belly and by <u>45\_ROM\_16\_18</u> # For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.

belly and goeth <u>41\_MAR\_07\_19</u> # Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats?

belly and his <u>27\_DAN\_02\_32</u># This image's head [was] of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his belly and his thighs of brass,

belly and is <u>40\_MAT\_15\_17</u># Do not ye yet understand, that whatsoever entereth in at the mouth goeth into the belly, and is cast out into the draught?

belly and the <u>46\_1CO\_06\_13</u> # Meats for the belly, and the belly for meats: but God shall destroy both it and them. Now the body [is] not for fornication, but for the Lord; and the Lord for the body.

belly and the <u>07\_JUD\_03\_22</u> # And the haft also went in after the blade; and the fat closed upon the blade, so that he could not draw the dagger out of his belly; and the dirt came out.

belly and whose <u>50\_PHP\_03\_19</u># Whose end [is] destruction, whose God [is their] belly, and [whose] glory [is] in their shame, who mind earthly things.]

belly bitter but <u>66\_REV\_10\_09</u> # And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take [it], and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.

belly cleaveth unto <u>19\_PSA\_44\_25</u># For our soul is bowed down to the dust: our belly cleaveth unto the earth.

belly for meats <u>46\_1CO\_06\_13</u> # Meats for the belly, and the belly for meats: but God shall destroy both it and them. Now the body [is] not for fornication, but for the Lord; and the Lord for the body.

belly God shall <u>18\_JOB\_20\_23</u> # [When] he is about to fill his belly, [God] shall cast the fury of his wrath upon him, and shall rain [it] upon him while he is eating.

belly he shall <u>18\_JOB\_20\_20</u># Surely he shall not feel quietness in his belly, he shall not save of that which he desired.

belly I knew <u>24\_JER\_01\_05</u># Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, [and] I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.

belly is as <u>18\_JOB\_32\_19</u># Behold, my belly [is] as wine [which] hath no vent; it is ready to burst like new bottles.

belly is as <u>22\_SON\_05\_14</u> # His hands [are as] gold rings set with the beryl: his belly [is as] bright ivory

belly of hell <u>32\_JON\_02\_02</u> # And said, I cried by reason of mine affliction unto the LORD, and he heard me; out of the belly of hell cried I, [and] thou heardest my voice.

belly of the <u>32\_JON\_01\_17</u> # Now the LORD had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

belly of the <u>20\_PRO\_13\_25</u># The righteous eateth to the satisfying of his soul: but the belly of the wicked shall want.

belly prepareth deceit <u>18\_JOB\_15\_35</u># They conceive mischief, and bring forth vanity, and their belly prepareth deceit.
