alter and to 15_EZR_06_12 # And the God that hath caused his name to dwell there destroy all kings and people, that shall put to their hand to alter [and] to destroy this house of God which [is] at Jerusalem. I Darius have made a decree; let it be done with speed.

alter it nor <u>03_LEV_27_10</u> # He shall not alter it, nor change it, a good for a bad, or a bad for a good: and if he shall at all change beast for beast, then it and the exchange thereof shall be holy.

alter the thing 19_PSA_89_34 # My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips.

alter this word <u>15_EZR_06_11</u># Also I have made a decree, that whosoever shall alter this word, let timber be pulled down from his house, and being set up, let him be hanged thereon; and let his house be made a dunghill for this.

altered and his <u>42_LUK_09_29</u> # And as he prayed, the fashion of his countenance was altered, and his raiment [was] white [and] glistering.

altered That Vashti <u>17_EST_01_19</u># If it please the king, let there go a royal commandment from him, and let it be written among the laws of the Persians and the Medes, that it be not altered, That Vashti come no more before king Ahasuerus; and let the king give her royal estate unto another that is better than she.

altereth not <u>27_DAN_06_08</u> # Now, O king, establish the decree, and sign the writing, that it be not changed, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

altereth not <u>27_DAN_06_12</u> # Then they came near, and spake before the king concerning the king's decree; Hast thou not signed a decree, that every man that shall ask [a petition] of any God or man within thirty days, save of thee, O king, shall be cast into the den of lions? The king answered and said, The thing [is] true, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

psalteries and harps <u>13_1CH_15_16</u> # And David spake to the chief of the Levites to appoint their brethren [to be] the singers with instruments of music, psalteries and harps and cymbals, sounding, by lifting up the voice with joy.

psalteries and harps <u>13_1CH_15_28</u> # Thus all Israel brought up the ark of the covenant of the LORD with shouting, and with sound of the cornet, and with trumpets, and with cymbals, making a noise with psalteries and harps.

psalteries and harps <u>13_1CH_25_06</u> # All these [were] under the hands of their father for song [in] the house of the LORD, with cymbals, psalteries, and harps, for the service of the house of God, according to the king's order to Asaph, Jeduthun, and Heman.

psalteries and harps 14_2CH_05_12 # Also the Levites [which were] the singers, all of them of Asaph, of Heman, of Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, [being] arrayed in white linen, having cymbals and psalteries and harps, stood at the east end of the altar, and with them an hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets:]

psalteries and harps <u>14_2CH_20_28</u> # And they came to Jerusalem with psalteries and harps and trumpets unto the house of the LORD.

psalteries and on <u>10_2SA_06_05</u># And David and all the house of Israel played before the LORD on all manner of [instruments made of] fir wood, even on harps, and on psalteries, and on timbrels, and on cornets, and on cymbals.

psalteries and with <u>13_1CH_13_08</u># And David and all Israel played before God with all [their] might, and with singing, and with harps, and with psalteries, and with timbrels, and with cymbals, and with trumpets.

psalteries and with <u>13_1CH_16_05</u># Asaph the chief, and next to him Zechariah, Jeiel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Mattithiah, and Eliab, and Benaiah, and Obededom: and Jeiel with psalteries and with harps; but Asaph made a sound with cymbals;

psalteries and with 13 1CH 25 01 # Moreover David and the captains of the host separated to the service of the sons of Asaph, and of Heman, and of Jeduthun, who should prophesy with harps, with psalteries, and with cymbals: and the number of the workmen according to their service was:

psalteries and with 14_2CH_29_25 # And he set the Levites in the house of the LORD with cymbals, with psalteries, and with harps, according to the commandment of David, and of Gad the king's seer, and Nathan the prophet: for [so was] the commandment of the LORD by his prophets.

psalteries and with <u>16_NEH_12_27</u># And at the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem they sought the Levites out of all their places, to bring them to Jerusalem, to keep the dedication with gladness, both with thanksgivings, and with singing, [with] cymbals, psalteries, and with harps.

psalteries for singers <u>11_1KI_10_12</u># And the king made of the almug trees pillars for the house of the LORD, and for the king's house, harps also and psalteries for singers: there came no such almug trees, nor were seen unto this day.

psalteries for singers <u>14_2CH_09_11</u># And the king made [of] the algum trees terraces to the house of the LORD, and to the king's palace, and harps and psalteries for singers: and there were none such seen before in the land of Judah.

psalteries on Alamoth <u>13_1CH_15_20</u> # And Zechariah, and Aziel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Unni, and Eliab, and Maaseiah, and Benaiah, with psalteries on Alamoth;

psaltery and a <u>09_1SA_10_05</u># After that thou shalt come to the hill of God, where [is] the garrison of the Philistines: and it shall come to pass, when thou art come thither to the city, that thou shalt meet a company of prophets coming down from the high place with a psaltery, and a tabret, and a pipe, and a harp, before them; and they shall prophesy:

psaltery and all <u>27_DAN_03_07</u># Therefore at that time, when all the people heard the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and all kinds of music, all the people, the nations, and the languages, fell down [and] worshipped the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.

psaltery and an <u>19_PSA_144_09</u> # I will sing a new song unto thee, O God: upon a psaltery [and] an instrument of ten strings will I sing praises unto thee.

psaltery and an <u>19_PSA_33_02</u> # Praise the LORD with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery [and] an instrument of ten strings.

psaltery and dulcimer <u>27_DAN_03_10</u> # Thou, O king, hast made a decree, that every man that shall hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and dulcimer, and all kinds of music, shall fall down and worship the golden image:

psaltery and dulcimer <u>27_DAN_03_15</u># Now if ye be ready that at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and dulcimer, and all kinds of music, ye fall down and worship the

image which I have made; [well]: but if ye worship not, ye shall be cast the same hour into the midst of a burning fiery furnace; and who [is] that God that shall deliver you out of my hands?

psaltery and harp 19 PSA 108 02 # Awake, psaltery and harp: I [myself] will awake early.

psaltery and harp $\underline{19_PSA_150_03}$ # Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp.

psaltery and harp <u>19_PSA_57_08</u> # Awake up, my glory; awake, psaltery and harp: I [myself] will awake early.

psaltery dulcimer and <u>27_DAN_03_05</u># [That] at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, dulcimer, and all kinds of music, ye fall down and worship the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king hath set up:

psaltery even thy 19 PSA 71 22 # I will also praise thee with the psaltery, [even] thy truth, O my God: unto thee will I sing with the harp, O thou Holy One of Israel.

psaltery upon the 19_PSA_92_03 # Upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon the psaltery; upon the harp with a solemn sound.

psaltery 19 PSA 81 02 # Take a psalm, and bring hither the timbrel, the pleasant harp with the psaltery.
