

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

barn and God <u>42\_LUK\_12\_24</u> # Consider the ravens: for they neither sow nor reap; which neither have storehouse nor barn; and God feedeth them: how much more are ye better than the fowls?

barn yea as <u>37\_HAG\_02\_19</u> # Is the seed yet in the barn? yea, as yet the vine, and the fig tree, and the pomegranate, and the olive tree, hath not brought forth: from this day will I bless [you].

barn <u>18\_JOB\_39\_12</u> # Wilt thou believe him, that he will bring home thy seed, and gather [it into] thy barn?

barn <u>40 MAT\_13\_30</u># Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.

Barnabas also was 48\_GAL\_02\_13 # And the other Jews dissembled likewise with him; insomuch that Barnabas also was carried away with their dissimulation.

Barnabas and certain <u>44\_ACT\_15\_02</u># When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.

Barnabas and expelled <u>44\_ACT\_13\_50</u># But the Jews stirred up the devout and honourable women, and the chief men of the city, and raised persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them out of their coasts.

Barnabas and Paul <u>44\_ACT\_14\_14</u> # [Which] when the apostles, Barnabas and Paul, heard [of], they rent their clothes, and ran in among the people, crying out,

Barnabas and Paul <u>44\_ACT\_15\_12</u> # Then all the multitude kept silence, and gave audience to Barnabas and Paul, declaring what miracles and wonders God had wrought among the Gentiles by them.

Barnabas and Paul <u>44\_ACT\_15\_25</u> # It seemed good unto us, being assembled with one accord, to send chosen men unto you with our beloved Barnabas and Paul,

Barnabas and Saul <u>44\_ACT\_11\_30</u># Which also they did, and sent it to the elders by the hands of Barnabas and Saul.

Barnabas and Saul <u>44\_ACT\_12\_25</u> # And Barnabas and Saul returned from Jerusalem, when they had fulfilled [their] ministry, and took with them John, whose surname was Mark.

Barnabas and Saul <u>44\_ACT\_13\_02</u> # As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.

Barnabas and Saul <u>44\_ACT\_13\_07</u> # Which was with the deputy of the country, Sergius Paulus, a prudent man; who called for Barnabas and Saul, and desired to hear the word of God.

Barnabas and Simeon <u>44\_ACT\_13\_01</u> # Now there were in the church that was at Antioch certain prophets and teachers; as Barnabas, and Simeon that was called Niger, and Lucius of Cyrene, and Manaen, which had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul.

Barnabas and took <u>48\_GAL\_02\_01</u> # Then fourteen years after I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, and took Titus with [me] also.

Barnabas continued in 44\_ACT\_15\_35 # Paul also and Barnabas continued in Antioch, teaching and preaching the word of the Lord, with many others also.

Barnabas determined to 44\_ACT\_15\_37 # And Barnabas determined to take with them John, whose surname was Mark.

Barnabas had no <u>44\_ACT\_15\_02</u># When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.

Barnabas have not 46\_1CO\_09\_06 # Or I only and Barnabas, have not we power to forbear working?

Barnabas Jupiter and 44\_ACT\_14\_12 # And they called Barnabas, Jupiter; and Paul, Mercurius, because he was the chief speaker.

Barnabas Let us <u>44\_ACT\_15\_36</u># And some days after Paul said unto Barnabas, Let us go again and visit our brethren in every city where we have preached the word of the Lord, [and see] how they do.

Barnabas namely Judas <u>44\_ACT\_15\_22</u> # Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; [namely], Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

Barnabas that he <u>44\_ACT\_11\_22</u># Then tidings of these things came unto the ears of the church which was in Jerusalem: and they sent forth Barnabas, that he should go as far as Antioch.

Barnabas the right <u>48\_GAL\_02\_09</u># And when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we [should go] unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision.

Barnabas to Derbe <u>44\_ACT\_14\_20</u> # Howbeit, as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.

Barnabas to Tarsus 44\_ACT\_11\_25 # Then departed Barnabas to Tarsus, for to seek Saul:

Barnabas took him <u>44\_ACT\_09\_27</u> # But Barnabas took him, and brought [him] to the apostles, and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way, and that he had spoken to him, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus.

Barnabas took Mark <u>44\_ACT\_15\_39</u> # And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus;

Barnabas touching whom <u>51\_COL\_04\_10</u> # Aristarchus my fellowprisoner saluteth you, and Marcus, sister's son to Barnabas, [touching whom ye received commandments: if he come unto you, receive him;]

Barnabas waxed bold <u>44\_ACT\_13\_46</u># Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles.

Barnabas which is <u>44\_ACT\_04\_36</u> # And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas, [which is, being interpreted, The son of consolation,] a Levite, [and] of the country of Cyprus,

Barnabas who speaking 44\_ACT\_13\_43 # Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the grace of God.

barnfloor or out 12 2KI 06 27 # And he said, If the LORD do not help thee, whence shall I help thee? out of the barnfloor, or out of the winepress?

barns and build 42 LUK 12 18 # And he said, This will I do: I will pull down my barns, and build greater; and there will I bestow all my fruits and my goods.

barns are broken <u>29\_JOE\_01\_17</u># The seed is rotten under their clods, the garners are laid desolate, the barns are broken down; for the corn is withered.

barns be filled <u>20\_PRO\_03\_10</u># So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

barns yet your <u>40\_MAT\_06\_26</u># Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?

Kadeshbarnea and passed <u>06\_JOS\_15\_03</u># And it went out to the south side to Maalehacrabbim, and passed along to Zin, and ascended up on the south side unto Kadeshbarnea, and passed along to Hezron, and went up to Adar, and fetched a compass to Karkaa:

Kadeshbarnea and shall <u>04\_NUM\_34\_04</u># And your border shall turn from the south to the ascent of Akrabbim, and pass on to Zin: and the going forth thereof shall be from the south to Kadeshbarnea, and shall go on to Hazaraddar, and pass on to Azmon:

Kadeshbarnea saying Go <u>05 DEU 09 23 #</u> Likewise when the LORD sent you from Kadeshbarnea, saying, Go up and possess the land which I have given you; then ye rebelled against the commandment of the LORD your God, and ye believed him not, nor hearkened to his voice.

Kadeshbarnea to espy <u>06\_JOS\_14\_07</u> # Forty years old [was] I when Moses the servant of the LORD sent me from Kadeshbarnea to espy out the land; and I brought him word again as [it was] in mine heart.

Kadeshbarnea to see <u>04\_NUM\_32\_08</u> # Thus did your fathers, when I sent them from Kadeshbarnea to see the land.

Kadeshbarnea until we <u>05\_DEU\_02\_14</u># And the space in which we came from Kadeshbarnea, until we were come over the brook Zered, [was] thirty and eight years; until all the generation of the men of war were wasted out from among the host, as the LORD sware unto them.

Kadeshbarnea <u>05\_DEU\_01\_02</u># [[There are] eleven days' [journey] from Horeb by the way of mount Seir unto Kadeshbarnea.]

Kadeshbarnea <u>05\_DEU\_01\_19</u># And when we departed from Horeb, we went through all that great and terrible wilderness, which ye saw by the way of the mountain of the Amorites, as the LORD our God commanded us; and we came to Kadeshbarnea.

Kadeshbarnea <u>06\_JOS\_14\_06</u># Then the children of Judah came unto Joshua in Gilgal: and Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenezite said unto him, Thou knowest the thing that the LORD said unto Moses the man of God concerning me and thee in Kadeshbarnea.
