bake it with <u>26\_EZE\_04\_12</u># And thou shalt eat it [as] barley cakes, and thou shalt bake it with dung that cometh out of man, in their sight.

bake that which <u>02\_EXO\_16\_23</u> # And he said unto them, This [is that] which the LORD hath said, To morrow [is] the rest of the holy sabbath unto the LORD: bake [that] which ye will bake [to day], and see the that ye will see the; and that which remaine th over lay up for you to be kept until the morning.

bake the cakes <u>10\_2SA\_13\_08</u># So Tamar went to her brother Amnon's house; and he was laid down. And she took flour, and kneaded [it], and made cakes in his sight, and did bake the cakes.

bake the meat <u>26\_EZE\_46\_20</u># Then said he unto me, This [is] the place where the priests shall boil the trespass offering and the sin offering, where they shall bake the meat offering; that they bear [them] not out into the utter court, to sanctify the people.

bake to day <u>02\_EXO\_16\_23</u># And he said unto them, This [is that] which the LORD hath said, To morrow [is] the rest of the holy sabbath unto the LORD: bake [that] which ye will bake [to day], and see the that ye will see the; and that which remaine th over lay up for you to be kept until the morning.

bake twelve cakes <u>03\_LEV\_24\_05</u># And thou shalt take fine flour, and bake twelve cakes thereof: two tenth deals shall be in one cake.

bake unleavened bread <u>09\_1SA\_28\_24</u> # And the woman had a fat calf in the house; and she hasted, and killed it, and took flour, and kneaded [it], and did bake unleavened bread thereof:

bake unleavened bread <u>01\_GEN\_19\_03</u> # And he pressed upon them greatly; and they turned in unto him, and entered into his house; and he made them a feast, and did bake unleavened bread, and they did eat.

bake your bread <u>03\_LEV\_26\_26</u> # [And] when I have broken the staff of your bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall deliver [you] your bread again by weight: and ye shall eat, and not be satisfied.

baked bread upon 23\_ISA\_44\_19 # And none considereth in his heart, neither [is there] knowledge nor understanding to say, I have burned part of it in the fire; yea, also I have baked bread upon the coals thereof; I have roasted flesh, and eaten [it]: and shall I make the residue thereof an abomination? shall I fall down to the stock of a tree?

baked in the <u>13\_1CH\_23\_29</u> # Both for the showbread, and for the fine flour for meat offering, and for the unleavened cakes, and for [that which is baked in] the pan, and for that which is fried, and for all manner of measure and size;

baked it in <u>04\_NUM\_11\_08</u># [And] the people went about, and gathered [it], and ground [it] in mills, or beat [it] in a mortar, and baked [it] in pans, and made cakes of it: and the taste of it was as the taste of fresh oil.

baked unleavened cakes <u>02\_EXO\_12\_39</u> # And they baked unleavened cakes of the dough which they brought forth out of Egypt, for it was not leavened; because they were thrust out of Egypt, and could not tarry, neither had they prepared for themselves any victual.

bakemeats for Pharaoh <u>01\_GEN\_40\_17</u> # And in the uppermost basket [there was] of all manner of bakemeats for Pharaoh; and the birds did eat them out of the basket upon my head.

baken in a <u>03\_LEV\_02\_05</u># And if thy oblation [be] a meat offering [baken] in a pan, it shall be [of] fine flour unleavened, mingled with oil.

baken in the <u>03\_LEV\_02\_04</u> # And if thou bring an oblation of a meat offering baken in the oven, [it shall be] unleavened cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, or unleavened wafers anointed with oil.

baken in the <u>03\_LEV\_02\_07</u> # And if thy oblation [be] a meat offering [baken] in the fryingpan, it shall be made [of] fine flour with oil.

baken in the <u>03\_LEV\_07\_09</u># And all the meat offering that is baken in the oven, and all that is dressed in the fryingpan, and in the pan, shall be the priest's that offereth it.

baken on the <u>11\_1KI\_19\_06</u># And he looked, and, behold, [there was] a cake baken on the coals, and a cruse of water at his head. And he did eat and drink, and laid him down again.

baken pieces of <u>03\_LEV\_06\_21</u># In a pan it shall be made with oil; [and when it is] baken, thou shalt bring it in: [and] the baken pieces of the meat offering shalt thou offer [for] a sweet savour unto the LORD.

baken with leaven <u>03\_LEV\_06\_17</u># It shall not be baken with leaven. I have given it [unto them for] their portion of my offerings made by fire; it [is] most holy, as [is] the sin offering, and as the trespass offering.

baken with leaven <u>03\_LEV\_23\_17</u># Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave loaves of two tenth deals: they shall be of fine flour; they shall be baken with leaven; [they are] the firstfruits unto the LORD.

baker among his <u>01\_GEN\_40\_20</u># And it came to pass the third day, [which was] Pharaoh's birthday, that he made a feast unto all his servants: and he lifted up the head of the chief butler and of the chief baker among his servants.

baker as Joseph 01\_GEN\_40\_22 # But he hanged the chief baker: as Joseph had interpreted to them.

baker had offended <u>01\_GEN\_40\_01</u># And it came to pass after these things, [that] the butler of the king of Egypt and [his] baker had offended their lord the king of Egypt.

baker of the <u>01\_GEN\_40\_05</u> # And they dreamed a dream both of them, each man his dream in one night, each man according to the interpretation of his dream, the butler and the baker of the king of Egypt, which [were] bound in the prison.

baker saw that <u>01\_GEN\_40\_16</u># When the chief baker saw that the interpretation was good, he said unto Joseph, I also [was] in my dream, and, behold, [I had] three white baskets on my head:

baker sleepeth all <u>28\_HOS\_07\_06</u># For they have made ready their heart like an oven, whiles they lie in wait: their baker sleepeth all the night; in the morning it burneth as a flaming fire.

baker who ceaseth <u>28\_HOS\_07\_04</u> # They [are] all adulterers, as an oven heated by the baker, [who] ceaseth from raising after he hath kneaded the dough, until it be leavened.

baker <u>01\_GEN\_41\_10</u> # Pharaoh was wroth with his servants, and put me in ward in the captain of the guard's house, [both] me and the chief baker:

bakers street until <u>24\_JER\_37\_21</u> # Then Zedekiah the king commanded that they should commit Jeremiah into the court of the prison, and that they should give him daily a piece of bread out of the bakers' street, until all the bread in the city were spent. Thus Jeremiah remained in the court of the prison.

bakers <u>09\_1SA\_08\_13</u># And he will take your daughters [to be] confectionaries, and [to be] cooks, and [to be] bakers.
