus promote Haman <u>17\_EST\_03\_01</u># After these things did king Ahasuerus promote Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, and advanced him, and set his seat above all the princes that [were] with him.

Ahasuerus said unto <u>17\_EST\_08\_07</u># Then the king Ahasuerus said unto Esther the queen and to Mordecai the Jew, Behold, I have given Esther the house of Haman, and him they have hanged upon the gallows, because he laid his hand upon the Jews.

Ahasuerus sat on <u>17\_EST\_01\_02</u> # [That] in those days, when the king Ahasuerus sat on the throne of his kingdom, which [was] in Shushan the palace,

Ahasuerus they cast 17\_EST\_03\_07 # In the first month, that [is], the month Nisan, in the twelfth year of king Ahasuerus, they cast Pur, that [is], the lot, before Haman from day to day, and from month to month, [to] the twelfth [month], that [is], the month Adar.

Ahasuerus this is <u>17\_EST\_01\_01</u> # Now it came to pass in the days of Ahasuerus, [this [is] Ahasuerus which reigned, from India even unto Ethiopia, [over] an hundred and seven and twenty provinces:]

Ahasuerus to lay <u>17\_EST\_09\_02</u> # The Jews gathered themselves together in their cities throughout all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus, to lay hand on such as sought their hurt: and no man could withstand them; for the fear of them fell upon all people.

Ahasuerus was appeased <u>17\_EST\_02\_01</u># After these things, when the wrath of king Ahasuerus was appeased, he remembered Vashti, and what she had done, and what was decreed against her.

Ahasuerus which reigned <u>17\_EST\_01\_01</u># Now it came to pass in the days of Ahasuerus, [this [is] Ahasuerus which reigned, from India even unto Ethiopia, [over] an hundred and seven and twenty provinces:]

Ahasuerus with words <u>17\_EST\_09\_30</u> # And he sent the letters unto all the Jews, to the hundred twenty and seven provinces of the kingdom of Ahasuerus, [with] words of peace and truth,

Ahasuerus <u>17\_EST\_01\_09</u> # Also Vashti the queen made a feast for the women [in] the royal house which [belonged] to king Ahasuerus.

Ahasuerus 17\_EST\_01\_16 # And Memucan answered before the king and the princes, Vashti the queen hath not done wrong to the king only, but also to all the princes, and to all the people that [are] in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus.

Ahasuerus 17\_EST\_02\_21 # In those days, while Mordecai sat in the king's gate, two of the king's

chamberlains, Bigthan and Teresh, of those which kept the door, were wroth, and sought to lay hand on the king Ahasuerus.

Ahaz and Hezekiah <u>23\_ISA\_01\_01</u># The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah.

Ahaz and Hezekiah 33\_MIC\_01\_01 # The word of the LORD that came to Micah the Morasthite in the days of Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah, which he saw concerning Samaria and Jerusalem.

Ahaz begat Jarah <u>13\_1CH\_09\_42</u># And Ahaz begat Jarah; and Jarah begat Alemeth, and Azmaveth, and Zimri; and Zimri begat Moza;

Ahaz begat Jehoadah <u>13\_1CH\_08\_36</u> # And Ahaz begat Jehoadah; and Jehoadah begat Alemeth, and Azmaveth, and Zimri; and Zimri begat Moza,

Ahaz but could 12 2KI 16 05 # Then Rezin king of Syria and Pekah son of Remaliah king of Israel came up to Jerusalem to war: and they besieged Ahaz, but could not overcome [him].

Ahaz came from 12\_2KI\_16\_11 # And Urijah the priest built an altar according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus: so Urijah the priest made [it] against king Ahaz came from Damascus.

Ahaz gathered together 14\_2CH\_28\_24 # And Ahaz gathered together the vessels of the house of God, and

cut in pieces the vessels of the house of God, and shut up the doors of the house of the LORD, and he made him altars in every corner of Jerusalem.

Ahaz had sent 12 2KI 16 11 # And Urijah the priest built an altar according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus: so Urijah the priest made [it] against king Ahaz came from Damascus.

Ahaz king of 12 2KI 17 01 # In the twelfth year of Ahaz king of Judah began Hoshea the son of Elah to reign in Samaria over Israel nine years.

Ahaz king of 12 2KI 18 01 # Now it came to pass in the third year of Hoshea son of Elah king of Israel, [that] Hezekiah the son of Ahaz king of Judah began to reign.

Ahaz said I 23\_ISA\_07\_12 # But Ahaz said, I will not ask, neither will I tempt the LORD.

Ahaz saying 23\_ISA\_07\_10 # Moreover the LORD spake again unto Ahaz, saying,

Ahaz send unto 14\_2CH\_28\_16 # At that time did king Ahaz send unto the kings of Assyria to help him.

Ahaz sent messengers 12 2KI 16 07 # So Ahaz sent messengers to Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, saying, I [am] thy servant and thy son: come up, and save me out of the hand of the king of Syria, and out of the hand of the king of Israel, which rise up against me.

Ahaz sent to 12\_2KI\_16\_10 # And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and saw an altar that [was] at Damascus: and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof.

Ahaz thou and <u>23\_ISA\_07\_03</u># Then said the LORD unto Isaiah, Go forth now to meet Ahaz, thou, and Shearjashub thy son, at the end of the conduit of the upper pool in the highway of the fuller's field;

Ahaz took away 14\_2CH\_28\_21 # For Ahaz took away a portion [out] of the house of the LORD, and [out] of the house of the king, and of the princes, and gave [it] unto the king of Assyria: but he helped him not.

Ahaz which the 12\_2KI\_23\_12 # And the altars that [were] on the top of the upper chamber of Ahaz, which the kings of Judah had made, and the altars which Manasseh had made in the two courts of the house of the LORD, did the king beat down, and brake [them] down from thence, and cast the dust of them into the brook Kidron.

Ahaz 13\_1CH\_08\_35 # And the sons of Micah [were], Pithon, and Melech, and Tarea, and Ahaz.

Ahaz 13\_1CH\_09\_41 # And the sons of Micah [were], Pithon, and Melech, and Tahrea, [and Ahaz].

Ahaz 14\_2CH\_28\_22 # And in the time of his distress did he trespass yet more against the LORD: this [is that] king Ahaz.

Ahaz <u>12\_2KI\_20\_11</u># And Isaiah the prophet cried unto the LORD: and he brought the shadow ten degrees backward, by which it had gone down in the dial of Ahaz.

Ahaziah and stole 14\_2CH\_22\_11# But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

Ahaziah had no 14\_2CH\_22\_09 # And he sought Ahaziah: and they caught him, [for he was hid in Samaria, ] and brought him to Jehu: and when they had slain him, they buried him: Because, said they, he [is] the son of Jehoshaphat, who sought the LORD with all his heart. So the house of Ahaziah had no power to keep still the kingdom.

Ahaziah king of 12 2KI 13 01 # In the three and twentieth year of Joash the son of Ahaziah king of Judah Jehoahaz the son of Jehu began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] seventeen years.

Ahaziah saw that 14\_2CH\_22\_10 # But when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal of the house of Judah.

Ahaziah saw that 12\_2KI\_11\_01 # And when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal.

Ahaziah that ministered <u>14\_2CH\_22\_08</u># And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

Ahaziah the king 12 2KI 09 27 # But when Ahaziah the king of Judah saw [this], he fled by the way of the garden house. And Jehu followed after him, and said, Smite him also in the chariot. [And they did so] at the going up to Gur, which [is] by Ibleam. And he fled to Megiddo, and died there.

Ahaziah the son 14\_2CH\_22\_01 # And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

Ahaziah the son 12\_2KI\_08\_25 # In the twelfth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel did Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah begin to reign.

reigned one year in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Athaliah the daughter of Omri.

O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast scattered us, thou hast been displeased; O turn thyself to us again.

Baharumite Eliahba the 13\_1CH\_11\_33 # Azmaveth the Baharumite, Eliahba the Shaalbonite,

Beerlahairoi behold it <u>01\_GEN\_16\_14</u># Wherefore the well was called Beerlahairoi; behold, [it is] between Kadesh and Bered.

Dizahab <u>05\_DEU\_01\_01</u> # These [be] the words which Moses spake unto all Israel on this side Jordan in the wilderness, in the plain over against the Red [sea], between Paran, and Tophel, and Laban, and Hazeroth, and Dizahab.

Gaham and Thahash <u>01\_GEN\_22\_24</u># And his concubine, whose name [was] Reumah, she bare also Tebah, and Gaham, and Thahash, and Maachah.

Gahar the children 15\_EZR\_02\_47 # The children of Giddel, the children of Gahar, the children of Reaiah,

Gahar 16\_NEH\_07\_49 # The children of Hanan, the children of Giddel, the children of Gahar,

Haahashtari These were <u>13\_1CH\_04\_06</u># And Naarah bare him Ahuzam, and Hepher, and Temeni, and Haahashtari. These [were] the sons of Naarah.

Irnahash These are 13\_1CH\_04\_12 # And Eshton begat Bethrapha, and Paseah, and Tehinnah the father of Irnahash. These [are] the men of Recah.
