Barabbas and destroy 40 MAT 27 20 # But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus.

Barabbas Now Barabbas <u>43_JOH_18_40</u># Then cried they all again, saying, Not this man, but Barabbas. Now Barabbas was a robber.

Barabbas or Jesus 40_MAT_27_17 # Therefore when they were gathered together, Pilate said unto them, Whom will ye that I release unto you? Barabbas, or Jesus which is called Christ?

Barabbas unto them <u>41_MAR_15_11</u># But the chief priests moved the people, that he should rather release Barabbas unto them.

Barabbas unto them <u>41_MAR_15_15</u> # And [so] Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged [him], to be crucified.

Barabbas unto them 40_MAT_27_26# Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered [him] to be crucified.

Barabbas which lay 41_MAR_15_07 # And there was [one] named Barabbas, [which lay] bound with them that had made insurrection with him, who had committed murder in the insurrection.

Barabbas <u>42_LUK_23_18</u># And they cried out all at once, saying, Away with this [man], and release unto us Barabbas:

Barabbas 40_MAT_27_16# And they had then a notable prisoner, called Barabbas.

Barabbas <u>40 MAT_27_21</u># The governor answered and said unto them, Whether of the twain will ye that I release unto you? They said, Barabbas.
