born a male <u>03\_LEV\_12\_07</u># Who shall offer it before the LORD, and make an atonement for her; and she shall be cleansed from the issue of her blood. This [is] the law for her that hath born a male or a female.

born a man <u>03\_LEV\_12\_02</u> # Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If a woman have conceived seed, and born a man child: then she shall be unclean seven days; according to the days of the separation for her infirmity shall she be unclean.

born a son <u>01\_GEN\_04\_26</u># And to Seth, to him also there was born a son; and he called his name Enos: then began men to call upon the name of the LORD.

born and make <u>28\_HOS\_02\_03</u># Lest I strip her naked, and set her as in the day that she was born, and make her as a wilderness, and set her like a dry land, and slay her with thirst.

born and the <u>18\_JOB\_03\_03</u># Let the day perish wherein I was born, and the night [in which] it was said, There is a man child conceived.

born in that 13\_1CH\_07\_21 # And Zabad his son, and Shuthelah his son, and Ezer, and Elead, whom the men of Gath [that were] born in [that] land slew, because they came down to take away their cattle.

born in the 02\_EXO\_12\_19 # Seven days shall there be no leaven found in your houses: for whosoever

born King of 40\_MAT\_02\_02 # Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.

born let not 24\_JER\_20\_14 # Cursed [be] the day wherein I was born: let not the day wherein my mother bare me be blessed.

born like a 18\_JOB\_11\_12 # For vain man would be wise, though man be born [like] a wild ass's colt.

born Manasseh and <u>01\_GEN\_46\_20</u># And unto Joseph in the land of Egypt were born Manasseh and Ephraim, which Asenath the daughter of Potipherah priest of On bare unto him.

born Nadab and 04\_NUM\_26\_60 # And unto Aaron was born Nadab, and Abihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar.

born neither having 45 ROM\_09\_11 # [For [the children] being not yet born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works, but of him that calleth;]

born not of 43\_JOH\_01\_13 # Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

born of a 18\_JOB\_14\_01 # Man [that is] born of a woman [is] of few days, and full of trouble.

born shall dwell <u>03\_LEV\_23\_42</u> # Ye shall dwell in booths seven days; all that are Israelites born shall dwell in booths:

born speaking lies <u>19\_PSA\_58\_03</u> # The wicked are estranged from the womb: they go astray as soon as they be born, speaking lies.

born that he 19\_PSA\_22\_31 # They shall come, and shall declare his righteousness unto a people that shall be born, that he hath done [this].

born thy navel <u>26\_EZE\_16\_04</u> # And [as for] thy nativity, in the day thou wast born thy navel was not cut, neither wast thou washed in water to supple [thee]; thou wast not salted at all, nor swaddled at all.

born to Bethuel <u>01\_GEN\_24\_15</u># And it came to pass, before he had done speaking, that, behold, Rebekah came out, who was born to Bethuel, son of Milcah, the wife of Nahor, Abraham's brother, with her pitcher upon her shoulder.

born to David <u>10\_2SA\_03\_05</u># And the sixth, Ithream, by Eglah David's wife. These were born to David in Hebron.

born to Naomi <u>08\_RUT\_04\_17</u> # And the women her neighbours gave it a name, saying, There is a son born to Naomi; and they called his name Obed: he [is] the father of Jesse, the father of David.

born to the <u>10\_2SA\_21\_20</u># And there was yet a battle in Gath, where was a man of [great] stature, that had on every hand six fingers, and on every foot six toes, four and twenty in number; and he also was born to the giant.

born to the <u>10\_2SA\_21\_22</u># These four were born to the giant in Gath, and fell by the hand of David, and by the hand of his servants.

born unto him <u>13\_1CH\_02\_03</u> # The sons of Judah; Er, and Onan, and Shelah: [which] three were born unto him of the daughter of Shua the Canaanitess. And Er, the firstborn of Judah, was evil in the sight of the LORD; and he slew him.

born unto him <u>13\_1CH\_02\_09</u> # The sons also of Hezron, that were born unto him; Jerahmeel, and Ram, and Chelubai.

born unto him <u>13\_1CH\_03\_01</u> # Now these were the sons of David, which were born unto him in Hebron; the firstborn Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess; the second Daniel, of Abigail the Carmelitess:

firstborn of thy <u>02\_EXO\_34\_20</u># But the firstling of an ass thou shalt redeem with a lamb: and if thou redeem [him] not, then shalt thou break his neck. All the firstborn of thy sons thou shalt redeem. And none shall appear before me empty.

firstborn put thy <u>01\_GEN\_48\_18</u># And Joseph said unto his father, Not so, my father: for this [is] the firstborn; put thy right hand upon his head.

firstborn said unto <u>01\_GEN\_19\_31</u># And the firstborn said unto the younger, Our father [is] old, and [there is] not a man in the earth to come in unto us after the manner of all the earth:

firstborn said unto <u>01\_GEN\_19\_34</u># And it came to pass on the morrow, that the firstborn said unto the younger, Behold, I lay yesternight with my father: let us make him drink wine this night also; and go thou in, [and] lie with him, that we may preserve seed of our father.

firstborn should touch <u>58\_HEB\_11\_28</u># Through faith he kept the passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them.

firstborn son Abdon <u>13\_1CH\_08\_30</u> # And his firstborn son Abdon, and Zur, and Kish, and Baal, and Nadab,

firstborn son Abdon <u>13\_1CH\_09\_36</u># And his firstborn son Abdon, then Zur, and Kish, and Baal, and Ner, and Nadab,

firstborn son and <u>42\_LUK\_02\_07</u># And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.

firstborn son and 40\_MAT\_01\_25# And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS.

firstborn son be <u>05\_DEU\_21\_15</u># If a man have two wives, one beloved, and another hated, and they have born him children, [both] the beloved and the hated; and [if] the firstborn son be hers that was hated:

firstborn son of <u>01\_GEN\_36\_15</u># These [were] dukes of the sons of Esau: the sons of Eliphaz the firstborn [son] of Esau; duke Teman, duke Omar, duke Zepho, duke Kenaz,

firstborn that openeth <u>04\_NUM\_03\_12</u> # And I, behold, I have taken the Levites from among the children of Israel instead of all the firstborn that openeth the matrix among the children of Israel: therefore the Levites shall be mine;

firstborn Up and <u>07\_JUD\_08\_20</u> # And he said unto Jether his firstborn, Up, [and] slay them. But the youth drew not his sword: for he feared, because he [was] yet a youth.

firstborn Vashni and 13\_1CH\_06\_28 # And the sons of Samuel; the firstborn Vashni, and Abiah.

firstborn was Amnon <u>10\_2SA\_03\_02</u> # And unto David were sons born in Hebron: and his firstborn was Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess;

firstborn was Joel <u>09\_1SA\_08\_02</u># Now the name of his firstborn was Joel; and the name of his second, Abiah: [they were] judges in Beersheba.

firstborn was wicked <u>01\_GEN\_38\_07</u> # And Er, Judah's firstborn, was wicked in the sight of the LORD; and the LORD slew him.

firstborn went in <u>01\_GEN\_19\_33</u> # And they made their father drink wine that night: and the firstborn went in, and lay with her father; and he perceived not when she lay down, nor when she arose.

firstborn whatsoever openeth <u>02\_EXO\_13\_02</u> # Sanctify unto me all the firstborn, whatsoever openeth the womb among the children of Israel, [both] of man and of beast: it [is] mine.

firstborn which are <u>58\_HEB\_12\_23</u># To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,

firstborn which she <u>05\_DEU\_25\_06</u># And it shall be, [that] the firstborn which she beareth shall succeed in the name of his brother [which is] dead, that his name be not put out of Israel.

firstborn which the <u>04\_NUM\_33\_04</u> # For the Egyptians buried all [their] firstborn, which the LORD had smitten among them: upon their gods also the LORD executed judgments.

firstborn which was 13\_1CH\_02\_42 # Now the sons of Caleb the brother of Jerahmeel [were], Mesha his firstborn, which was the father of Ziph; and the sons of Mareshah the father of Hebron.

firstborn whose name <u>01\_GEN\_38\_06</u> # And Judah took a wife for Er his firstborn, whose name [was] Tamar.

firstborn yet his <u>13\_1CH\_26\_10</u> # Also Hosah, of the children of Merari, had sons; Simri the chief, [for [though] he was not the firstborn, yet his father made him the chief;]

firstborn 14\_2CH\_21\_03 # And their father gave them great gifts of silver, and of gold, and of precious things, with fenced cities in Judah: but the kingdom gave he to Jehoram; because he [was] the firstborn.

firstborn <u>05\_DEU\_21\_16</u># Then it shall be, when he maketh his sons to inherit [that] which he hath, [that] he may not make the son of the beloved firstborn before the son of the hated, [which is indeed] the firstborn:

firstborn <u>02\_EXO\_04\_22</u> # And thou shalt say unto Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD, Israel [is] my son, [even] my firstborn:

firstborn <u>01\_GEN\_46\_08</u># And these [are] the names of the children of Israel, which came into Egypt, Jacob and his sons: Reuben, Jacob's firstborn.

firstborn <u>01\_GEN\_48\_14</u> # And Israel stretched out his right hand, and laid [it] upon Ephraim's head, who [was] the younger, and his left hand upon Manasseh's head, guiding his hands wittingly; for Manasseh [was] the firstborn.

firstborn 24\_JER\_31\_09 # They shall come with weeping, and with supplications will I lead them: I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters in a straight way, wherein they shall not stumble: for I am a father to Israel, and Ephraim [is] my firstborn.

firstborn 38\_ZEC\_12\_10 # And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for [his] only [son], and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for [his] firstborn.

forborne to fight 24\_JER\_51\_30 # The mighty men of Babylon have forborne to fight, they have remained

in [their] holds: their might hath failed; they became as women: they have burned her dwellingplaces; her bars are broken.

homeborn and unto <u>02\_EXO\_12\_49</u># One law shall be to him that is homeborn, and unto the stranger that sojourneth among you.

homeborn slave why 24\_JER\_02\_14 # [Is] Israel a servant? [is] he a homeborn [slave]? why is he spoiled?

newborn babes desire <u>60\_1PE\_02\_02</u># As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:

stubborn and rebellious <u>05\_DEU\_21\_18</u># If a man have a stubborn and rebellious son, which will not obey the voice of his father, or the voice of his mother, and [that], when they have chastened him, will not hearken unto them:

stubborn and rebellious <u>05\_DEU\_21\_20</u> # And they shall say unto the elders of his city, This our son [is] stubborn and rebellious, he will not obey our voice; [he is] a glutton, and a drunkard.

stubborn and rebellious 19\_PSA\_78\_08 # And might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation; a generation [that] set not their heart aright, and whose spirit was not stedfast with God.

stubborn her feet 20\_PRO\_07\_11 # [She [is] loud and stubborn; her feet abide not in her house:

stubborn way <u>07\_JUD\_02\_19</u> # And it came to pass, when the judge was dead, [that] they returned, and corrupted [themselves] more than their fathers, in following other gods to serve them, and to bow down unto them; they ceased not from their own doings, nor from their stubborn way.

stubbornness is as <u>09 1SA 15 23</u> # For rebellion [is as] the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness [is as] iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from [being] king.

stubbornness of this <u>05\_DEU\_09\_27</u> # Remember thy servants, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; look not unto the stubbornness of this people, nor to their wickedness, nor to their sin:

suborned men which <u>44\_ACT\_06\_11</u># Then they suborned men, which said, We have heard him speak blasphemous words against Moses, and [against] God.
