black and dark [20 PRO 07 09](#) # In the twilight, in the evening, in the black and dark night:

black as a [22 SON 05 11](#) # His head [is as] the most fine gold, his locks [are] bushy, [and] black as a raven.

black as sackcloth [66 REV 06 12](#) # And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;

black astonishment hath [24 JER 08 21](#) # For the hurt of the daughter of my people am I hurt; I am black; astonishment hath taken hold on me.

black because I [24 JER 04 28](#) # For this shall the earth mourn, and the heavens above be black: because I have spoken [it], I have purposed [it], and will not repent, neither will I turn back from it.

black because the [22 SON 01 06](#) # Look not upon me, because I [am] black, because the sun hath looked upon me: my mother's children were angry with me; they made me the keeper of the vineyards; [but] mine own vineyard have I not kept.

black but comely [22 SON 01 05](#) # I [am] black, but comely, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, as the tents of Kedar, as the curtains of Solomon.

black hair grown [03 LEV 13 37](#) # But if the scall be in his sight at a stay, and [that] there is black hair grown up therein; the scall is healed, he [is] clean: and the priest shall pronounce him clean.

black hair in [03 LEV 13 31](#) # And if the priest look on the plague of the scall, and, behold, it [be] not in sight deeper than the skin, and [that there is] no black hair in it; then the priest shall shut up [him that hath] the plague of the scall seven days:

black horse and [66 REV 06 05](#) # And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

black horses which [38 ZEC 06 06](#) # The black horses which [are] therein go forth into the north country; and the white go forth after them; and the grisled go forth toward the south country.

black horses [38 ZEC 06 02](#) # In the first chariot [were] red horses; and in the second chariot black horses;

black like an [25 LAM 05 10](#) # Our skin was black like an oven because of the terrible famine.

black marble [17 EST 01 06](#) # [Where were] white, green, and blue, [hangings], fastened with cords of fine linen and purple to silver rings and pillars of marble: the beds [were of] gold and silver, upon a pavement of red, and blue, and white, and black, marble.

black unto the [24 JER 14 02](#) # Judah mourneth, and the gates thereof languish; they are black unto the ground; and the cry of Jerusalem is gone up.

black upon me [18 JOB 30 30](#) # My skin is black upon me, and my bones are burned with heat.

black with clouds [11 1KI 18 45](#) # And it came to pass in the mean while, that the heaven was black with clouds and wind, and there was a great rain. And Ahab rode, and went to Jezreel.

black [40 MAT 05 36](#) # Neither shalt thou swear by thy head, because thou canst not make one hair white or black.

blacker than a [25 LAM 04 08](#) # Their visage is blacker than a coal; they are not known in the streets: their skin cleaveth to their bones; it is withered, it is become like a stick.

blackish by reason [18 JOB 06 16](#) # Which are blackish by reason of the ice, [and] wherein the snow is hid:

blackness and darkness [58 HEB 12 18](#) # For ye are not come unto the mount that might be touched, and that burned with fire, nor unto blackness, and darkness, and tempest,

blackness and I [23 ISA 50 03](#) # I clothe the heavens with blackness, and I make sackcloth their covering.

blackness of darkness [65 JDE 01 13](#) # Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.

blackness of the [18 JOB 03 05](#) # Let darkness and the shadow of death stain it; let a cloud dwell upon it; let the blackness of the day terrify it.

blackness [29 JOE 02 06](#) # Before their face the people shall be much pained: all faces shall gather blackness.

blackness [34 NAH 02 10](#) # She is empty, and void, and waste: and the heart melteth, and the knees smite together, and much pain [is] in all loins, and the faces of them all gather blackness.
