Arphaxad and Lud <u>01_GEN_10_22</u># The children of Shem; Elam, and Asshur, and Arphaxad, and Lud, and Aram.

Arphaxad begat Salah 01_GEN_10_24 # And Arphaxad begat Salah; and Salah begat Eber.

Arphaxad begat Shelah 13_1CH_01_18 # And Arphaxad begat Shelah, and Shelah begat Eber.

Arphaxad five hundred <u>01_GEN_11_11</u># And Shem lived after he begat Arphaxad five hundred years, and begat sons and daughters.

Arphaxad two years <u>01_GEN_11_10</u># These [are] the generations of Shem: Shem [was] an hundred years old, and begat Arphaxad two years after the flood:

Arphaxad which was 42 LUK 03 36 # Which was [the son] of Cainan, which was [the son] of Arphaxad, which was [the son] of Sem, which was [the son] of Noe, which was [the son] of Lamech,

Artaxerxes king of <u>15_EZR_04_07</u> # And in the days of Artaxerxes wrote Bishlam, Mithredath, Tabeel, and the rest of their companions, unto Artaxerxes king of Persia; and the writing of the letter [was] written in the Syrian tongue, and interpreted in the Syrian tongue.

Artaxerxes king of <u>15_EZR_06_14</u> # And the elders of the Jews builded, and they prospered through the prophesying of Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the son of Iddo. And they builded, and finished [it], according to the commandment of the God of Israel, and according to the commandment of Cyrus, and Darius, and Artaxerxes king of Persia.

Artaxerxes king of <u>15_EZR_07_01</u># Now after these things, in the reign of Artaxerxes king of Persia, Ezra the son of Seraiah, the son of Azariah, the son of Hilkiah,

Artaxerxes king of <u>15_EZR_07_12</u> # Artaxerxes, king of kings, unto Ezra the priest, a scribe of the law of the God of heaven, perfect [peace], and at such a time.

Artaxerxes king of <u>16_NEH_13_06</u># But in all this [time] was not I at Jerusalem: for in the two and thirtieth year of Artaxerxes king of Babylon came I unto the king, and after certain days obtained I leave of the king:

Artaxerxes the king <u>15_EZR_07_21</u># And I, [even] I Artaxerxes the king, do make a decree to all the treasurers which [are] beyond the river, that whatsoever Ezra the priest, the scribe of the law of the God of heaven, shall require of you, it be done speedily,

Artaxerxes the king <u>15_EZR_08_01</u> # These [are] now the chief of their fathers, and [this is] the genealogy of them that went up with me from Babylon, in the reign of Artaxerxes the king.

Artaxerxes the king 16 NEH 02 01 # And it came to pass in the month Nisan, in the twentieth year of Artaxerxes the king, [that] wine [was] before him: and I took up the wine, and gave [it] unto the king. Now I had not been [beforetime] sad in his presence.

ax head fell 12_2KI_06_05 # But as one was felling a beam, the ax head fell into the water: and he cried, and said, Alas, master! for it was borrowed.

ax in his <u>07_JUD_09_48</u> # And Abimelech gat him up to mount Zalmon, he and all the people that [were] with him; and Abimelech took an ax in his hand, and cut down a bough from the trees, and took it, and laid [it] on his shoulder, and said unto the people that [were] with him, What ye have seen me do, make haste, [and] do as I [have done].

axes Even so <u>13_1CH_20_03</u># And he brought out the people that [were] in it, and cut [them] with saws, and with harrows of iron, and with axes. Even so dealt David with all the cities of the children of Ammon. And David and all the people returned to Jerusalem.

axes he shall <u>26_EZE_26_09</u> # And he shall set engines of war against thy walls, and with his axes he shall break down thy towers.

axes of iron 10_28A_12_31 # And he brought forth the people that [were] therein, and put [them] under saws, and under harrows of iron, and under axes of iron, and made them pass through the brickkiln: and thus did he unto all the cities of the children of Ammon. So David and all the people returned unto Jerusalem.

axes upon the 19_PSA_74_05 # [A man] was famous according as he had lifted up axes upon the thick trees.

axletrees and their 11_1KI_07_33 # And the work of the wheels [was] like the work of a chariot wheel: their axletrees, and their naves, and their felloes, and their spokes, [were] all molten.

axletrees of the <u>11_1KI_07_32</u># And under the borders [were] four wheels; and the axletrees of the wheels [were joined] to the base: and the height of a wheel [was] a cubit and half a cubit.

flax and the <u>02_EXO_09_31</u># And the flax and the barley was smitten: for the barley [was] in the ear, and the flax [was] bolled.

flax and they <u>23_ISA_19_09</u># Moreover they that work in fine flax, and they that weave networks, shall be confounded.

flax and worketh 20_PRO_31_13 # She seeketh wool, and flax, and worketh willingly with her hands.

flax given to <u>28_HOS_02_09</u> # Therefore will I return, and take away my corn in the time thereof, and my wine in the season thereof, and will recover my wool and my flax [given] to cover her nakedness.

flax in his 26 EZE 40 03 # And he brought me thither, and, behold, [there was] a man, whose appearance [was] like the appearance of brass, with a line of flax in his hand, and a measuring reed; and he stood in the gate.

flax mine oil <u>28_HOS_02_05</u># For their mother hath played the harlot: she that conceived them hath done shamefully: for she said, I will go after my lovers, that give [me] my bread and my water, my wool and my flax, mine oil and my drink.

flax shall he <u>23_ISA_42_03</u> # A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment unto truth.

flax shall he <u>40_MAT_12_20</u># A bruised reed shall he not break, and smoking flax shall he not quench, till he send forth judgment unto victory.

flax that was <u>07_JUD_15_14</u> # [And] when he came unto Lehi, the Philistines shouted against him: and the spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him, and the cords that [were] upon his arms became as flax that was burnt with fire, and his bands loosed from off his hands.

flax was bolled <u>02_EXO_09_31</u># And the flax and the barley was smitten: for the barley [was] in the ear, and the flax [was] bolled.

flax which she <u>06_JOS_02_06</u># But she had brought them up to the roof of the house, and hid them with the stalks of flax, which she had laid in order upon the roof.

taxation to give 12_2KI_23_35 # And Jehoiakim gave the silver and the gold to Pharaoh; but he taxed the land to give the money according to the commandment of Pharaoh: he exacted the silver and the gold of the people of the land, of every one according to his taxation, to give [it] unto Pharaohnechoh.

taxed every one 42_LUK_02_03 # And all went to be taxed, every one into his own city.

taxes in the <u>27_DAN_11_20</u># Then shall stand up in his estate a raiser of taxes [in] the glory of the kingdom: but within few days he shall be destroyed, neither in anger, nor in battle.

taxing and drew 44_ACT_05_37 # After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much people after him: he also perished; and all, [even] as many as obeyed him, were dispersed.

taxing was first 42_LUK_02_02 # [[And] this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.]

wax feeble anguish 24_JER_06_24 # We have heard the fame thereof: our hands wax feeble: anguish hath taken hold of us, [and] pain, as of a woman in travail.

wax hot against <u>02_EXO_32_10</u> # Now therefore let me alone, that my wrath may wax hot against them, and that I may consume them: and I will make of thee a great nation.

wax not old <u>42_LUK_12_33</u> # Sell that ye have, and give alms; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a treasure in the heavens that faileth not, where no thief approacheth, neither moth corrupteth.

wax old as <u>58_HEB_01_11</u># They shall perish; but thou remainest; and they all shall wax old as doth a garment;

wax old as <u>23_ISA_50_09</u> # Behold, the Lord GOD will help me; who [is] he [that] shall condemn me? lo, they all shall wax old as a garment; the moth shall eat them up.

waxed strong in <u>42_LUK_01_80</u># And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, and was in the deserts till the day of his showing unto Israel.

waxed strong in 42_LUK_02_40 # And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the grace of God was upon him.

waxed stronger and 10_2SA_03_01 # Now there was long war between the house of Saul and the house of David: but David waxed stronger and stronger, and the house of Saul waxed weaker and weaker.

waxen strong that <u>06_JOS_17_13</u># Yet it came to pass, when the children of Israel were waxen strong, that they put the Canaanites to tribute; but did not utterly drive them out.

waxeth old because 19_PSA_06_07 # Mine eye is consumed because of grief; it waxeth old because of all mine enemies.

waxeth old is <u>58_HEB_08_13</u># In that he saith, A new [covenant], he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old [is] ready to vanish away.

waxing confident by <u>50_PHP_01_14</u> # And many of the brethren in the Lord, waxing confident by my bonds, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.
