bring a blind <u>41_MAR_08_22</u> # And he cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto him, and besought him to touch him.

bring a city <u>20_PRO_29_08</u># Scornful men bring a city into a snare: but wise [men] turn away wrath.

bring a clean <u>18_JOB_14_04</u> # Who can bring a clean [thing] out of an unclean? not one.

bring a cloud <u>01_GEN_09_14</u># And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud:

bring a curse <u>01_GEN_27_12</u> # My father peradventure will feel me, and I shall seem to him as a deceiver; and I shall bring a curse upon me, and not a blessing.

bring a fear <u>24_JER_49_05</u># Behold, I will bring a fear upon thee, saith the Lord GOD of hosts, from all those that be about thee; and ye shall be driven out every man right forth; and none shall gather up him that wandereth.

bring a flood <u>01_GEN_06_17</u># And, behold, I, even I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein [is] the breath of life, from under heaven; [and] every thing that [is] in the earth shall die.

bring a lamb <u>03_LEV_04_32</u># And if he bring a lamb for a sin offering, he shall bring it a female without blemish.

bring a lamb <u>03 LEV 05 07</u> # And if he be not able to bring a lamb, then he shall bring for his trespass, which he hath committed, two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, unto the LORD; one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering.

bring a lamb <u>03_LEV_12_06</u># And when the days of her purifying are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall bring a lamb of the first year for a burnt offering, and a young pigeon, or a turtledove, for a sin offering, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, unto the priest:

bring a lamb <u>03_LEV_12_08</u># And if she be not able to bring a lamb, then she shall bring two turtles, or two young pigeons; the one for the burnt offering, and the other for a sin offering: and the priest shall make an atonement for her, and she shall be clean.

bring a lamb <u>04_NUM_06_12</u> # And he shall consecrate unto the LORD the days of his separation, and shall bring a lamb of the first year for a trespass offering: but the days that were before shall be lost, because his separation was defiled.

bring a meat <u>04_NUM_15_04</u> # Then shall he that offereth his offering unto the LORD bring a meat offering of a tenth deal of flour mingled with the fourth [part] of an hin of oil.

bring a nation <u>05_DEU_28_49</u># The LORD shall bring a nation against thee from far, from the end of the earth, [as swift] as the eagle flieth; a nation whose tongue thou shalt not understand;

bring a nation <u>24_JER_05_15</u> # Lo, I will bring a nation upon you from far, O house of Israel, saith the LORD: it [is] a mighty nation, it [is] an ancient nation, a nation whose language thou knowest not, neither understandest what they say.

bring a new <u>04_NUM_28_26</u> # Also in the day of the firstfruits, when ye bring a new meat offering unto the LORD, after your weeks [be out], ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work:

bring a ram <u>03_LEV_05_18</u># And he shall bring a ram without blemish out of the flock, with thy estimation, for a trespass offering, unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his ignorance wherein he erred and wist [it] not, and it shall be forgiven him.

bring a she <u>04_NUM_15_27</u># And if any soul sin through ignorance, then he shall bring a she goat of the first year for a sin offering.

bring a sheaf <u>03 LEV 23 10</u> # Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest:

bring a sword <u>26_EZE_06_03</u># And say, Ye mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Lord GOD; Thus saith the Lord GOD to the mountains, and to the hills, to the rivers, and to the valleys; Behold, I, [even] I, will bring a sword upon you, and I will destroy your high places.

bring a sword <u>26_EZE_11_08</u># Ye have feared the sword; and I will bring a sword upon you, saith the Lord GOD.

bring a sword <u>26 EZE 14 17</u> # Or [if] I bring a sword upon that land, and say, Sword, go through the land; so that I cut off man and beast from it:

bring a sword <u>26_EZE_29_08</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will bring a sword upon thee, and cut off man and beast out of thee.

bring a sword <u>03_LEV_26_25</u> # And I will bring a sword upon you, that shall avenge the quarrel of [my] covenant: and when ye are gathered together within your cities, I will send the pestilence among you; and ye shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy.

bring a thousand <u>22_SON_08_11</u># Solomon had a vineyard at Baalhamon; he let out the vineyard unto keepers; every one for the fruit thereof was to bring a thousand [pieces] of silver.

bring a troop <u>24_JER_18_22</u> # Let a cry be heard from their houses, when thou shalt bring a troop suddenly upon them: for they have digged a pit to take me, and hid snares for my feet.

bring Aaron and <u>02_EXO_40_12</u># And thou shalt bring Aaron and his sons unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and wash them with water.

Bring Aaron's rod <u>04_NUM_17_10</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, Bring Aaron's rod again before the testimony, to be kept for a token against the rebels; and thou shalt quite take away their murmurings from me, that they die not.

bring about all <u>10_2SA_03_12</u> # And Abner sent messengers to David on his behalf, saying, Whose [is] the land? saying [also], Make thy league with me, and, behold, my hand [shall be] with thee, to bring about all Israel unto thee.

bring again from <u>19_PSA_68_22</u> # The Lord said, I will bring again from Bashan, I will bring [my people] again from the depths of the sea:

bring again into <u>24_JER_28_03</u> # Within two full years will I bring again into this place all the vessels of the LORD'S house, that Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took away from this place, and carried them to Babylon:

bring again that <u>26_EZE_34_16</u># I will seek that which was lost, and bring again that which was driven away, and will bind up [that which was] broken, and will strengthen that which was sick: but I will destroy the fat and the strong; I will feed them with judgment.

bring again the <u>13_1CH_13_03</u># And let us bring again the ark of our God to us: for we inquired not at it in the days of Saul.

bring again the <u>30_AMO_09_14</u># And I will bring again the captivity of my people of Israel, and they shall build the waste cities, and inhabit [them]; and they shall plant vineyards, and drink the wine thereof; they shall also make gardens, and eat the fruit of them.

bring again the <u>26_EZE_16_53</u># When I shall bring again their captivity, the captivity of Sodom and her daughters, and the captivity of Samaria and her daughters, then [will I bring again] the captivity of thy captives in the midst of them:

bring again the <u>26_EZE_29_14</u># And I will bring again the captivity of Egypt, and will cause them to return [into] the land of Pathros, into the land of their habitation; and they shall be there a base kingdom.

bring again the <u>26 EZE 39 25</u> # Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have mercy upon the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for my holy name;

bring again the <u>23_ISA_38_08</u> # Behold, I will bring again the shadow of the degrees, which is gone down in the sun dial of Ahaz, ten degrees backward. So the sun returned ten degrees, by which degrees it was gone down.

bring again the <u>24_JER_28_06</u># Even the prophet Jeremiah said, Amen: the LORD do so: the LORD perform thy words which thou hast prophesied, to bring again the vessels of the LORD'S house, and all that is carried away captive, from Babylon into this place.

bring again the <u>24_JER_30_03</u># For, lo, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will bring again the captivity of my people Israel and Judah, saith the LORD: and I will cause them to return to the land that I gave to their fathers, and they shall possess it.

bring again the <u>24_JER_30_18</u># Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will bring again the captivity of Jacob's tents, and have mercy on his dwellingplaces; and the city shall be builded upon her own heap, and the palace shall remain after the manner thereof.

bring again the <u>24_JER_48_47</u> # Yet will I bring again the captivity of Moab in the latter days, saith the LORD. Thus far [is] the judgment of Moab.

bring again the <u>24_JER_49_06</u># And afterward I will bring again the captivity of the children of Ammon, saith the LORD.

bring again the <u>24_JER_49_39</u># But it shall come to pass in the latter days, [that] I will bring again the captivity of Elam, saith the LORD.

bring again the <u>29_JOE_03_01</u># For, behold, in those days, and in that time, when I shall bring again the captivity of Judah and Jerusalem,

bring again their <u>26_EZE_16_53</u># When I shall bring again their captivity, the captivity of Sodom and her daughters, and the captivity of Samaria and her daughters, then [will I bring again] the captivity of thy captives in the midst of them:

bring again their 24_JER_31_23 # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; As yet they shall use

this speech in the land of Judah and in the cities thereof, when I shall bring again their captivity; The LORD bless thee, O habitation of justice, [and] mountain of holiness.

bring again to <u>13_1CH_21_12</u> # Either three years' famine; or three months to be destroyed before thy foes, while that the sword of thine enemies overtaketh [thee]; or else three days the sword of the LORD, even the pestilence, in the land, and the angel of the LORD destroying throughout all the coasts of Israel. Now therefore advise thyself what word I shall bring again to him that sent me.

bring again to <u>24_JER_28_04</u> # And I will bring again to this place Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, with all the captives of Judah, that went into Babylon, saith the LORD: for I will break the yoke of the king of Babylon.

bring again Zion <u>23_ISA_52_08</u># Thy watchmen shall lift up the voice; with the voice together shall they sing: for they shall see eye to eye, when the LORD shall bring again Zion.

bring against him <u>65_JDE_01_09</u> # Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.

bring all that <u>05_DEU_12_11</u># Then there shall be a place which the LORD your God shall choose to cause his name to dwell there; thither shall ye bring all that I command you; your burnt offerings, and your sacrifices, your tithes, and the heave offering of your hand, and all your choice vows which ye vow unto the LORD:

bring all things <u>43_JOH_14_26</u> # But the Comforter, [which is] the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

bring all this <u>16_NEH_13_18</u># Did not your fathers thus, and did not our God bring all this evil upon us, and upon this city? yet ye bring more wrath upon Israel by profaning the sabbath.

bring all your <u>23_ISA_66_20</u> # And they shall bring all your brethren [for] an offering unto the LORD out of all nations upon horses, and in chariots, and in litters, and upon mules, and upon swift beasts, to my holy mountain Jerusalem, saith the LORD, as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the house of the LORD.

bring alms to <u>44_ACT_24_17</u> # Now after many years I came to bring alms to my nation, and offerings.

bring an abomination <u>05_DEU_07_26</u> # Neither shalt thou bring an abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it: [but] thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for it [is] a cursed thing.

bring an everlasting <u>24_JER_23_40</u> # And I will bring an everlasting reproach upon you, and a perpetual shame, which shall not be forgotten.

bring an heir <u>33_MIC_01_15</u># Yet will I bring an heir unto thee, O inhabitant of Mareshah: he shall come unto Adullam the glory of Israel.

bring an oblation <u>03_LEV_02_04</u> # And if thou bring an oblation of a meat offering baken in the oven, [it shall be] unleavened cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, or unleavened wafers anointed with oil.

bring an offering <u>13_1CH_16_29</u># Give unto the LORD the glory [due] unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

bring an offering <u>23_ISA_66_20</u> # And they shall bring all your brethren [for] an offering unto the LORD out of all nations upon horses, and in chariots, and in litters, and upon mules, and upon swift beasts, to my

holy mountain Jerusalem, saith the LORD, as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the house of the LORD.

bring an offering <u>03_LEV_01_02</u># Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, If any man of you bring an offering unto the LORD, ye shall bring your offering of the cattle, [even] of the herd, and of the flock.

bring an offering <u>03_LEV_27_09</u> # And if [it be] a beast, whereof men bring an offering unto the LORD, all that [any man] giveth of such unto the LORD shall be holy.

bring an offering <u>19_PSA_96_08</u> # Give unto the LORD the glory [due unto] his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts.

Bring and let <u>30_AMO_04_01</u> # Hear this word, ye kine of Bashan, that [are] in the mountain of Samaria, which oppress the poor, which crush the needy, which say to their masters, Bring, and let us drink.

bring and they <u>43_JOH_10_16</u># And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, [and] one shepherd.

bring back all <u>10_2SA_17_03</u># And I will bring back all the people unto thee: the man whom thou seekest [is] as if all returned: [so] all the people shall be in peace.

bring back his <u>18_JOB_33_30</u># To bring back his soul from the pit, to be enlightened with the light of the living.

bring back the <u>10_2SA_19_12</u> # Ye [are] my brethren, ye [are] my bones and my flesh: wherefore then are ye the last to bring back the king?

bring cedar trees <u>15_EZR_03_07</u> # They gave money also unto the masons, and to the carpenters; and meat, and drink, and oil, unto them of Zidon, and to them of Tyre, to bring cedar trees from Lebanon to the sea of Joppa, according to the grant that they had of Cyrus king of Persia.

bring certain of <u>27_DAN_01_03</u># And the king spake unto Ashpenaz the master of his eunuchs, that he should bring [certain] of the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes;

bring Christ down <u>45_ROM_10_06</u># But the righteousness which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? [that is, to bring Christ down [from above]:]

bring distress upon <u>36_ZEP_01_17</u> # And I will bring distress upon men, that they shall walk like blind men, because they have sinned against the LORD: and their blood shall be poured out as dust, and their flesh as the dung.

bring down high <u>19_PSA_18_27</u># For thou wilt save the afflicted people; but wilt bring down high looks.

bring down lay <u>23_ISA_25_12</u># And the fortress of the high fort of thy walls shall he bring down, lay low, [and] bring to the ground, [even] to the dust.

bring down my <u>01_GEN_42_38</u> # And he said, My son shall not go down with you; for his brother is dead, and he is left alone: if mischief befall him by the way in the which ye go, then shall ye bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave.

bring down my <u>01_GEN_44_29</u> # And if ye take this also from me, and mischief befall him, ye shall bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave.

bring down my <u>01_GEN_45_13</u># And ye shall tell my father of all my glory in Egypt, and of all that ye

have seen; and ye shall haste and bring down my father hither.

bring down Paul <u>44_ACT_23_20</u># And he said, The Jews have agreed to desire thee that thou wouldest bring down Paul to morrow into the council, as though they would inquire somewhat of him more perfectly.

bring down the <u>05_DEU_21_04</u> # And the elders of that city shall bring down the heifer unto a rough valley, which is neither eared nor sown, and shall strike off the heifer's neck there in the valley:

bring down the <u>01_GEN_44_31</u> # It shall come to pass, when he seeth that the lad [is] not [with us], that he will die: and thy servants shall bring down the gray hairs of thy servant our father with sorrow to the grave.

bring down the <u>23_ISA_25_05</u> # Thou shalt bring down the noise of strangers, as the heat in a dry place; [even] the heat with the shadow of a cloud: the branch of the terrible ones shall be brought low.

bring down their <u>23_ISA_25_11</u># And he shall spread forth his hands in the midst of them, as he that swimmeth spreadeth forth [his hands] to swim: and he shall bring down their pride together with the spoils of their hands.

bring down their <u>23_ISA_63_06</u># And I will tread down the people in mine anger, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth.

bring down thy <u>30_AMO_03_11</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; An adversary [there shall be] even round about the land; and he shall bring down thy strength from thee, and thy palaces shall be spoiled.

bring every work <u>21_ECC_12_14</u> # For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether [it be] good, or whether [it be] evil.

bring evil and <u>23_ISA_31_02</u> # Yet he also [is] wise, and will bring evil, and will not call back his words: but will arise against the house of the evildoers, and against the help of them that work iniquity.

bring evil from <u>24_JER_04_06</u># Set up the standard toward Zion: retire, stay not: for I will bring evil from the north, and a great destruction.

bring evil on 24_JER_25_29 # For, lo, I begin to bring evil on the city which is called by my name, and should ye be utterly unpunished? Ye shall not be unpunished: for I will call for a sword upon all the inhabitants of the earth, saith the LORD of hosts.

bring evil upon <u>11_1KI_14_10</u># Therefore, behold, I will bring evil upon the house of Jeroboam, and will cut off from Jeroboam him that pisseth against the wall, [and] him that is shut up and left in Israel, and will take away the remnant of the house of Jeroboam, as a man taketh away dung, till it be all gone.

bring evil upon <u>11_1KI_21_21</u># Behold, I will bring evil upon thee, and will take away thy posterity, and will cut off from Ahab him that pisseth against the wall, and him that is shut up and left in Israel,

bring evil upon <u>14_2CH_34_24</u> # Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, and upon the inhabitants thereof, [even] all the curses that are written in the book which they have read before the king of Judah:

bring evil upon <u>12_2KI_22_16</u># Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, and upon the inhabitants thereof, [even] all the words of the book which the king of Judah hath read:

bring evil upon <u>10_2SA_15_14</u> # And David said unto all his servants that [were] with him at Jerusalem, Arise, and let us flee; for we shall not [else] escape from Absalom: make speed to depart, lest he overtake us suddenly, and bring evil upon us, and smite the city with the edge of the sword. bring evil upon <u>10_2SA_17_14</u># And Absalom and all the men of Israel said, The counsel of Hushai the Archite [is] better than the counsel of Ahithophel. For the LORD had appointed to defeat the good counsel of Ahithophel, to the intent that the LORD might bring evil upon Absalom.

bring evil upon <u>24_JER_06_19</u># Hear, O earth: behold, I will bring evil upon this people, [even] the fruit of their thoughts, because they have not hearkened unto my words, nor to my law, but rejected it.

bring evil upon <u>24_JER_11_11</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will bring evil upon them, which they shall not be able to escape; and though they shall cry unto me, I will not hearken unto them.

bring evil upon <u>24_JER_11_23</u># And there shall be no remnant of them: for I will bring evil upon the men of Anathoth, [even] the year of their visitation.

bring evil upon <u>24_JER_19_03</u># And say, Hear ye the word of the LORD, O kings of Judah, and inhabitants of Jerusalem; Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, the which whosoever heareth, his ears shall tingle.

bring evil upon <u>24_JER_23_12</u># Wherefore their way shall be unto them as slippery [ways] in the darkness: they shall be driven on, and fall therein: for I will bring evil upon them, [even] the year of their visitation, saith the LORD.

bring evil upon <u>24_JER_45_05</u> # And seekest thou great things for thyself? seek [them] not: for, behold, I will bring evil upon all flesh, saith the LORD: but thy life will I give unto thee for a prey in all places whither thou goest.

bring evil upon 24_JER_49_37 # For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies, and before them that seek their life: and I will bring evil upon them, [even] my fierce anger, saith the LORD; and I will send the sword after them, till I have consumed them:

bring for a <u>04_NUM_15_10</u># And thou shalt bring for a drink offering half an hin of wine, [for] an offering made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

bring for all <u>02_EXO_35_29</u> # The children of Israel brought a willing offering unto the LORD, every man and woman, whose heart made them willing to bring for all manner of work, which the LORD had commanded to be made by the hand of Moses.

bring for his <u>03_LEV_04_03</u> # If the priest that is anointed do sin according to the sin of the people; then let him bring for his sin, which he hath sinned, a young bullock without blemish unto the LORD for a sin offering.

bring for his <u>03_LEV_05_07</u> # And if he be not able to bring a lamb, then he shall bring for his trespass, which he hath committed, two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, unto the LORD; one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering.

bring for his <u>03_LEV_05_11</u># But if he be not able to bring two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, then he that sinned shall bring for his offering the tenth part of an ephah of fine flour for a sin offering; he shall put no oil upon it, neither shall he put [any] frankincense thereon: for it [is] a sin offering.

bring for his <u>03_LEV_05_15</u> # If a soul commit a trespass, and sin through ignorance, in the holy things of the LORD; then he shall bring for his trespass unto the LORD a ram without blemish out of the flocks, with thy estimation by shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for a trespass offering:

bring forth a <u>26_EZE_28_18</u># Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffic; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I

will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee.

bring forth a <u>23_ISA_65_09</u> # And I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and out of Judah an inheritor of my mountains: and mine elect shall inherit it, and my servants shall dwell there.

bring forth a <u>42_LUK_01_31</u># And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.

bring forth a <u>40_MAT_01_21</u># And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

bring forth a <u>40_MAT_01_23</u># Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.

bring forth abundantly <u>01_GEN_01_20</u> # And God said, Let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, and fowl [that] may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.

bring forth abundantly <u>01_GEN_09_07</u> # And you, be ye fruitful, and multiply; bring forth abundantly in the earth, and multiply therein.

bring forth all <u>05_DEU_14_28</u># At the end of three years thou shalt bring forth all the tithe of thine increase the same year, and shalt lay [it] up within thy gates:

bring forth and <u>23_ISA_55_10</u># For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:

bring forth and <u>23_ISA_66_09</u># Shall I bring to the birth, and not cause to bring forth? saith the LORD: shall I cause to bring forth, and shut [the womb]? saith thy God.

bring forth before <u>36_ZEP_02_02</u># Before the decree bring forth, [before] the day pass as the chaff, before the fierce anger of the LORD come upon you, before the day of the LORD'S anger come upon you.

bring forth boughs <u>26_EZE_17_23</u># In the mountain of the height of Israel will I plant it: and it shall bring forth boughs, and bear fruit, and be a goodly cedar: and under it shall dwell all fowl of every wing; in the shadow of the branches thereof shall they dwell.

bring forth boughs <u>18_JOB_14_09</u> # [Yet] through the scent of water it will bud, and bring forth boughs like a plant.

bring forth branches <u>26_EZE_17_08</u># It was planted in a good soil by great waters, that it might bring forth branches, and that it might bear fruit, that it might be a goodly vine.

bring forth by <u>15_EZR_01_08</u># Even those did Cyrus king of Persia bring forth by the hand of Mithredath the treasurer, and numbered them unto Sheshbazzar, the prince of Judah.

bring forth children <u>01_GEN_03_16</u># Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire [shall be] to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

bring forth children 23_ISA_23_04 # Be thou ashamed, O Zidon: for the sea hath spoken, [even] the strength of the sea, saying, I travail not, nor bring forth children, neither do I nourish up young men, [nor] bring up virgins.

bring his wife <u>04_NUM_05_15</u> # Then shall the man bring his wife unto the priest, and he shall bring her offering for her, the tenth [part] of an ephah of barley meal; he shall pour no oil upon it, nor put frankincense thereon; for it [is] an offering of jealousy, an offering of memorial, bringing iniquity to remembrance.

Bring hither a <u>09_1SA_13_09</u> # And Saul said, Bring hither a burnt offering to me, and peace offerings. And he offered the burnt offering.

bring hither and <u>42_LUK_19_27</u># But those mine enemies, which would not that I should reign over them, bring hither, and slay [them] before me.

Bring hither the <u>09_1SA_14_18</u># And Saul said unto Ahiah, Bring hither the ark of God. For the ark of God was at that time with the children of Israel.

Bring hither the <u>09_1SA_23_09</u> # And David knew that Saul secretly practiced mischief against him; and he said to Abiathar the priest, Bring hither the ephod.

bring hither the <u>42_LUK_15_23</u># And bring hither the fatted calf, and kill [it]; and let us eat, and be merry:

bring hither the <u>19_PSA_81_02</u># Take a psalm, and bring hither the timbrel, the pleasant harp with the psaltery.

bring home thy <u>18_JOB_39_12</u># Wilt thou believe him, that he will bring home thy seed, and gather [it into] thy barn?

bring in all <u>27_DAN_04_06</u> # Therefore made I a decree to bring in all the wise [men] of Babylon before me, that they might make known unto me the interpretation of the dream.

bring in and <u>02_EXO_16_05</u># And it shall come to pass, that on the sixth day they shall prepare [that] which they bring in; and it shall be twice as much as they gather daily.

bring in and <u>04_NUM_14_31</u># But your little ones, which ye said should be a prey, them will I bring in, and they shall know the land which ye have despised.

bring out the <u>30_AMO_06_10</u> # And a man's uncle shall take him up, and he that burneth him, to bring out the bones out of the house, and shall say unto him that [is] by the sides of the house, [Is there] yet [any] with thee? and he shall say, No. Then shall he say, Hold thy tongue: for we may not make mention of the name of the LORD.

bring out the <u>05_DEU_22_21</u> # Then they shall bring out the damsel to the door of her father's house, and the men of her city shall stone her with stones that she die: because she hath wrought folly in Israel, to play the whore in her father's house: so shalt thou put evil away from among you.

bring out the <u>05_DEU_24_11</u># Thou shalt stand abroad, and the man to whom thou dost lend shall bring out the pledge abroad unto thee.

Bring out the <u>02_EXO_06_26</u># These [are] that Aaron and Moses, to whom the LORD said, Bring out the children of Israel from the land of Egypt according to their armies.

bring out the <u>02_EXO_06_27</u># These [are] they which spake to Pharaoh king of Egypt, to bring out the children of Israel from Egypt: these [are] that Moses and Aaron.

bring out the <u>02_EXO_07_05</u> # And the Egyptians shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I stretch forth mine hand upon Egypt, and bring out the children of Israel from among them.

bring out the <u>23_ISA_42_07</u> # To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, [and] them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

bring out the <u>24_JER_08_01</u> # At that time, saith the LORD, they shall bring out the bones of the kings of Judah, and the bones of his princes, and the bones of the priests, and the bones of the prophets, and the bones of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, out of their graves:

bring silver and <u>23_ISA_60_17</u># For brass I will bring gold, and for iron I will bring silver, and for wood brass, and for stones iron: I will also make thy officers peace, and thine exactors righteousness.

bring strangers upon <u>26_EZE_28_07</u> # Behold, therefore I will bring strangers upon thee, the terrible of the nations: and they shall draw their swords against the beauty of thy wisdom, and they shall defile thy brightness.

bring that the <u>03_LEV_07_30</u> # His own hands shall bring the offerings of the LORD made by fire, the fat with the breast, it shall he bring, that the breast may be waved [for] a wave offering before the LORD.

bring the ark <u>13_1CH_13_05</u># So David gathered all Israel together, from Shihor of Egypt even unto the entering of Hemath, to bring the ark of God from Kirjathjearim.

bringeth the wheel <u>20_PRO_20_26</u> # A wise king scattereth the wicked, and bringeth the wheel over them.

bringeth the wind <u>19_PSA_135_07</u># He causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth; he maketh lightnings for the rain; he bringeth the wind out of his treasuries.

bringeth thee into <u>05_DEU_08_07</u># For the LORD thy God bringeth thee into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and depths that spring out of valleys and hills;

bringing forth the <u>40_MAT_21_43</u># Therefore say I unto you, The kingdom of God shall be taken from you, and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof.

bringing gold and <u>11_1KI_10_22</u># For the king had at sea a navy of Tharshish with the navy of Hiram: once in three years came the navy of Tharshish, bringing gold, and silver, ivory, and apes, and peacocks.

bringing many sons <u>58_HEB_02_10</u># For it became him, for whom [are] all things, and by whom [are] all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

bringing me into <u>45_ROM_07_23</u> # But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

bringing one sick <u>41_MAR_02_03</u># And they come unto him, bringing one sick of the palsy, which was borne of four.

bringing such evil <u>12_2KI_21_12</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Behold, I [am] bringing [such] evil upon Jerusalem and Judah, that whosoever heareth of it, both his ears shall tingle.

bringing the king <u>10_2SA_19_10</u> # And Absalom, whom we anointed over us, is dead in battle. Now therefore why speak ye not a word of bringing the king back?
