brass and committed 14_2CH_12_10 # Instead of which king Rehoboam made shields of brass, and committed [them] to the hands of the chief of the guard, that kept the entrance of the king's house.

brass in abundance 13_1CH_22_03 # And David prepared iron in abundance for the nails for the doors of

the gates, and for the joinings; and brass in abundance without weight;

brass in iron 14_2CH_02_14 # The son of a woman of the daughters of Dan, and his father [was] a man of Tyre, skilful to work in gold, and in silver, in brass, in iron, in stone, and in timber, in purple, in blue, and in fine linen, and in crimson; also to grave any manner of graving, and to find out every device which shall be put to him, with thy cunning men, and with the cunning men of my lord David thy father.

brass twenty cubits <u>14_2CH_04_01</u> # Moreover he made an altar of brass, twenty cubits the length thereof, and twenty cubits the breadth thereof, and ten cubits the height thereof.

brass upon his <u>09_1SA_17_38</u># And Saul armed David with his armour, and he put an helmet of brass upon his head; also he armed him with a coat of mail.

brass was upon 24_JER_52_22 # And a chapiter of brass [was] upon it; and the height of one chapiter [was] five cubits, with network and pomegranates upon the chapiters round about, all [of] brass. The second pillar also and the pomegranates [were] like unto these.

brass wherewith Solomon <u>13_1CH_18_08</u># Likewise from Tibhath, and from Chun, cities of Hadarezer, brought David very much brass, wherewith Solomon made the brazen sea, and the pillars, and the vessels of brass.

brass wherewith they 12_2KI_25_14 # And the pots, and the shovels, and the snuffers, and the spoons, and all the vessels of brass wherewith they ministered, took they away.

brass wherewith they <u>24_JER_52_18</u># The caldrons also, and the shovels, and the snuffers, and the bowls, and the spoons, and all the vessels of brass wherewith they ministered, took they away.

brass which devoured <u>27_DAN_07_19</u># Then I would know the truth of the fourth beast, which was diverse from all the others, exceeding dreadful, whose teeth [were of] iron, and his nails [of] brass; [which] devoured, brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with his feet;

brass which shall <u>27_DAN_02_39</u># And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee, and another third kingdom of brass, which shall bear rule over all the earth.

brass 11_1KI_07_45 # And the pots, and the shovels, and the basins: and all these vessels, which Hiram made to king Solomon for the house of the LORD, [were of] bright brass.

brass <u>09_1SA_17_05</u> # And [he had] an helmet of brass upon his head, and he [was] armed with a coat of mail; and the weight of the coat [was] five thousand shekels of brass.

brass <u>14_2CH_04_09</u> # Furthermore he made the court of the priests, and the great court, and doors for the court, and overlaid the doors of them with brass.

and all the pins of the court, [shall be of] brass.

brass 02_EXO_31_04 # To devise cunning works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass,

brass <u>02_EXO_35_05</u> # Take ye from among you an offering unto the LORD: whosoever [is] of a willing heart, let him bring it, an offering of the LORD; gold, and silver, and brass,

brass 02_EXO_35_32 # And to devise curious works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass,

brass <u>02_EXO_36_38</u> # And the five pillars of it with their hooks: and he overlaid their chapiters and their fillets with gold: but their five sockets [were of] brass.

brass <u>02_EXO_38_02</u> # And he made the horns thereof on the four corners of it; the horns thereof were of the same: and he overlaid it with brass.

brass <u>26_EZE_01_07</u># And their feet [were] straight feet; and the sole of their feet [was] like the sole of a calf's foot: and they sparkled like the colour of burnished brass.

brass <u>23_ISA_48_04</u> # Because I knew that thou [art] obstinate, and thy neck [is] an iron sinew, and thy brow brass;

brass 18_JOB_06_12 # [Is] my strength the strength of stones? or [is] my flesh of brass?

brass <u>03_LEV_26_19</u> # And I will break the pride of your power; and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass:

brass <u>66_REV_02_18</u> # And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet [are] like fine brass;
