Abelbethmaachah and all <u>11\_1KI\_15\_20</u># So Benhadad hearkened unto king Asa, and sent the captains of the hosts which he had against the cities of Israel, and smote Ijon, and Dan, and Abelbethmaachah, and all Cinneroth, with all the land of Naphtali.

Abelbethmaachah and Janoah <u>12\_2KI\_15\_29</u># In the days of Pekah king of Israel came Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and took Ijon, and Abelbethmaachah, and Janoah, and Kedesh, and Hazor, and Gilead, and Galilee, all the land of Naphtali, and carried them captive to Assyria.

BETH Wherewithal shall 19 PSA 119 09 # BETH. Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed [thereto] according to thy word.

Bethabara beyond Jordan <u>43\_JOH\_01\_28</u> # These things were done in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing.

Bethanath and Bethshemesh <u>06\_JOS\_19\_38</u># And Iron, and Migdalel, Horem, and Bethanath, and Bethshemesh; nineteen cities with their villages.

Bethanath became tributaries <u>07\_JUD\_01\_33</u># Neither did Naphtali drive out the inhabitants of Bethshemesh, nor the inhabitants of Bethanath; but he dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: nevertheless the inhabitants of Bethshemesh and of Bethanath became tributaries unto them.

Bethanath but he <u>07\_JUD\_01\_33</u># Neither did Naphtali drive out the inhabitants of Bethshemesh, nor the inhabitants of Bethanath; but he dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: nevertheless the inhabitants of Bethshemesh and of Bethanath became tributaries unto them.

Bethanoth and Eltekon <u>06\_JOS\_15\_59</u># And Maarath, and Bethanoth, and Eltekon; six cities with their villages:

Bethany and he <u>42\_LUK\_24\_50</u># And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them.

Bethany and he <u>40\_MAT\_21\_17</u># And he left them, and went out of the city into Bethany; and he lodged there.

Bethany at the <u>42\_LUK\_19\_29</u># And it came to pass, when he was come nigh to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount called [the mount] of Olives, he sent two of his disciples,

Bethany at the <u>41\_MAR\_11\_01</u># And when they came nigh to Jerusalem, unto Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount of Olives, he sendeth forth two of his disciples,

Bethany he was 41\_MAR\_11\_12 # And on the morrow, when they were come from Bethany, he was hungry:

Bethany in the <u>41\_MAR\_14\_03</u># And being in Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, as he sat at meat, there came a woman having an alabaster box of ointment of spikenard very precious; and she brake the box, and poured [it] on his head.

Bethany in the 40\_MAT\_26\_06 # Now when Jesus was in Bethany, in the house of Simon the leper,

Bethany the town 43\_JOH\_11\_01# Now a certain [man] was sick, [named] Lazarus, of Bethany, the town of Mary and her sister Martha.

Bethany was nigh 43\_JOH\_11\_18 # Now Bethany was nigh unto Jerusalem, about fifteen furlongs off:

Bethany where Lazarus 43\_JOH\_12\_01 # Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.

Bethany with the <u>41\_MAR\_11\_11</u># And Jesus entered into Jerusalem, and into the temple: and when he had looked round about upon all things, and now the eventide was come, he went out unto Bethany with the twelve.

Betharabah and the <u>06\_JOS\_15\_06</u># And the border went up to Bethhogla, and passed along by the north of Betharabah; and the border went up to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben:

Betharabah and Zemaraim 06\_JOS\_18\_22 # And Betharabah, and Zemaraim, and Bethel,

Betharabah Middin and 06\_JOS\_15\_61 # In the wilderness, Betharabah, Middin, and Secacah,

Betharam and Bethnimrah <u>06\_JOS\_13\_27</u> # And in the valley, Betharam, and Bethnimrah, and Succoth, and Zaphon, the rest of the kingdom of Sihon king of Heshbon, Jordan and [his] border, [even] unto the edge of the sea of Chinnereth on the other side Jordan eastward.

Betharbel in the <u>28\_HOS\_10\_14</u># Therefore shall a tumult arise among thy people, and all thy fortresses shall be spoiled, as Shalman spoiled Betharbel in the day of battle: the mother was dashed in pieces upon [her] children.

Bethaven after thee <u>28\_HOS\_05\_08</u># Blow ye the cornet in Gibeah, [and] the trumpet in Ramah: cry aloud [at] Bethaven, after thee, O Benjamin.

Bethaven for the <u>28\_HOS\_10\_05</u># The inhabitants of Samaria shall fear because of the calves of Bethaven: for the people thereof shall mourn over it, and the priests thereof [that] rejoiced on it, for the glory thereof, because it is departed from it.

Bethaven nor swear 28\_HOS\_04\_15 # Though thou, Israel, play the harlot, [yet] let not Judah offend; and come not ye unto Gilgal, neither go ye up to Bethaven, nor swear, The LORD liveth.

Bethaven on the <u>06\_JOS\_07\_02</u># And Joshua sent men from Jericho to Ai, which [is] beside Bethaven, on the east side of Bethel, and spake unto them, saying, Go up and view the country. And the men went up and viewed Ai.

Bethaven <u>09\_1SA\_13\_05</u># And the Philistines gathered themselves together to fight with Israel, thirty thousand chariots, and six thousand horsemen, and people as the sand which [is] on the sea shore in multitude: and they came up, and pitched in Michmash, eastward from Bethaven.

Bethaven 09\_1SA\_14\_23 # So the LORD saved Israel that day: and the battle passed over unto Bethaven.

Bethaven <u>06\_JOS\_18\_12</u> # And their border on the north side was from Jordan; and the border went up to the side of Jericho on the north side, and went up through the mountains westward; and the goings out thereof were at the wilderness of Bethaven.

Bethazmaveth forty and 16\_NEH\_07\_28 # The men of Bethazmaveth, forty and two.

Bethbaalmeon 06\_JOS\_13\_17 # Heshbon, and all her cities that [are] in the plain; Dibon, and Bamothbaal,

and Bethbaalmeon,

Bethbarah and Jordan <u>07\_JUD\_07\_24</u># And Gideon sent messengers throughout all mount Ephraim, saying, Come down against the Midianites, and take before them the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan. Then all the men of Ephraim gathered themselves together, and took the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan.

Bethbarah and Jordan <u>07\_JUD\_07\_24</u># And Gideon sent messengers throughout all mount Ephraim, saying, Come down against the Midianites, and take before them the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan. Then all the men of Ephraim gathered themselves together, and took the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan.

Bethbirei and at 13\_1CH\_04\_31 # And at Bethmarcaboth, and Hazarsusim, and at Bethbirei, and at Shaaraim. These [were] their cities unto the reign of David.

Bethcar <u>09\_1SA\_07\_11</u># And the men of Israel went out of Mizpeh, and pursued the Philistines, and smote them, until [they came] under Bethcar.

Bethdagon and Naamah <u>06\_JOS\_15\_41</u> # And Gederoth, Bethdagon, and Naamah, and Makkedah; sixteen cities with their villages:

Bethdagon and reacheth <u>06\_JOS\_19\_27</u># And turneth toward the sunrising to Bethdagon, and reacheth to Zebulun, and to the valley of Jiphthahel toward the north side of Bethemek, and Neiel, and goeth out to Cabul on the left hand,

Bethdiblathaim 24\_JER\_48\_22 # And upon Dibon, and upon Nebo, and upon Bethdiblathaim,

Bethel and a <u>09\_1SA\_13\_02</u> # Saul chose him three thousand [men] of Israel; [whereof] two thousand were with Saul in Michmash and in mount Bethel, and a thousand were with Jonathan in Gibeah of Benjamin: and the rest of the people he sent every man to his tent.

Bethel and against 11\_1KI\_13\_32 # For the saying which he cried by the word of the LORD against the altar in Bethel, and against all the houses of the high places which [are] in the cities of Samaria, shall surely come to pass.

Bethel and Ai 15 EZR 02 28 # The men of Bethel and Ai, two hundred twenty and three.

Bethel and Ai <u>06\_JOS\_08\_09</u> # Joshua therefore sent them forth: and they went to lie in ambush, and abode between Bethel and Ai, on the west side of Ai: but Joshua lodged that night among the people.

Bethel and Ai <u>06\_JOS\_08\_12</u> # And he took about five thousand men, and set them to lie in ambush between Bethel and Ai, on the west side of the city.

Bethel and Ai 16\_NEH\_07\_32 # The men of Bethel and Ai, an hundred twenty and three.

Bethel and as 12\_2KI\_02\_23 # And he went up from thence unto Bethel: and as he was going up by the way, there came forth little children out of the city, and mocked him, and said unto him, Go up, thou bald head; go up, thou bald head.

Bethel and dwell <u>01\_GEN\_35\_01</u># And God said unto Jacob, Arise, go up to Bethel, and dwell there: and make there an altar unto God, that appeared unto thee when thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy brother.

Bethel And Elisha 12\_2KI\_02\_02 # And Elijah said unto Elisha, Tarry here, I pray thee; for the LORD hath sent me to Bethel. And Elisha said [unto him, As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not

leave thee. So they went down to Bethel.

Bethel and Gilgal <u>09\_1SA\_07\_16</u> # And he went from year to year in circuit to Bethel, and Gilgal, and Mizpeh, and judged Israel in all those places.

Bethel and Hai <u>01\_GEN\_13\_03</u># And he went on his journeys from the south even to Bethel, unto the place where his tent had been at the beginning, between Bethel and Hai;

Bethel and his 11\_1KI\_13\_11# Now there dwelt an old prophet in Bethel; and his sons came and told him all the works that the man of God had done that day in Bethel: the words which he had spoken unto the king, them they told also to their father.

Bethel and I <u>01\_GEN\_35\_03</u> # And let us arise, and go up to Bethel; and I will make there an altar unto God, who answered me in the day of my distress, and was with me in the way which I went.

Bethel and in 16\_NEH\_11\_31 # The children also of Benjamin from Geba [dwelt] at Michmash, and Aija, and Bethel, and [in] their villages,

Bethel and Jeroboam 11\_1KI\_13\_01# And, behold, there came a man of God out of Judah by the word of the LORD unto Bethel: and Jeroboam stood by the altar to burn incense.

Bethel and pitched <u>01\_GEN\_12\_08</u># And he removed from thence unto a mountain on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, [having] Bethel on the west, and Hai on the east: and there he builded an altar unto the LORD, and called upon the name of the LORD.

Bethel and spake <u>06\_JOS\_07\_02</u># And Joshua sent men from Jericho to Ai, which [is] beside Bethaven, on the east side of Bethel, and spake unto them, saying, Go up and view the country. And the men went up and viewed Ai.

Bethel and taught 12\_2KI\_17\_28 # Then one of the priests whom they had carried away from Samaria came and dwelt in Bethel, and taught them how they should fear the LORD.

Bethel and that 12\_2KI\_10\_29 # Howbeit [from] the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, Jehu departed not from after them, [to wit], the golden calves that [were] in Bethel, and that [were] in Dan.

Bethel and the <u>13\_1CH\_07\_28</u> # And their possessions and habitations [were], Bethel and the towns thereof, and eastward Naaran, and westward Gezer, with the towns thereof; Shechem also and the towns thereof, unto Gaza and the towns thereof:

Bethel and the 11\_1KI\_12\_29 # And he set the one in Bethel, and the other put he in Dan.

Bethel and the <u>12\_2KI\_23\_15</u> # Moreover the altar that [was] at Bethel, [and] the high place which Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, had made, both that altar and the high place he brake down, and burned the high place, [and] stamped [it] small to powder, and burned the grove.

Bethel and the <u>30\_AMO\_03\_14</u> # That in the day that I shall visit the transgressions of Israel upon him I will also visit the altars of Bethel: and the horns of the altar shall be cut off, and fall to the ground.

Bethel and the <u>07\_JUD\_01\_22</u> # And the house of Joseph, they also went up against Bethel: and the LORD [was] with them.

Bethel and there <u>01\_GEN\_35\_16</u> # And they journeyed from Bethel; and there was but a little way to come to Ephrath: and Rachel travailed, and she had hard labour.

Bethel and there <u>28\_HOS\_12\_04</u> # Yea, he had power over the angel, and prevailed: he wept, and made supplication unto him: he found him [in] Bethel, and there he spake with us;

Bethel and to <u>09\_1SA\_30\_27</u> # To [them] which [were] in Bethel, and to [them] which [were] in south Ramoth, and to [them] which [were] in Jattir,

Bethel and transgress 30\_AMO\_04\_04 # Come to Bethel, and transgress; at Gilgal multiply transgression; and bring your sacrifices every morning, [and] your tithes after three years:

Bethel but the <u>01\_GEN\_28\_19</u># And he called the name of that place Bethel: but the name of that city [was called] Luz at the first.

Bethel came forth 12 2KI 02 03 # And the sons of the prophets that [were] at Bethel came forth to Elisha, and said unto him, Knowest thou that the LORD will take away thy master from thy head to day? And he said, Yea, I know [it]; hold ye your peace.

Bethel do unto <u>28\_HOS\_10\_15</u># So shall Bethel do unto you because of your great wickedness: in a morning shall the king of Israel utterly be cut off.

Bethel for it 30\_AMO\_07\_13 # But prophesy not again any more at Bethel: for it [is] the king's chapel, and it [is] the king's court.

Bethel he and <u>01\_GEN\_35\_06</u> # So Jacob came to Luz, which [is] in the land of Canaan, that [is], Bethel, he and all the people that [were] with him.

Bethel in mount <u>07\_JUD\_04\_05</u> # And she dwelt under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel came up to her for judgment.

Bethel nor enter <u>30\_AMO\_05\_05</u> # But seek not Bethel, nor enter into Gilgal, and pass not to Beersheba: for Gilgal shall surely go into captivity, and Bethel shall come to nought.

Bethel Now the <u>07\_JUD\_01\_23</u># And the house of Joseph sent to descry Bethel. [Now the name of the city before [was] Luz.]

Bethel on the <u>01\_GEN\_12\_08</u># And he removed from thence unto a mountain on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, [having] Bethel on the west, and Hai on the east: and there he builded an altar unto the LORD, and called upon the name of the LORD.

Bethel on the <u>07\_JUD\_21\_19</u># Then they said, Behold, [there is] a feast of the LORD in Shiloh yearly [in a place] which [is] on the north side of Bethel, on the east side of the highway that goeth up from Bethel to Shechem, and on the south of Lebonah.

Bethel one carrying <u>09\_1SA\_10\_03</u># Then shalt thou go on forward from thence, and thou shalt come to the plain of Tabor, and there shall meet thee three men going up to God to Bethel, one carrying three kids, and another carrying three loaves of bread, and another carrying a bottle of wine:

Bethel one 06\_JOS\_12\_09 # The king of Jericho, one; the king of Ai, which [is] beside Bethel, one;

Bethel one <a href="Marked-105"><u>06\_JOS\_12\_16</u></a># The king of Makkedah, one; the king of Bethel, one;

Bethel sacrificing unto 11\_1KI\_12\_32 # And Jeroboam ordained a feast in the eighth month, on the fifteenth day of the month, like unto the feast that [is] in Judah, and he offered upon the altar. So did he in Bethel, sacrificing unto the calves that he had made: and he placed in Bethel the priests of the high places which he had made.

Bethel sent to <u>30\_AMO\_07\_10</u># Then Amaziah the priest of Bethel sent to Jeroboam king of Israel, saying, Amos hath conspired against thee in the midst of the house of Israel: the land is not able to bear all his words.

Bethel shall come <u>30\_AMO\_05\_05</u># But seek not Bethel, nor enter into Gilgal, and pass not to Beersheba: for Gilgal shall surely go into captivity, and Bethel shall come to nought.

Bethel southward and <u>06\_JOS\_18\_13</u># And the border went over from thence toward Luz, to the side of Luz, which [is] Bethel, southward; and the border descended to Atarothadar, near the hill that [lieth] on the south side of the nether Bethhoron.

Bethel that he <u>11\_1KI\_13\_04</u># And it came to pass, when king Jeroboam heard the saying of the man of God, which had cried against the altar in Bethel, that he put forth his hand from the altar, saying, Lay hold on him. And his hand, which he put forth against him, dried up, so that he could not pull it in again to him.

Bethel that went <u>06\_JOS\_08\_17</u> # And there was not a man left in Ai or Bethel, that went not out after Israel: and they left the city open, and pursued after Israel.

Bethel the fifteenth 11\_1KI\_12\_33 # So he offered upon the altar which he had made in Bethel the fifteenth day of the eighth month, [even] in the month which he had devised of his own heart; and ordained a feast unto the children of Israel: and he offered upon the altar, and burnt incense.

Bethel the priests 11\_1KI\_12\_32# And Jeroboam ordained a feast in the eighth month, on the fifteenth day of the month, like unto the feast that [is] in Judah, and he offered upon the altar. So did he in Bethel, sacrificing unto the calves that he had made: and he placed in Bethel the priests of the high places which he had made.

Bethel the words 11 1KI 13 11 Wow there dwelt an old prophet in Bethel; and his sons came and told him all the works that the man of God had done that day in Bethel: the words which he had spoken unto the king, them they told also to their father.

Bethel their confidence 24\_JER\_48\_13 # And Moab shall be ashamed of Chemosh, as the house of Israel was ashamed of Bethel their confidence.

Bethel to Luz <u>06\_JOS\_16\_02</u> # And goeth out from Bethel to Luz, and passeth along unto the borders of Archi to Ataroth,

Bethel to Shechem <u>07\_JUD\_21\_19</u> # Then they said, Behold, [there is] a feast of the LORD in Shiloh yearly [in a place] which [is] on the north side of Bethel, on the east side of the highway that goeth up from Bethel to Shechem, and on the south of Lebonah.

Bethel under an <u>01\_GEN\_35\_08</u># But Deborah Rebekah's nurse died, and she was buried beneath Bethel under an oak: and the name of it was called Allonbachuth.

Bethel unto the <u>01\_GEN\_13\_03</u># And he went on his journeys from the south even to Bethel, unto the place where his tent had been at the beginning, between Bethel and Hai;

Bethel where thou <u>01\_GEN\_31\_13</u># I [am] the God of Bethel, where thou anointedst the pillar, [and] where thou vowedst a vow unto me: now arise, get thee out from this land, and return unto the land of thy kindred.

Bethel with the 14\_2CH\_13\_19 # And Abijah pursued after Jeroboam, and took cities from him, Bethel with the towns thereof, and Jeshanah with the towns thereof, and Ephrain with the towns thereof.

Bethel 11\_1KI\_13\_10 # So he went another way, and returned not by the way that he came to Bethel.

Bethel <u>12\_2KI\_02\_02</u># And Elijah said unto Elisha, Tarry here, I pray thee; for the LORD hath sent me to Bethel. And Elisha said [unto him, As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. So they went down to Bethel.

Bethel 12\_2KI\_23\_04 # And the king commanded Hilkiah the high priest, and the priests of the second order, and the keepers of the door, to bring forth out of the temple of the LORD all the vessels that were made for Baal, and for the grove, and for all the host of heaven: and he burned them without Jerusalem in the fields of Kidron, and carried the ashes of them unto Bethel.

Bethel <u>12\_2KI\_23\_17</u> # Then he said, What title [is] that that I see? And the men of the city told him, [It is] the sepulchre of the man of God, which came from Judah, and proclaimed these things that thou hast done against the altar of Bethel.

Bethel 12 2KI 23 19 # And all the houses also of the high places that [were] in the cities of Samaria, which the kings of Israel had made to provoke [the LORD] to anger, Josiah took away, and did to them according to all the acts that he had done in Bethel.

Bethel <u>30\_AMO\_05\_06</u> # Seek the LORD, and ye shall live; lest he break out like fire in the house of Joseph, and devour [it], and [there be] none to quench [it] in Bethel.

Bethel 01\_GEN\_35\_15 # And Jacob called the name of the place where God spake with him, Bethel.

Bethel <u>06\_JOS\_16\_01</u> # And the lot of the children of Joseph fell from Jordan by Jericho, unto the water of Jericho on the east, to the wilderness that goeth up from Jericho throughout mount Bethel.

Bethel 06\_JOS\_18\_22 # And Betharabah, and Zemaraim, and Bethel,

Bethelite build Jericho 11\_1KI\_16\_34# In his days did Hiel the Bethelite build Jericho: he laid the foundation thereof in Abiram his firstborn, and set up the gates thereof in his youngest [son] Segub, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by Joshua the son of Nun.

Bethemek and Neiel <u>06\_JOS\_19\_27</u># And turneth toward the sunrising to Bethdagon, and reacheth to Zebulun, and to the valley of Jiphthahel toward the north side of Bethemek, and Neiel, and goeth out to Cabul on the left hand,

Bether <u>22\_SON\_02\_17</u> # Until the day break, and the shadows flee away, turn, my beloved, and be thou like a roe or a young hart upon the mountains of Bether.

Bethesda having five <u>43\_JOH\_05\_02</u> # Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep [market] a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches.

Bethezel he shall <u>33\_MIC\_01\_11</u># Pass ye away, thou inhabitant of Saphir, having thy shame naked: the inhabitant of Zaanan came not forth in the mourning of Bethezel; he shall receive of you his standing.

Bethgader 13\_1CH\_02\_51 # Salma the father of Bethlehem, Hareph the father of Bethgader.

Bethgamul and upon 24\_JER\_48\_23 # And upon Kiriathaim, and upon Bethgamul, and upon Bethmeon,

Bethhaccerem for evil <u>24\_JER\_06\_01</u> # O ye children of Benjamin, gather yourselves to flee out of the midst of Jerusalem, and blow the trumpet in Tekoa, and set up a sign of fire in Bethhaccerem: for evil appeareth out of the north, and great destruction.

Bethhaccerem he built <u>16\_NEH\_03\_14</u> # But the dung gate repaired Malchiah the son of Rechab, the ruler of part of Bethhaccerem; he built it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

Bethharan fenced cities <u>04\_NUM\_32\_36</u> # And Bethnimrah, and Bethharan, fenced cities: and folds for sheep.

Bethhogla and passed <u>06\_JOS\_15\_06</u> # And the border went up to Bethhogla, and passed along by the north of Betharabah; and the border went up to the stone of Bohan the son of Reuben:

Bethhoglah and the <u>06\_JOS\_18\_21</u> # Now the cities of the tribe of the children of Benjamin according to their families were Jericho, and Bethhoglah, and the valley of Keziz.

Bethhoglah northward and <u>06\_JOS\_18\_19</u># And the border passed along to the side of Bethhoglah northward: and the outgoings of the border were at the north bay of the salt sea at the south end of Jordan: this [was] the south coast.

Bethhoron and another <u>09\_1SA\_13\_18</u># And another company turned the way [to] Bethhoron: and another company turned [to] the way of the border that looketh to the valley of Zeboim toward the wilderness.

Bethhoron and smote 14\_2CH\_25\_13 # But the soldiers of the army which Amaziah sent back, that they should not go with him to battle, fell upon the cities of Judah, from Samaria even unto Bethhoron, and smote three thousand of them, and took much spoil.

Bethhoron and smote <u>06\_JOS\_10\_10</u># And the LORD discomfited them before Israel, and slew them with a great slaughter at Gibeon, and chased them along the way that goeth up to Bethhoron, and smote them to Azekah, and unto Makkedah.

Bethhoron southward and <u>06\_JOS\_18\_14</u># And the border was drawn [thence], and compassed the corner of the sea southward, from the hill that [lieth] before Bethhoron southward; and the goings out thereof were at Kirjathbaal, which [is] Kirjathjearim, a city of the children of Judah: this [was] the west quarter.

Bethhoron the nether <u>06\_JOS\_16\_03</u> # And goeth down westward to the coast of Japhleti, unto the coast of Bethhoron the nether, and to Gezer: and the goings out thereof are at the sea.

Bethhoron the upper 14\_2CH\_08\_05 # Also he built Bethhoron the upper, and Bethhoron the nether, fenced cities, with walls, gates, and bars;

Bethhoron the upper <u>06\_JOS\_16\_05</u># And the border of the children of Ephraim according to their families was [thus]: even the border of their inheritance on the east side was Atarothaddar, unto Bethhoron the upper;

Bethhoron with her 13\_1CH\_06\_68 # And Jokmeam with her suburbs, and Bethhoron with her suburbs,

Bethhoron with her <u>06\_JOS\_21\_22</u># And Kibzaim with her suburbs, and Bethhoron with her suburbs; four cities.

Bethlehem where David <u>43\_JOH\_07\_42</u> # Hath not the scripture said, That Christ cometh of the seed of David, and out of the town of Bethlehem, where David was?

Bethlehem which is <u>10\_2SA\_23\_15</u> # And David longed, and said, Oh that one would give me drink of the water of the well of Bethlehem, which [is] by the gate!

Bethlehem <u>13\_1CH\_04\_04</u> # And Penuel the father of Gedor, and Ezer the father of Hushah. These [are] the sons of Hur, the firstborn of Ephratah, the father of Bethlehem.

Bethlehem 13\_1CH\_11\_16# And David [was] then in the hold, and the Philistines' garrison [was] then at Bethlehem.

Bethlehem 13\_1CH\_11\_26# Also the valiant men of the armies [were], Asahel the brother of Joab, Elhanan the son of Dodo of Bethlehem,

Bethlehem <u>09\_1SA\_17\_15</u> # But David went and returned from Saul to feed his father's sheep at Bethlehem.

Bethnimrah and Succoth <u>06 JOS 13 27</u> # And in the valley, Betharam, and Bethnimrah, and Succoth, and Zaphon, the rest of the kingdom of Sihon king of Heshbon, Jordan and [his] border, [even] unto the edge of the sea of Chinnereth on the other side Jordan eastward.

Bethpalet <u>06\_JOS\_15\_27</u> # And Hazargaddah, and Heshmon, and Bethpalet,

Bethpazzez 06\_JOS\_19\_21 # And Remeth, and Engannim, and Enhaddah, and Bethpazzez;

Bethpeor and Ashdothpisgah <u>06\_JOS\_13\_20</u> # And Bethpeor, and Ashdothpisgah, and Bethjeshimoth,

Bethpeor but no <u>05\_DEU\_34\_06</u># And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, over against Bethpeor: but no man knoweth of his sepulchre unto this day.

Bethpeor in the <u>05\_DEU\_04\_46</u># On this side Jordan, in the valley over against Bethpeor, in the land of Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt at Heshbon, whom Moses and the children of Israel smote, after they were come forth out of Egypt:

Bethsaida of Galilee 43\_JOH\_12\_21 # The same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus.

Bethsaida the city 43\_JOH\_01\_44 # Now Philip was of Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.

Bethsaida while he <u>41\_MAR\_06\_45</u># And straightway he constrained his disciples to get into the ship, and to go to the other side before unto Bethsaida, while he sent away the people.

Bethsaida <u>42 LUK\_09\_10</u> # And the apostles, when they were returned, told him all that they had done. And he took them, and went aside privately into a desert place belonging to the city called Bethsaida.
