aloud and cut 11 1KI 18 28# And they cried aloud, and cut themselves after their manner with knives and lancets, till the blood gushed out upon them.

aloud and he 19 PSA 55 17 # Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: and he shall hear my voice.

aloud and said 27 DAN 04 14# He cried aloud, and said thus, Hew down the tree, and cut off his branches; shake off his leaves, and scatter his fruit; let the beasts get away from under it, and the fowls from his branches;

aloud and the 01 GEN 45 02 # And he wept aloud: and the Egyptians and the house of Pharaoh heard.

aloud at Bethaven 28 HOS 05 08 # Blow ye the cornet in Gibeah, [and] the trumpet in Ramah: cry aloud [at] Bethaven, after thee, O Benjamin.

aloud began to 41 MAR 15 08 # And the multitude crying aloud began to desire [him to do] as he had ever done unto them.

aloud but there 18 JOB 19 07 # Behold, I cry out of wrong, but I am not heard: I cry aloud, but [there is] no judgment.

aloud for he 11 1KI 18 27 # And it came to pass at noon, that Elijah mocked them, and said, Cry aloud: for he [is] a god; either he is talking, or he is pursuing, or he is in a journey, [or] peradventure he sleepeth, and must be awaked.

aloud for joy 15 EZR 03 12 # But many of the priests and Levites and chief of the fathers, [who were] ancient men, that had seen the first house, when the foundation of this house was laid before their eyes, wept with a loud voice; and many shouted aloud for joy:

aloud for joy 19 PSA 132 16 # I will also clothe her priests with salvation: and her saints shall shout aloud for joy.

aloud from the 23 ISA 24 14 #They shall lift up their voice, they shall sing for the majesty of the LORD, they shall cry aloud from the sea.

aloud is there 33 MIC 04 09 # Now why dost thou cry out aloud? [is there] no king in thee? is thy counsellor perished? for pangs have taken thee as a woman in travail.

aloud of thy 19 PSA 51 14# Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, thou God of my salvation: [and] my tongue shall sing aloud of thy righteousness.

aloud of thy 19 PSA 59 16 # But I will sing of thy power; yea, I will sing aloud of thy mercy in the morning: for thou hast been my defence and refuge in the day of my trouble.

aloud spare not 23 ISA 58 01 # Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and show my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins.

aloud thou that 23 ISA 54 01 # Sing, O barren, thou [that] didst not bear; break forth into singing, and cry aloud, thou [that] didst not travail with child: for more [are] the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, saith the LORD.

aloud to bring 27 DAN 05 07. The king cried aloud to bring in the astrologers, the Chaldeans, and the soothsayers. [And] the king spake, and said to the wise [men] of Babylon, Whosoever shall read this writing, and show me the interpretation thereof, shall be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about his neck, and shall be the third ruler in the kingdom.

aloud To you 27 DAN 03 04 # Then an herald cried aloud, To you it is commanded, O people, nations, and languages,

aloud unto God 19 PSA 81 01 # To the chief Musician upon Gittith, [A Psalm] of Asaph. Sing aloud unto God our strength: make a joyful noise unto the God of Jacob.

aloud upon their $\underline{19}$ PSA $\underline{149}$ $\underline{05}$ # Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds.
