

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

broidered coat a <u>02\_EXO\_28\_04</u># And these [are] the garments which they shall make; a breastplate, and an ephod, and a robe, and a broidered coat, a mitre, and a girdle: and they shall make holy garments for Aaron thy brother, and his sons, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

broidered garments and <u>26\_EZE\_16\_18</u># And tookest thy broidered garments, and coveredst them: and thou hast set mine oil and mine incense before them.

broidered garments they <u>26\_EZE\_26\_16</u># Then all the princes of the sea shall come down from their thrones, and lay away their robes, and put off their broidered garments: they shall clothe themselves with trembling; they shall sit upon the ground, and shall tremble at [every] moment, and be astonished at thee.

broidered work and <u>26\_EZE\_16\_10</u># I clothed thee also with broidered work, and shod thee with badgers' skin, and I girded thee about with fine linen, and I covered thee with silk.

broidered work and <u>26\_EZE\_27\_16</u># Syria [was] thy merchant by reason of the multitude of the wares of thy making: they occupied in thy fairs with emeralds, purple, and broidered work, and fine linen, and coral, and agate.

broidered work and <u>26\_EZE\_27\_24</u># These [were] thy merchants in all sorts [of things], in blue clothes, and broidered work, and in chests of rich apparel, bound with cords, and made of cedar, among thy merchandise.

broidered work from <u>26\_EZE\_27\_07</u># Fine linen with broidered work from Egypt was that which thou spreadest forth to be thy sail; blue and purple from the isles of Elishah was that which covered thee.

broidered work thou <u>26\_EZE\_16\_13</u># Thus wast thou decked with gold and silver; and thy raiment [was of] fine linen, and silk, and broidered work; thou didst eat fine flour, and honey, and oil: and thou wast exceeding beautiful, and thou didst prosper into a kingdom.
