attentive and thine <u>16\_NEH\_01\_06</u># Let thine ear now be attentive, and thine eyes open, that thou mayest hear the prayer of thy servant, which I pray before thee now, day and night, for the children of Israel thy servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against thee: both I and my father's house have sinned.

attentive to hear 42\_LUK\_19\_48 # And could not find what they might do: for all the people were very attentive to hear him.

attentive to the <u>16\_NEH\_01\_11</u># O Lord, I beseech thee, let now thine ear be attentive to the prayer of thy servant, and to the prayer of thy servants, who desire to fear thy name: and prosper, I pray thee, thy servant this day, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man. For I was the king's cupbearer.

attentive to the <u>19\_PSA\_130\_02</u># Lord, hear my voice: let thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications.

attentive unto the <u>16\_NEH\_08\_03</u># And he read therein before the street that [was] before the water gate from the morning until midday, before the men and the women, and those that could understand; and the ears of all the people [were attentive] unto the book of the law.

attentively the noise <u>18\_JOB\_37\_02</u># Hear attentively the noise of his voice, and the sound [that] goeth out of his mouth.
