bread according to <u>01_GEN_47_12</u> # And Joseph nourished his father, and his brethren, and all his father's household, with bread, according to [their] families.

bread after that 43_JOH_06_23 # [Howbeit there came other boats from Tiberias nigh unto the place where they did eat bread, after that the Lord had given thanks:]

bread again by <u>03 LEV_26_26</u> # [And] when I have broken the staff of your bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall deliver [you] your bread again by weight: and ye shall eat, and not be satisfied.

bread all the <u>09_1SA_28_20</u># Then Saul fell straightway all along on the earth, and was sore afraid, because of the words of Samuel: and there was no strength in him; for he had eaten no bread all the day, nor all the night.

bread alone but 42_LUK_04_04 # And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.

bread alone but 40_MAT_04_04# But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

bread also can <u>19_PSA_78_20</u> # Behold, he smote the rock, that the waters gushed out, and the streams overflowed; can he give bread also? can he provide flesh for his people?

bread and in 44_ACT_02_42 # And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

bread till thou <u>01_GEN_03_19</u># In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou [art], and unto dust shalt thou return.

bread to eat <u>01_GEN_28_20</u># And Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on,

bread to eat <u>20_PRO_25_21</u># If thine enemy be hungry, give him bread to eat; and if he be thirsty, give him water to drink:

bread to slay 26 EZE 13 19 # And will ye pollute me among my people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, to slay the souls that should not die, and to save the souls alive that should not live, by your lying to my people that hear [your] lies?

bread to the <u>21_ECC_09_11</u># I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race [is] not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of understanding, nor yet favour to men of skill; but time and chance happeneth to them all.

bread upon the <u>23_ISA_44_19</u> # And none considereth in his heart, neither [is there] knowledge nor understanding to say, I have burned part of it in the fire; yea, also I have baked bread upon the coals thereof; I have roasted flesh, and eaten [it]: and shall I make the residue thereof an abomination? shall I fall down to the stock of a tree?

bread we took <u>06_JOS_09_12</u> # This our bread we took hot [for] our provision out of our houses on the day we came forth to go unto you; but now, behold, it is dry, and it is mouldy:

bread when the <u>42_LUK_22_07</u># Then came the day of unleavened bread, when the passover must be killed.

bread with defiled 41_MAR_07_02 # And when they saw some of his disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault.

showbread and for <u>16 NEH 10 33 #</u> For the showbread, and for the continual meat offering, and for the continual burnt offering, of the sabbaths, of the new moons, for the set feasts, and for the holy [things], and for the sin offerings to make an atonement for Israel, and [for] all the work of the house of our God.

showbread and gave <u>42_LUK_06_04</u># How he went into the house of God, and did take and eat the showbread, and gave also to them that were with him; which it is not lawful to eat but for the priests alone?

showbread before me 02_EXO_25_30 # And thou shalt set upon the table showbread before me alway.

showbread for every <u>13_1CH_28_16</u> # And by weight [he gave] gold for the tables of showbread, for every table; and [likewise] silver for the tables of silver:

showbread table with 14_2CH_29_18 # Then they went in to Hezekiah the king, and said, We have cleansed all the house of the LORD, and the altar of burnt offering, with all the vessels thereof, and the showbread table, with all the vessels thereof.

showbread that was <u>09_1SA_21_06</u># So the priest gave him hallowed [bread]: for there was no bread there but the showbread, that was taken from before the LORD, to put hot bread in the day when it was taken away.

showbread they shall <u>04_NUM_04_07</u> # And upon the table of showbread they shall spread a cloth of blue, and put thereon the dishes, and the spoons, and the bowls, and covers to cover withal: and the continual bread shall be thereon:

showbread which was 40_MAT_12_04# How he entered into the house of God, and did eat the showbread, which was not lawful for him to eat, neither for them which were with him, but only for the priests?
