

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Baalathbeer Ramath of <u>06\_JOS\_19\_08</u># And all the villages that [were] round about these cities to Baalathbeer, Ramath of the south. This [is] the inheritance of the tribe of the children of Simeon according to their families.

Beer and dwelt <u>07\_JUD\_09\_21</u> # And Jotham ran away, and fled, and went to Beer, and dwelt there, for fear of Abimelech his brother.

Beer that is <u>04\_NUM\_21\_16</u> # And from thence [they went] to Beer: that [is] the well whereof the LORD spake unto Moses, Gather the people together, and I will give them water.

Beera 13 1CH 07 37 # Bezer, and Hod, and Shamma, and Shilshah, and Ithran, and Beera.

Beerah his son <u>13\_1CH\_05\_06</u># Beerah his son, whom Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria carried away [captive]: he [was] prince of the Reubenites.

Beerelim <u>23\_ISA\_15\_08</u># For the cry is gone round about the borders of Moab; the howling thereof unto Eglaim, and the howling thereof unto Beerelim.

Beeri in the <u>28\_HOS\_01\_01</u># The word of the LORD that came unto Hosea, the son of Beeri, in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash, king of Israel.

Beeri the Hittite <u>01\_GEN\_26\_34</u># And Esau was forty years old when he took to wife Judith the daughter of Beeri the Hittite, and Bashemath the daughter of Elon the Hittite:

Beerlahairoi behold it <u>01\_GEN\_16\_14</u> # Wherefore the well was called Beerlahairoi; behold, [it is] between Kadesh and Bered.

Beeroth also was <u>10\_2SA\_04\_02</u> # And Saul's son had two men [that were] captains of bands: the name of the one [was] Baanah, and the name of the other Rechab, the sons of Rimmon a Beerothite, of the children of Benjamin: [for Beeroth also was reckoned to Benjamin.

Beeroth and Kirjathjearim <u>06\_JOS\_09\_17</u> # And the children of Israel journeyed, and came unto their cities on the third day. Now their cities [were] Gibeon, and Chephirah, and Beeroth, and Kirjathjearim.

Beeroth of the <u>05\_DEU\_10\_06</u># And the children of Israel took their journey from Beeroth of the children of Jaakan to Mosera: there Aaron died, and there he was buried; and Eleazar his son ministered in the priest's office in his stead.

Beeroth seven hundred <u>15\_EZR\_02\_25</u># The children of Kirjatharim, Chephirah, and Beeroth, seven hundred and forty and three.

Beeroth seven hundred <u>16\_NEH\_07\_29</u> # The men of Kirjathjearim, Chephirah, and Beeroth, seven hundred forty and three.

Beeroth 06\_JOS\_18\_25 # Gibeon, and Ramah, and Beeroth,

Beerothite and said 10\_2SA\_04\_09 # And David answered Rechab and Baanah his brother, the sons of

Rimmon the Beerothite, and said unto them, [As] the LORD liveth, who hath redeemed my soul out of all adversity,

Beerothite armourbearer to <u>10\_2SA\_23\_37</u> # Zelek the Ammonite, Nahari the Beerothite, armourbearer to Joab the son of Zeruiah,

Beerothite of the <u>10\_2SA\_04\_02</u> # And Saul's son had two men [that were] captains of bands: the name of the one [was] Baanah, and the name of the other Rechab, the sons of Rimmon a Beerothite, of the children of Benjamin: [for Beeroth also was reckoned to Benjamin.

Beerothite Rechab and 10\_2SA\_04\_05 # And the sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, Rechab and Baanah, went, and came about the heat of the day to the house of Ishbosheth, who lay on a bed at noon.

Beerothites fled to <u>10\_2SA\_04\_03</u># And the Beerothites fled to Gittaim, and were sojourners there until this day.]

Beersheba all the 11 1KI 04 25 # And Judah and Israel dwelt safely, every man under his vine and under his fig tree, from Dan even to Beersheba, all the days of Solomon.

Beersheba and Abraham <u>01\_GEN\_22\_19</u># So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.

Beersheba and Bizjothjah 06\_JOS\_15\_28 # And Hazarshual, and Beersheba, and Bizjothjah,

Beersheba and brake 12\_2KI\_23\_08 # And he brought all the priests out of the cities of Judah, and defiled the high places where the priests had burned incense, from Geba to Beersheba, and brake down the high places of the gates that [were] in the entering in of the gate of Joshua the governor of the city, which [were] on a man's left hand at the gate of the city.

Beersheba and called <u>01\_GEN\_21\_33</u> # And [Abraham] planted a grove in Beersheba, and called there on the name of the LORD, the everlasting God.

Beersheba and in 16\_NEH\_11\_27 # And at Hazarshual, and at Beersheba, and [in] the villages thereof,

Beersheba and Moladah 13\_1CH\_04\_28 # And they dwelt at Beersheba, and Moladah, and Hazarshual,

Beersheba and number 10\_2SA\_24\_02 # For the king said to Joab the captain of the host, which [was] with him, Go now through all the tribes of Israel, from Dan even to Beersheba, and number ye the people, that I may know the number of the people.

Beersheba and offered <u>01\_GEN\_46\_01</u># And Israel took his journey with all that he had, and came to Beersheba, and offered sacrifices unto the God of his father Isaac.

Beersheba and Sheba <u>06\_JOS\_19\_02</u># And they had in their inheritance Beersheba, and Sheba, and Moladah,

Beersheba and the <u>01\_GEN\_46\_05</u># And Jacob rose up from Beersheba: and the sons of Israel carried Jacob their father, and their little ones, and their wives, in the wagons which Pharaoh had sent to carry him.

Beersheba and went 01\_GEN\_28\_10 # And Jacob went out from Beersheba, and went toward Haran.

Beersheba as the <u>10\_2SA\_17\_11</u># Therefore I counsel that all Israel be generally gathered unto thee, from Dan even to Beersheba, as the sand that [is] by the sea for multitude; and that thou go to battle in thine own person.

Beersheba because there <u>01\_GEN\_21\_31</u># Wherefore he called that place Beersheba; because there they sware both of them.

Beersheba even to 13\_1CH\_21\_02 # And David said to Joab and to the rulers of the people, Go, number Israel from Beersheba even to Dan; and bring the number of them to me, that I may know [it].

Beersheba even to 14 2CH 30 05 # So they established a decree to make proclamation throughout all Israel, from Beersheba even to Dan, that they should come to keep the passover unto the LORD God of Israel at Jerusalem: for they had not done [it] of a long [time in such sort] as it was written.

Beersheba for Gilgal 30\_AMO\_05\_05 # But seek not Bethel, nor enter into Gilgal, and pass not to Beersheba: for Gilgal shall surely go into captivity, and Bethel shall come to nought.

Beersheba knew that <u>09\_1SA\_03\_20</u> # And all Israel from Dan even to Beersheba knew that Samuel [was] established [to be] a prophet of the LORD.

Beersheba liveth even 30\_AMO\_08\_14 # They that swear by the sin of Samaria, and say, Thy god, O Dan, liveth; and, The manner of Beersheba liveth; even they shall fall, and never rise up again.

Beersheba seventy thousand <u>10\_2SA\_24\_15</u> # So the LORD sent a pestilence upon Israel from the morning even to the time appointed: and there died of the people from Dan even to Beersheba seventy thousand men.

Beersheba then Abimelech <u>01\_GEN\_21\_32</u> # Thus they made a covenant at Beersheba: then Abimelech rose up, and Phichol the chief captain of his host, and they returned into the land of the Philistines.

Beersheba to mount 14 2CH 19 04 # And Jehoshaphat dwelt at Jerusalem: and he went out again through the people from Beersheba to mount Ephraim, and brought them back unto the LORD God of their fathers.

Beersheba unto the <u>16\_NEH\_11\_30</u># Zanoah, Adullam, and [in] their villages, at Lachish, and the fields thereof, at Azekah, and [in] the villages thereof. And they dwelt from Beersheba unto the valley of Hinnom.

Beersheba unto this <u>01\_GEN\_26\_33</u># And he called it Shebah: therefore the name of the city [is] Beersheba unto this day.

Beersheba which belongeth 11\_1KI\_19\_03 # And when he saw [that], he arose, and went for his life, and came to Beersheba, which [belongeth] to Judah, and left his servant there.

Beersheba with the <u>07\_JUD\_20\_01</u># Then all the children of Israel went out, and the congregation was gathered together as one man, from Dan even to Beersheba, with the land of Gilead, unto the LORD in Mizpeh.

Beersheba <u>09\_1SA\_08\_02</u> # Now the name of his firstborn was Joel; and the name of his second, Abiah: [they were] judges in Beersheba.

Beersheba <u>14\_2CH\_24\_01</u> # Joash [was] seven years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Zibiah of Beersheba.

Beersheba 12\_2KI\_12\_01 # In the seventh year of Jehu Jehoash began to reign; and forty years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Zibiah of Beersheba.

Beersheba <u>10\_2SA\_03\_10</u> # To translate the kingdom from the house of Saul, and to set up the throne of David over Israel and over Judah, from Dan even to Beersheba.

Beersheba 10\_2SA\_24\_07 # And came to the strong hold of Tyre, and to all the cities of the Hivites, and of the Canaanites: and they went out to the south of Judah, [even] to Beersheba.

Beersheba <u>01\_GEN\_21\_14</u># And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and took bread, and a bottle of water, and gave [it] unto Hagar, putting [it] on her shoulder, and the child, and sent her away: and she departed, and wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba.

Beersheba <u>01\_GEN\_22\_19</u># So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.

Beersheba 01\_GEN\_26\_23 # And he went up from thence to Beersheba.
