always a conscience <u>44\_ACT\_24\_16</u> # And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and [toward] men.

always abounding in <u>46\_1CO\_15\_58</u> # Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

always and in <u>44\_ACT\_24\_03</u># We accept [it] always, and in all places, most noble Felix, with all thankfulness.

always and whensoever <u>41\_MAR\_14\_07</u># For ye have the poor with you always, and whensoever ye will ye may do them good: but me ye have not always.

Always bearing about <u>47\_2CO\_04\_10</u> # Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body.

always before him <u>20\_PRO\_08\_30</u># Then I was by him, [as] one brought up [with him]: and I was daily [his] delight, rejoicing always before him;

always before me <u>19\_PSA\_16\_08</u> # I have set the LORD always before me: because [he is] at my right hand, I shall not be moved.

always before my <u>44\_ACT\_02\_25</u># For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved:

always behold the <u>40\_MAT\_18\_10</u># Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven.

always but because <u>43\_JOH\_11\_42</u># And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said [it], that they may believe that thou hast sent me.

always by all <u>53\_2TH\_03\_16</u># Now the Lord of peace himself give you peace always by all means. The Lord [be] with you all.

always call upon <u>18\_JOB\_27\_10</u> # Will he delight himself in the Almighty? will he always call upon God?

always causeth us <u>47\_2CO\_02\_14</u> # Now thanks [be] unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

always chide neither <u>19\_PSA\_103\_09</u># He will not always chide: neither will he keep [his anger] for ever.

always confident knowing <u>47\_2CO\_05\_06</u> # Therefore [we are] always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord:

always desiring greatly <u>52\_1TH\_03\_06</u> # But now when Timotheus came from you unto us, and brought us good tidings of your faith and charity, and that ye have good remembrance of us always, desiring greatly to see us, as we also [to see] you:

always evil the <u>14\_2CH\_18\_07</u> # And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, [There is] yet one man, by

whom we may inquire of the LORD: but I hate him; for he never prophesied good unto me, but always evil: the same [is] Micaiah the son of Imla. And Jehoshaphat said, Let not the king say so.

always for all <u>49\_EPH\_05\_20</u> # Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;

always for you <u>52\_1TH\_01\_02</u> # We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers;

always for you <u>53\_2TH\_01\_03</u> # We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith groweth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other aboundeth;

always for you <u>53\_2TH\_01\_11</u># Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of [this] calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of [his] goodness, and the work of faith with power:

always for you <u>51\_COL\_01\_03</u># We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you,

always great with <u>24\_JER\_20\_17</u> # Because he slew me not from the womb; or that my mother might have been my grave, and her womb [to be] always great [with me].

always grievous thy <u>19\_PSA\_10\_05</u> # His ways are always grievous; thy judgments [are] far above out of his sight: [as for] all his enemies, he puffeth at them.

always having all <u>47\_2CO\_09\_08</u># And God [is] able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all [things], may abound to every good work:

always in a <u>48\_GAL\_04\_18</u> # But [it is] good to be zealously affected always in [a] good [thing], and not only when I am present with you.

Always in every <u>50\_PHP\_01\_04</u> # Always in every prayer of mine for you all making request with joy,

always in my 57\_PHM\_01\_04 # I thank my God, making mention of thee always in my prayers,

always in my <u>45\_ROM\_01\_09</u># For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers;

always in remembrance <u>61\_2PE\_01\_12</u> # Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know [them], and be established in the present truth.

always in remembrance <u>61\_2PE\_01\_15</u># Moreover I will endeavour that ye may be able after my decease to have these things always in remembrance.

always into the <u>58\_HEB\_09\_06</u># Now when these things were thus ordained, the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service [of God].

always labouring fervently 51\_COL\_04\_12 # Epaphras, who is [one] of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God.

always night and <u>41\_MAR\_05\_05</u># And always, night and day, he was in the mountains, and in the tombs, crying, and cutting himself with stones.

always obeyed not <u>50\_PHP\_02\_12</u> # Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.

always of his <u>13\_1CH\_16\_15</u># Be ye mindful always of his covenant; the word [which] he commanded to a thousand generations;

always on your <u>46\_1CO\_01\_04</u># I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ;

always resist the <u>44\_ACT\_07\_51</u># Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers [did], so [do] ye.

always resort and <u>43\_JOH\_18\_20</u> # Jesus answered him, I spake openly to the world; I ever taught in the synagogue, and in the temple, whither the Jews always resort; and in secret have I said nothing.

always so now <u>50\_PHP\_01\_20</u># According to my earnest expectation and [my] hope, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but [that] with all boldness, as always, [so] now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether [it be] by life, or by death.

always strive with <u>01\_GEN\_06\_03</u># And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also [is] flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

always that he <u>05\_DEU\_06\_24</u> # And the LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that he might preserve us alive, as [it is] at this day.

always that it <u>05\_DEU\_05\_29</u> # O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear me, and keep all my commandments always, that it might be well with them, and with their children for ever!

always that ye <u>42\_LUK\_21\_36</u> # Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.

always those things <u>43\_JOH\_08\_29</u> # And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.

always to give <u>60\_1PE\_03\_15</u># But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and [be] ready always to [give] an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

always to pray <u>42\_LUK\_18\_01</u> # And he spake a parable unto them [to this end], that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;

always upon his <u>02\_EXO\_28\_38</u># And it shall be upon Aaron's forehead, that Aaron may bear the iniquity of the holy things, which the children of Israel shall hallow in all their holy gifts; and it shall be always upon his forehead, that they may be accepted before the LORD.

always upon it <u>05\_DEU\_11\_12</u># A land which the LORD thy God careth for: the eyes of the LORD thy God [are] always upon it, from the beginning of the year even unto the end of the year.

always waste but <u>26\_EZE\_38\_08</u> # After many days thou shalt be visited: in the latter years thou shalt come into the land [that is] brought back from the sword, [and is] gathered out of many people, against the mountains of Israel, which have been always waste: but it is brought forth out of the nations, and they shall dwell safely all of them.

always white and <u>21\_ECC\_09\_08</u># Let thy garments be always white; and let thy head lack no ointment.

always wise neither <u>18\_JOB\_32\_09</u># Great men are not [always] wise: neither do the aged understand judgment.

always with all <u>49\_EPH\_06\_18</u># Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

always with her <u>20\_PRO\_05\_19</u># [Let her be as] the loving hind and pleasant roe; let her breasts satisfy thee at all times; and be thou ravished always with her love.

always with you <u>40\_MAT\_26\_11</u># For ye have the poor always with you; but me ye have not always.

always wroth for <u>23\_ISA\_57\_16</u># For I will not contend for ever, neither will I be always wroth: for the spirit should fail before me, and the souls [which] I have made.

always ye have <u>43\_JOH\_12\_08</u> # For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always.
