betroth a wife <u>05_DEU_28_30</u> # Thou shalt betroth a wife, and another man shall lie with her: thou shalt build an house, and thou shalt not dwell therein: thou shalt plant a vineyard, and shalt not gather the grapes thereof.

betroth thee unto <u>28_HOS_02_19</u># And I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies.

betroth thee unto 28_HOS_02_19 # And I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies.

betroth thee unto <u>28_HOS_02_20</u># I will even betroth thee unto me in faithfulness: and thou shalt know the LORD.

betrothed a wife <u>05_DEU_20_07</u> # And what man [is there] that hath betrothed a wife, and hath not taken her? let him go and return unto his house, lest he die in the battle, and another man take her.

betrothed and lay <u>05_DEU_22_28</u> # If a man find a damsel [that is] a virgin, which is not betrothed, and lay hold on her, and lie with her, and they be found;

betrothed and lie <u>02_EXO_22_16</u> # And if a man entice a maid that is not betrothed, and lie with her, he shall surely endow her to be his wife.

betrothed damsel cried <u>05_DEU_22_27</u> # For he found her in the field, [and] the betrothed damsel cried, and [there was] none to save her.

betrothed damsel in <u>05_DEU_22_25</u># But if a man find a betrothed damsel in the field, and the man force her, and lie with her: then the man only that lay with her shall die:

betrothed her to <u>02_EXO_21_08</u># If she please not her master, who hath betrothed her to himself, then shall he let her be redeemed: to sell her unto a strange nation he shall have no power, seeing he hath dealt deceitfully with her.

betrothed her unto $\underline{02_EXO_21_09}$ # And if he have betrothed her unto his son, he shall deal with her after the manner of daughters.

betrothed to an <u>03_LEV_19_20</u> # And whosoever lieth carnally with a woman, that [is] a bondmaid, betrothed to an husband, and not at all redeemed, nor freedom given her; she shall be scourged; they shall not be put to death, because she was not free.

betrothed unto an <u>05_DEU_22_23</u># If a damsel [that is] a virgin be betrothed unto an husband, and a man find her in the city, and lie with her;
