bough and an <u>23\_ISA\_17\_09</u> # In that day shall his strong cities be as a forsaken bough, and an uppermost branch, which they left because of the children of Israel: and there shall be desolation.

bough and followed <u>07\_JUD\_09\_49</u> # And all the people likewise cut down every man his bough, and followed Abimelech, and put [them] to the hold, and set the hold on fire upon them; so that all the men of the tower of Shechem died also, about a thousand men and women.

bough by a <u>01\_GEN\_49\_22</u> # Joseph [is] a fruitful bough, [even] a fruitful bough by a well; [whose] branches run over the wall:

bough with terror <u>23\_ISA\_10\_33</u> # Behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, shall lop the bough with terror: and the high ones of stature [shall be] hewn down, and the haughty shall be humbled.

boughs again it <u>05\_DEU\_24\_20</u> # When thou beatest thine olive tree, thou shalt not go over the boughs again: it shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow.

boughs and bear <u>26\_EZE\_17\_23</u> # In the mountain of the height of Israel will I plant it: and it shall bring forth boughs, and bear fruit, and be a goodly cedar: and under it shall dwell all fowl of every wing; in the shadow of the branches thereof shall they dwell.

boughs and his <u>26\_EZE\_31\_10</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thou hast lifted up thyself in height, and he hath shot up his top among the thick boughs, and his heart is lifted up in his height;

boughs and the <u>26\_EZE\_31\_08</u># The cedars in the garden of God could not hide him: the fir trees were not like his boughs, and the chestnut trees were not like his branches; nor any tree in the garden of God was like unto him in his beauty.

boughs and under <u>26\_EZE\_31\_06</u># All the fowls of heaven made their nests in his boughs, and under his branches did all the beasts of the field bring forth their young, and under his shadow dwelt all great nations.

boughs are broken <u>26\_EZE\_31\_12</u> # And strangers, the terrible of the nations, have cut him off, and have left him: upon the mountains and in all the valleys his branches are fallen, and his boughs are broken by all the rivers of the land; and all the people of the earth are gone down from his shadow, and have left him.

boughs like a <u>18\_JOB\_14\_09</u># [Yet] through the scent of water it will bud, and bring forth boughs like a

plant.

boughs neither their <u>26\_EZE\_31\_14</u># To the end that none of all the trees by the waters exalt themselves for their height, neither shoot up their top among the thick boughs, neither their trees stand up in their height, all that drink water: for they are all delivered unto death, to the nether parts of the earth, in the midst of the children of men, with them that go down to the pit.

boughs of a <u>10\_2SA\_18\_09</u># And Absalom met the servants of David. And Absalom rode upon a mule, and the mule went under the thick boughs of a great oak, and his head caught hold of the oak, and he was taken up between the heaven and the earth; and the mule that [was] under him went away.

boughs thereof now <u>22\_SON\_07\_08</u> # I said, I will go up to the palm tree, I will take hold of the boughs thereof: now also thy breasts shall be as clusters of the vine, and the smell of thy nose like apples;

boughs thereof were <u>19\_PSA\_80\_10</u># The hills were covered with the shadow of it, and the boughs thereof [were like] the goodly cedars.

boughs unto the <u>19\_PSA\_80\_11</u># She sent out her boughs unto the sea, and her branches unto the river.

boughs were multiplied <u>26\_EZE\_31\_05</u> # Therefore his height was exalted above all the trees of the field, and his boughs were multiplied, and his branches became long because of the multitude of waters, when he shot forth.

boughs <u>26\_EZE\_31\_03</u> # Behold, the Assyrian [was] a cedar in Lebanon with fair branches, and with a shadowing shroud, and of an high stature; and his top was among the thick boughs.

bought a parcel <u>01\_GEN\_33\_19</u># And he bought a parcel of a field, where he had spread his tent, at the hand of the children of Hamor, Shechem's father, for an hundred pieces of money.

bought a piece <u>42\_LUK\_14\_18</u> # And they all with one [consent] began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused.

bought all that <u>08\_RUT\_04\_09</u> # And Boaz said unto the elders, and [unto] all the people, Ye [are] witnesses this day, that I have bought all that [was] Elimelech's, and all that [was] Chilion's and Mahlon's, of the hand of Naomi.

bought all the <u>01\_GEN\_47\_20</u> # And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.

bought and Joseph <u>01\_GEN\_47\_14</u># And Joseph gathered up all the money that was found in the land of Egypt, and in the land of Canaan, for the corn which they bought: and Joseph brought the money into Pharaoh's house.

bought and nourished <u>10\_2SA\_12\_03</u> # But the poor [man] had nothing, save one little ewe lamb, which he had bought and nourished up: and it grew up together with him, and with his children; it did eat of his own meat, and drank of his own cup, and lay in his bosom, and was unto him as a daughter.

bought even to <u>03\_LEV\_27\_24</u> # In the year of the jubilee the field shall return unto him of whom it was bought, [even] to him to whom the possession of the land [did belong].

bought fine linen <u>41\_MAR\_15\_46</u> # And he bought fine linen, and took him down, and wrapped him in the linen, and laid him in a sepulchre which was hewn out of a rock, and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulchre.

bought five yoke <u>42\_LUK\_14\_19</u> # And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused.

bought for a <u>44\_ACT\_07\_16</u># And were carried over into Sychem, and laid in the sepulchre that Abraham bought for a sum of money of the sons of Emmor [the father] of Sychem.

bought for money <u>02\_EXO\_12\_44</u> # But every man's servant that is bought for money, when thou hast circumcised him, then shall he eat thereof.

bought for <u>03\_LEV\_25\_51</u># If [there be] yet many years [behind], according unto them he shall give again the price of his redemption out of the money that he was bought for.

bought he not <u>01\_GEN\_47\_22</u># Only the land of the priests bought he not; for the priests had a portion [assigned them] of Pharaoh, and did eat their portion which Pharaoh gave them: wherefore they sold not their lands.

bought her to <u>28\_HOS\_03\_02</u># So I bought her to me for fifteen [pieces] of silver, and [for] an homer of barley, and an half homer of barley:

bought him from <u>03\_LEV\_25\_50</u> # And he shall reckon with him that bought him from the year that he was sold to him unto the year of jubilee: and the price of his sale shall be according unto the number of years, according to the time of an hired servant shall it be with him.

bought him of <u>01\_GEN\_39\_01</u># And Joseph was brought down to Egypt; and Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh, captain of the guard, an Egyptian, bought him of the hands of the Ishmeelites, which had brought him down thither.

bought in the <u>41\_MAR\_11\_15</u># And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves;

bought in the <u>40\_MAT\_21\_12</u># And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves,

bought in this <u>24\_JER\_32\_43</u> # And fields shall be bought in this land, whereof ye say, [It is] desolate without man or beast; it is given into the hand of the Chaldeans.

bought it throughout <u>03\_LEV\_25\_30</u> # And if it be not redeemed within the space of a full year, then the house that [is] in the walled city shall be established for ever to him that bought it throughout his generations: it shall not go out in the jubilee.

bought it until <u>03\_LEV\_25\_28</u> # But if he be not able to restore [it] to him, then that which is sold shall remain in the hand of him that hath bought it until the year of jubilee: and in the jubilee it shall go out, and he shall return unto his possession.

bought it <u>40 MAT\_13\_46</u># Who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had, and bought it.

bought me no <u>23\_ISA\_43\_24</u># Thou hast bought me no sweet cane with money, neither hast thou filled me with the fat of thy sacrifices: but thou hast made me to serve with thy sins, thou hast wearied me with thine iniquities.

bought of the <u>06\_JOS\_24\_32</u> # And the bones of Joseph, which the children of Israel brought up out of Egypt, buried they in Shechem, in a parcel of ground which Jacob bought of the sons of Hamor the father of Shechem for an hundred pieces of silver: and it became the inheritance of the children of Joseph.

bought sweet spices <u>41\_MAR\_16\_01</u> # And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the [mother] of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him.

bought the field <u>24\_JER\_32\_09</u> # And I bought the field of Hanameel my uncle's son, that [was] in Anathoth, and weighed him the money, [even] seventeen shekels of silver.

bought the hill <u>11\_1KI\_16\_24</u># And he bought the hill Samaria of Shemer for two talents of silver, and built on the hill, and called the name of the city which he built, after the name of Shemer, owner of the hill, Samaria.

bought the threshingfloor <u>10\_28A\_24\_24</u> # And the king said unto Araunah, Nay; but I will surely buy [it] of thee at a price: neither will I offer burnt offerings unto the LORD my God of that which doth cost me nothing. So David bought the threshingfloor and the oxen for fifty shekels of silver.

bought thee hath <u>05\_DEU\_32\_06</u># Do ye thus requite the LORD, O foolish people and unwise? [is] not he thy father [that] hath bought thee? hath he not made thee, and established thee?

bought them and <u>61\_2PE\_02\_01</u> # But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

bought they sold <u>42\_LUK\_17\_28</u> # Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded;

bought we any <u>16\_NEH\_05\_16</u># Yea, also I continued in the work of this wall, neither bought we any land: and all my servants [were] gathered thither unto the work.

bought which is <u>03\_LEV\_27\_22</u> # And if [a man] sanctify unto the LORD a field which he hath bought, which [is] not of the fields of his possession;

bought with a <u>46\_1CO\_06\_20</u> # For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

bought with a <u>46\_1CO\_07\_23</u> # Ye are bought with a price; be not ye the servants of men.

bought with his <u>01\_GEN\_17\_23</u># And Abraham took Ishmael his son, and all that were born in his house, and all that were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham's house; and circumcised the flesh of their foreskin in the selfsame day, as God had said unto him.

bought with money <u>01\_GEN\_17\_12</u> # And he that is eight days old shall be circumcised among you, every man child in your generations, he that is born in the house, or bought with money of any stranger, which [is] not of thy seed.

bought with money <u>01\_GEN\_17\_27</u># And all the men of his house, born in the house, and bought with money of the stranger, were circumcised with him.

bought with the <u>01\_GEN\_49\_30</u> # In the cave that [is] in the field of Machpelah, which [is] before Mamre, in the land of Canaan, which Abraham bought with the field of Ephron the Hittite for a possession of a buryingplace.

bought with the <u>01\_GEN\_50\_13</u> # For his sons carried him into the land of Canaan, and buried him in the cave of the field of Machpelah, which Abraham bought with the field for a possession of a buryingplace of Ephron the Hittite, before Mamre.

bought with them <u>40\_MAT\_27\_07</u># And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.

bought with thy <u>01\_GEN\_17\_13</u> # He that is born in thy house, and he that is bought with thy money, must needs be circumcised: and my covenant shall be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant.

bought you this <u>01\_GEN\_47\_23</u># Then Joseph said unto the people, Behold, I have bought you this day and your land for Pharaoh: lo, [here is] seed for you, and ye shall sow the land.

bought <u>42\_LUK\_19\_45</u> # And he went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold therein, and them that bought;
