anger against the <u>35_HAB_03_08</u> # Was the LORD displeased against the rivers? [was] thine anger against the rivers? [was] thy wrath against the sea, that thou didst ride upon thine horses [and] thy chariots of salvation?

anger against them <u>26_EZE_20_08</u># But they rebelled against me, and would not hearken unto me: they did not every man cast away the abominations of their eyes, neither did they forsake the idols of Egypt: then I said, I will pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the midst of the land of Egypt.

anger against them <u>26_EZE_20_21</u> # Notwithstanding the children rebelled against me: they walked not in my statutes, neither kept my judgments to do them, which [if] a man do, he shall even live in them; they polluted my sabbaths: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the wilderness.

anger all the <u>25_LAM_02_03</u># He hath cut off in [his] fierce anger all the horn of Israel: he hath drawn back his right hand from before the enemy, and he burned against Jacob like a flaming fire, [which] devoureth round about.

anger also came <u>19_PSA_78_21</u># Therefore the LORD heard [this], and was wroth: so a fire was kindled against Jacob, and anger also came up against Israel;

anger and a <u>20_PRO_21_14</u># A gift in secret pacifieth anger: and a reward in the bosom strong wrath.

anger and according <u>26_EZE_25_14</u> # And I will lay my vengeance upon Edom by the hand of my people Israel: and they shall do in Edom according to mine anger and according to my fury; and they shall know my vengeance, saith the Lord GOD.

anger and according <u>26_EZE_35_11</u># Therefore, [as] I live, saith the Lord GOD, I will even do according to thine anger, and according to thine envy which thou hast used out of thy hatred against them; and I will make myself known among them, when I have judged thee.

anger and by <u>19_PSA_90_07</u># For we are consumed by thine anger, and by thy wrath are we troubled.

anger and cast <u>25_LAM_02_01</u> # How hath the Lord covered the daughter of Zion with a cloud in his anger, [and] cast down from heaven unto the earth the beauty of Israel, and remembered not his footstool in the day of his anger!

anger and clamour <u>49_EPH_04_31</u> # Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

anger and did <u>09_1SA_20_34</u> # So Jonathan arose from the table in fierce anger, and did eat no meat the second day of the month: for he was grieved for David, because his father had done him shame.

anger and for <u>23_ISA_48_09</u># For my name's sake will I defer mine anger, and for my praise will I refrain for thee, that I cut thee not off.

anger and forsake <u>19_PSA_37_08</u># Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not thyself in any wise to do evil.

anger and fury <u>33_MIC_05_15</u># And I will execute vengeance in anger and fury upon the heathen, such as they have not heard.

anger and great <u>26_EZE_13_13</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; I will even rend [it] with a stormy wind in my fury; and there shall be an overflowing shower in mine anger, and great hailstones in [my] fury to consume [it].

anger and great <u>34_NAH_01_03</u># The LORD [is] slow to anger, and great in power, and will not at all acquit [the wicked]: the LORD hath his way in the whirlwind and in the storm, and the clouds [are] the dust of his feet.

anger and hast <u>11_1KI_14_09</u># But hast done evil above all that were before thee: for thou hast gone and made thee other gods, and molten images, to provoke me to anger, and hast cast me behind thy back:

anger and hath <u>25_LAM_04_11</u> # The LORD hath accomplished his fury; he hath poured out his fierce anger, and hath kindled a fire in Zion, and it hath devoured the foundations thereof.

anger and hot <u>05_DEU_09_19</u># For I was afraid of the anger and hot displeasure, wherewith the LORD was wroth against you to destroy you. But the LORD hearkened unto me at that time also.

anger and in <u>05_DEU_29_23</u> # [And that] the whole land thereof [is] brimstone, and salt, [and] burning, [that] it is not sown, nor beareth, nor any grass groweth therein, like the overthrow of Sodom, and Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboim, which the LORD overthrew in his anger, and in his wrath:

anger and in <u>05_DEU_29_28</u># And the LORD rooted them out of their land in anger, and in wrath, and in great indignation, and cast them into another land, as [it is] this day.

anger and in <u>26_EZE_05_15</u># So it shall be a reproach and a taunt, an instruction and an astonishment unto the nations that [are] round about thee, when I shall execute judgments in thee in anger and in fury and in furious rebukes. I the LORD have spoken [it].

anger and in <u>26_EZE_22_20</u># [As] they gather silver, and brass, and iron, and lead, and tin, into the midst of the furnace, to blow the fire upon it, to melt [it]; so will I gather [you] in mine anger and in my fury, and I will leave [you there], and melt you.

anger and in <u>24_JER_21_05</u> # And I myself will fight against you with an outstretched hand and with a strong arm, even in anger, and in fury, and in great wrath.

anger and in <u>24_JER_32_37</u> # Behold, I will gather them out of all countries, whither I have driven them in mine anger, and in my fury, and in great wrath; and I will bring them again unto this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely:

anger and in <u>24_JER_33_05</u># They come to fight with the Chaldeans, but [it is] to fill them with the dead bodies of men, whom I have slain in mine anger and in my fury, and for all whose wickedness I have hid my face from this city.

anger and it <u>20_PRO_19_11</u># The discretion of a man deferreth his anger; and [it is] his glory to pass over a transgression.

anger and lo <u>26_EZE_08_17</u> # Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen [this], O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with violence, and have returned to provoke me to anger: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose.

anger and made <u>11_1KI_21_22</u># And will make thine house like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat,

and like the house of Baasha the son of Ahijah, for the provocation wherewith thou hast provoked [me] to anger, and made Israel to sin.

anger and make <u>23_ISA_63_06</u> # And I will tread down the people in mine anger, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth.

anger and my <u>24_JER_07_20</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, mine anger and my fury shall be poured out upon this place, upon man, and upon beast, and upon the trees of the field, and upon the fruit of the ground; and it shall burn, and shall not be quenched.

anger and my <u>24_JER_42_18</u> # For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; As mine anger and my fury hath been poured forth upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem; so shall my fury be poured forth upon you, when ye shall enter into Egypt: and ye shall be an execration, and an astonishment, and a curse, and a reproach; and ye shall see this place no more.

anger and of <u>24_JER_32_31</u># For this city hath been to me [as] a provocation of mine anger and of my fury from the day that they built it even unto this day; that I should remove it from before my face,

anger and of <u>29_JOE_02_13</u> # And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the LORD your God: for he [is] gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil.

anger and of <u>32_JON_04_02</u> # And he prayed unto the LORD, and said, I pray thee, O LORD, [was] not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou [art] a gracious God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of the evil.

anger and of <u>16_NEH_09_17</u># And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou [art] a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.

anger and of <u>19_PSA_145_08</u># The LORD [is] gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.

anger and persecuted <u>25_LAM_03_43</u># Thou hast covered with anger, and persecuted us: thou hast slain, thou hast not pitied.

anger and plenteous <u>19_PSA_103_08</u># The LORD [is] merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy.

anger and shall <u>05_DEU_32_22</u> # For a fire is kindled in mine anger, and shall burn unto the lowest hell, and shall consume the earth with her increase, and set on fire the foundations of the mountains.

anger and show <u>05_DEU_13_17</u> # And there shall cleave nought of the cursed thing to thine hand: that the LORD may turn from the fierceness of his anger, and show thee mercy, and have compassion upon thee, and multiply thee, as he hath sworn unto thy fathers;

anger and the <u>23_ISA_10_05</u># O Assyrian, the rod of mine anger, and the staff in their hand is mine indignation.

anger and the <u>23_ISA_30_27</u># Behold, the name of the LORD cometh from far, burning [with] his anger, and the burden [thereof is] heavy: his lips are full of indignation, and his tongue as a devouring fire:

anger and the <u>23_ISA_42_25</u># Therefore he hath poured upon him the fury of his anger, and the strength of battle: and it hath set him on fire round about, yet he knew not; and it burned him, yet he laid [it] not to heart.

anger and the <u>24_JER_36_07</u> # It may be they will present their supplication before the LORD, and will return every one from his evil way: for great [is] the anger and the fury that the LORD hath pronounced against this people.

anger and thy <u>27_DAN_09_16</u> # O Lord, according to all thy righteousness, I beseech thee, let thine anger and thy fury be turned away from thy city Jerusalem, thy holy mountain: because for our sins, and for the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and thy people [are become] a reproach to all [that are] about us.

anger and took <u>28_HOS_13_11</u># I gave thee a king in mine anger, and took [him] away in my wrath.

anger and trample <u>23_ISA_63_03</u># I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people [there was] none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.

anger and with <u>23_ISA_30_30</u> # And the LORD shall cause his glorious voice to be heard, and shall show the lighting down of his arm, with the indignation of [his] anger, and [with] the flame of a devouring fire, [with] scattering, and tempest, and hailstones.

anger appeaseth strife <u>20_PRO_15_18</u># A wrathful man stirreth up strife: but [he that is] slow to anger appeaseth strife.

anger away and <u>19_PSA_78_38</u># But he, [being] full of compassion, forgave [their] iniquity, and destroyed [them] not: yea, many a time turned he his anger away, and did not stir up all his wrath.

anger be accomplished <u>26_EZE_05_13</u> # Thus shall mine anger be accomplished, and I will cause my fury to rest upon them, and I will be comforted: and they shall know that I the LORD have spoken [it] in my zeal, when I have accomplished my fury in them.

anger be hot <u>07_JUD_06_39</u> # And Gideon said unto God, Let not thine anger be hot against me, and I will speak but this once: let me prove, I pray thee, but this once with the fleece; let it now be dry only upon the fleece, and upon all the ground let there be dew.

anger before the <u>16_NEH_04_05</u> # And cover not their iniquity, and let not their sin be blotted out from before thee: for they have provoked [thee] to anger before the builders.

anger being grieved <u>41_MAR_03_05</u> # And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched [it] out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.

anger burn against <u>01_GEN_44_18</u> # Then Judah came near unto him, and said, Oh my lord, let thy servant, I pray thee, speak a word in my lord's ears, and let not thine anger burn against thy servant: for thou [art] even as Pharaoh.

anger burned in <u>17_EST_01_12</u># But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by [his] chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

anger cast down <u>19_PSA_56_07</u># Shall they escape by iniquity? in [thine] anger cast down the people, O God.

anger come upon <u>36_ZEP_02_02</u># Before the decree bring forth, [before] the day pass as the chaff, before the fierce anger of the LORD come upon you, before the day of the LORD'S anger come upon you.

anger continually to <u>23_ISA_65_03</u> # A people that provoketh me to anger continually to my face; that sacrificeth in gardens, and burneth incense upon altars of brick;

anger did tear <u>30_AMO_01_11</u># Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Edom, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because he did pursue his brother with the sword, and did cast off all pity, and his anger did tear perpetually, and he kept his wrath for ever:

anger endureth but <u>19_PSA_30_05</u># For his anger [endureth but] a moment; in his favour [is] life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy [cometh] in the morning.

anger even according <u>19_PSA_90_11</u># Who knoweth the power of thine anger? even according to thy fear, [so is] thy wrath.

anger even them <u>23_ISA_13_03</u> # I have commanded my sanctified ones, I have also called my mighty ones for mine anger, [even] them that rejoice in my highness.

anger for all <u>36_ZEP_03_08</u># Therefore wait ye upon me, saith the LORD, until the day that I rise up to the prey: for my determination [is] to gather the nations, that I may assemble the kingdoms, to pour upon them mine indignation, [even] all my fierce anger: for all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of my jealousy.

anger for ever <u>24_JER_03_05</u># Will he reserve [his anger] for ever? will he keep [it] to the end? Behold, thou hast spoken and done evil things as thou couldest.

anger for ever <u>24_JER_03_12</u># Go and proclaim these words toward the north, and say, Return, thou backsliding Israel, saith the LORD; [and] I will not cause mine anger to fall upon you: for I [am] merciful, saith the LORD, [and] I will not keep [anger] for ever.

anger for ever <u>33_MIC_07_18</u> # Who [is] a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth [in] mercy.

anger for ever <u>19_PSA_103_09</u> # He will not always chide: neither will he keep [his anger] for ever.

anger for it <u>01_GEN_49_07</u># Cursed [be] their anger, for [it was] fierce; and their wrath, for it was cruel: I will divide them in Jacob, and scatter them in Israel.

anger from under <u>25_LAM_03_66</u># Persecute and destroy them in anger from under the heavens of the LORD.

anger he spared <u>19_PSA_78_50</u># He made a way to his anger; he spared not their soul from death, but gave their life over to the pestilence;

anger his fury <u>34_NAH_01_06</u> # Who can stand before his indignation? and who can abide in the fierceness of his anger? his fury is poured out like fire, and the rocks are thrown down by him.

anger I will <u>28_HOS_11_09</u># I will not execute the fierceness of mine anger, I will not return to destroy Ephraim: for I [am] God, and not man; the Holy One in the midst of thee: and I will not enter into the city.

anger in offering <u>24_JER_11_17</u># For the LORD of hosts, that planted thee, hath pronounced evil against thee, for the evil of the house of Israel and of the house of Judah, which they have done against themselves to provoke me to anger in offering incense unto Baal.

anger in that <u>24_JER_44_03</u># Because of their wickedness which they have committed to provoke me to anger, in that they went to burn incense, [and] to serve other gods, whom they knew not, [neither] they, ye, nor your fathers.

anger in their <u>23_ISA_10_25</u># For yet a very little while, and the indignation shall cease, and mine anger in their destruction.

anger is better <u>20_PRO_16_32</u> # [He that is] slow to anger [is] better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city.

anger is kindled <u>28_HOS_08_05</u># Thy calf, O Samaria, hath cast [thee] off; mine anger is kindled against them: how long [will it be] ere they attain to innocency?

anger is not 23_ISA_05_25 # Therefore is the anger of the LORD kindled against his people, and he hath stretched forth his hand against them, and hath smitten them: and the hills did tremble, and their carcases [were] torn in the midst of the streets. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

anger is not 23_ISA_09_12 # The Syrians before, and the Philistines behind; and they shall devour Israel with open mouth. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

anger is not 23_ISA_09_17 # Therefore the Lord shall have no joy in their young men, neither shall have mercy on their fatherless and widows: for every one [is] an hypocrite and an evildoer, and every mouth speaketh folly. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

anger is not 23_ISA_09_21 # Manasseh, Ephraim; and Ephraim, Manasseh: [and] they together [shall be] against Judah. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

anger is not <u>23_ISA_10_04</u> # Without me they shall bow down under the prisoners, and they shall fall under the slain. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

anger is outrageous <u>20_PRO_27_04</u> # Wrath [is] cruel, and anger [is] outrageous; but who [is] able to stand before envy?

anger is persecuted <u>23_ISA_14_06</u># He who smote the people in wrath with a continual stroke, he that ruled the nations in anger, is persecuted, [and] none hindereth.

anger is turned <u>28_HOS_14_04</u> # I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely: for mine anger is turned away from him.

anger is turned <u>23_ISA_12_01</u> # And in that day thou shalt say, O LORD, I will praise thee: though thou wast angry with me, thine anger is turned away, and thou comfortedst me.

anger Josiah took <u>12_2KI_23_19</u> # And all the houses also of the high places that [were] in the cities of Samaria, which the kings of Israel had made to provoke [the LORD] to anger, Josiah took away, and did to them according to all the acts that he had done in Bethel.

anger lest they <u>51_COL_03_21</u># Fathers, provoke not your children [to anger], lest they be discouraged.

anger lest thou <u>24_JER_10_24</u> # O LORD, correct me, but with judgment; not in thine anger, lest thou bring me to nothing.

anger lift up <u>19_PSA_07_06</u># Arise, O LORD, in thine anger, lift up thyself because of the rage of mine enemies: and awake for me [to] the judgment [that] thou hast commanded.

anger most bitterly <u>28_HOS_12_14</u> # Ephraim provoked [him] to anger most bitterly: therefore shall he leave his blood upon him, and his reproach shall his Lord return unto him.

anger neither chasten <u>19_PSA_06_01</u># To the chief Musician on Neginoth upon Sheminith, A Psalm of

David. O LORD, rebuke me not in thine anger, neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure.

anger neither is <u>19_PSA_38_03</u># [There is] no soundness in my flesh because of thine anger; neither [is there any] rest in my bones because of my sin.

anger none escaped <u>25_LAM_02_22</u> # Thou hast called as in a solemn day my terrors round about, so that in the day of the LORD'S anger none escaped nor remained: those that I have swaddled and brought up hath mine enemy consumed.

anger nor in <u>27_DAN_11_20</u># Then shall stand up in his estate a raiser of taxes [in] the glory of the kingdom: but within few days he shall be destroyed, neither in anger, nor in battle.

anger of my <u>02_EXO_32_22</u> # And Aaron said, Let not the anger of my lord wax hot: thou knowest the people, that they [are set] on mischief.

anger of Rezin 23_ISA_07_04 # And say unto him, Take heed, and be quiet; fear not, neither be fainthearted for the two tails of these smoking firebrands, for the fierce anger of Rezin with Syria, and of the son of Remaliah.

anger of the <u>13_1CH_13_10</u># And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzza, and he smote him, because he put his hand to the ark: and there he died before God.

anger of the <u>14_2CH_25_15</u># Wherefore the anger of the LORD was kindled against Amaziah, and he sent unto him a prophet, which said unto him, Why hast thou sought after the gods of the people, which could not deliver their own people out of thine hand?

anger of the <u>12_2KI_13_03</u># And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he delivered them into the hand of Hazael king of Syria, and into the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael, all [their] days.

anger of the <u>12_2KI_24_20</u># For through the anger of the LORD it came to pass in Jerusalem and Judah, until he had cast them out from his presence, that Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.

anger of the <u>10_2SA_06_07</u># And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzzah; and God smote him there for [his] error; and there he died by the ark of God.

anger of the <u>10_2SA_24_01</u> # And again the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number Israel and Judah.

anger of the <u>05_DEU_06_15</u># [For the LORD thy God [is] a jealous God among you] lest the anger of the LORD thy God be kindled against thee, and destroy thee from off the face of the earth.

anger of the <u>05_DEU_07_04</u> # For they will turn away thy son from following me, that they may serve other gods: so will the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and destroy thee suddenly.

anger of the <u>05_DEU_29_20</u> # The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven.

anger of the <u>05_DEU_29_27</u># And the anger of the LORD was kindled against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book:

anger of the <u>02_EXO_04_14</u> # And the anger of the LORD was kindled against Moses, and he said, [Is] not Aaron the Levite thy brother? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he cometh forth to meet thee: and when he seeth thee, he will be glad in his heart.

anger of the <u>23_ISA_05_25</u> # Therefore is the anger of the LORD kindled against his people, and he hath stretched forth his hand against them, and hath smitten them: and the hills did tremble, and their carcases [were] torn in the midst of the streets. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

anger of the <u>24_JER_04_08</u># For this gird you with sackcloth, lament and howl: for the fierce anger of the LORD is not turned back from us.

anger of the <u>24_JER_12_13</u># They have sown wheat, but shall reap thorns: they have put themselves to pain, [but] shall not profit: and they shall be ashamed of your revenues because of the fierce anger of the LORD.

anger of the <u>24_JER_23_20</u># The anger of the LORD shall not return, until he have executed, and till he have performed the thoughts of his heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it perfectly.

anger of the <u>24_JER_25_37</u> # And the peaceable habitations are cut down because of the fierce anger of the LORD.

anger of the <u>24_JER_30_24</u> # The fierce anger of the LORD shall not return, until he have done [it], and until he have performed the intents of his heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it.

anger of the <u>24_JER_51_45</u> # My people, go ye out of the midst of her, and deliver ye every man his soul from the fierce anger of the LORD.

anger of the <u>24_JER_52_03</u># For through the anger of the LORD it came to pass in Jerusalem and Judah, till he had cast them out from his presence, that Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.

anger of the <u>06_JOS_07_01</u> # But the children of Israel committed a trespass in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel.

anger of the <u>06_JOS_23_16</u> # When ye have transgressed the covenant of the LORD your God, which he commanded you, and have gone and served other gods, and bowed yourselves to them; then shall the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and ye shall perish quickly from off the good land which he hath given unto you.

anger of the <u>07_JUD_02_14</u># And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he delivered them into the hands of spoilers that spoiled them, and he sold them into the hands of their enemies round about, so that they could not any longer stand before their enemies.

anger of the <u>07_JUD_02_20</u> # And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel; and he said, Because that this people hath transgressed my covenant which I commanded their fathers, and have not hearkened unto my voice;

anger of the <u>07_JUD_03_08</u># Therefore the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hand of Chushanrishathaim king of Mesopotamia: and the children of Israel served Chushanrishathaim eight years.

anger of the <u>07_JUD_10_07</u># And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hands of the Philistines, and into the hands of the children of Ammon.

anger of the <u>25_LAM_04_16</u> # The anger of the LORD hath divided them; he will no more regard them: they respected not the persons of the priests, they favoured not the elders.

anger of the <u>04_NUM_11_10</u># Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in

the door of his tent: and the anger of the LORD was kindled greatly; Moses also was displeased.

anger of the <u>04_NUM_12_09</u># And the anger of the LORD was kindled against them; and he departed.

anger of the <u>04_NUM_25_03</u># And Israel joined himself unto Baalpeor: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel.

stranger and take <u>20_PRO_20_16</u># Take his garment that is surety [for] a stranger: and take a pledge of him for a strange woman.

stranger and take <u>20_PRO_27_13</u># Take his garment that is surety for a stranger, and take a pledge of him for a strange woman.

stranger and the <u>05_DEU_14_29</u> # And the Levite, [because he hath no part nor inheritance with thee,] and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, which [are] within thy gates, shall come, and shall eat and be satisfied; that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hand which thou doest.

stranger and the <u>05_DEU_16_11</u># And thou shalt rejoice before the LORD thy God, thou, and thy son, and thy daughter, and thy manservant, and thy maidservant, and the Levite that [is] within thy gates, and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that [are] among you, in the place which the LORD thy God hath chosen to place his name there.

stranger eat of <u>03_LEV_22_10</u># There shall no stranger eat [of] the holy thing: a sojourner of the priest, or an hired servant, shall not eat [of] the holy thing.

stranger eat thereof <u>02_EXO_12_43</u># And the LORD said unto Moses and Aaron, This [is] the ordinance of the passover: There shall no stranger eat thereof:

stranger in the <u>01_GEN_37_01</u># And Jacob dwelt in the land wherein his father was a stranger, in the land of Canaan.

stranger in the 24_JER_14_08 # O the hope of Israel, the saviour thereof in time of trouble, why shouldest

thou be as a stranger in the land, and as a wayfaring man [that] turneth aside to tarry for a night?

stranger in the <u>19_PSA_119_19</u># I [am] a stranger in the earth: hide not thy commandments from me.

stranger in thee <u>26_EZE_22_07</u> # In thee have they set light by father and mother: in the midst of thee have they dealt by oppression with the stranger: in thee have they vexed the fatherless and the widow.

stranger which flattereth <u>20_PRO_07_05</u># That they may keep thee from the strange woman, from the stranger [which] flattereth with her words.

stranger which God <u>01_GEN_28_04</u> # And give thee the blessing of Abraham, to thee, and to thy seed with thee; that thou mayest inherit the land wherein thou art a stranger, which God gave unto Abraham.

stranger which is <u>14_2CH_06_32</u># Moreover concerning the stranger, which is not of thy people Israel, but is come from a far country for thy great name's sake, and thy mighty hand, and thy stretched out arm; if they come and pray in this house;

stranger which is <u>01_GEN_17_12</u> # And he that is eight days old shall be circumcised among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which [is] not of thy seed.

stranger which is <u>04_NUM_16_40</u># [To be] a memorial unto the children of Israel, that no stranger, which [is] not of the seed of Aaron, come near to offer incense before the LORD; that he be not as Korah, and as his company: as the LORD said to him by the hand of Moses.

stranger will they <u>43_JOH_10_05</u> # And a stranger will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers.

stranger with thee <u>19_PSA_39_12</u># Hear my prayer, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry; hold not thy peace at my tears: for I [am] a stranger with thee, [and] a sojourner, as all my fathers [were].

stranger with us <u>11_1KI_03_18</u># And it came to pass the third day after that I was delivered, that this woman was delivered also: and we [were] together; [there was] no stranger with us in the house, save we two in the house.

stranger's family <u>03_LEV_25_47</u> # And if a sojourner or stranger wax rich by thee, and thy brother [that dwelleth] by him wax poor, and sell himself unto the stranger [or] sojourner by thee, or to the stock of the stranger's family:

stranger's hand shall <u>03_LEV_22_25</u># Neither from a stranger's hand shall ye offer the bread of your God of any of these; because their corruption [is] in them, [and] blemishes [be] in them: they shall not be accepted for you.

strangers and after <u>24_JER_02_25</u># Withhold thy foot from being unshod, and thy throat from thirst: but thou saidst, There is no hope: no; for I have loved strangers, and after them will I go.

strangers and appointed <u>16_NEH_13_30</u># Thus cleansed I them from all strangers, and appointed the wards of the priests and the Levites, every one in his business;

strangers and foreigners <u>49_EPH_02_19</u> # Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God;

strangers and pilgrims <u>60_1PE_02_11</u># Dearly beloved, I beseech [you] as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;

strangers and pilgrims <u>58_HEB_11_13</u># These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of [them], and embraced [them], and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

strangers and sojourners <u>03_LEV_25_23</u># The land shall not be sold for ever: for the land [is] mine; for ye [are] strangers and sojourners with me.

strangers and stood <u>16_NEH_09_02</u># And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.

strangers and will <u>26_EZE_11_09</u># And I will bring you out of the midst thereof, and deliver you into the hands of strangers, and will execute judgments among you.

strangers are come <u>24_JER_51_51</u> # We are confounded, because we have heard reproach: shame hath covered our faces: for strangers are come into the sanctuaries of the LORD'S house.

strangers are risen <u>19_PSA_54_03</u> # For strangers are risen up against me, and oppressors seek after my soul: they have not set God before them. Selah.

strangers as the <u>23_ISA_25_05</u> # Thou shalt bring down the noise of strangers, as the heat in a dry place; [even] the heat with the shadow of a cloud: the branch of the terrible ones shall be brought low.

strangers be filled <u>20_PRO_05_10</u># Lest strangers be filled with thy wealth; and thy labours [be] in the house of a stranger;

strangers before thee <u>13_1CH_29_15</u># For we [are] strangers before thee, and sojourners, as [were] all our fathers: our days on the earth [are] as a shadow, and [there is] none abiding.

strangers carried away <u>31_OBA_01_11</u># In the day that thou stoodest on the other side, in the day that the strangers carried away captive his forces, and foreigners entered into his gates, and cast lots upon Jerusalem, even thou [wast] as one of them.

strangers could not <u>01_GEN_36_07</u># For their riches were more than that they might dwell together; and the land wherein they were strangers could not bear them because of their cattle.

strangers devour it <u>23_ISA_01_07</u># Your country [is] desolate, your cities [are] burned with fire: your land, strangers devour it in your presence, and [it is] desolate, as overthrown by strangers.

strangers eat <u>23_ISA_05_17</u># Then shall the lambs feed after their manner, and the waste places of the fat ones shall strangers eat.

strangers for a <u>26_EZE_07_21</u> # And I will give it into the hands of the strangers for a prey, and to the wicked of the earth for a spoil; and they shall pollute it.

strangers for he <u>01_GEN_31_15</u># Are we not counted of him strangers? for he hath sold us, and hath quite devoured also our money.

strangers for I <u>26_EZE_28_10</u> # Thou shalt die the deaths of the uncircumcised by the hand of strangers: for I have spoken [it], saith the Lord GOD.

strangers for thereby <u>58_HEB_13_02</u># Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

strangers from the <u>49_EPH_02_12</u> # That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world:

Strangers have devoured <u>28_HOS_07_09</u> # Strangers have devoured his strength, and he knoweth [it] not: yea, gray hairs are here and there upon him, yet he knoweth not.

strangers he relieveth <u>19_PSA_146_09</u># The LORD preserveth the strangers; he relieveth the fatherless and widow: but the way of the wicked he turneth upside down.

strangers I the <u>26_EZE_30_12</u># And I will make the rivers dry, and sell the land into the hand of the wicked: and I will make the land waste, and all that is therein, by the hand of strangers: I the LORD have spoken [it].

strangers if she <u>54_1TI_05_10</u># Well reported of for good works; if she have brought up children, if she have lodged strangers, if she have washed the saints' feet, if she have relieved the afflicted, if she have diligently followed every good work.

strangers in a 24_JER_05_19 # And it shall come to pass, when ye shall say, Wherefore doeth the LORD our God all these [things] unto us? then shalt thou answer them, Like as ye have forsaken me, and served strange gods in your land, so shall ye serve strangers in a land [that is] not yours.

strangers in Israel <u>03_LEV_22_18</u># Speak unto Aaron, and to his sons, and unto all the children of Israel, and say unto them, Whatsoever [he be] of the house of Israel, or of the strangers in Israel, that will offer his oblation for all his vows, and for all his freewill offerings, which they will offer unto the LORD for a burnt offering;

strangers in it <u>13_1CH_16_19</u># When ye were but few, even a few, and strangers in it.

strangers in it <u>19_PSA_105_12</u># When they were [but] a few men in number; yea, very few, and strangers in it.

strangers in the <u>44_ACT_13_17</u># The God of this people of Israel chose our fathers, and exalted the people when they dwelt as strangers in the land of Egypt, and with an high arm brought he them out of it.

strangers in the <u>05_DEU_10_19</u># Love ye therefore the stranger: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

strangers in the <u>02_EXO_22_21</u> # Thou shalt neither vex a stranger, nor oppress him: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

strangers in the <u>02_EXO_23_09</u> # Also thou shalt not oppress a stranger: for ye know the heart of a stranger, seeing ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.

strangers in the <u>03_LEV_19_34</u> # [But] the stranger that dwelleth with you shall be unto you as one born among you, and thou shalt love him as thyself; for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt: I [am] the LORD your God.

strangers in <u>40_MAT_27_07</u># And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.

strangers instead of <u>26_EZE_16_32</u># [But as] a wife that committeth adultery, [which] taketh strangers instead of her husband!

strangers Jesus saith <u>40_MAT_17_26</u># Peter saith unto him, Of strangers. Jesus saith unto him, Then are the children free.

strangers of Rome <u>44_ACT_02_10</u> # Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes,

strangers of the <u>05_DEU_31_16</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Behold, thou shalt sleep with thy fathers; and this people will rise up, and go a whoring after the gods of the strangers of the land, whither they go [to be] among them, and will forsake me, and break my covenant which I have made with them.

strangers our houses 25_LAM_05_02 # Our inheritance is turned to strangers, our houses to aliens.

strangers pass through <u>29_JOE_03_17</u> # So shall ye know that I [am] the LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my holy mountain: then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more.

strangers scattered throughout <u>60_1PE_01_01</u># Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to the strangers scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia,

strangers shall be <u>23_ISA_14_01</u> # For the LORD will have mercy on Jacob, and will yet choose Israel, and set them in their own land: and the strangers shall be joined with them, and they shall cleave to the house of Jacob.

strangers shall no <u>24_JER_30_08</u> # For it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, [that] I will break his yoke from off thy neck, and will burst thy bonds, and strangers shall no more serve themselves of him:

strangers shall stand <u>23_ISA_61_05</u># And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien [shall be] your plowmen and your vinedressers.

Strangers shall submit <u>10_2SA_22_45</u># Strangers shall submit themselves unto me: as soon as they hear, they shall be obedient unto me.

strangers shall submit <u>19_PSA_18_44</u> # As soon as they hear of me, they shall obey me: the strangers shall submit themselves unto me.

strangers shall swallow <u>28_HOS_08_07</u> # For they have sown the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind: it hath no stalk: the bud shall yield no meal: if so be it yield, the strangers shall swallow it up.

strangers spoil his <u>19_PSA_109_11</u># Let the extortioner catch all that he hath; and let the strangers spoil his labour.

strangers that are <u>05_DEU_24_14</u> # Thou shalt not oppress an hired servant [that is] poor and needy, [whether he be] of thy brethren, or of thy strangers that [are] in thy land within thy gates:

strangers that came <u>14_2CH_30_25</u> # And all the congregation of Judah, with the priests and the Levites, and all the congregation that came out of Israel, and the strangers that came out of the land of Israel, and that dwelt in Judah, rejoiced.

strangers that do <u>03_LEV_25_45</u> # Moreover of the children of the strangers that do sojourn among you, of them shall ye buy, and of their families that [are] with you, which they begat in your land: and they shall be your possession.

strangers upon thee <u>26_EZE_28_07</u># Behold, therefore I will bring strangers upon thee, the terrible of the nations: and they shall draw their swords against the beauty of thy wisdom, and they shall defile thy brightness.

strangers which sojourn <u>03_LEV_17_08</u># And thou shalt say unto them, Whatsoever man [there be] of the house of Israel, or of the strangers which sojourn among you, that offereth a burnt offering or sacrifice,

strangers which were <u>44_ACT_17_21</u> # [For all the Athenians and strangers which were there spent their time in nothing else, but either to tell, or to hear some new thing.]

strangers with thee <u>20_PRO_05_17</u> # Let them be only thine own, and not strangers' with thee.

strangers with them <u>14_2CH_15_09</u> # And he gathered all Judah and Benjamin, and the strangers with them out of Ephraim and Manasseh, and out of Simeon: for they fell to him out of Israel in abundance, when they saw that the LORD his God [was] with him.

strangers <u>64_3JO_01_05</u># Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers;

strangers <u>02_EXO_06_04</u> # And I have also established my covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, wherein they were strangers.

strangers <u>23_ISA_01_07</u> # Your country [is] desolate, your cities [are] burned with fire: your land, strangers devour it in your presence, and [it is] desolate, as overthrown by strangers.

strangers <u>40_MAT_17_25</u># He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, Jesus prevented him, saying, What thinkest thou, Simon? of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? of their own children, or of strangers?
