Bathsheba And she [11_1KI_01_28](#) # Then king David answered and said, Call me Bathsheba. And she came into the king's presence, and stood before the king.

Bathsheba bowed with [11_1KI_01_31](#) # Then Bathsheba bowed with [her] face to the earth, and did reverence to the king, and said, Let my lord king David live for ever.

Bathsheba Have mercy [19_PSA_51_01](#) # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba. Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions.
