beat at the <u>07_JUD_19_22</u> # [Now] as they were making their hearts merry, behold, the men of the city, certain sons of Belial, beset the house round about, [and] beat at the door, and spake to the master of the house, the old man, saying, Bring forth the man that came into thine house, that we may know him.

beat down and <u>12_2KI_23_12</u> # And the altars that [were] on the top of the upper chamber of Ahaz, which the kings of Judah had made, and the altars which Manasseh had made in the two courts of the house of the LORD, did the king beat down, and brake [them] down from thence, and cast the dust of them into the brook Kidron.

beat down his <u>19_PSA_89_23</u> # And I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague them that hate him.

beat down the <u>12_2KI_03_25</u> # And they beat down the cities, and on every good piece of land cast every man his stone, and filled it; and they stopped all the wells of water, and felled all the good trees: only in Kirharaseth left they the stones thereof; howbeit the slingers went about [it], and smote it.

beat in every <u>44_ACT_22_19</u># And I said, Lord, they know that I imprisoned and beat in every synagogue them that believed on thee:

beat them as <u>10_2SA_22_43</u># Then did I beat them as small as the dust of the earth, I did stamp them as the mire of the street, [and] did spread them abroad.

beaten and demanded <u>02_EXO_05_14</u> # And the officers of the children of Israel, which Pharaoh's taskmasters had set over them, were beaten, [and] demanded, Wherefore have ye not fulfilled your task in making brick both yesterday and to day, as heretofore?

beaten and the <u>10_2SA_02_17</u> # And there was a very sore battle that day; and Abner was beaten, and the men of Israel, before the servants of David.

beaten oil <u>04_NUM_28_05</u># And a tenth [part] of an ephah of flour for a meat offering, mingled with the fourth [part] of an hin of beaten oil.

beaten out of <u>02_EXO_37_07</u> # And he made two cherubims [of] gold, beaten out of one piece made he them, on the two ends of the mercy seat;

beaten out of <u>03_LEV_02_14</u># And if thou offer a meat offering of thy firstfruits unto the LORD, thou shalt offer for the meat offering of thy firstfruits green ears of corn dried by the fire, [even] corn beaten out of full ears.

beaten out with <u>23_ISA_28_27</u> # For the fitches are not threshed with a threshing instrument, neither is a cart wheel turned about upon the cummin; but the fitches are beaten out with a staff, and the cummin with a rod.

beaten work made <u>02_EXO_37_17</u># And he made the candlestick [of] pure gold: [of] beaten work made he the candlestick; his shaft, and his branch, his bowls, his knops, and his flowers, were of the same:

beateth the air <u>46_1CO_09_26</u> # I therefore so run, not as uncertainly; so fight I, not as one that beateth the air:

beating down one <u>09_1SA_14_16</u># And the watchmen of Saul in Gibeah of Benjamin looked; and, behold, the multitude melted away, and they went on beating down [one another].

beating of Paul <u>44_ACT_21_32</u> # Who immediately took soldiers and centurions, and ran down unto them: and when they saw the chief captain and the soldiers, they left beating of Paul.

beating some and <u>41_MAR_12_05</u> # And again he sent another; and him they killed, and many others; beating some, and killing some.

Gibeath and Kirjath <u>06_JOS_18_28</u># And Zelah, Eleph, and Jebusi, which [is] Jerusalem, Gibeath, [and] Kirjath; fourteen cities with their villages. This [is] the inheritance of the children of Benjamin according to their families.
