

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

borrow and thou <u>05\_DEU\_15\_06</u># For the LORD thy God blesseth thee, as he promised thee: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, but thou shalt not borrow; and thou shalt reign over many nations, but they shall not reign over thee.

borrow not a 12\_2KI\_04\_03 # Then he said, Go, borrow thee vessels abroad of all thy neighbours, [even] empty vessels; borrow not a few.

borrow of her <u>02\_EXO\_03\_22</u> # But every woman shall borrow of her neighbour, and of her that sojourneth in her house, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment: and ye shall put [them] upon your sons, and upon your daughters; and ye shall spoil the Egyptians.

borrow of his <u>02\_EXO\_11\_02</u># Speak now in the ears of the people, and let every man borrow of his neighbour, and every woman of her neighbour, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold.

borrow of thee <u>40\_MAT\_05\_42</u># Give to him that asketh thee, and from him that would borrow of thee turn not thou away.

borrow ought of <u>02\_EXO\_22\_14</u># And if a man borrow [ought] of his neighbour, and it be hurt, or die, the owner thereof [being] not with it, he shall surely make [it] good.

borrow thee vessels <u>12\_2KI\_04\_03</u> # Then he said, Go, borrow thee vessels abroad of all thy neighbours, [even] empty vessels; borrow not a few.

borrow <u>05\_DEU\_28\_12</u> # The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.

borrowed money for <u>16\_NEH\_05\_04</u># There were also that said, We have borrowed money for the king's tribute, [and that upon] our lands and vineyards.

borrowed of the <u>02\_EXO\_12\_35</u># And the children of Israel did according to the word of Moses; and they borrowed of the Egyptians jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment:

borrowed 12\_2KI\_06\_05 # But as one was felling a beam, the ax head fell into the water: and he cried, and said, Alas, master! for it was borrowed.

borrower as with <u>23\_ISA\_24\_02</u> # And it shall be, as with the people, so with the priest; as with the servant, so with his master; as with the maid, so with her mistress; as with the buyer, so with the seller; as with the lender, so with the borrower; as with the taker of usury, so with the giver of usury to him.

borrower is servant <u>20\_PRO\_22\_07</u> # The rich ruleth over the poor, and the borrower [is] servant to the lender.

borroweth and payeth 19\_PSA\_37\_21 # The wicked borroweth, and payeth not again: but the righteous showeth mercy, and giveth.
