

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

bind a stone 24\_JER\_51\_63 # And it shall be, when thou hast made an end of reading this book, [that] thou shalt bind a stone to it, and cast it into the midst of Euphrates:

bind all that <u>44\_ACT\_09\_14</u># And here he hath authority from the chief priests to bind all that call on thy name.

bind heavy burdens 40 MAT 23 04 # For they bind heavy burdens and grievous to be borne, and lay [them] on men's shoulders; but they [themselves] will not move them with one of their fingers.

bind herself by <u>04\_NUM\_30\_03</u># If a woman also vow a vow unto the LORD, and bind [herself] by a bond, [being] in her father's house in her youth;

bind him for <u>18\_JOB\_41\_05</u> # Wilt thou play with him as [with] a bird? or wilt thou bind him for thy maidens?

Bind him hand 40 MAT 22 13 # Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast [him] into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

bind him no <u>41\_MAR\_05\_03</u># Who had [his] dwelling among the tombs; and no man could bind him, no, not with chains:

bind him to <u>07\_JUD\_16\_05</u># And the lords of the Philistines came up unto her, and said unto her, Entice him, and see wherein his great strength [lieth], and by what [means] we may prevail against him, that we may bind him to afflict him: and we will give thee every one of us eleven hundred [pieces] of silver.

bind his princes 19\_PSA\_105\_22 # To bind his princes at his pleasure; and teach his senators wisdom.

bind his soul <u>04\_NUM\_30\_02</u># If a man vow a vow unto the LORD, or swear an oath to bind his soul with a bond; he shall not break his word, he shall do according to all that proceedeth out of his mouth.

bind it as 18\_JOB\_31\_36 # Surely I would take it upon my shoulder, [and] bind it [as] a crown to me.

bind it to <u>26\_EZE\_30\_21</u> # Son of man, I have broken the arm of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and, lo, it shall not be bound up to be healed, to put a roller to bind it, to make it strong to hold the sword.

bind me fast <u>07\_JUD\_16\_11</u># And he said unto her, If they bind me fast with new ropes that never were occupied, then shall I be weak, and be as another man.

bind me with <u>07\_JUD\_16\_07</u> # And Samson said unto her, If they bind me with seven green withs that were never dried, then shall I be weak, and be as another man.

bind on earth <u>40\_MAT\_16\_19</u># And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

bind on earth <u>40\_MAT\_18\_18</u># Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

bind on thy <u>44\_ACT\_12\_08</u> # And the angel said unto him, Gird thyself, and bind on thy sandals. And so he did. And he saith unto him, Cast thy garment about thee, and follow me.

bind Samson are <u>07\_JUD\_15\_10</u># And the men of Judah said, Why are ye come up against us? And they answered, To bind Samson are we come up, to do to him as he hath done to us.

bind Shadrach Meshach <u>27\_DAN\_03\_20</u> # And he commanded the most mighty men that [were] in his army to bind Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, [and] to cast [them] into the burning fiery furnace.

bind the breastplate <u>02\_EXO\_28\_28</u> # And they shall bind the breastplate by the rings thereof unto the rings of the ephod with a lace of blue, that [it] may be above the curious girdle of the ephod, and that the breastplate be not loosed from the ephod.

bind the breastplate <u>02\_EXO\_39\_21</u># And they did bind the breastplate by his rings unto the rings of the ephod with a lace of blue, that it might be above the curious girdle of the ephod, and that the breastplate might not be loosed from the ephod; as the LORD commanded Moses.

bind the chariot <u>33\_MIC\_01\_13</u># O thou inhabitant of Lachish, bind the chariot to the swift beast: she [is] the beginning of the sin to the daughter of Zion: for the transgressions of Israel were found in thee.

bind the man <u>44\_ACT\_21\_11</u># And when he was come unto us, he took Paul's girdle, and bound his own hands and feet, and said, Thus saith the Holy Ghost, So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man that owneth this girdle, and shall deliver [him] into the hands of the Gentiles.

bind the sacrifice 19\_PSA\_118\_27 # God [is] the LORD, which hath showed us light: bind the sacrifice with cords, [even] unto the horns of the altar.

bind the strong 41\_MAR\_03\_27 # No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house.

bind the strong 40\_MAT\_12\_29 # Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house.

bind the sweet <u>18\_JOB\_38\_31</u> # Canst thou bind the sweet influences of Pleiades, or loose the bands of Orion?

bind the tire <u>26\_EZE\_24\_17</u> # Forbear to cry, make no mourning for the dead, bind the tire of thine head upon thee, and put on thy shoes upon thy feet, and cover not [thy] lips, and eat not the bread of men.

bind the unicorn <u>18\_JOB\_39\_10</u> # Canst thou bind the unicorn with his band in the furrow? or will he harrow the valleys after thee?

bind thee fast <u>07\_JUD\_15\_13</u> # And they spake unto him, saying, No; but we will bind thee fast, and deliver thee into their hand: but surely we will not kill thee. And they bound him with two new cords, and brought him up from the rock.

bind thee that <u>07\_JUD\_15\_12</u># And they said unto him, We are come down to bind thee, that we may deliver thee into the hand of the Philistines. And Samson said unto them, Swear unto me, that ye will not fall upon me yourselves.

bind thee with <u>26\_EZE\_03\_25</u> # But thou, O son of man, behold, they shall put bands upon thee, and shall bind thee with them, and thou shalt not go out among them:

bind their faces 18\_JOB\_40\_13 # Hide them in the dust together; [and] bind their faces in secret.

bind their kings 19\_PSA\_149\_08 # To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron;

bind them about <u>20\_PRO\_03\_03</u># Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart:

Bind them continually <u>20\_PRO\_06\_21</u> # Bind them continually upon thine heart, [and] tie them about thy neck.

bind them for <u>05\_DEU\_06\_08</u># And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes.

bind them for <u>05\_DEU\_11\_18</u># Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes.

bind them in 26\_EZE\_05\_03 # Thou shalt also take thereof a few in number, and bind them in thy skirts.

bind them in <u>40\_MAT\_13\_30</u># Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.

bind them on 23\_ISA\_49\_18 # Lift up thine eyes round about, and behold: all these gather themselves together, [and] come to thee. [As] I live, saith the LORD, thou shalt surely clothe thee with them all, as with an ornament, and bind them [on thee], as a bride [doeth].

Bind them upon 20\_PRO\_07\_03 # Bind them upon thy fingers, write them upon the table of thine heart.

bind themselves in <u>28\_HOS\_10\_10</u> # [It is] in my desire that I should chastise them; and the people shall be gathered against them, when they shall bind themselves in their two furrows.

bind this line <u>06\_JOS\_02\_18</u> # Behold, [when] we come into the land, thou shalt bind this line of scarlet thread in the window which thou didst let us down by: and thou shalt bring thy father, and thy mother, and thy brethren, and all thy father's household, home unto thee.

bind up that <u>26\_EZE\_34\_16</u># I will seek that which was lost, and bring again that which was driven away, and will bind up [that which was] broken, and will strengthen that which was sick: but I will destroy the fat and the strong; I will feed them with judgment.

bind up the <u>05\_DEU\_14\_25</u> # Then shalt thou turn [it] into money, and bind up the money in thine hand, and shalt go unto the place which the LORD thy God shall choose:

Bind up the 23\_ISA\_08\_16 # Bind up the testimony, seal the law among my disciples.

bind up the <u>23\_ISA\_61\_01</u># The spirit of the Lord GOD [is] upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to [them that are] bound;

bind us up <u>28\_HOS\_06\_01</u> # Come, and let us return unto the LORD: for he hath torn, and he will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up.

bindeth a stone 20\_PRO\_26\_08 # As he that bindeth a stone in a sling, so [is] he that giveth honour to a fool.

bindeth me about <u>18\_JOB\_30\_18</u> # By the great force [of my disease] is my garment changed: it bindeth me about as the collar of my coat.

bindeth sheaves his 19\_PSA\_129\_07 # Wherewith the mower filleth not his hand; nor he that bindeth

sheaves his bosom.

bindeth the floods <u>18\_JOB\_28\_11</u># He bindeth the floods from overflowing; and [the thing that is] hid bringeth he forth to light.

bindeth them <u>18\_JOB\_36\_13</u># But the hypocrites in heart heap up wrath: they cry not when he bindeth them.

bindeth up he <u>18\_JOB\_05\_18</u># For he maketh sore, and bindeth up: he woundeth, and his hands make whole.

bindeth up the <u>23\_ISA\_30\_26</u># Moreover the light of the moon shall be as the light of the sun, and the light of the sun shall be sevenfold, as the light of seven days, in the day that the LORD bindeth up the breach of his people, and healeth the stroke of their wound.

bindeth up the <u>18\_JOB\_26\_08</u># He bindeth up the waters in his thick clouds; and the cloud is not rent under them.

bindeth up their 19\_PSA\_147\_03 # He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.

binding and delivering 44\_ACT\_22\_04 # And I persecuted this way unto the death, binding and delivering into prisons both men and women.

Binding his foal <u>01\_GEN\_49\_11</u># Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:

binding oath to <u>04\_NUM\_30\_13</u> # Every vow, and every binding oath to afflict the soul, her husband may establish it, or her husband may make it void.

binding of woven <u>02\_EXO\_28\_32</u># And there shall be an hole in the top of it, in the midst thereof: it shall have a binding of woven work round about the hole of it, as it were the hole of an habergeon, that it be not rent.

binding sheaves in <u>01\_GEN\_37\_07</u> # For, behold, we [were] binding sheaves in the field, and, lo, my sheaf arose, and also stood upright; and, behold, your sheaves stood round about, and made obeisance to my sheaf.
