

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

bewail her and <u>66\_REV\_18\_09</u># And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her, shall bewail her, and lament for her, when they shall see the smoke of her burning,

bewail her father <u>05\_DEU\_21\_13</u> # And she shall put the raiment of her captivity from off her, and shall remain in thine house, and bewail her father and her mother a full month: and after that thou shalt go in unto her, and be her husband, and she shall be thy wife.

bewail many which <u>47\_2CO\_12\_21</u> # [And] lest, when I come again, my God will humble me among you, and [that] I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed.

bewail my virginity <u>07\_JUD\_11\_37</u># And she said unto her father, Let this thing be done for me: let me alone two months, that I may go up and down upon the mountains, and bewail my virginity, I and my fellows.

bewail the burning <u>03\_LEV\_10\_06</u># And Moses said unto Aaron, and unto Eleazar and unto Ithamar, his sons, Uncover not your heads, neither rend your clothes; lest ye die, and lest wrath come upon all the people: but let your brethren, the whole house of Israel, bewail the burning which the LORD hath kindled.

bewail with the <u>23\_ISA\_16\_09</u> # Therefore I will bewail with the weeping of Jazer the vine of Sibmah: I will water thee with my tears, O Heshbon, and Elealeh: for the shouting for thy summer fruits and for thy harvest is fallen.

bewailed and lamented <u>42\_LUK\_23\_27</u># And there followed him a great company of people, and of women, which also bewailed and lamented him.

bewailed her but <u>42\_LUK\_08\_52</u> # And all wept, and bewailed her: but he said, Weep not; she is not dead, but sleepeth.

bewailed her virginity <u>07\_JUD\_11\_38</u># And he said, Go. And he sent her away [for] two months: and she went with her companions, and bewailed her virginity upon the mountains.

bewaileth herself that <u>24\_JER\_04\_31</u> # For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, [and] the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, [that] bewaileth herself, [that] spreadeth her hands, [saying], Woe [is] me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.
