art a bloody <u>10\_2SA\_16\_08</u># The LORD hath returned upon thee all the blood of the house of Saul, in whose stead thou hast reigned; and the LORD hath delivered the kingdom into the hand of Absalom thy son: and, behold, thou [art taken] in thy mischief, because thou [art] a bloody man.

art a comfort <u>26\_EZE\_16\_54</u> # That thou mayest bear thine own shame, and mayest be confounded in all that thou hast done, in that thou art a comfort unto them.

art a fair <u>01\_GEN\_12\_11</u># And it came to pass, when he was come near to enter into Egypt, that he said unto Sarai his wife, Behold now, I know that thou [art] a fair woman to look upon:

art a Galilaean 41 MAR 14 70 # And he denied it again. And a little after, they that stood by said again to Peter, Surely thou art [one] of them: for thou art a Galilaean, and thy speech agreeth [thereto].

art a God 23\_ISA\_45\_15 # Verily thou [art] a God that hidest thyself, O God of Israel, the Saviour.

art a God <u>16\_NEH\_09\_17</u> # And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou [art] a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.

art a God <u>19\_PSA\_86\_15</u> # But thou, O Lord, [art] a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth.

art a gracious <u>32\_JON\_04\_02</u># And he prayed unto the LORD, and said, I pray thee, O LORD, [was] not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou [art] a gracious God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of the evil.

art a gracious <u>16\_NEH\_09\_31</u># Nevertheless for thy great mercies' sake thou didst not utterly consume them, nor forsake them; for thou [art] a gracious and merciful God.

art a great <u>06\_JOS\_17\_17</u># And Joshua spake unto the house of Joseph, [even] to Ephraim and to Manasseh, saying, Thou [art] a great people, and hast great power: thou shalt not have one lot [only]:

art a guide <u>45\_ROM\_02\_19</u># And art confident that thou thyself art a guide of the blind, a light of them which are in darkness,

art a king <u>27\_DAN\_02\_37</u> # Thou, O king, [art] a king of kings: for the God of heaven hath given thee a kingdom, power, and strength, and glory.

art a man 11\_1KI\_17\_24 # And the woman said to Elijah, Now by this I know that thou [art] a man of God, [and] that the word of the LORD in thy mouth [is] truth.

art a man <u>26\_EZE\_28\_02</u> # Son of man, say unto the prince of Tyrus, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thine heart [is] lifted up, and thou hast said, I [am] a God, I sit [in] the seat of God, in the midst of the seas; yet thou [art] a man, and not God, though thou set thine heart as the heart of God:

art a merchant <u>26\_EZE\_27\_03</u># And say unto Tyrus, O thou that art situate at the entry of the sea, [which art] a merchant of the people for many isles, Thus saith the Lord GOD; O Tyrus, thou hast said, I [am] of

perfect beauty.

art a mighty <u>01\_GEN\_23\_06</u># Hear us, my lord: thou [art] a mighty prince among us: in the choice of our sepulchres bury thy dead; none of us shall withhold from thee his sepulchre, but that thou mayest bury thy dead.

art a near <u>08\_RUT\_03\_09</u># And he said, Who [art] thou? And she answered, I [am] Ruth thine handmaid: spread therefore thy skirt over thine handmaid; for thou [art] a near kinsman.

art a priest <u>58\_HEB\_05\_06</u> # As he saith also in another [place], Thou [art] a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

art a priest 58\_HEB\_07\_17 # For he testifieth, Thou [art] a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

art a priest <u>58\_HEB\_07\_21</u># [For those priests were made without an oath; but this with an oath by him that said unto him, The Lord sware and will not repent, Thou [art] a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec:]

art a priest 19\_PSA\_110\_04# The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou [art] a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.

art a prophet 43\_JOH\_04\_19 # The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet.

art a Samaritan <u>43\_JOH\_08\_48</u> # Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that thou art a Samaritan, and hast a devil?

art a shield 19\_PSA\_03\_03\_# But thou, O LORD, [art] a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.

art a stiffnecked <u>05\_DEU\_09\_06</u># Understand therefore, that the LORD thy God giveth thee not this good land to possess it for thy righteousness; for thou [art] a stiffnecked people.

art a stiffnecked <u>02\_EXO\_33\_03</u># Unto a land flowing with milk and honey: for I will not go up in the midst of thee; for thou [art] a stiffnecked people: lest I consume thee in the way.

art a stranger <u>10\_2SA\_15\_19</u> # Then said the king to Ittai the Gittite, Wherefore goest thou also with us? return to thy place, and abide with the king: for thou [art] a stranger, and also an exile.

art a stranger <u>01\_GEN\_17\_08</u># And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their God.

art a stranger <u>01\_GEN\_28\_04</u> # And give thee the blessing of Abraham, to thee, and to thy seed with thee; that thou mayest inherit the land wherein thou art a stranger, which God gave unto Abraham.

art a swift 24\_JER\_02\_23 # How canst thou say, I am not polluted, I have not gone after Baalim? see thy way in the valley, know what thou hast done: [thou art] a swift dromedary traversing her ways;

art a teacher <u>43\_JOH\_03\_02</u># The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.

art a valiant <u>11\_1KI\_01\_42</u># And while he yet spake, behold, Jonathan the son of Abiathar the priest came: and Adonijah said unto him, Come in; for thou [art] a valiant man, and bringest good tidings.

art a virtuous 08\_RUT\_03\_11 # And now, my daughter, fear not; I will do to thee all that thou requirest:

for all the city of my people doth know that thou [art] a virtuous woman.

art a wise 11\_1KI\_02\_09# Now therefore hold him not guiltless: for thou [art] a wise man, and knowest what thou oughtest to do unto him; but his hoar head bring thou down to the grave with blood.

art abhorred of <u>10\_2SA\_16\_21</u># And Ahithophel said unto Absalom, Go in unto thy father's concubines, which he hath left to keep the house; and all Israel shall hear that thou art abhorred of thy father: then shall the hands of all that [are] with thee be strong.

art able for <u>27\_DAN\_04\_18</u># This dream I king Nebuchadnezzar have seen. Now thou, O Belteshazzar, declare the interpretation thereof, forasmuch as all the wise [men] of my kingdom are not able to make known unto me the interpretation: but thou [art] able; for the spirit of the holy gods [is] in thee.

art acquainted with 19\_PSA\_139\_03 # Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted [with] all my ways.

art afraid <u>05\_DEU\_07\_19</u># The great temptations which thine eyes saw, and the signs, and the wonders, and the mighty hand, and the stretched out arm, whereby the LORD thy God brought thee out: so shall the LORD thy God do unto all the people of whom thou art afraid.

art afraid 24\_JER\_39\_17 # But I will deliver thee in that day, saith the LORD: and thou shalt not be given into the hand of the men of whom thou [art] afraid.

art all fair 22\_SON\_04\_07 # Thou [art] all fair, my love; [there is] no spot in thee.

art also called <u>54\_1TI\_06\_12</u># Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

art also of <u>42\_LUK\_22\_58</u># And after a little while another saw him, and said, Thou art also of them. And Peter said, Man, I am not.

art also taken <u>24\_JER\_50\_24</u> # I have laid a snare for thee, and thou art also taken, O Babylon, and thou wast not aware: thou art found, and also caught, because thou hast striven against the LORD.

art among this <u>04\_NUM\_14\_14</u># And they will tell [it] to the inhabitants of this land: [for] they have heard that thou LORD [art] among this people, that thou LORD art seen face to face, and [that] thy cloud standeth over them, and [that] thou goest before them, by day time in a pillar of a cloud, and in a pillar of fire by night.

art an austere <u>42\_LUK\_19\_21</u> # For I feared thee, because thou art an austere man: thou takest up that thou layedst not down, and reapest that thou didst not sow.

art an hard 40\_MAT\_25\_24# Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strowed:

art an holy <u>05\_DEU\_07\_06</u># For thou [art] an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that [are] upon the face of the earth.

art an holy <u>05\_DEU\_14\_02</u> # For thou [art] an holy people unto the LORD thy God, and the LORD hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto himself, above all the nations that [are] upon the earth.

art an holy <u>05\_DEU\_14\_21</u># Ye shall not eat [of] any thing that dieth of itself: thou shalt give it unto the stranger that [is] in thy gates, that he may eat it; or thou mayest sell it unto an alien: for thou [art] an holy people unto the LORD thy God. Thou shalt not seethe a kid in his mother's milk.

art an offence 40 MAT\_16\_23# But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

art and an <u>11\_1KI\_13\_18</u># He said unto him, I [am] a prophet also as thou [art]; and an angel spake unto me by the word of the LORD, saying, Bring him back with thee into thine house, that he may eat bread and drink water. [But] he lied unto him.

art and I <u>09\_1SA\_19\_03</u> # And I will go out and stand beside my father in the field where thou [art], and I will commune with my father of thee; and what I see, that I will tell thee.

art and man's <u>44\_ACT\_17\_29</u> # Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device.

art and my 14\_2CH 18\_03 # And Ahab king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat king of Judah, Wilt thou go with me to Ramothgilead? And he answered him, I [am] as thou [art], and my people as thy people; and [we will be] with thee in the war.

art and they 14\_2CH\_16\_14# And they buried him in his own sepulchres, which he had made for himself in the city of David, and laid him in the bed which was filled with sweet odours and divers kinds [of spices] prepared by the apothecaries' art: and they made a very great burning for him.

art and thy <u>18\_JOB\_35\_08</u> # Thy wickedness [may hurt] a man as thou [art]; and thy righteousness [may profit] the son of man.

art and unto <u>01\_GEN\_03\_19</u># In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou [art], and unto dust shalt thou return.

art and wast <u>66\_REV\_11\_17</u># Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

art and wast <u>66\_REV\_16\_05</u># And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou art righteous, O Lord, which art, and wast, and shalt be, because thou hast judged thus.

art angry 19\_PSA\_76\_07 # Thou, [even] thou, [art] to be feared: and who may stand in thy sight when once thou art angry?

art as a <u>26\_EZE\_32\_02</u># Son of man, take up a lamentation for Pharaoh king of Egypt, and say unto him, Thou art like a young lion of the nations, and thou [art] as a whale in the seas: and thou camest forth with thy rivers, and troubledst the waters with thy feet, and fouledst their rivers.

art athirst go <u>08\_RUT\_02\_09</u> # [Let] thine eyes [be] on the field that they do reap, and go thou after them: have I not charged the young men that they shall not touch thee? and when thou art athirst, go unto the vessels, and drink of [that] which the young men have drawn.

art barren and <u>07\_JUD\_13\_03</u> # And the angel of the LORD appeared unto the woman, and said unto her, Behold now, thou [art] barren, and bearest not: but thou shalt conceive, and bear a son.

art beautiful O <u>22\_SON\_06\_04</u># Thou [art] beautiful, O my love, as Tirzah, comely as Jerusalem, terrible as [an army] with banners.

art because of <u>02\_EXO\_04\_26</u># So he let him go: then she said, A bloody husband [thou art], because of the circumcision.

art become a <u>59\_JAM\_02\_11</u># For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law.

art become cruel <u>18\_JOB\_30\_21</u># Thou art become cruel to me: with thy strong hand thou opposest thyself against me.

art become guilty <u>26\_EZE\_22\_04</u># Thou art become guilty in thy blood that thou hast shed; and hast defiled thyself in thine idols which thou hast made; and thou hast caused thy days to draw near, and art come [even] unto thy years: therefore have I made thee a reproach unto the heathen, and a mocking to all countries.

art become my 19\_PSA\_118\_21 # I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation.

art become the <u>05\_DEU\_27\_09</u># And Moses and the priests the Levites spake unto all Israel, saying, Take heed, and hearken, O Israel; this day thou art become the people of the LORD thy God.

art become their <u>10\_2SA\_07\_24</u> # For thou hast confirmed to thyself thy people Israel [to be] a people unto thee for ever: and thou, LORD, art become their God.

art beside thyself <u>44\_ACT\_26\_24</u># And as he thus spake for himself, Festus said with a loud voice, Paul, thou art beside thyself; much learning doth make thee mad.

art bidden go <u>42\_LUK\_14\_10</u># But when thou art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade thee cometh, he may say unto thee, Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have worship in the presence of them that sit at meat with thee.

art bidden of 42\_LUK\_14\_08 # When thou art bidden of any [man] to a wedding, sit not down in the highest room; lest a more honourable man than thou be bidden of him;

art but a <u>09\_1SA\_17\_33</u> # And Saul said to David, Thou art not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him: for thou [art but] a youth, and he a man of war from his youth.

art but a <u>01\_GEN\_20\_03</u># But God came to Abimelech in a dream by night, and said to him, Behold, thou [art but] a dead man, for the woman which thou hast taken; for she [is] a man's wife.

art called a <u>45\_ROM\_02\_17</u> # Behold, thou art called a Jew, and restest in the law, and makest thy boast of God,

art called by <u>05\_DEU\_28\_10</u># And all people of the earth shall see that thou art called by the name of the LORD; and they shall be afraid of thee.

art careful and <u>42\_LUK\_10\_41</u> # And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things:

art cast out <u>23\_ISA\_14\_19</u># But thou art cast out of thy grave like an abominable branch, [and as] the raiment of those that are slain, thrust through with a sword, that go down to the stones of the pit; as a carcase trodden under feet.

art Christ the <u>42\_LUK\_04\_41</u># And devils also came out of many, crying out, and saying, Thou art Christ the Son of God. And he rebuking [them] suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ.

art clothed with 19\_PSA\_104\_01 # Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honour and majesty.

art come against <u>07\_JUD\_11\_12</u># And Jephthah sent messengers unto the king of the children of Ammon, saying, What hast thou to do with me, that thou art come against me to fight in my land?

art come down <u>09\_1SA\_17\_28</u># And Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why camest thou down hither? and with whom hast thou left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know thy pride, and the naughtiness of thine heart; for thou art come down that thou mightest see the battle.

art come even <u>26\_EZE\_22\_04</u># Thou art become guilty in thy blood that thou hast shed; and hast defiled thyself in thine idols which thou hast made; and thou hast caused thy days to draw near, and art come [even] unto thy years: therefore have I made thee a reproach unto the heathen, and a mocking to all countries.

art come in 12\_2KI\_04\_04 # And when thou art come in, thou shalt shut the door upon thee and upon thy sons, and shalt pour out into all those vessels, and thou shalt set aside that which is full.

art come in <u>05\_DEU\_26\_01</u> # And it shall be, when thou [art] come in unto the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee [for] an inheritance, and possessest it, and dwellest therein;

art come into <u>05\_DEU\_18\_09</u> # When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations.

art come into 20\_PRO\_06\_03 # Do this now, my son, and deliver thyself, when thou art come into the hand of thy friend; go, humble thyself, and make sure thy friend.

art come Now <u>44\_ACT\_10\_33</u> # Immediately therefore I sent to thee; and thou hast well done that thou art come. Now therefore are we all here present before God, to hear all things that are commanded thee of God.

art come thither <u>09\_1SA\_10\_05</u># After that thou shalt come to the hill of God, where [is] the garrison of the Philistines: and it shall come to pass, when thou art come thither to the city, that thou shalt meet a company of prophets coming down from the high place with a psaltery, and a tabret, and a pipe, and a harp, before them; and they shall prophesy:

art come to <u>17\_EST\_04\_14</u> # For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, [then] shall there enlargement and deliverance arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy father's house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for [such] a time as this?

art come unto <u>08\_RUT\_02\_11</u># And Boaz answered and said unto her, It hath fully been showed me, all that thou hast done unto thy mother in law since the death of thine husband: and [how] thou hast left thy father and thy mother, and the land of thy nativity, and art come unto a people which thou knewest not heretofore.

art come <u>44\_ACT\_21\_22</u># What is it therefore? the multitude must needs come together: for they will hear that thou art come.

art commanded this <u>01\_GEN\_45\_19</u> # Now thou art commanded, this do ye; take you wagons out of the

land of Egypt for your little ones, and for your wives, and bring your father, and come.

art confident that <u>45\_ROM\_02\_19</u> # And art confident that thou thyself art a guide of the blind, a light of them which are in darkness,

art contrary <u>26\_EZE\_16\_34</u> # And the contrary is in thee from [other] women in thy whoredoms, whereas none followeth thee to commit whoredoms: and in that thou givest a reward, and no reward is given unto thee, therefore thou art contrary.

art converted strengthen <u>42\_LUK\_22\_32</u># But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.

art covered with <u>05\_DEU\_32\_15</u># But Jeshurun waxed fat, and kicked: thou art waxen fat, thou art grown thick, thou art covered [with fatness]; then he forsook God [which] made him, and lightly esteemed the Rock of his salvation.

art cursed above <u>01\_GEN\_03\_14</u># And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou [art] cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:

art dead <u>66\_REV\_03\_01</u># And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.

art departed from <u>11\_1KI\_20\_36</u># Then said he unto him, Because thou hast not obeyed the voice of the LORD, behold, as soon as thou art departed from me, a lion shall slay thee. And as soon as he was departed from him, a lion found him, and slew him.

art departed from <u>09\_1SA\_10\_02</u># When thou art departed from me to day, then thou shalt find two men by Rachel's sepulchre in the border of Benjamin at Zelzah; and they will say unto thee, The asses which thou wentest to seek are found: and, lo, thy father hath left the care of the asses, and sorroweth for you, saying, What shall I do for my son?

art dissolved for 23\_ISA\_14\_31 # Howl, O gate; cry, O city; thou, whole Palestina, [art] dissolved: for there shall come from the north a smoke, and none [shall be] alone in his appointed times.

art even as <u>01\_GEN\_44\_18</u># Then Judah came near unto him, and said, Oh my lord, let thy servant, I pray thee, speak a word in my lord's ears, and let not thine anger burn against thy servant: for thou [art] even as Pharaoh.

art ever with <u>42\_LUK\_15\_31</u># And he said unto him, Son, thou art ever with me, and all that I have is thine.

art exalted as <u>13\_1CH\_29\_11</u># Thine, O LORD, [is] the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all [that is] in the heaven and in the earth [is thine]; thine [is] the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all.

art exalted far 19\_PSA\_97\_09 # For thou, LORD, [art] high above all the earth: thou art exalted far above all gods.

art exalted to <u>42\_LUK\_10\_15</u># And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted to heaven, shalt be thrust down to hell.

art exalted unto 40\_MAT\_11\_23# And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell: for if the mighty works, which have been done in thee, had been done in Sodom, it would have

remained until this day.

art fair my <u>22\_SON\_01\_15</u># Behold, thou [art] fair, my love; behold, thou [art] fair; thou [hast] doves' eyes.

art fair my 22\_SON\_01\_16 # Behold, thou [art] fair, my beloved, yea, pleasant: also our bed [is] green.

art fair my 22\_SON\_04\_01 # Behold, thou [art] fair, my love; behold, thou [art] fair; thou [hast] doves' eyes within thy locks: thy hair [is] as a flock of goats, that appear from mount Gilead.

art fair thou <u>22\_SON\_01\_15</u># Behold, thou [art] fair, my love; behold, thou [art] fair; thou [hast] doves' eyes.

art fair thou 22\_SON\_04\_01 # Behold, thou [art] fair, my love; behold, thou [art] fair; thou [hast] doves' eyes within thy locks: thy hair [is] as a flock of goats, that appear from mount Gilead.

art fairer than 19\_PSA\_45\_02 # Thou art fairer than the children of men: grace is poured into thy lips: therefore God hath blessed thee for ever.

art fallen and <u>66\_REV\_02\_05</u># Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.

art filled with <u>35\_HAB\_02\_16</u># Thou art filled with shame for glory: drink thou also, and let thy foreskin be uncovered: the cup of the LORD'S right hand shall be turned unto thee, and shameful spewing [shall be] on thy glory.

art from everlasting 19\_PSA\_93\_02 # Thy throne [is] established of old: thou [art] from everlasting.

art full and <u>05\_DEU\_08\_12</u> # Lest [when] thou hast eaten and art full, and hast built goodly houses, and dwelt [therein];

art full of <u>23\_ISA\_22\_02</u> # Thou that art full of stirs, a tumultuous city, a joyous city: thy slain [men are] not slain with the sword, nor dead in battle.

art full then <u>05\_DEU\_08\_10</u> # When thou hast eaten and art full, then thou shalt bless the LORD thy God for the good land which he hath given thee.

Art thou he <u>26\_EZE\_38\_17</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; [Art] thou he of whom I have spoken in old time by my servants the prophets of Israel, which prophesied in those days [many] years that I would bring thee against them?

art thou he 24\_JER\_49\_12 # For thus saith the LORD; Behold, they whose judgment [was] not to drink of the cup have assuredly drunken; and [art] thou he [that] shall altogether go unpunished? thou shalt not go unpunished, but thou shalt surely drink [of it].

Art thou he <u>42\_LUK\_07\_19</u> # And John calling [unto him] two of his disciples sent [them] to Jesus, saying, Art thou he that should come? or look we for another?

Art thou he <u>42\_LUK\_07\_20</u> # When the men were come unto him, they said, John Baptist hath sent us unto thee, saying, Art thou he that should come? or look we for another?

Art thou he 40 MAT\_11\_03# And said unto him, Art thou he that should come, or do we look for another?

Art thou in 10\_2SA\_20\_09 # And Joab said to Amasa, [Art] thou in health, my brother? And Joab took Amasa by the beard with the right hand to kiss him.

art thou in 19\_PSA\_66\_03 # Say unto God, How terrible [art thou in] thy works! through the greatness of thy power shall thine enemies submit themselves unto thee.

Art thou Joab <u>10\_2SA\_20\_17</u> # And when he was come near unto her, the woman said, [Art] thou Joab? And he answered, I [am he]. Then she said unto him, Hear the words of thine handmaid. And he answered,

I do hear.

art thou knowing <u>43\_JOH\_21\_12</u># Jesus saith unto them, Come [and] dine. And none of the disciples durst ask him, Who art thou? knowing that it was the Lord.

art thou like <u>26\_EZE\_31\_02</u># Son of man, speak unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, and to his multitude; Whom art thou like in thy greatness?

Art thou loosed 46\_1CO\_07\_27 # Art thou bound unto a wife? seek not to be loosed. Art thou loosed from a wife? seek not a wife.

art thou Lord 44\_ACT\_09\_05# And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: [it is] hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

art thou Lord <u>44\_ACT\_22\_08</u># And I answered, Who art thou, Lord? And he said unto me, I am Jesus of Nazareth, whom thou persecutest.

art thou Lord <u>44\_ACT\_26\_15</u># And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest.

Art thou made 14\_2CH\_25\_16 # And it came to pass, as he talked with him, that [the king] said unto him, Art thou made of the king's counsel? forbear; why shouldest thou be smitten? Then the prophet forbare, and said, I know that God hath determined to destroy thee, because thou hast done this, and hast not hearkened unto my counsel.

art thou my <u>01\_GEN\_27\_18</u># And he came unto his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here [am] I; who [art] thou, my son?

Art thou my 01\_GEN\_27\_24 # And he said, [Art] thou my very son Esau? And he said, I [am].

art thou my <u>08\_RUT\_03\_16</u> # And when she came to her mother in law, she said, Who [art] thou, my daughter? And she told her all that the man had done to her.

Art thou not 10\_2SA\_19\_13 # And say ye to Amasa, [Art] thou not of my bone, and of my flesh? God do so to me, and more also, if thou be not captain of the host before me continually in the room of Joab.

Art thou not <u>35\_HAB\_01\_12</u> # [Art] thou not from everlasting, O LORD my God, mine Holy One? we shall not die. O LORD, thou hast ordained them for judgment; and, O mighty God, thou hast established them for correction.

Art thou not 23\_ISA\_51\_09 # Awake, awake, put on strength, O arm of the LORD; awake, as in the ancient days, in the generations of old. [Art] thou not it that hath cut Rahab, [and] wounded the dragon?

Art thou not 23\_ISA\_51\_10 # [Art] thou not it which hath dried the sea, the waters of the great deep; that hath made the depths of the sea a way for the ransomed to pass over?

art thou O <u>05\_DEU\_33\_29</u> # Happy [art] thou, O Israel: who [is] like unto thee, O people saved by the LORD, the shield of thy help, and who [is] the sword of thy excellency! and thine enemies shall be found liars unto thee; and thou shalt tread upon their high places.

art thou O <u>21\_ECC\_10\_17</u> # Blessed [art] thou, O land, when thy king [is] the son of nobles, and thy princes eat in due season, for strength, and not for drunkenness!

art thou O 24\_JER\_12\_01 # Righteous [art] thou, O LORD, when I plead with thee: yet let me talk with thee of [thy] judgments: Wherefore doth the way of the wicked prosper? [wherefore] are all they happy

that deal very treacherously?

art thou O 19 PSA 119 12 # Blessed [art] thou, O LORD: teach me thy statutes.

art thou O 19\_PSA\_119\_137 # TZADDI. Righteous [art] thou, O LORD, and upright [are] thy judgments.

art thou O 22\_SON\_07\_06 # How fair and how pleasant art thou, O love, for delights!

art thou O <u>38\_ZEC\_04\_07</u> # Who [art] thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel [thou shalt become] a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone [thereof with] shoutings, [crying], Grace, grace unto it.

Art thou only <u>42\_LUK\_24\_18</u># And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?

art thou red <u>23\_ISA\_63\_02</u> # Wherefore [art thou] red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?

art thou Simon 40\_MAT\_16\_17# And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed [it] unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.

art thou so 19 PSA 22 01 # To the chief Musician upon Aijeleth Shahar, A Psalm of David. My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? [why art thou so] far from helping me, [and from] the words of my roaring?

art thou tell <u>01\_GEN\_24\_23</u> # And said, Whose daughter [art] thou? tell me, I pray thee: is there room [in] thy father's house for us to lodge in?

Art thou that <u>11\_1KI\_18\_07</u> # And as Obadiah was in the way, behold, Elijah met him: and he knew him, and fell on his face, and said, [Art] thou that my lord Elijah?

art thou that <u>09\_1SA\_26\_14</u># And David cried to the people, and to Abner the son of Ner, saying, Answerest thou not, Abner? Then Abner answered and said, Who [art] thou [that] criest to the king?

Art thou that <u>27\_DAN\_05\_13</u> # Then was Daniel brought in before the king. [And] the king spake and said unto Daniel, [Art] thou that Daniel, which [art] of the children of the captivity of Judah, whom the king my father brought out of Jewry?

art thou that 23\_ISA\_51\_12 # I, [even] I, [am] he that comforteth you: who [art] thou, that thou shouldest be afraid of a man [that] shall die, and of the son of man [which] shall be made [as] grass;

art thou that <u>59\_JAM\_04\_12</u># There is one lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy: who art thou that judgest another?

Art thou that 43\_JOH\_01\_21# And they asked him, What then? Art thou Elias? And he saith, I am not. Art thou that prophet? And he answered, No.

art thou that <u>43\_JOH\_01\_22</u># Then said they unto him, Who art thou? that we may give an answer to them that sent us. What sayest thou of thyself?

art thou that <u>45\_ROM\_09\_20</u> # Nay but, O man, who art thou that repliest against God? Shall the thing formed say to him that formed [it], Why hast thou made me thus?

Art thou the <u>43\_JOH\_18\_33</u> # Then Pilate entered into the judgment hall again, and called Jesus, and said unto him, Art thou the King of the Jews?

Art thou the <u>07\_JUD\_13\_11</u># And Manoah arose, and went after his wife, and came to the man, and said unto him, [Art] thou the man that spakest unto the woman? And he said, I [am].

Art thou the 42\_LUK\_22\_67 # Art thou the Christ? tell us. And he said unto them, If I tell you, ye will not believe:

Art thou the <u>42\_LUK\_23\_03</u> # And Pilate asked him, saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? And he answered him and said, Thou sayest [it].

Art thou the <u>41\_MAR\_14\_61</u> # But he held his peace, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?

art thou to <u>02\_EXO\_04\_25</u># Then Zipporah took a sharp stone, and cut off the foreskin of her son, and cast [it] at his feet, and said, Surely a bloody husband [art] thou to me.

art thou turned 24\_JER\_02\_21 # Yet I had planted thee a noble vine, wholly a right seed: how then art thou turned into the degenerate plant of a strange vine unto me?

art thou wroth <u>01\_GEN\_04\_06</u># And the LORD said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen?

Art thou Ziba 10 2SA 09 02 # And [there was] of the house of Saul a servant whose name [was] Ziba. And when they had called him unto David, the king said unto him, [Art] thou Ziba? And he said, Thy servant [is he].

art thou 01\_GEN\_03\_09 # And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where [art] thou?

art thou 01\_GEN\_47\_08 # And Pharaoh said unto Jacob, How old [art] thou?

art thou <u>43\_JOH\_01\_19</u> # And this is the record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou?

art thou <u>32 JON\_01\_08</u># Then said they unto him, Tell us, we pray thee, for whose cause this evil [is] upon us; What [is] thine occupation? and whence comest thou? what [is] thy country? and of what people [art] thou?

art thy mother's <u>26\_EZE\_16\_45</u># Thou [art] thy mother's daughter, that loatheth her husband and her children; and thou [art] the sister of thy sisters, which loathed their husbands and their children: your mother [was] an Hittite, and your father an Amorite.

art to be 19\_PSA\_137\_08 # O daughter of Babylon, who art to be destroyed; happy [shall he be], that rewardeth thee as thou hast served us.

art to be 19\_PSA\_76\_07\_# Thou, [even] thou, [art] to be feared: and who may stand in thy sight when once thou art angry?

art to bring <u>05\_DEU\_04\_38</u> # To drive out nations from before thee greater and mightier than thou [art], to bring thee in, to give thee their land [for] an inheritance, as [it is] this day.

art to come <u>66\_REV\_11\_17</u># Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

art to pass 05\_DEU\_02\_18 # Thou art to pass over through Ar, the coast of Moab, this day:

art to pass <u>05\_DEU\_09\_01</u># Hear, O Israel: Thou [art] to pass over Jordan this day, to go in to possess nations greater and mightier than thyself, cities great and fenced up to heaven,

art tormented <u>42\_LUK\_16\_25</u> # But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented.

art troubled <u>18\_JOB\_04\_05</u> # But now it is come upon thee, and thou faintest; it toucheth thee, and thou art troubled.

art true and <u>41\_MAR\_12\_14</u># And when they were come, they say unto him, Master, we know that thou art true, and carest for no man: for thou regardest not the person of men, but teachest the way of God in truth: Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar, or not?

art true and <u>40\_MAT\_22\_16</u># And they sent out unto him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, Master, we know that thou art true, and teachest the way of God in truth, neither carest thou for any [man]: for thou regardest not the person of men.

art undone O <u>04\_NUM\_21\_29</u> # Woe to thee, Moab! thou art undone, O people of Chemosh: he hath given his sons that escaped, and his daughters, into captivity unto Sihon king of the Amorites.

art unmindful and <u>05\_DEU\_32\_18</u># Of the Rock [that] begat thee thou art unmindful, and hast forgotten God that formed thee.

art unto them <u>26\_EZE\_33\_32</u> # And, lo, thou [art] unto them as a very lovely song of one that hath a pleasant voice, and can play well on an instrument: for they hear thy words, but they do them not.

art very great 19\_PSA\_104\_01 # Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honour and majesty.

art very wroth 25\_LAM\_05\_22 # But thou hast utterly rejected us; thou art very wroth against us.

art vile <u>34\_NAH\_01\_14</u># And the LORD hath given a commandment concerning thee, [that] no more of thy name be sown: out of the house of thy gods will I cut off the graven image and the molten image: I will make thy grave; for thou art vile.

art waxen fat <u>05 DEU 32\_15</u># But Jeshurun waxed fat, and kicked: thou art waxen fat, thou art grown thick, thou art covered [with fatness]; then he forsook God [which] made him, and lightly esteemed the Rock of his salvation.

art weighed in 27\_DAN\_05\_27 # TEKEL; Thou art weighed in the balances, and art found wanting.

art wholly gone <u>23\_ISA\_22\_01</u> # The burden of the valley of vision. What aileth thee now, that thou art wholly gone up to the housetops?

art wicked and <u>18\_JOB\_34\_18</u># [Is it fit] to say to a king, [Thou art] wicked? [and] to princes, [Ye are] ungodly?

art wiser than <u>26\_EZE\_28\_03</u># Behold, thou [art] wiser than Daniel; there is no secret that they can hide from thee:

art with child <u>01\_GEN\_16\_11</u># And the angel of the LORD said unto her, Behold, thou [art] with child, and shalt bear a son, and shalt call his name Ishmael; because the LORD hath heard thy affliction.
