

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Bethaven after thee <u>28_HOS_05_08</u># Blow ye the cornet in Gibeah, [and] the trumpet in Ramah: cry aloud [at] Bethaven, after thee, O Benjamin.

Bethaven for the <u>28_HOS_10_05</u># The inhabitants of Samaria shall fear because of the calves of Bethaven: for the people thereof shall mourn over it, and the priests thereof [that] rejoiced on it, for the glory thereof, because it is departed from it.

Bethaven nor swear <u>28_HOS_04_15</u> # Though thou, Israel, play the harlot, [yet] let not Judah offend; and come not ye unto Gilgal, neither go ye up to Bethaven, nor swear, The LORD liveth.

Bethaven on the <u>06_JOS_07_02</u> # And Joshua sent men from Jericho to Ai, which [is] beside Bethaven, on the east side of Bethel, and spake unto them, saying, Go up and view the country. And the men went up and viewed Ai.

Bethaven <u>09_1SA_13_05</u> # And the Philistines gathered themselves together to fight with Israel, thirty thousand chariots, and six thousand horsemen, and people as the sand which [is] on the sea shore in multitude: and they came up, and pitched in Michmash, eastward from Bethaven.

Bethaven <u>09_1SA_14_23</u> # So the LORD saved Israel that day: and the battle passed over unto Bethaven.

Bethaven <u>06_JOS_18_12</u> # And their border on the north side was from Jordan; and the border went up to the side of Jericho on the north side, and went up through the mountains westward; and the goings out thereof were at the wilderness of Bethaven.
