began Abijah to 14_2CH_13_01 # Now in the eighteenth year of king Jeroboam began Abijah to reign over Judah.

began again to 41_MAR_04_01 # And he began again to teach by the sea side: and there was gathered unto him a great multitude, so that he entered into a ship, and sat in the sea; and the whole multitude was by the sea on the land.

began Ahab the <u>11_1KI_16_29</u># And in the thirty and eighth year of Asa king of Judah began Ahab the son of Omri to reign over Israel: and Ahab the son of Omri reigned over Israel in Samaria twenty and two years.

began Ahaziah to 12_2KI_09_29 # And in the eleventh year of Joram the son of Ahab began Ahaziah to reign over Judah.

began also with <u>14_2CH_29_27</u> # And Hezekiah commanded to offer the burnt offering upon the altar. And when the burnt offering began, the song of the LORD began [also] with the trumpets, and with the instruments [ordained] by David king of Israel.

began as they <u>41_MAR_02_23</u># And it came to pass, that he went through the corn fields on the sabbath day; and his disciples began, as they went, to pluck the ears of corn.

began at the 44_ACT_08_35 # Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus.

began at the <u>26_EZE_09_06</u># Slay utterly old [and] young, both maids, and little children, and women: but come not near any man upon whom [is] the mark; and begin at my sanctuary. Then they began at the ancient men which [were] before the house.

began at the <u>01_GEN_44_12</u> # And he searched, [and] began at the eldest, and left at the youngest: and the cup was found in Benjamin's sack.

began Azariah son <u>12_2KI_15_01</u># In the twenty and seventh year of Jeroboam king of Israel began Azariah son of Amaziah king of Judah to reign.

began Baasha the 11_1KI_15_33# In the third year of Asa king of Judah began Baasha the son of Ahijah to reign over all Israel in Tirzah, twenty and four years.

began both to <u>44_ACT_01_01</u># The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach,

began Elah the 11_1KI_16_08# In the twenty and sixth year of Asa king of Judah began Elah the son of Baasha to reign over Israel in Tirzah, two years.

began every one 40_MAT_26_22# And they were exceeding sorrowful, and began every one of them to say unto him, Lord, is it I?

began from Galilee <u>44_ACT_10_37</u># That word, [I say], ye know, which was published throughout all Judaea, and began from Galilee, after the baptism which John preached;

began he to <u>15_EZR_07_09</u># For upon the first [day] of the first month began he to go up from Babylon, and on the first [day] of the fifth month came he to Jerusalem, according to the good hand of his God upon him.

began he to 42_LUK_20_09 # Then began he to speak to the people this parable; A certain man planted a vineyard, and let it forth to husbandmen, and went into a far country for a long time.

began he to 40_MAT_11_20# Then began he to upbraid the cities wherein most of his mighty works were done, because they repented not:

began he to 40_MAT_26_74 # Then began he to curse and to swear, [saying], I know not the man. And immediately the cock crew.

began Hoshea the 12_2KI_17_01 # In the twelfth year of Ahaz king of Judah began Hoshea the son of Elah to reign in Samaria over Israel nine years.

began in the 14_2CH_31_21 # And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, and in the law, and in the commandments, to seek his God, he did [it] with all his heart, and prospered.

began Jehoash the 12_2KI_13_10 # In the thirty and seventh year of Joash king of Judah began Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] sixteen years.

began Jesus to 40_MAT_16_21# From that time forth began Jesus to show unto his disciples, how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day.

began Jotham the 12_2KI_15_32 # In the second year of Pekah the son of Remaliah king of Israel began Jotham the son of Uzziah king of Judah to reign.

began men to <u>01_GEN_04_26</u> # And to Seth, to him also there was born a son; and he called his name Enos: then began men to call upon the name of the LORD.

began Menahem the 12_2KI_15_17# In the nine and thirtieth year of Azariah king of Judah began Menahem the son of Gadi to reign over Israel, [and reigned] ten years in Samaria.

began Moses to <u>05_DEU_01_05</u> # On this side Jordan, in the land of Moab, began Moses to declare this law, saying,

began Omri to 11_1KI_16_23# In the thirty and first year of Asa king of Judah began Omri to reign over Israel, twelve years: six years reigned he in Tirzah.

began on the <u>14_2CH_29_17</u> # Now they began on the first [day] of the first month to sanctify, and on the eighth day of the month came they to the porch of the LORD: so they sanctified the house of the LORD in eight days; and in the sixteenth day of the first month they made an end.

began the song 14_2CH_29_27 # And Hezekiah commanded to offer the burnt offering upon the altar. And when the burnt offering began, the song of the LORD began [also] with the trumpets, and with the instruments [ordained] by David king of Israel.

began to arise <u>07_JUD_20_40</u> # But when the flame began to arise up out of the city with a pillar of smoke, the Benjamites looked behind them, and, behold, the flame of the city ascended up to heaven.

began to be 13_1CH_01_10 # And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be mighty upon the earth.

began to be 01_GEN_09_20 # And Noah began [to be] an husbandman, and he planted a vineyard:

began to be <u>01_GEN_10_08</u># And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be a mighty one in the earth.

began to be <u>58_HEB_02_03</u># How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard [him];

began to be <u>42_LUK_03_23</u> # And Jesus himself began to be about thirty years of age, being [as was supposed] the son of Joseph, which was [the son] of Heli,

began to be 42_LUK_15_14 # And when he had spent all, there arose a mighty famine in that land; and he began to be in want.

began to be 42_LUK_15_24 # For this my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost, and is found. And they began to be merry.

began to be 41_MAR_10_41 # And when the ten heard [it], they began to be much displeased with James and John.

began to be <u>41_MAR_14_19</u> # And they began to be sorrowful, and to say unto him one by one, [Is] it I? and another [said, Is] it I?

began to be <u>41_MAR_14_33</u> # And he taketh with him Peter and James and John, and began to be sore amazed, and to be very heavy;

began to be <u>40_MAT_26_37</u># And he took with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be sorrowful and very heavy.

began to be <u>16_NEH_04_07</u> # But it came to pass, [that] when Sanballat, and Tobiah, and the Arabians, and the Ammonites, and the Ashdodites, heard that the walls of Jerusalem were made up, [and] that the breaches began to be stopped, then they were very wroth,

began to be 16_NEH_13_19 # And it came to pass, that when the gates of Jerusalem began to be dark before the sabbath, I commanded that the gates should be shut, and charged that they should not be opened till after the sabbath: and [some] of my servants set I at the gates, [that] there should no burden be brought in on the sabbath day.

began to cast 41_MAR_11_15# And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves;

began to come <u>01_GEN_41_54</u># And the seven years of dearth began to come, according as Joseph had said: and the dearth was in all lands; but in all the land of Egypt there was bread.

began to commit <u>04_NUM_25_01</u> # And Israel abode in Shittim, and the people began to commit whoredom with the daughters of Moab.

began to cry 41_MAR_10_47 # And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, [thou] son of David, have mercy on me.

began to curse <u>41_MAR_14_71</u> # But he began to curse and to swear, [saying], I know not this man of whom ye speak.

began to cut 12_2KI_10_32 # In those days the LORD began to cut Israel short: and Hazael smote them in all the coasts of Israel;

began to dawn 40_MAT_28_01# In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first [day] of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.

began to desire 41_MAR_15_08 # And the multitude crying aloud began to desire [him to do] as he had ever done unto them.

began to eat <u>44_ACT_27_35</u># And when he had thus spoken, he took bread, and gave thanks to God in presence of them all: and when he had broken [it], he began to eat.

began to enter 32_JON_03_04 # And Jonah began to enter into the city a day's journey, and he cried, and

said, Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown.

began to grow 07_JUD_16_22 # Howbeit the hair of his head began to grow again after he was shaven.

began to inquire 42_LUK_22_23 # And they began to inquire among themselves, which of them it was that should do this thing.

began to lay 14_2CH_31_07 # In the third month they began to lay the foundation of the heaps, and finished [them] in the seventh month.

began to make <u>42_LUK_14_18</u># And they all with one [consent] began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused.

began to move <u>07_JUD_13_25</u># And the spirit of the LORD began to move him at times in the camp of Dan between Zorah and Eshtaol.

began to multiply <u>01_GEN_06_01</u> # And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them,

began to number 13 1CH 27 24 # Joab the son of Zeruiah began to number, but he finished not, because there fell wrath for it against Israel; neither was the number put in the account of the chronicles of king David.

began to pluck 40_MAT_12_01# At that time Jesus went on the sabbath day through the corn; and his disciples were an hungred, and began to pluck the ears of corn, and to eat.

began to pray 41_MAR_05_17 # And they began to pray him to depart out of their coasts.

began to preach <u>40_MAT_04_17</u># From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

began to publish 41 MAR 01 45 # But he went out, and began to publish [it] much, and to blaze abroad the matter, insomuch that Jesus could no more openly enter into the city, but was without in desert places: and they came to him from every quarter.

began to publish 41_MAR_05_20 # And he departed, and began to publish in Decapolis how great things Jesus had done for him: and all [men] did marvel.

began to reign <u>11_1KI_15_25</u># And Nadab the son of Jeroboam began to reign over Israel in the second year of Asa king of Judah, and reigned over Israel two years.

began to reign <u>11_1KI_16_11</u># And it came to pass, when he began to reign, as soon as he sat on his throne, [that] he slew all the house of Baasha: he left him not one that pisseth against a wall, neither of his kinsfolks, nor of his friends.

And his mother's name [was] Naamah an Ammonitess.

began to reign 14_2CH_20_31 # And Jehoshaphat reigned over Judah: [he was] thirty and five years old when he began to reign, and he reigned twenty and five years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Azubah the daughter of Shilhi.

began to reign 14_2CH_21_05 # Jehoram [was] thirty and two years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eight years in Jerusalem.

began to reign 14_2CH_21_20 # Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem eight years, and departed without being desired. Howbeit they buried him in the city of David, but not in the sepulchres of the kings.

began to reign 14_2CH_22_02 # Forty and two years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Athaliah the daughter of Omri.

began to reign <u>14_2CH_24_01</u> # Joash [was] seven years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Zibiah of Beersheba.

began to reign 14_2CH_25_01 # Amaziah [was] twenty and five years old [when] he began to reign, and he reigned twenty and nine years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jehoaddan of Jerusalem.

began to reign 14_2CH_26_03 # Sixteen years old [was] Uzziah when he began to reign, and he reigned fifty and two years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Jecoliah of Jerusalem.

began to reign 14_2CH_27_01 # Jotham [was] twenty and five years old when he began to reign, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Jerushah, the daughter of Zadok.

began to reign <u>14_2CH_27_08</u># He was five and twenty years old when he began to reign, and reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem.

began to reign 14_2CH_28_01 # Ahaz [was] twenty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned

sixteen years in Jerusalem: but he did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, like David his father:

began to reign 14_2CH_29_01 # Hezekiah began to reign [when he was] five and twenty years old, and he reigned nine and twenty years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Abijah, the daughter of Zechariah.

began to reign <u>14_2CH_33_01</u> # Manasseh [was] twelve years old when he began to reign, and he reigned fifty and five years in Jerusalem:

began to reign 14_2CH_33_21 # Amon [was] two and twenty years old when he began to reign, and reigned two years in Jerusalem.

began to reign <u>14_2CH_34_01</u> # Josiah [was] eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem one and thirty years.

began to reign <u>14_2CH_36_02</u> # Jehoahaz [was] twenty and three years old when he began to reign, and he reigned three months in Jerusalem.

began to reign 14_2CH_36_05 # Jehoiakim [was] twenty and five years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem: and he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD his God.

began to reign <u>14_2CH_36_09</u> # Jehoiachin [was] eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned three months and ten days in Jerusalem: and he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD.

began to reign <u>14_2CH_36_11</u> # Zedekiah [was] one and twenty years old when he began to reign, and reigned eleven years in Jerusalem.

began to reign 12_2KI_03_01 # Now Jehoram the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the eighteenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned twelve years.

began to reign <u>12_2KI_08_16</u> # And in the fifth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel, Jehoshaphat [being] then king of Judah, Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah began to reign.

began to reign <u>12_2KI_08_17</u> # Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign; and he reigned eight years in Jerusalem.

began to reign 12_2KI_08_26 # Two and twenty years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign; and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Athaliah, the daughter of Omri king of Israel.

began to reign 12_2KI_11_21 # Seven years old [was] Jehoash when he began to reign.

began to reign 12_2KI_12_01 # In the seventh year of Jehu Jehoash began to reign; and forty years reigned he in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Zibiah of Beersheba.

began to reign 12_2KI_13_01# In the three and twentieth year of Joash the son of Ahaziah king of Judah Jehoahaz the son of Jehu began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] seventeen years.

began to reign 12_2KI_14_02 # He was twenty and five years old when he began to reign, and reigned twenty and nine years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jehoaddan of Jerusalem.

began to reign 12_2KI_14_23 # In the fifteenth year of Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah Jeroboam the son of Joash king of Israel began to reign in Samaria, [and reigned] forty and one years.

began to reign 12_2KI_15_33 # Five and twenty years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jerusha, the daughter of Zadok.

began to reign 12_2KI_16_01# In the seventeenth year of Pekah the son of Remaliah Ahaz the son of Jotham king of Judah began to reign.

began to reign 12_2KI_16_02 # Twenty years old [was] Ahaz when he began to reign, and reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem, and did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD his God, like David his father.

began to reign 12_2KI_18_01 # Now it came to pass in the third year of Hoshea son of Elah king of Israel, [that] Hezekiah the son of Ahaz king of Judah began to reign.

began to reign 12_2KI_21_19 # Amon [was] twenty and two years old when he began to reign, and he reigned two years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Meshullemeth, the daughter of Haruz of Jotbah.

began to reign 12_2KI_22_01 # Josiah [was] eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned thirty and one years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jedidah, the daughter of Adaiah of Boscath.

began to reign 12 2KI 23 31 # Jehoahaz [was] twenty and three years old when he began to reign; and he reigned three months in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Hamutal, the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah.

began to reign 12_2KI_23_36 # Jehoiakim [was] twenty and five years old when he began to reign; and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Zebudah, the daughter of Pedaiah of Rumah.

began to reign 12_2KI_25_27 # And it came to pass in the seven and thirtieth year of the captivity of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, on the seven and twentieth [day] of the month, [that] Evilmerodach king of Babylon in the year that he began to reign did lift up the head of Jehoiachin king of

Judah out of prison;

began to reign <u>10_2SA_02_10</u> # Ishbosheth Saul's son [was] forty years old when he began to reign over Israel, and reigned two years. But the house of Judah followed David.

began to reign <u>10_2SA_05_04</u> # David [was] thirty years old when he began to reign, [and] he reigned forty years.

began to reign 24_JER_52_01 # Zedekiah [was] one and twenty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Hamutal the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah.

began to rejoice 42 LUK 19 37 # And when he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen;

began to salute 41_MAR_15_18 # And began to salute him, Hail, King of the Jews!

began to say 42_LUK_04_21# And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.

began to say <u>42_LUK_07_49</u> # And they that sat at meat with him began to say within themselves, Who is this that forgiveth sins also?

began to seek 14_2CH_34_03 # For in the eighth year of his reign, while he was yet young, he began to seek after the God of David his father: and in the twelfth year he began to purge Judah and Jerusalem from the high places, and the groves, and the carved images, and the molten images.

began to send 12_2KI_15_37 # In those days the LORD began to send against Judah Rezin the king of Syria, and Pekah the son of Remaliah.

began to send <u>41_MAR_06_07</u> # And he called [unto him] the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and gave them power over unclean spirits;

began to sing 14_2CH_20_22 # And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were

smitten.

began to sink <u>42_LUK_05_07</u># And they beckoned unto [their] partners, which were in the other ship, that they should come and help them. And they came, and filled both the ships, so that they began to sink.

began to smite <u>07_JUD_20_31</u># And the children of Benjamin went out against the people, [and] were drawn away from the city; and they began to smite of the people, [and] kill, as at other times, in the highways, of which one goeth up to the house of God, and the other to Gibeah in the field, about thirty men of Israel.

began to smite <u>07_JUD_20_39</u> # And when the men of Israel retired in the battle, Benjamin began to smite [and] kill of the men of Israel about thirty persons: for they said, Surely they are smitten down before us, as [in] the first battle.

began to speak 44_ACT_02_04 # And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

began to speak <u>44_ACT_11_15</u># And as I began to speak, the Holy Ghost fell on them, as on us at the beginning.

began to speak 44_ACT_18_26 # And he began to speak boldly in the synagogue: whom when Aquila and Priscilla had heard, they took him unto [them], and expounded unto him the way of God more perfectly.

began to speak <u>42_LUK_07_15</u># And he that was dead sat up, and began to speak. And he delivered him to his mother.

began to speak <u>42_LUK_07_24</u> # And when the messengers of John were departed, he began to speak unto the people concerning John, What went ye out into the wilderness for to see? A reed shaken with the wind?

began to speak 41_MAR_12_01 # And he began to speak unto them by parables. A [certain] man planted a vineyard, and set an hedge about [it], and digged [a place for] the winefat, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and went into a far country.

began to spit 41_MAR_14_65 # And some began to spit on him, and to cover his face, and to buffet him, and to say unto him, Prophesy: and the servants did strike him with the palms of their hands.

began to spring <u>07_JUD_19_25</u> # But the men would not hearken to him: so the man took his concubine, and brought her forth unto them; and they knew her, and abused her all the night until the morning: and when the day began to spring, they let her go.

began to teach <u>41_MAR_06_02</u> # And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing [him] were astonished, saying, From whence hath this [man] these things? and what wisdom [is] this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands?

began to teach <u>41_MAR_06_34</u> # And Jesus, when he came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and he began to teach them many things.

began to teach <u>41_MAR_08_31</u> # And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and [of] the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.

began to tell <u>41_MAR_10_32</u> # And they were in the way going up to Jerusalem; and Jesus went before them: and they were amazed; and as they followed, they were afraid. And he took again the twelve, and began to tell them what things should happen unto him,

began to urge 42 LUK 11 53 # And as he said these things unto them, the scribes and the Pharisees began to urge [him] vehemently, and to provoke him to speak of many things:

began to wash 43_JOH_13_05 # After that he poureth water into a basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe [them] with the towel wherewith he was girded.

began to wash 42_LUK_07_38 # And stood at his feet behind [him] weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe [them] with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed [them] with the ointment.

began to wax <u>09_1SA_03_02</u> # And it came to pass at that time, when Eli [was] laid down in his place, and his eyes began to wax dim, [that] he could not see;

began to wear 42_LUK_09_12 # And when the day began to wear away, then came the twelve, and said unto him, Send the multitude away, that they may go into the towns and country round about, and lodge, and get victuals: for we are here in a desert place.

began was it <u>43_JOH_09_32</u> # Since the world began was it not heard that any man opened the eyes of one that was born blind.

began Zerubbabel the <u>15_EZR_03_08</u># Now in the second year of their coming unto the house of God at Jerusalem, in the second month, began Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and the remnant of their brethren the priests and the Levites, and all they that were come out of the captivity unto Jerusalem; and appointed the Levites, from twenty years old and upward, to set forward the work of the house of the LORD.

began <u>55_2TI_01_09</u> # Who hath saved us, and called [us] with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

began <u>44_ACT_03_21</u> # Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

began <u>42_LUK_01_70</u> # As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began:

began <u>45_ROM_16_25</u># Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began,

began 56_TIT_01_02 # In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;
