aside after lucre [09 ISA 08 03](#) # And his sons walked not in his ways, but turned aside after lucre, and took bribes, and perverted judgment.

aside after Satan [54 1TI 05 15](#) # For some are already turned aside after Satan.

aside all malice [60 1PE 02 01](#) # Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings,

aside and brought [11 1KI 20 39](#) # And as the king passed by, he cried unto the king: and he said, Thy servant went out into the midst of the battle; and, behold, a man turned aside, and brought a man unto me, and said, Keep this man: if by any means he be missing, then shall thy life be for his life, or else thou shalt pay a talent of silver.

aside and commit [04 NUM 05 12](#) # Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, If any man's wife go aside, and commit a trespass against him,

aside and sat [08 RUT 04 01](#) # Then went Boaz up to the gate, and sat him down there: and, behold, the kinsman of whom Boaz spake came by; unto whom he said, Ho, such a one! turn aside, sit down here. And he turned aside, and sat down.

aside and see [02 EXO 03 03](#) # And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt.

aside and serve [05 DEU 11 16](#) # Take heed to yourselves, that your heart be not deceived, and ye turn aside, and serve other gods, and worship them;

aside and stand [10 2SA 18 30](#) # And the king said [unto him], Turn aside, [and] stand here. And he turned aside, and stood still.

aside by the [22 SON 01 07](#) # Tell me, O thou whom my soul loveth, where thou feedest, where thou makest [thy flock] to rest at noon: for why should I be as one that turneth aside by the flocks of thy companions?

aside every weight [58 HEB 12 01](#) # Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset [us], and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,

aside for then [09 ISA 12 21](#) # And turn ye not aside: for [then should ye go] after vain [things], which cannot profit nor deliver; for they [are] vain.

aside from any [11 1KI 15 05](#) # Because David did [that which was] right in the eyes of the LORD, and turned not aside from any [thing] that he commanded him all the days of his life, save only in the matter of Uriah the Hittite.

aside from any [05 DEU 28 14](#) # And thou shalt not go aside from any of the words which I command thee this day, [to] the right hand, or [to] the left, to go after other gods to serve them.

aside from following [09 1SA 12 20](#) # And Samuel said unto the people, Fear not: ye have done all this wickedness: yet turn not aside from following the LORD, but serve the LORD with all your heart;

aside from following [10 2SA 02 21](#) # And Abner said to him, Turn thee aside to thy right hand or to thy left, and lay thee hold on one of the young men, and take thee his armour. But Asahel would not turn aside from following of him.

aside from following [10 2SA 02 22](#) # And Abner said again to Asahel, Turn thee aside from following me: wherefore should I smite thee to the ground? how then should I hold up my face to Joab thy brother?

aside from it [11 1KI 22 43](#) # And he walked in all the ways of Asa his father; he turned not aside from it, doing [that which was] right in the eyes of the LORD: nevertheless the high places were not taken away; [for] the people offered and burnt incense yet in the high places.

aside into the [13 1CH 13 13](#) # So David brought not the ark [home] to himself to the city of David, but carried it aside into the house of Obededom the Gittite.

aside into the [10 2SA 06 10](#) # So David would not remove the ark of the LORD unto him into the city of David: but David carried it aside into the house of Obededom the Gittite.

aside into the [40 MAT 02 22](#) # But when he heard that Archelaus did reign in Judaea in the room of his father Herod, he was afraid to go thither: notwithstanding, being warned of God in a dream, he turned aside into the parts of Galilee:

aside it shall [19 PSA 101 03](#) # I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes: I hate the work of them that turn aside; [it] shall not cleave to me.

aside like a [19 PSA 78 57](#) # But turned back, and dealt unfaithfully like their fathers: they were turned aside like a deceitful bow.

aside my ways [25 LAM 03 11](#) # He hath turned aside my ways, and pulled me in pieces: he hath made me desolate.

aside out of [44 ACT 04 15](#) # But when they had commanded them to go aside out of the council, they conferred among themselves,

aside out of [05 DEU 09 12](#) # And the LORD said unto me, Arise, get thee down quickly from hence; for thy people which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt have corrupted [themselves]; they are quickly turned aside out of the way which I commanded them; they have made them a molten image.

aside out of [05 DEU 11 28](#) # And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known.

aside that which [12 2KI 04 04](#) # And when thou art come in, thou shalt shut the door upon thee and upon thy sons, and shalt pour out into all those vessels, and thou shalt set aside that which is full.

aside the commandment [41 MAR 07 08](#) # For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, [as] the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do.

aside the just [23 ISA 29 21](#) # That make a man an offender for a word, and lay a snare for him that reproveth in the gate, and turn aside the just for a thing of nought.

aside the needy [23 ISA 10 02](#) # To turn aside the needy from judgment, and to take away the right from the poor of my people, that widows may be their prey, and [that] they may rob the fatherless!

aside the poor [30 AMO 05 12](#) # For I know your manifold transgressions, and your mighty sins: they

afflict the just, they take a bribe, and they turn aside the poor in the gate [from their right].

aside the right [25 LAM 03 35](#) # To turn aside the right of a man before the face of the most High,

aside the stranger [39 MAL 03 05](#) # And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in [his] wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger [from his right], and fear not me, saith the LORD of hosts.

aside the way [30 AMO 02 07](#) # That pant after the dust of the earth on the head of the poor, and turn aside the way of the meek: and a man and his father will go in unto the [same] maid, to profane my holy name:

aside therefrom to [06 JOS 23 06](#) # Be ye therefore very courageous to keep and to do all that is written in the book of the law of Moses, that ye turn not aside therefrom [to] the right hand or [to] the left;

aside they are [19 PSA 14 03](#) # They are all gone aside, they are [all] together become filthy: [there is] none that doeth good, no, not one.

aside they go [18 JOB 06 18](#) # The paths of their way are turned aside; they go to nothing, and perish.

aside they talked [44 ACT 26 31](#) # And when they were gone aside, they talked between themselves, saying, This man doeth nothing worthy of death or of bonds.

aside thither to [07 JUD 19 15](#) # And they turned aside thither, to go in [and] to lodge in Gibeah: and when he went in, he sat him down in a street of the city: for [there was] no man that took them into his house to lodging.

aside to another [04 NUM 05 20](#) # But if thou hast gone aside [to another] instead of thy husband, and if thou be defiled, and some man have lain with thee beside thine husband:

aside to another [04 NUM 05 29](#) # This [is] the law of jealousies, when a wife goeth aside [to another] instead of her husband, and is defiled;

aside to ask [24 JER 15 05](#) # For who shall have pity upon thee, O Jerusalem? or who shall bemoan thee? or who shall go aside to ask how thou doest?

aside to fight [11 1KI 22 32](#) # And it came to pass, when the captains of the chariots saw Jehoshaphat, that they said, Surely it [is] the king of Israel. And they turned aside to fight against him: and Jehoshaphat cried out.

aside to lies [19 PSA 40 04](#) # Blessed [is] that man that maketh the LORD his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.

aside to see [02 EXO 03 04](#) # And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here [am] I.

aside to see [07 JUD 14 08](#) # And after a time he returned to take her, and he turned aside to see the carcass of the lion: and, behold, [there was] a swarm of bees and honey in the carcass of the lion.

aside to tarry [24 JER 14 08](#) # O the hope of Israel, the saviour thereof in time of trouble, why shouldest thou be as a stranger in the land, and as a wayfaring man [that] turneth aside to tarry for a night?

aside to the [09 ISA 06 12](#) # And the kine took the straight way to the way of Bethshemesh, [and] went along the highway, lowing as they went, and turned not aside [to] the right hand or [to] the left; and the

lords of the Philistines went after them unto the border of Bethshemesh.

aside to the [12 2KI 22 02](#) # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, and walked in all the way of David his father, and turned not aside to the right hand or to the left.
