Neballat <u>16_NEH_11_34</u># Hadid, Zeboim, Neballat,

Sanballat according to <u>16_NEH_06_14</u> # My God, think thou upon Tobiah and Sanballat according to these their works, and on the prophetess Noadiah, and the rest of the prophets, that would have put me in fear.

Sanballat and Geshem <u>16_NEH_06_02</u># That Sanballat and Geshem sent unto me, saying, Come, let us meet together in [some one of] the villages in the plain of Ono. But they thought to do me mischief.

Sanballat and Tobiah <u>16_NEH_04_07</u># But it came to pass, [that] when Sanballat, and Tobiah, and the Arabians, and the Ammonites, and the Ashdodites, heard that the walls of Jerusalem were made up, [and] that the breaches began to be stopped, then they were very wroth,

Sanballat and Tobiah <u>16_NEH_06_01</u> # Now it came to pass, when Sanballat, and Tobiah, and Geshem the Arabian, and the rest of our enemies, heard that I had builded the wall, and [that] there was no breach left therein; [though at that time I had not set up the doors upon the gates;]

Sanballat had hired <u>16_NEH_06_12</u># And, lo, I perceived that God had not sent him; but that he pronounced this prophecy against me: for Tobiah and Sanballat had hired him.

Sanballat heard that <u>16_NEH_04_01</u> # But it came to pass, that when Sanballat heard that we builded the wall, he was wroth, and took great indignation, and mocked the Jews.

Sanballat his servant <u>16_NEH_06_05</u># Then sent Sanballat his servant unto me in like manner the fifth time with an open letter in his hand;

Sanballat the Horonite <u>16_NEH_02_10</u> # When Sanballat the Horonite, and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, heard [of it], it grieved them exceedingly that there was come a man to seek the welfare of the children of Israel.

Sanballat the Horonite <u>16_NEH_02_19</u> # But when Sanballat the Horonite, and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, and Geshem the Arabian, heard [it], they laughed us to scorn, and despised us, and said, What [is] this thing that ye do? will ye rebel against the king?

Sanballat the Horonite <u>16_NEH_13_28</u> # And [one] of the sons of Joiada, the son of Eliashib the high priest, [was] son in law to Sanballat the Horonite: therefore I chased him from me.
