Arbite 10\_2SA\_23\_35 # Hezrai the Carmelite, Paarai the Arbite,

Backbiters haters of <u>45\_ROM\_01\_30</u> # Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents,

backbiteth not with 19\_PSA\_15\_03 # [He that] backbiteth not with his tongue, nor doeth evil to his neighbour, nor taketh up a reproach against his neighbour.

bite and devour <u>48\_GAL\_05\_15</u># But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.

bite him <u>21\_ECC\_10\_08</u># He that diggeth a pit shall fall into it; and whoso breaketh an hedge, a serpent shall bite him.

bite thee and <u>35\_HAB\_02\_07</u># Shall they not rise up suddenly that shall bite thee, and awake that shall vex thee, and thou shalt be for booties unto them?

bite them <u>30\_AMO\_09\_03</u># And though they hide themselves in the top of Carmel, I will search and take them out thence; and though they be hid from my sight in the bottom of the sea, thence will I command the serpent, and he shall bite them:

bite with their <u>33\_MIC\_03\_05</u> # Thus saith the LORD concerning the prophets that make my people err, that bite with their teeth, and cry, Peace; and he that putteth not into their mouths, they even prepare war against him.

bite without enchantment <u>21\_ECC\_10\_11</u># Surely the serpent will bite without enchantment; and a babbler is no better.

bite you saith <u>24\_JER\_08\_17</u> # For, behold, I will send serpents, cockatrices, among you, which [will] not [be] charmed, and they shall bite you, saith the LORD.

biteth like a 20\_PRO\_23\_32 # At the last it biteth like a serpent, and stingeth like an adder.

biteth the horse <u>01\_GEN\_49\_17</u> # Dan shall be a serpent by the way, an adder in the path, that biteth the horse heels, so that his rider shall fall backward.

inhabited again in <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_06</u># In that day will I make the governors of Judah like an hearth of fire among the wood, and like a torch of fire in a sheaf; and they shall devour all the people round about, on the right hand and on the left: and Jerusalem shall be inhabited again in her own place, [even] in Jerusalem.

inhabited and he <u>03\_LEV\_16\_22</u># And the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness.

inhabited and I <u>26\_EZE\_26\_20</u> # When I shall bring thee down with them that descend into the pit, with the people of old time, and shall set thee in the low parts of the earth, in places desolate of old, with them that go down to the pit, that thou be not inhabited; and I shall set glory in the land of the living;

inhabited and in 38\_ZEC\_07\_07 # [Should ye] not [hear] the words which the LORD hath cried by the

former prophets, when Jerusalem was inhabited and in prosperity, and the cities thereof round about her, when [men] inhabited the south and the plain?

inhabited and the <u>26\_EZE\_36\_10</u> # And I will multiply men upon you, all the house of Israel, [even] all of it: and the cities shall be inhabited, and the wastes shall be builded:

inhabited and to <u>23\_ISA\_44\_26</u># That confirmeth the word of his servant, and performeth the counsel of his messengers; that saith to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be inhabited; and to the cities of Judah, Ye shall be built, and I will raise up the decayed places thereof:

inhabited and upon <u>26\_EZE\_38\_12</u> # To take a spoil, and to take a prey; to turn thine hand upon the desolate places [that are now] inhabited, and upon the people [that are] gathered out of the nations, which have gotten cattle and goods, that dwell in the midst of the land.

inhabited as in <u>24\_JER\_46\_26</u># And I will deliver them into the hand of those that seek their lives, and into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of his servants: and afterward it shall be inhabited, as in the days of old, saith the LORD.

inhabited as towns <u>38\_ZEC\_02\_04</u> # And said unto him, Run, speak to this young man, saying, Jerusalem shall be inhabited [as] towns without walls for the multitude of men and cattle therein:

inhabited but it <u>24\_JER\_50\_13</u> # Because of the wrath of the LORD it shall not be inhabited, but it shall be wholly desolate: every one that goeth by Babylon shall be astonished, and hiss at all her plagues.

inhabited for ever <u>24\_JER\_50\_39</u># Therefore the wild beasts of the desert with the wild beasts of the islands shall dwell [there], and the owls shall dwell therein: and it shall be no more inhabited for ever; neither shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation.

inhabited forty years <u>26\_EZE\_29\_11</u># No foot of man shall pass through it, nor foot of beast shall pass through it, neither shall it be inhabited forty years.

inhabited I am <u>23\_ISA\_45\_18</u># For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I [am] the LORD; and [there is] none else.

inhabited in her <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_10</u># All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the first gate, unto the corner gate, and [from] the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses.

inhabited Jerusalem but <u>07\_JUD\_01\_21</u> # And the children of Benjamin did not drive out the Jebusites that inhabited Jerusalem; but the Jebusites dwell with the children of Benjamin in Jerusalem unto this day.

inhabited neither shall <u>23\_ISA\_13\_20</u># It shall never be inhabited, neither shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation: neither shall the Arabian pitch tent there; neither shall the shepherds make their fold there.

inhabited of seafaring <u>26\_EZE\_26\_17</u> # And they shall take up a lamentation for thee, and say to thee, How art thou destroyed, [that wast] inhabited of seafaring men, the renowned city, which wast strong in the sea, she and her inhabitants, which cause their terror [to be] on all that haunt it!

inhabited places of <u>26\_EZE\_34\_13</u># And I will bring them out from the people, and gather them from the countries, and will bring them to their own land, and feed them upon the mountains of Israel by the rivers, and in all the inhabited places of the country.

inhabited shall be 26\_EZE\_12\_20 # And the cities that are inhabited shall be laid waste, and the land shall

be desolate; and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD.

inhabited the land <u>01\_GEN\_36\_20</u> # These [are] the sons of Seir the Horite, who inhabited the land; Lotan, and Shobal, and Zibeon, and Anah,

inhabited the south <u>38\_ZEC\_07\_07</u># [Should ye] not [hear] the words which the LORD hath cried by the former prophets, when Jerusalem was inhabited and in prosperity, and the cities thereof round about her, when [men] inhabited the south and the plain?

inhabited they did <u>02\_EXO\_16\_35</u># And the children of Israel did eat manna forty years, until they came to a land inhabited; they did eat manna, until they came unto the borders of the land of Canaan.

inhabited unto the <u>13\_1CH\_05\_09</u># And eastward he inhabited unto the entering in of the wilderness from the river Euphrates: because their cattle were multiplied in the land of Gilead.

inhabited when I <u>26\_EZE\_26\_19</u># For thus saith the Lord GOD; When I shall make thee a desolate city, like the cities that are not inhabited; when I shall bring up the deep upon thee, and great waters shall cover thee;

inhabited Zephath and <u>07\_JUD\_01\_17</u> # And Judah went with Simeon his brother, and they slew the Canaanites that inhabited Zephath, and utterly destroyed it. And the name of the city was called Hormah.

inhabited <u>26\_EZE\_36\_35</u> # And they shall say, This land that was desolate is become like the garden of Eden; and the waste and desolate and ruined cities [are become] fenced, [and] are inhabited.

inhabited <u>23\_ISA\_54\_03</u># For thou shalt break forth on the right hand and on the left; and thy seed shall inherit the Gentiles, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited.

inhabited <u>24\_JER\_06\_08</u># Be thou instructed, O Jerusalem, lest my soul depart from thee; lest I make thee desolate, a land not inhabited.

inhabited <u>24\_JER\_17\_06</u># For he shall be like the heath in the desert, and shall not see when good cometh; but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, [in] a salt land and not inhabited.

inhabited <u>24\_JER\_22\_06</u># For thus saith the LORD unto the king's house of Judah; Thou [art] Gilead unto me, [and] the head of Lebanon: [yet] surely I will make thee a wilderness, [and] cities [which] are not inhabited.

inhabited <u>38\_ZEC\_09\_05</u> # Ashkelon shall see [it], and fear; Gaza also [shall see it], and be very sorrowful, and Ekron; for her expectation shall be ashamed; and the king shall perish from Gaza, and Ashkelon shall not be inhabited.

inhabited <u>38\_ZEC\_14\_11</u> # And [men] shall dwell in it, and there shall be no more utter destruction; but Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited.

inhabiters of the <u>66\_REV\_08\_13</u># And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, to the inhabiters of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!

inhabiters of the <u>66\_REV\_12\_12</u># Therefore rejoice, [ye] heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

inhabitest the praises 19\_PSA\_22\_03 # But thou [art] holy, [O thou] that inhabitest the praises of Israel.

inhabiteth eternity whose 23 ISA 57 15 # For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name [is] Holy; I dwell in the high and holy [place], with him also [that is] of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.

inhabiteth which are <u>18\_JOB\_15\_28</u># And he dwelleth in desolate cities, [and] in houses which no man inhabiteth, which are ready to become heaps.

Jashubites of Shimron <u>04\_NUM\_26\_24</u> # Of Jashub, the family of the Jashubites: of Shimron, the family of the Shimronites.

Moabite shall not <u>05\_DEU\_23\_03</u> # An Ammonite or Moabite shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD; even to their tenth generation shall they not enter into the congregation of the LORD for ever:

Moabite should not <u>16\_NEH\_13\_01</u># On that day they read in the book of Moses in the audience of the people; and therein was found written, that the Ammonite and the Moabite should not come into the congregation of God for ever;

Moabite 13\_1CH\_11\_46# Eliel the Mahavite, and Jeribai, and Joshaviah, the sons of Elnaam, and Ithmah the Moabite,

Moabites also into 12\_2KI\_03\_18 # And this is [but] a light thing in the sight of the LORD: he will deliver the Moabites also into your hand.

Moabites Ammonites Edomites <u>11\_1KI\_11\_01</u># But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, [and] Hittites;

Moabites and bands 12 2KI 24 02 # And the LORD sent against him bands of the Chaldees, and bands of the Syrians, and bands of the Moabites, and bands of the children of Ammon, and sent them against Judah to destroy it, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by his servants the prophets.

Moabites and for 12 2KI 23 13 # And the high places that [were] before Jerusalem, which [were] on the right hand of the mount of corruption, which Solomon the king of Israel had builded for Ashtoreth the abomination of the Zidonians, and for Chemosh the abomination of the Moabites, and for Milcom the abomination of the children of Ammon, did the king defile.

Moabites and Milcom 11 1KI 11 33 # Because that they have forsaken me, and have worshipped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon, and have not walked in my ways, to do [that which is] right in mine eyes, and [to keep] my statutes and my judgments, as [did] David his father.

Moabites at that <u>04\_NUM\_22\_04</u># And Moab said unto the elders of Midian, Now shall this company lick up all [that are] round about us, as the ox licketh up the grass of the field. And Balak the son of Zippor [was] king of the Moabites at that time.

Moabites became David's 13\_1CH\_18\_02 # And he smote Moab; and the Moabites became David's servants, [and] brought gifts.

Moabites became David's <u>10\_2SA\_08\_02</u> # And he smote Moab, and measured them with a line, casting them down to the ground; even with two lines measured he to put to death, and with one full line to keep alive. And [so] the Moabites became David's servants, [and] brought gifts.

Moabites call them <u>05\_DEU\_02\_11</u># Which also were accounted giants, as the Anakims; but the Moabites call them Emims.

Moabites even in 12\_2KI\_03\_24 # And when they came to the camp of Israel, the Israelites rose up and

smote the Moabites, so that they fled before them: but they went forward smiting the Moabites, even in [their] country.

Moabites heard that 12 2KI 03 21 # And when all the Moabites heard that the kings were come up to fight against them, they gathered all that were able to put on armour, and upward, and stood in the border.

Moabites into your <u>07\_JUD\_03\_28</u># And he said unto them, Follow after me: for the LORD hath delivered your enemies the Moabites into your hand. And they went down after him, and took the fords of Jordan toward Moab, and suffered not a man to pass over.

Moabites invaded the 12 2KI 13 20 # And Elisha died, and they buried him. And the bands of the Moabites invaded the land at the coming in of the year.

Moabites neither contend <u>05\_DEU\_02\_09</u># And the LORD said unto me, Distress not the Moabites, neither contend with them in battle: for I will not give thee of their land [for] a possession; because I have given Ar unto the children of Lot [for] a possession.

Moabites saw the 12\_2KI\_03\_22 # And they rose up early in the morning, and the sun shone upon the water, and the Moabites saw the water on the other side [as] red as blood:

Moabites so that 12\_2KI\_03\_24 # And when they came to the camp of Israel, the Israelites rose up and smote the Moabites, so that they fled before them: but they went forward smiting the Moabites, even in [their] country.

Moabites the Egyptians <u>15\_EZR\_09\_01</u># Now when these things were done, the princes came to me, saying, The people of Israel, and the priests, and the Levites, have not separated themselves from the people of the lands, [doing] according to their abominations, [even] of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Jebusites, the Ammonites, the Moabites, the Egyptians, and the Amorites.

Moabites unto this <u>01\_GEN\_19\_37</u># And the firstborn bare a son, and called his name Moab: the same [is] the father of the Moabites unto this day.

Moabites which dwell <u>05\_DEU\_02\_29</u> # [As the children of Esau which dwell in Seir, and the Moabites which dwell in Ar, did unto me;] until I shall pass over Jordan into the land which the LORD our God giveth us.

Moabitess her daughter <u>08\_RUT\_01\_22</u># So Naomi returned, and Ruth the Moabitess, her daughter in law, with her, which returned out of the country of Moab: and they came to Bethlehem in the beginning of barley harvest.

Moabitess said He <u>08\_RUT\_02\_21</u> # And Ruth the Moabitess said, He said unto me also, Thou shalt keep fast by my young men, until they have ended all my harvest.

Moabitess said unto <u>08\_RUT\_02\_02</u> # And Ruth the Moabitess said unto Naomi, Let me now go to the field, and glean ears of corn after [him] in whose sight I shall find grace. And she said unto her, Go, my daughter.

Moabitess the wife <u>08\_RUT\_04\_05</u># Then said Boaz, What day thou buyest the field of the hand of Naomi, thou must buy [it] also of Ruth the Moabitess, the wife of the dead, to raise up the name of the dead upon his inheritance.

Moabitess the wife <u>08\_RUT\_04\_10</u> # Moreover Ruth the Moabitess, the wife of Mahlon, have I purchased to be my wife, to raise up the name of the dead upon his inheritance, that the name of the dead be not cut off from among his brethren, and from the gate of his place: ye [are] witnesses this day.

Moabitess 14\_2CH\_24\_26 # And these are they that conspired against him; Zabad the son of Shimeath an

Ammonitess, and Jehozabad the son of Shimrith a Moabitess.

Rechabites and speak <u>24\_JER\_35\_02</u># Go unto the house of the Rechabites, and speak unto them, and bring them into the house of the LORD, into one of the chambers, and give them wine to drink.

Rechabites pots full 24\_JER\_35\_05 # And I set before the sons of the house of the Rechabites pots full of wine, and cups, and I said unto them, Drink ye wine.

Rechabites Thus saith 24 JER 35 18 # And Jeremiah said unto the house of the Rechabites, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Because ye have obeyed the commandment of Jonadab your father, and kept all his precepts, and done according unto all that he hath commanded you:

Rechabites <u>24\_JER\_35\_03</u> # Then I took Jaazaniah the son of Jeremiah, the son of Habaziniah, and his brethren, and all his sons, and the whole house of the Rechabites;

Tishbite Arise go 12 2KI 01 03 # But the angel of the LORD said to Elijah the Tishbite, Arise, go up to meet the messengers of the king of Samaria, and say unto them, [Is it] not because [there is] not a God in Israel, [that] ye go to inquire of Baalzebub the god of Ekron?

Tishbite saying In 12 2KI 09 36 # Wherefore they came again, and told him. And he said, This [is] the word of the LORD, which he spake by his servant Elijah the Tishbite, saying, In the portion of Jezreel shall dogs eat the flesh of Jezebel:

Tishbite saying 11\_1KI\_21\_17 # And the word of the LORD came to Elijah the Tishbite, saying,

Tishbite saying 11\_1KI\_21\_28 # And the word of the LORD came to Elijah the Tishbite, saying,

Tishbite who was 11\_1KI\_17\_01 # And Elijah the Tishbite, [who was] of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, [As] the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.

Tishbite 12\_2KI\_01\_08 # And they answered him, [He was] an hairy man, and girt with a girdle of leather about his loins. And he said, It [is] Elijah the Tishbite.
