approve by your <u>46\_1CO\_16\_03</u> # And when I come, whomsoever ye shall approve by [your] letters, them will I send to bring your liberality unto Jerusalem.

approve their sayings <u>19\_PSA\_49\_13</u># This their way [is] their folly: yet their posterity approve their sayings. Selah.

approve things that <u>50\_PHP\_01\_10</u># That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ;

approved but that <u>47\_2CO\_13\_07</u> # Now I pray to God that ye do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that ye should do that which is honest, though we be as reprobates.

approved but whom <u>47\_2CO\_10\_18</u># For not he that commendeth himself is approved, but whom the Lord commendeth.

approved in Christ <u>45\_ROM\_16\_10</u># Salute Apelles approved in Christ. Salute them which are of Aristobulus' [household].

approved may be <u>46\_1CO\_11\_19</u># For there must be also heresies among you, that they which are approved may be made manifest among you.

approved of God <u>44\_ACT\_02\_22</u># Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know:

approved of men <u>45\_ROM\_14\_18</u># For he that in these things serveth Christ [is] acceptable to God, and approved of men.

approved unto God <u>55\_2TI\_02\_15</u> # Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

approved yourselves to <u>47\_2CO\_07\_11</u> # For behold this selfsame thing, that ye sorrowed after a godly sort, what carefulness it wrought in you, yea, [what] clearing of yourselves, yea, [what] indignation, yea, [what] fear, yea, [what] vehement desire, yea, [what] zeal, yea, [what] revenge! In all [things] ye have approved yourselves to be clear in this matter.

approvest the things <u>45\_ROM\_02\_18</u> # And knowest [his] will, and approvest the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the law;

approveth not 25\_LAM\_03\_36 # To subvert a man in his cause, the Lord approveth not.
