bear a burden 24\_JER\_17\_27 # But if ye will not hearken unto me to hallow the sabbath day, and not to bear a burden, even entering in at the gates of Jerusalem on the sabbath day; then will I kindle a fire in the gates thereof, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem, and it shall not be quenched.

bear a child <u>01\_GEN\_18\_13</u># And the LORD said unto Abraham, Wherefore did Sarah laugh, saying, Shall I of a surety bear a child, which am old?

bear a maid <u>03\_LEV\_12\_05</u># But if she bear a maid child, then she shall be unclean two weeks, as in her separation: and she shall continue in the blood of her purifying threescore and six days.

bear a son <u>01\_GEN\_16\_11</u># And the angel of the LORD said unto her, Behold, thou [art] with child, and shalt bear a son, and shalt call his name Ishmael; because the LORD hath heard thy affliction.

bear a son <u>23\_ISA\_07\_14</u> # Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

bear a son <u>07\_JUD\_13\_03</u># And the angel of the LORD appeared unto the woman, and said unto her, Behold now, thou [art] barren, and bearest not: but thou shalt conceive, and bear a son.

bear and his <u>66\_REV\_13\_02</u> # And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as [the feet] of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

bear and it 27\_DAN\_07\_05 # And behold another beast, a second, like to a bear, and it raised up itself on

one side, and [it had] three ribs in the mouth of it between the teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh.

bear And the 12\_2KI\_18\_14 # And Hezekiah king of Judah sent to the king of Assyria to Lachish, saying, I have offended; return from me: that which thou puttest on me will I bear. And the king of Assyria appointed unto Hezekiah king of Judah three hundred talents of silver and thirty talents of gold.

bear and this <u>09\_1SA\_17\_36</u># Thy servant slew both the lion and the bear: and this uncircumcised Philistine shall be as one of them, seeing he hath defied the armies of the living God.

bear and took <u>09\_1SA\_17\_34</u> # And David said unto Saul, Thy servant kept his father's sheep, and there came a lion, and a bear, and took a lamb out of the flock:

bear any grudge <u>03\_LEV\_19\_18</u> # Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I [am] the LORD.

bear because of 24\_JER\_44\_22 # So that the LORD could no longer bear, because of the evil of your doings, [and] because of the abominations which ye have committed; therefore is your land a desolation, and an astonishment, and a curse, without an inhabitant, as at this day.

bear before the <u>06\_JOS\_06\_04</u> # And seven priests shall bear before the ark seven trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets.

bear break forth <u>23\_ISA\_54\_01</u> # Sing, O barren, thou [that] didst not bear; break forth into singing, and cry aloud, thou [that] didst not travail with child: for more [are] the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, saith the LORD.

bear buckler and <u>13\_1CH\_05\_18</u># The sons of Reuben, and the Gadites, and half the tribe of Manasseh, of valiant men, men able to bear buckler and sword, and to shoot with bow, and skilful in war, [were] four and forty thousand seven hundred and threescore, that went out to the war.

bear burdens and 14\_2CH\_02\_02 # And Solomon told out threescore and ten thousand men to bear burdens, and fourscore thousand to hew in the mountain, and three thousand and six hundred to oversee them.

bear children guide <u>54\_1TI\_05\_14</u># I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.

bear even I <u>23\_ISA\_46\_04</u># And [even] to [your] old age I [am] he; and [even] to hoar hairs will I carry [you]: I have made, and I will bear; even I will carry, and will deliver [you].

bear false witness 05\_DEU\_05\_20 # Neither shalt thou bear false witness against thy neighbour.

bear false witness 02\_EXO\_20\_16 # Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

bear false witness 42\_LUK\_18\_20 # Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother.

bear false witness 41\_MAR\_10\_19 # Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother.

bear false witness 40\_MAT\_19\_18# He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness,

bear false witness 45\_ROM\_13\_09 # For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou

shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if [there be] any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

bear for she <u>05\_DEU\_28\_57</u># And toward her young one that cometh out from between her feet, and toward her children which she shall bear: for she shall eat them for want of all [things] secretly in the siege and straitness, wherewith thine enemy shall distress thee in thy gates.

bear fruit and 26 EZE 17 23 # In the mountain of the height of Israel will I plant it: and it shall bring forth boughs, and bear fruit, and be a goodly cedar: and under it shall dwell all fowl of every wing; in the shadow of the branches thereof shall they dwell.

bear fruit of 43\_JOH\_15\_04 # Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

bear fruit that <u>26\_EZE\_17\_08</u># It was planted in a good soil by great waters, that it might bring forth branches, and that it might bear fruit, that it might be a goodly vine.

bear fruit upward 12 2KI 19 30 # And the remnant that is escaped of the house of Judah shall yet again take root downward, and bear fruit upward.

bear fruit upward 23 ISA 37 31 # And the remnant that is escaped of the house of Judah shall again take root downward, and bear fruit upward:

bear fruit well 42\_LUK\_13\_09 # And if it bear fruit, [well]: and if not, [then] after that thou shalt cut it down.

bear he shall <u>40\_MAT\_03\_11</u># I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and [with] fire:

bear he will <u>09\_1SA\_17\_37</u># David said moreover, The LORD that delivered me out of the paw of the lion, and out of the paw of the bear, he will deliver me out of the hand of this Philistine. And Saul said unto David, Go, and the LORD be with thee.

bear her iniquity <u>04\_NUM\_05\_31</u># Then shall the man be guiltless from iniquity, and this woman shall bear her iniquity.

bear her iniquity <u>04\_NUM\_30\_15</u> # But if he shall any ways make them void after that he hath heard [them]; then he shall bear her iniquity.

bear him record 51\_COL\_04\_13 # For I bear him record, that he hath a great zeal for you, and them [that are] in Laodicea and them in Hierapolis.

bear him upon 23 ISA 46 07 # They bear him upon the shoulder, they carry him, and set him in his place, and he standeth; from his place shall he not remove: yea, [one] shall cry unto him, yet can he not answer, nor save him out of his trouble.

bear his cross <u>42\_LUK\_14\_27</u> # And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.

bear his cross <u>41\_MAR\_15\_21</u> # And they compel one Simon a Cyrenian, who passed by, coming out of the country, the father of Alexander and Rufus, to bear his cross.

bear his cross 40\_MAT\_27\_32 # And as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name: him they compelled to bear his cross.

bear his iniquity <u>03\_LEV\_05\_01</u> # And if a soul sin, and hear the voice of swearing, and [is] a witness, whether he hath seen or known [of it]; if he do not utter [it], then he shall bear his iniquity.

bear his iniquity <u>03\_LEV\_05\_17</u> # And if a soul sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments of the LORD; though he wist [it] not, yet is he guilty, and shall bear his iniquity.

bear his iniquity <u>03\_LEV\_07\_18</u># And if [any] of the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offerings be eaten at all on the third day, it shall not be accepted, neither shall it be imputed unto him that offereth it: it shall be an abomination, and the soul that eateth of it shall bear his iniquity.

bear his iniquity <u>03\_LEV\_17\_16</u># But if he wash [them] not, nor bathe his flesh; then he shall bear his iniquity.

bear his iniquity <u>03\_LEV\_19\_08</u> # Therefore [every one] that eateth it shall bear his iniquity, because he hath profaned the hallowed thing of the LORD: and that soul shall be cut off from among his people.

bear his iniquity <u>03\_LEV\_20\_17</u> # And if a man shall take his sister, his father's daughter, or his mother's daughter, and see her nakedness, and she see his nakedness; it [is] a wicked thing; and they shall be cut off in the sight of their people: he hath uncovered his sister's nakedness; he shall bear his iniquity.

bear his judgment <u>48 GAL\_05\_10</u># I have confidence in you through the Lord, that ye will be none otherwise minded: but he that troubleth you shall bear his judgment, whosoever he be.

bear his own 48\_GAL\_06\_05\_# For every man shall bear his own burden.

bear his sin <u>03\_LEV\_24\_15</u> # And thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel, saying, Whosoever curseth his God shall bear his sin.

bear his sin <u>04\_NUM\_09\_13</u> # But the man that [is] clean, and is not in a journey, and forbeareth to keep the passover, even the same soul shall be cut off from among his people: because he brought not the offering of the LORD in his appointed season, that man shall bear his sin.

bear his son <u>05\_DEU\_01\_31</u> # And in the wilderness, where thou hast seen how that the LORD thy God bare thee, as a man doth bear his son, in all the way that ye went, until ye came into this place.

bear holy flesh <u>37\_HAG\_02\_12</u># If one bear holy flesh in the skirt of his garment, and with his skirt do touch bread, or pottage, or wine, or oil, or any meat, shall it be holy? And the priests answered and said, No.

bear in my <u>48\_GAL\_06\_17</u> # From henceforth let no man trouble me: for I bear in my body the marks of the Lord Jesus.

bear in my 19\_PSA\_89\_50 # Remember, Lord, the reproach of thy servants; [how] I do bear in my bosom [the reproach of] all the mighty people;

bear it after <u>42\_LUK\_23\_26</u># And as they led him away, they laid hold upon one Simon, a Cyrenian, coming out of the country, and on him they laid the cross, that he might bear [it] after Jesus.

bear it but <u>04\_NUM\_04\_15</u># And when Aaron and his sons have made an end of covering the sanctuary, as the camp is to set forward; after that, the sons of Kohath shall come to bear [it]: but they shall not touch [any] holy thing, lest they die. These [things are] the burden of the sons of Kohath in the tabernacle of the congregation.

bear it neither 46\_1CO\_03\_02 # I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able [to bear it], neither yet now are ye able.

bear it not <u>04\_NUM\_11\_17</u># And I will come down and talk with thee there: and I will take of the spirit which [is] upon thee, and will put [it] upon them; and they shall bear the burden of the people with thee, that thou bear [it] not thyself alone.

bear it upon 26\_EZE\_12\_06 # In their sight shalt thou bear [it] upon [thy] shoulders, [and] carry [it] forth in the twilight: thou shalt cover thy face, that thou see not the ground: for I have set thee [for] a sign unto the house of Israel.

bear it withal <u>02\_EXO\_30\_04</u> # And two golden rings shalt thou make to it under the crown of it, by the two corners thereof, upon the two sides of it shalt thou make [it]; and they shall be for places for the staves to bear it withal.

bear it withal <u>02\_EXO\_37\_27</u># And he made two rings of gold for it under the crown thereof, by the two corners of it, upon the two sides thereof, to be places for the staves to bear it withal.

bear it withal <u>02\_EXO\_38\_07</u> # And he put the staves into the rings on the sides of the altar, to bear it withal; he made the altar hollow with boards.

bear it <u>46\_1CO\_10\_13</u># There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God [is] faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear [it].

bear it <u>02\_EXO\_27\_07</u># And the staves shall be put into the rings, and the staves shall be upon the two sides of the altar, to bear it.

bear it <u>24\_JER\_10\_19</u> # Woe is me for my hurt! my wound is grievous: but I said, Truly this [is] a grief, and I must bear it.

bear it <u>20\_PRO\_09\_12</u># If thou be wise, thou shalt be wise for thyself: but [if] thou scornest, thou alone shalt bear [it].

bear long with <u>42\_LUK\_18\_07</u> # And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?

bear lying in 25\_LAM\_03\_10 # He [was] unto me [as] a bear lying in wait, [and as] a lion in secret places.

bear me witness <u>44\_ACT\_22\_05</u># As also the high priest doth bear me witness, and all the estate of the elders: from whom also I received letters unto the brethren, and went to Damascus, to bring them which were there bound unto Jerusalem, for to be punished.

bear me witness 43\_JOH\_03\_28 # Ye yourselves bear me witness, that I said, I am not the Christ, but that I am sent before him.

bear met him <u>30\_AMO\_05\_19</u> # As if a man did flee from a lion, and a bear met him; or went into the house, and leaned his hand on the wall, and a serpent bit him.

bear much fruit <u>43\_JOH\_15\_08</u># Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.

bear my name <u>44\_ACT\_09\_15</u> # But the Lord said unto him, Go thy way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel:

bear no burden 24\_JER\_17\_21 # Thus saith the LORD; Take heed to yourselves, and bear no burden on the sabbath day, nor bring [it] in by the gates of Jerusalem;

bear no fruit <u>28\_HOS\_09\_16</u> # Ephraim is smitten, their root is dried up, they shall bear no fruit: yea, though they bring forth, yet will I slay [even] the beloved [fruit] of their womb.

bear no sin <u>04\_NUM\_18\_32</u> # And ye shall bear no sin by reason of it, when ye have heaved from it the best of it: neither shall ye pollute the holy things of the children of Israel, lest ye die.

bear no tidings 10\_2SA\_18\_20 # And Joab said unto him, Thou shalt not bear tidings this day, but thou shalt bear tidings another day: but this day thou shalt bear no tidings, because the king's son is dead.

bear not iniquity <u>02\_EXO\_28\_43</u> # And they shall be upon Aaron, and upon his sons, when they come in unto the tabernacle of the congregation, or when they come near unto the altar to minister in the holy [place]; that they bear not iniquity, and die: [it shall be] a statute for ever unto him and his seed after him.

bear olive berries <u>59\_JAM\_03\_12</u> # Can the fig tree, my brethren, bear olive berries? either a vine, figs? so [can] no fountain both yield salt water and fresh.

bear record and <u>64\_3JO\_01\_12</u> # Demetrius hath good report of all [men], and of the truth itself: yea, and we [also] bear record; and ye know that our record is true.

bear record in <u>62\_1JO\_05\_07</u> # For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

bear record of <u>43\_JOH\_08\_14</u> # Jesus answered and said unto them, Though I bear record of myself, [yet] my record is true: for I know whence I came, and whither I go; but ye cannot tell whence I come, and whither I go.

bear record yea <u>47\_2CO\_08\_03</u># For to [their] power, I bear record, yea, and beyond [their] power [they were] willing of themselves;

bear robbed of <u>10\_2SA\_17\_08</u># For, said Hushai, thou knowest thy father and his men, that they [be] mighty men, and they [be] chafed in their minds, as a bear robbed of her whelps in the field: and thy father [is] a man of war, and will not lodge with the people.

bear robbed of <u>20\_PRO\_17\_12</u> # Let a bear robbed of her whelps meet a man, rather than a fool in his folly.

bear rule but 20\_PRO\_12\_24 # The hand of the diligent shall bear rule: but the slothful shall be under tribute.

bear rule by <u>24\_JER\_05\_31</u> # The prophets prophesy falsely, and the priests bear rule by their means; and my people love [to have it] so: and what will ye do in the end thereof?

bear rule in <u>17\_EST\_01\_22</u># For he sent letters into all the king's provinces, into every province according to the writing thereof, and to every people after their language, that every man should bear rule in his own house, and that [it] should be published according to the language of every people.

bear rule over <u>27\_DAN\_02\_39</u> # And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee, and another third kingdom of brass, which shall bear rule over all the earth.

bear seven trumpets <u>06\_JOS\_06\_06</u> # And Joshua the son of Nun called the priests, and said unto them, Take up the ark of the covenant, and let seven priests bear seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD.

bear shall feed <u>23\_ISA\_11\_07</u># And the cow and the bear shall feed; their young ones shall lie down together: and the lion shall eat straw like the ox.

bear silver are <u>36\_ZEP\_01\_11</u># Howl, ye inhabitants of Maktesh, for all the merchant people are cut down; all they that bear silver are cut off.

bear sin and <u>04\_NUM\_18\_22</u># Neither must the children of Israel henceforth come nigh the tabernacle of the congregation, lest they bear sin, and die.

bear sin for <u>03\_LEV\_22\_09</u> # They shall therefore keep mine ordinance, lest they bear sin for it, and die therefore, if they profane it: I the LORD do sanctify them.

bear so is <u>20\_PRO\_28\_15</u> # [As] a roaring lion, and a ranging bear; [so is] a wicked ruler over the poor people.

bear sons and <u>24 JER\_29\_06</u># Take ye wives, and beget sons and daughters; and take wives for your sons, and give your daughters to husbands, that they may bear sons and daughters; that ye may be increased there, and not diminished.

bear sons <u>08\_RUT\_01\_12</u> # Turn again, my daughters, go [your way]; for I am too old to have an husband. If I should say, I have hope, [if] I should have an husband also to night, and should also bear sons;

bear that is <u>28\_HOS\_13\_08</u> # I will meet them as a bear [that is] bereaved [of her whelps], and will rend the caul of their heart, and there will I devour them like a lion: the wild beast shall tear them.

bear the ark <u>05\_DEU\_10\_08</u># At that time the LORD separated the tribe of Levi, to bear the ark of the covenant of the LORD, to stand before the LORD to minister unto him, and to bless in his name, unto this day.

bear the ark 02\_EXO\_37\_05 # And he put the staves into the rings by the sides of the ark, to bear the ark.

bear the ark <u>06\_JOS\_03\_08</u> # And thou shalt command the priests that bear the ark of the covenant, saying, When ye are come to the brink of the water of Jordan, ye shall stand still in Jordan.

bear the ark <u>06\_JOS\_03\_13</u># And it shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests that bear the ark of the LORD, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of Jordan, [that] the waters of Jordan shall be cut off [from] the waters that come down from above; and they shall stand upon an heap.

bear the blame <u>01\_GEN\_43\_09</u> # I will be surety for him; of my hand shalt thou require him: if I bring him not unto thee, and set him before thee, then let me bear the blame for ever:

by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth.

beareth witness of <u>43\_JOH\_05\_32</u> # There is another that beareth witness of me; and I know that the witness which he witnesseth of me is true.

beareth witness of 43\_JOH\_08\_18 # I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me.

beareth witness to <u>18\_JOB\_16\_08</u> # And thou hast filled me with wrinkles, [which] is a witness [against me]: and my leanness rising up in me beareth witness to my face.
