battle ax and 24\_JER\_51\_20 # Thou [art] my battle ax [and] weapons of war: for with thee will I break in pieces the nations, and with thee will I destroy kingdoms;

battle but they 13\_1CH\_12\_19 # And there fell [some] of Manasseh to David, when he came with the Philistines against Saul to battle: but they helped them not: for the lords of the Philistines upon advisement sent him away, saying, He will fall to his master Saul to [the jeopardy of] our heads.

battle by horses <u>28\_HOS\_01\_07</u> # But I will have mercy upon the house of Judah, and will save them by the LORD their God, and will not save them by bow, nor by sword, nor by battle, by horses, nor by horsemen.

battle do no 18\_JOB\_41\_08 # Lay thine hand upon him, remember the battle, do no more.

battle expert in 13\_1CH\_12\_33 # Of Zebulun, such as went forth to battle, expert in war, with all instruments of war, fifty thousand, which could keep rank: [they were] not of double heart.

battle expert in 13\_1CH\_12\_36 # And of Asher, such as went forth to battle, expert in war, forty thousand.

battle fell upon 14\_2CH\_25\_13 # But the soldiers of the army which Amaziah sent back, that they should not go with him to battle, fell upon the cities of Judah, from Samaria even unto Bethhoron, and smote three thousand of them, and took much spoil.

battle for God 13\_1CH\_14\_15 # And it shall be, when thou shalt hear a sound of going in the tops of the mulberry trees, [that] then thou shalt go out to battle: for God is gone forth before thee to smite the host of the Philistines.

But David tarried at Jerusalem. And Joab smote Rabbah, and destroyed it.

battle lest in <u>09\_1SA\_29\_04</u># And the princes of the Philistines were wroth with him; and the princes of the Philistines said unto him, Make this fellow return, that he may go again to his place which thou hast appointed him, and let him not go down with us to battle, lest in the battle he be an adversary to us: for wherewith should he reconcile himself unto his master? This [is] the ordinance of the law which the LORD commanded Moses;

battle thou and <u>09\_1SA\_28\_01</u> # And it came to pass in those days, that the Philistines gathered their armies together for warfare, to fight with Israel. And Achish said unto David, Know thou assuredly, that thou shalt go out with me to battle, thou and thy men.

battle thou hast 19 PSA 18 39 # For thou hast girded me with strength unto the battle: thou hast subdued under me those that rose up against me.

battle to destroy <u>06\_JOS\_22\_33</u> # And the thing pleased the children of Israel; and the children of Israel blessed God, and did not intend to go up against them in battle, to destroy the land wherein the children of Reuben and Gad dwelt.

battle where was <u>13\_1CH\_11\_13</u># He was with David at Pasdammim, and there the Philistines were gathered together to battle, where was a parcel of ground full of barley; and the people fled from before the Philistines.

battle with a <u>30\_AMO\_01\_14</u> # But I will kindle a fire in the wall of Rabbah, and it shall devour the palaces thereof, with shouting in the day of battle, with a tempest in the day of the whirlwind:

battle with a <u>27\_DAN\_11\_25</u># And he shall stir up his power and his courage against the king of the south with a great army; and the king of the south shall be stirred up to battle with a very great and mighty army; but he shall not stand: for they shall forecast devices against him.

Nebat who made 11\_1KI\_22\_52 # And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the way of his father, and in the way of his mother, and in the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin:

Nebat who made 12 2KI 10 29 # Howbeit [from] the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, Jehu departed not from after them, [to wit], the golden calves that [were] in Bethel, and that [were] in Dan.

Nebat who made 12\_2KI\_13\_11# And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD; he departed not from all the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel sin: [but] he walked therein.

Nebat who made 12 2KI 14 24 # And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD: he departed not from all the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin.

Nebat who made 12\_2KI\_23\_15 # Moreover the altar that [was] at Bethel, [and] the high place which Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin, had made, both that altar and the high place he brake down, and burned the high place, [and] stamped [it] small to powder, and burned the grove.

sabbath of the <u>14\_2CH\_23\_04</u> # This [is] the thing that ye shall do; A third part of you entering on the sabbath, of the priests and of the Levites, [shall be] porters of the doors;

sabbath of the <u>05\_DEU\_05\_14</u># But the seventh day [is] the sabbath of the LORD thy God: [in it] thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thine ox, nor thine ass, nor any of thy cattle, nor thy stranger that [is] within thy gates; that thy manservant and thy maidservant may rest as well as thou.

sabbath of the <u>02\_EXO\_20\_10</u># But the seventh day [is] the sabbath of the LORD thy God: [in it] thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that [is] within thy gates:

sabbath that we <u>30\_AMO\_08\_05</u> # Saying, When will the new moon be gone, that we may sell corn? and the sabbath, that we may set forth wheat, making the ephah small, and the shekel great, and falsifying the balances by deceit?

sabbath the priest <u>03 LEV\_23\_11</u># And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.

sabbath therefore for <u>02\_EXO\_31\_14</u> # Ye shall keep the sabbath therefore; for it [is] holy unto you: every one that defileth it shall surely be put to death: for whosoever doeth [any] work therein, that soul shall be cut off from among his people.

sabbath therefore he <u>02\_EXO\_16\_29</u> # See, for that the LORD hath given you the sabbath, therefore he giveth you on the sixth day the bread of two days; abide ye every man in his place, let no man go out of his place on the seventh day.

sabbath <u>43\_JOH\_05\_09</u> # And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath.

sabbaths for as <u>14\_2CH\_36\_21</u># To fulfil the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had enjoyed her sabbaths: [for] as long as she lay desolate she kept sabbath, to fulfil threescore and ten years.

sabbaths for their <u>26\_EZE\_20\_16</u># Because they despised my judgments, and walked not in my statutes, but polluted my sabbaths: for their heart went after their idols.

sabbaths I am <u>03 LEV 19 03 #</u> Ye shall fear every man his mother, and his father, and keep my sabbaths: I [am] the LORD your God.
