dark I will <u>26\_EZE\_32\_07</u> # And when I shall put thee out, I will cover the heaven, and make the stars thereof dark; I will cover the sun with a cloud, and the moon shall not give her light.

dark in his <u>18\_JOB\_18\_06</u># The light shall be dark in his tabernacle, and his candle shall be put out with him.

dark it is <u>03\_LEV\_13\_28</u># And if the bright spot stay in his place, [and] spread not in the skin, but it [be] somewhat dark; it [is] a rising of the burning, and the priest shall pronounce him clean: for it [is] an inflammation of the burning.

dark let it <u>18\_JOB\_03\_09</u># Let the stars of the twilight thereof be dark; let it look for light, but [have] none; neither let it see the dawning of the day:

dark mountains and <u>24\_JER\_13\_16</u># Give glory to the LORD your God, before he cause darkness, and before your feet stumble upon the dark mountains, and, while ye look for light, he turn it into the shadow of death, [and] make [it] gross darkness.

dark night <u>20\_PRO\_07\_09</u> # In the twilight, in the evening, in the black and dark night:

dark over thee <u>26\_EZE\_32\_08</u> # All the bright lights of heaven will I make dark over thee, and set darkness upon thy land, saith the Lord GOD.

dark over them <u>33\_MIC\_03\_06</u># Therefore night [shall be] unto you, that ye shall not have a vision; and it shall be dark unto you, that ye shall not divine; and the sun shall go down over the prophets, and the day shall be dark over them.

dark place of <u>23\_ISA\_45\_19</u> # I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I said not unto the seed of Jacob, Seek ye me in vain: I the LORD speak righteousness, I declare things that are right.

dark place until <u>61\_2PE\_01\_19</u># We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

dark places as <u>25\_LAM\_03\_06</u># He hath set me in dark places, as [they that be] dead of old.

dark speeches and <u>04\_NUM\_12\_08</u> # With him will I speak mouth to mouth, even apparently, and not in dark speeches; and the similitude of the LORD shall he behold: wherefore then were ye not afraid to speak against my servant Moses?

darkly but then <u>46\_1CO\_13\_12</u> # For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.

darkness a swaddlingband <u>18\_JOB\_38\_09</u># When I made the cloud the garment thereof, and thick darkness a swaddlingband for it,

darkness all the <u>19\_PSA\_82\_05</u> # They know not, neither will they understand; they walk on in darkness: all the foundations of the earth are out of course.

hearken unto me <u>44\_ACT\_15\_13</u> # And after they had held their peace, James answered, saying, Men [and] brethren, hearken unto me:

hearken unto me <u>02\_EXO\_06\_30</u> # And Moses said before the LORD, Behold, I [am] of uncircumcised lips, and how shall Pharaoh hearken unto me?

hearken unto me <u>26\_EZE\_03\_07</u> # But the house of Israel will not hearken unto thee; for they will not hearken unto me: for all the house of Israel [are] impudent and hardhearted.

hearken unto me <u>26\_EZE\_20\_08</u># But they rebelled against me, and would not hearken unto me: they did not every man cast away the abominations of their eyes, neither did they forsake the idols of Egypt: then I said, I will pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the midst of the land of Egypt.

hearken unto me <u>26\_EZE\_20\_39</u> # As for you, O house of Israel, thus saith the Lord GOD; Go ye, serve ye every one his idols, and hereafter [also], if ye will not hearken unto me: but pollute ye my holy name no more with your gifts, and with your idols.

hearken unto me <u>01\_GEN\_23\_15</u> # My lord, hearken unto me: the land [is worth] four hundred shekels of silver; what [is] that betwixt me and thee? bury therefore thy dead.

Hearken unto me <u>23\_ISA\_46\_03</u># Hearken unto me, O house of Jacob, and all the remnant of the house of Israel, which are borne [by me] from the belly, which are carried from the womb:

Hearken unto me 23\_ISA\_46\_12 # Hearken unto me, ye stouthearted, that [are] far from righteousness:

Hearken unto me <u>23\_ISA\_48\_12</u> # Hearken unto me, O Jacob and Israel, my called; I [am] he; I [am] the first, I also [am] the last.

Hearken unto me <u>23\_ISA\_51\_04</u> # Hearken unto me, my people; and give ear unto me, O my nation: for a law shall proceed from me, and I will make my judgment to rest for a light of the people.

Hearken unto me <u>23\_ISA\_51\_07</u> # Hearken unto me, ye that know righteousness, the people in whose heart [is] my law; fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings.

hearken unto me <u>24\_JER\_16\_12</u> # And ye have done worse than your fathers; for, behold, ye walk every one after the imagination of his evil heart, that they may not hearken unto me:

hearken unto me <u>24\_JER\_17\_24</u> # And it shall come to pass, if ye diligently hearken unto me, saith the LORD, to bring in no burden through the gates of this city on the sabbath day, but hallow the sabbath day,

to do no work therein;

hearken unto me <u>24\_JER\_17\_27</u> # But if ye will not hearken unto me to hallow the sabbath day, and not to bear a burden, even entering in at the gates of Jerusalem on the sabbath day; then will I kindle a fire in the gates thereof, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem, and it shall not be quenched.

hearken unto me <u>24\_JER\_38\_15</u> # Then Jeremiah said unto Zedekiah, If I declare [it] unto thee, wilt thou not surely put me to death? and if I give thee counsel, wilt thou not hearken unto me?

hearken unto me <u>18\_JOB\_33\_31</u># Mark well, O Job, hearken unto me: hold thy peace, and I will speak.

hearken unto me <u>18\_JOB\_33\_33</u> # If not, hearken unto me: hold thy peace, and I shall teach thee wisdom.

hearken unto me <u>18\_JOB\_34\_10</u> # Therefore hearken unto me, ye men of understanding: far be it from God, [that he should do] wickedness; and [from] the Almighty, [that he should commit] iniquity.

hearken unto me <u>18\_JOB\_34\_34</u> # Let men of understanding tell me, and let a wise man hearken unto me.

Hearken unto me <u>07\_JUD\_09\_07</u> # And when they told [it] to Jotham, he went and stood in the top of mount Gerizim, and lifted up his voice, and cried, and said unto them, Hearken unto me, ye men of Shechem, that God may hearken unto you.

hearken unto me <u>03\_LEV\_26\_14</u> # But if ye will not hearken unto me, and will not do all these commandments;

hearken unto me <u>03\_LEV\_26\_18</u># And if ye will not yet for all this hearken unto me, then I will punish you seven times more for your sins.

hearken unto me <u>03\_LEV\_26\_21</u># And if ye walk contrary unto me, and will not hearken unto me; I will bring seven times more plagues upon you according to your sins.

hearken unto me <u>03\_LEV\_26\_27</u># And if ye will not for all this hearken unto me, but walk contrary unto me;

Hearken unto me <u>41\_MAR\_07\_14</u> # And when he had called all the people [unto him], he said unto them, Hearken unto me every one [of you], and understand:

hearken unto me <u>04\_NUM\_23\_18</u># And he took up his parable, and said, Rise up, Balak, and hear; hearken unto me, thou son of Zippor:

Hearken unto me <u>20\_PRO\_07\_24</u> # Hearken unto me now therefore, O ye children, and attend to the words of my mouth.

hearken unto me <u>20\_PRO\_08\_32</u> # Now therefore hearken unto me, O ye children: for blessed [are they that] keep my ways.

hearken unto me <u>19\_PSA\_34\_11</u># Come, ye children, hearken unto me: I will teach you the fear of the LORD.

hearken unto me <u>19\_PSA\_81\_08</u># Hear, O my people, and I will testify unto thee: O Israel, if thou wilt hearken unto me;

hearken unto me <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_04</u> # Be ye not as your fathers, unto whom the former prophets have cried, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Turn ye now from your evil ways, and [from] your evil doings: but they did not hear, nor hearken unto me, saith the LORD.

hearken unto my <u>12\_2KI\_10\_06</u># Then he wrote a letter the second time to them, saying, If ye [be] mine, and [if] ye will hearken unto my voice, take ye the heads of the men your master's sons, and come to me to Jezreel by to morrow this time. Now the king's sons, [being] seventy persons, [were] with the great men of the city, which brought them up.

hearken unto my <u>05\_DEU\_18\_19</u># And it shall come to pass, [that] whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require [it] of him.

hearken unto my <u>02\_EXO\_04\_01</u> # And Moses answered and said, But, behold, they will not believe me, nor hearken unto my voice: for they will say, The LORD hath not appeared unto thee.

hearken unto my <u>01\_GEN\_04\_23</u> # And Lamech said unto his wives, Adah and Zillah, Hear my voice; ye wives of Lamech, hearken unto my speech: for I have slain a man to my wounding, and a young man to my hurt.

hearken unto our <u>10\_2SA\_12\_18</u> # And it came to pass on the seventh day, that the child died. And the servants of David feared to tell him that the child was dead: for they said, Behold, while the child was yet alive, we spake unto him, and he would not hearken unto our voice: how will he then vex himself, if we tell him that the child is dead?

hearken unto the <u>11\_1KI\_08\_28</u># Yet have thou respect unto the prayer of thy servant, and to his supplication, O LORD my God, to hearken unto the cry and to the prayer, which thy servant prayeth before thee to day:

hearken unto the <u>11\_1KI\_08\_29</u># That thine eyes may be open toward this house night and day, [even] toward the place of which thou hast said, My name shall be there: that thou mayest hearken unto the prayer which thy servant shall make toward this place.

Hearken unto the <u>09\_1SA\_08\_07</u> # And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them.

hearken unto the <u>14\_2CH\_06\_19</u># Have respect therefore to the prayer of thy servant, and to his supplication, O LORD my God, to hearken unto the cry and the prayer which thy servant prayeth before thee:

hearken unto the <u>14\_2CH\_06\_20</u> # That thine eyes may be open upon this house day and night, upon the place whereof thou hast said that thou wouldest put thy name there; to hearken unto the prayer which thy servant prayeth toward this place.

hearken unto the <u>05\_DEU\_13\_03</u># Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for the LORD your God proveth you, to know whether ye love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

hearken unto the <u>05\_DEU\_15\_05</u> # Only if thou carefully hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all these commandments which I command thee this day.

hearken unto the <u>05\_DEU\_17\_12</u> # And the man that will do presumptuously, and will not hearken unto the priest that standeth to minister there before the LORD thy God, or unto the judge, even that man shall die: and thou shalt put away the evil from Israel.

hearken unto the <u>05\_DEU\_28\_02</u># And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.

hearken unto the <u>05\_DEU\_28\_13</u> # And the LORD shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath; if that thou hearken unto the commandments of the LORD thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do [them]:

hearken unto the <u>05\_DEU\_28\_15</u> # But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

hearken unto the <u>05\_DEU\_30\_10</u># If thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which are written in this book of the law, [and] if thou turn unto the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul.

hearken unto the <u>24\_JER\_37\_02</u># But neither he, nor his servants, nor the people of the land, did hearken unto the words of the LORD, which he spake by the prophet Jeremiah.

hearken unto the <u>07\_JUD\_03\_04</u> # And they were to prove Israel by them, to know whether they would hearken unto the commandments of the LORD, which he commanded their fathers by the hand of Moses.

Hearken unto the <u>19\_PSA\_05\_02</u># Hearken unto the voice of my cry, my King, and my God: for unto thee will I pray.

hearken unto thee <u>26 EZE 03 07</u> # But the house of Israel will not hearken unto thee; for they will not hearken unto me: for all the house of Israel [are] impudent and hardhearted.

hearken unto thee <u>24\_JER\_44\_16</u># [As for] the word that thou hast spoken unto us in the name of the LORD, we will not hearken unto thee.

hearken unto thee <u>06\_JOS\_01\_17</u> # According as we hearkened unto Moses in all things, so will we hearken unto thee: only the LORD thy God be with thee, as he was with Moses.

hearken unto their <u>09\_1SA\_08\_09</u> # Now therefore hearken unto their voice: howbeit yet protest solemnly unto them, and show them the manner of the king that shall reign over them.

Hearken unto their <u>09\_1SA\_08\_22</u> # And the LORD said to Samuel, Hearken unto their voice, and make them a king. And Samuel said unto the men of Israel, Go ye every man unto his city.

hearken unto their <u>07\_JUD\_02\_17</u> # And yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in, obeying the commandments of the LORD; [but] they did not so.

hearken unto them <u>11\_1KI\_08\_52</u># That thine eyes may be open unto the supplication of thy servant, and unto the supplication of thy people Israel, to hearken unto them in all that they call for unto thee.

hearken unto them <u>14\_2CH\_10\_16</u># And when all Israel [saw] that the king would not hearken unto them, the people answered the king, saying, What portion have we in David? and [we have] none inheritance in the son of Jesse: every man to your tents, O Israel: [and] now, David, see to thine own house. So all Israel went to their tents.

hearken unto them <u>05\_DEU\_21\_18</u># If a man have a stubborn and rebellious son, which will not obey the voice of his father, or the voice of his mother, and [that], when they have chastened him, will not hearken unto them:

hearken unto them <u>02\_EXO\_07\_22</u> # And the magicians of Egypt did so with their enchantments: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, neither did he hearken unto them; as the LORD had said.

hearken unto them <u>24\_JER\_11\_11</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will bring evil upon them, which they shall not be able to escape; and though they shall cry unto me, I will not hearken unto them.

Hearken unto this <u>18\_JOB\_37\_14</u># Hearken unto this, O Job: stand still, and consider the wondrous works of God.

hearken unto thy <u>02\_EXO\_04\_09</u> # And it shall come to pass, if they will not believe also these two signs, neither hearken unto thy voice, that thou shalt take of the water of the river, and pour [it] upon the dry [land]: and the water which thou takest out of the river shall become blood upon the dry [land].

hearken unto thy <u>06\_JOS\_01\_18</u> # Whosoever [he be] that doth rebel against thy commandment, and will not hearken unto thy words in all that thou commandest him, he shall be put to death: only be strong and of a good courage.

Hearken unto thy <u>20\_PRO\_23\_22</u># Hearken unto thy father that begat thee, and despise not thy mother when she is old.

hearken unto us <u>01\_GEN\_34\_17</u> # But if ye will not hearken unto us, to be circumcised; then will we take our daughter, and we will be gone.

hearken unto you <u>09\_1SA\_30\_24</u> # For who will hearken unto you in this matter? but as his part [is] that goeth down to the battle, so [shall] his part [be] that tarrieth by the stuff: they shall part alike.

hearken unto you <u>44\_ACT\_04\_19</u># But Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye.

hearken unto you <u>02\_EXO\_07\_04</u># But Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you, that I may lay my hand upon Egypt, and bring forth mine armies, [and] my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgments.

hearken unto you <u>02\_EXO\_11\_09</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you; that my wonders may be multiplied in the land of Egypt.

hearken unto you 24\_JER\_29\_12 # Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you.

hearken unto you <u>07\_JUD\_09\_07</u> # And when they told [it] to Jotham, he went and stood in the top of mount Gerizim, and lifted up his voice, and cried, and said unto them, Hearken unto me, ye men of Shechem, that God may hearken unto you.

hearken unto you <u>16\_NEH\_13\_27</u># Shall we then hearken unto you to do all this great evil, to transgress against our God in marrying strange wives?

Hearken ye all <u>14\_2CH\_20\_15</u> # And he said, Hearken ye, all Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou king Jehoshaphat, Thus saith the LORD unto you, Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle [is] not yours, but God's.

hearken ye house <u>28\_HOS\_05\_01</u> # Hear ye this, O priests; and hearken, ye house of Israel; and give ye ear, O house of the king; for judgment [is] toward you, because ye have been a snare on Mizpah, and a net spread upon Tabor.

hearken ye people <u>23\_ISA\_34\_01</u> # Come near, ye nations, to hear; and hearken, ye people: let the earth hear, and all that is therein; the world, and all things that come forth of it.

hearken ye people 23\_ISA\_49\_01 # Listen, O isles, unto me; and hearken, ye people, from far; The LORD

hath called me from the womb; from the bowels of my mother hath he made mention of my name.

hearken <u>14\_2CH\_33\_10</u># And the LORD spake to Manasseh, and to his people: but they would not hearken.

hearken <u>05\_DEU\_18\_15</u># The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;

hearken <u>23\_ISA\_32\_03</u> # And the eyes of them that see shall not be dim, and the ears of them that hear shall hearken.

hearken <u>24\_JER\_06\_17</u># Also I set watchmen over you, [saying], Hearken to the sound of the trumpet. But they said, We will not hearken.

hearkened all that <u>01\_GEN\_34\_24</u> # And unto Hamor and unto Shechem his son hearkened all that went out of the gate of his city; and every male was circumcised, all that went out of the gate of his city.

hearkened and heard 24\_JER\_08\_06 # I hearkened and heard, [but] they spake not aright: no man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done? every one turned to his course, as the horse rusheth into the battle.

hearkened and heard <u>39\_MAL\_03\_16</u># Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard [it], and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.

hearkened diligently with <u>23\_ISA\_21\_07</u> # And he saw a chariot [with] a couple of horsemen, a chariot of asses, [and] a chariot of camels; and he hearkened diligently with much heed:

hearkened nor inclined <u>24\_JER\_25\_04</u> # And the LORD hath sent unto you all his servants the prophets, rising early and sending [them]; but ye have not hearkened, nor inclined your ear to hear.

hearkened not and <u>12\_2KI\_21\_09</u># But they hearkened not: and Manasseh seduced them to do more evil than did the nations whom the LORD destroyed before the children of Israel.

hearkened not nor <u>24\_JER\_07\_24</u> # But they hearkened not, nor inclined their ear, but walked in the counsels [and] in the imagination of their evil heart, and went backward, and not forward.

hearkened not nor <u>24\_JER\_44\_05</u># But they hearkened not, nor inclined their ear to turn from their wickedness, to burn no incense unto other gods.

hearkened not to <u>24\_JER\_37\_14</u> # Then said Jeremiah, [It is] false; I fall not away to the Chaldeans. But he hearkened not to him: so Irijah took Jeremiah, and brought him to the princes.

hearkened not to <u>16\_NEH\_09\_16</u># But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments,

hearkened not unto <u>11\_1KI\_12\_15</u># Wherefore the king hearkened not unto the people; for the cause was from the LORD, that he might perform his saying, which the LORD spake by Ahijah the Shilonite unto Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

hearkened not unto <u>11\_1KI\_12\_16</u># So when all Israel saw that the king hearkened not unto them, the people answered the king, saying, What portion have we in David? neither [have we] inheritance in the son of Jesse: to your tents, O Israel: now see to thine own house, David. So Israel departed unto their tents.

hearkened not unto 09\_1SA\_02\_25 # If one man sin against another, the judge shall judge him: but if a man

sin against the LORD, who shall entreat for him? Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto the voice of their father, because the LORD would slay them.

hearkened not unto <u>14\_2CH\_10\_15</u> # So the king hearkened not unto the people: for the cause was of God, that the LORD might perform his word, which he spake by the hand of Ahijah the Shilonite to Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

hearkened not unto <u>14\_2CH\_35\_22</u> # Nevertheless Josiah would not turn his face from him, but disguised himself, that he might fight with him, and hearkened not unto the words of Necho from the mouth of God, and came to fight in the valley of Megiddo.

hearkened not unto <u>17\_EST\_03\_04</u> # Now it came to pass, when they spake daily unto him, and he hearkened not unto them, that they told Haman, to see whether Mordecai's matters would stand: for he had told them that he [was] a Jew.

hearkened not unto <u>02\_EXO\_06\_09</u> # And Moses spake so unto the children of Israel: but they hearkened not unto Moses for anguish of spirit, and for cruel bondage.

hearkened not unto <u>02\_EXO\_07\_13</u> # And he hardened Pharaoh's heart, that he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

hearkened not unto <u>02\_EXO\_08\_15</u># But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he hardened his heart, and hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

hearkened not unto <u>02\_EXO\_08\_19</u># Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This [is] the finger of God: and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

hearkened not unto <u>02\_EXO\_09\_12</u># And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had spoken unto Moses.

hearkened not unto <u>02\_EXO\_16\_20</u> # Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto Moses; but some of them left of it until the morning, and it bred worms, and stank: and Moses was wroth with them.

hearkened not unto <u>01\_GEN\_39\_10</u> # And it came to pass, as she spake to Joseph day by day, that he hearkened not unto her, to lie by her, [or] to be with her.

hearkened not unto <u>24\_JER\_07\_26</u> # Yet they hearkened not unto me, nor inclined their ear, but hardened their neck: they did worse than their fathers.

hearkened not unto 24\_JER\_34\_14 # At the end of seven years let ye go every man his brother an Hebrew, which hath been sold unto thee; and when he hath served thee six years, thou shalt let him go free from thee: but your fathers hearkened not unto me, neither inclined their ear.

hearkened not unto <u>24\_JER\_35\_14</u># The words of Jonadab the son of Rechab, that he commanded his sons not to drink wine, are performed; for unto this day they drink none, but obey their father's commandment: notwithstanding I have spoken unto you, rising early and speaking; but ye hearkened not unto me.

hearkened not unto <u>07\_JUD\_11\_28</u># Howbeit the king of the children of Ammon hearkened not unto the words of Jephthah which he sent him.

hearkened not unto <u>16\_NEH\_09\_29</u># And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, [which if a man do, he shall live in them;] and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear. hearkened not unto <u>19\_PSA\_106\_25</u> # But murmured in their tents, [and] hearkened not unto the voice of the LORD.

hearkened not <u>24\_JER\_36\_31</u># And I will punish him and his seed and his servants for their iniquity; and I will bring upon them, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and upon the men of Judah, all the evil that I have pronounced against them; but they hearkened not.

hearkened therefore to <u>11\_1KI\_12\_24</u># Thus saith the LORD, Ye shall not go up, nor fight against your brethren the children of Israel: return every man to his house; for this thing is from me. They hearkened therefore to the word of the LORD, and returned to depart, according to the word of the LORD.

hearkened to her <u>01\_GEN\_30\_22</u># And God remembered Rachel, and God hearkened to her, and opened her womb.

hearkened to Hezekiah <u>14\_2CH\_30\_20</u> # And the LORD hearkened to Hezekiah, and healed the people.

hearkened to his <u>05\_DEU\_09\_23</u> # Likewise when the LORD sent you from Kadeshbarnea, saying, Go up and possess the land which I have given you; then ye rebelled against the commandment of the LORD your God, and ye believed him not, nor hearkened to his voice.

hearkened to my <u>23\_ISA\_48\_18</u># O that thou hadst hearkened to my commandments! then had thy peace been as a river, and thy righteousness as the waves of the sea:

hearkened to my <u>24\_JER\_29\_19</u> # Because they have not hearkened to my words, saith the LORD, which I sent unto them by my servants the prophets, rising up early and sending [them]; but ye would not hear, saith the LORD.

hearkened to my <u>04\_NUM\_14\_22</u># Because all those men which have seen my glory, and my miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to my voice;

hearkened to receive <u>24\_JER\_32\_33</u> # And they have turned unto me the back, and not the face: though I taught them, rising up early and teaching [them], yet they have not hearkened to receive instruction.

hearkened to the <u>05\_DEU\_26\_14</u> # I have not eaten thereof in my mourning, neither have I taken away [ought] thereof for [any] unclean [use], nor given [ought] thereof for the dead: [but] I have hearkened to the voice of the LORD my God, [and] have done according to all that thou hast commanded me.

hearkened to the <u>02\_EXO\_18\_24</u># So Moses hearkened to the voice of his father in law, and did all that he had said.

hearkened to the <u>01\_GEN\_16\_02</u># And Sarai said unto Abram, Behold now, the LORD hath restrained me from bearing: I pray thee, go in unto my maid; it may be that I may obtain children by her. And Abram hearkened to the voice of Sarai.

hearkened to the <u>07\_JUD\_13\_09</u> # And God hearkened to the voice of Manoah; and the angel of God came again unto the woman as she sat in the field: but Manoah her husband [was] not with her.

hearkened to the <u>04\_NUM\_21\_03</u># And the LORD hearkened to the voice of Israel, and delivered up the Canaanites; and they utterly destroyed them and their cities: and he called the name of the place Hormah.

hearkened to thy <u>09\_1SA\_25\_35</u> # So David received of her hand [that] which she had brought him, and said unto her, Go up in peace to thine house; see, I have hearkened to thy voice, and have accepted thy person.

hearkened unto Ephron <u>01\_GEN\_23\_16</u># And Abraham hearkened unto Ephron; and Abraham weighed to Ephron the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current [money] with the merchant.

hearkened unto him <u>12\_2KI\_13\_04</u> # And Jehoahaz besought the LORD, and the LORD hearkened unto him: for he saw the oppression of Israel, because the king of Syria oppressed them.

hearkened unto him <u>12\_2KI\_16\_09</u> # And the king of Assyria hearkened unto him: for the king of Assyria went up against Damascus, and took it, and carried [the people of] it captive to Kir, and slew Rezin.

hearkened unto him <u>05\_DEU\_34\_09</u># And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom; for Moses had laid his hands upon him: and the children of Israel hearkened unto him, and did as the LORD commanded Moses.

hearkened unto king <u>11\_1KI\_15\_20</u># So Benhadad hearkened unto king Asa, and sent the captains of the hosts which he had against the cities of Israel, and smote Ijon, and Dan, and Abelbethmaachah, and all Cinneroth, with all the land of Naphtali.

hearkened unto king <u>14\_2CH\_16\_04</u># And Benhadad hearkened unto king Asa, and sent the captains of his armies against the cities of Israel; and they smote Ijon, and Dan, and Abelmaim, and all the store cities of Naphtali.

hearkened unto me <u>44\_ACT\_27\_21</u> # But after long abstinence Paul stood forth in the midst of them, and said, Sirs, ye should have hearkened unto me, and not have loosed from Crete, and to have gained this harm and loss.

hearkened unto Moses <u>06\_JOS\_01\_17</u># According as we hearkened unto Moses in all things, so will we hearken unto thee: only the LORD thy God be with thee, as he was with Moses.

hearkened unto my <u>14\_2CH\_25\_16</u># And it came to pass, as he talked with him, that [the king] said unto him, Art thou made of the king's counsel? forbear; why shouldest thou be smitten?
