burdens and causes [25 LAM 02 14](#) # Thy prophets have seen vain and foolish things for thee: and they have not discovered thine iniquity, to turn away thy captivity; but have seen for thee false burdens and causes of banishment.

burdens and fourscore [11 1KI 05 15](#) # And Solomon had threescore and ten thousand that bare burdens, and fourscore thousand hewers in the mountains;

burdens and fourscore [14 2CH 02 02](#) # And Solomon told out threescore and ten thousand men to bear burdens, and fourscore thousand to hew in the mountain, and three thousand and six hundred to oversee them.

burdens and fourscore [14 2CH 02 18](#) # And he set threescore and ten thousand of them [to be] bearers of burdens, and fourscore thousand [to be] hewers in the mountain, and three thousand and six hundred overseers to set the people a work.

burdens and grievous [40 MAT 23 04](#) # For they bind heavy burdens and grievous to be borne, and lay [them] on men's shoulders; but they [themselves] will not move them with one of their fingers.

burdens and he [02 EXO 02 11](#) # And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out unto his brethren, and looked on their burdens: and he spied an Egyptian smiting an Hebrew, one of his brethren.

burdens and in [04 NUM 04 27](#) # At the appointment of Aaron and his sons shall be all the service of the sons of the Gershonites, in all their burdens, and in all their service: and ye shall appoint unto them in charge all their burdens.

burdens and so [48 GAL 06 02](#) # Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

burdens And they [02 EXO 01 11](#) # Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.

burdens and to [23 ISA 58 06](#) # [Is] not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?

burdens and were [14 2CH 34 13](#) # Also [they were] over the bearers of burdens, and [were] overseers of all that wrought the work in any manner of service: and of the Levites [there were] scribes, and officers, and porters.

burdens grievous to [42 LUK 11 46](#) # And he said, Woe unto you also, [ye] lawyers! for ye lade men with burdens grievous to be borne, and ye yourselves touch not the burdens with one of your fingers.

burdens is decayed [16 NEH 04 10](#) # And Judah said, The strength of the bearers of burdens is decayed, and [there is] much rubbish; so that we are not able to build the wall.

burdens laid upon [14 2CH 24 27](#) # Now [concerning] his sons, and the greatness of the burdens [laid] upon him, and the repairing of the house of God, behold, they [are] written in the story of the book of the kings. And Amaziah his son reigned in his stead.

burdens of the [02_EXO_06_06](#) # Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I [am] the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments:

burdens of the [02_EXO_06_07](#) # And I will take you to me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

burdens of wheat [30_AMO_05_11](#) # Forasmuch therefore as your treading [is] upon the poor, and ye take from him burdens of wheat: ye have built houses of hewn stone, but ye shall not dwell in them; ye have planted pleasant vineyards, but ye shall not drink wine of them.

burdens which they [16_NEH_13_15](#) # In those days saw I in Judah [some] treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all [manner of] burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I testified [against them] in the day wherein they sold victuals.

burdens with one [42_LUK_11_46](#) # And he said, Woe unto you also, [ye] lawyers! for ye lade men with burdens grievous to be borne, and ye yourselves touch not the burdens with one of your fingers.

burdens with those [16_NEH_04_17](#) # They which builded on the wall, and they that bare burdens, with those that laded, [every one] with one of his hands wrought in the work, and with the other [hand] held a weapon.

burdens [02_EXO_05_04](#) # And the king of Egypt said unto them, Wherefore do ye, Moses and Aaron, let the people from their works? get you unto your burdens.

burdens [02_EXO_05_05](#) # And Pharaoh said, Behold, the people of the land now [are] many, and ye make them rest from their burdens.

burdens [01_GEN_49_14](#) # Issachar [is] a strong ass couching down between two burdens:

burdens [04_NUM_04_24](#) # This [is] the service of the families of the Gershonites, to serve, and for burdens:

burdens [04_NUM_04_27](#) # At the appointment of Aaron and his sons shall be all the service of the sons of the Gershonites, in all their burdens, and in all their service: and ye shall appoint unto them in charge all their burdens.

burdensome as the [52_1TH_02_06](#) # Nor of men sought we glory, neither of you, nor [yet] of others, when we might have been burdensome, as the apostles of Christ.

burdensome stone for [38_ZEC_12_03](#) # And in that day will I make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all people: all that burden themselves with it shall be cut in pieces, though all the people of the earth be gathered together against it.

burdensome to you [47_2CO_12_13](#) # For what is it wherein ye were inferior to other churches, except [it be] that I myself was not burdensome to you? forgive me this wrong.

burdensome to you [47_2CO_12_14](#) # Behold, the third time I am ready to come to you; and I will not be burdensome to you: for I seek not yours, but you: for the children ought not to lay up for the parents, but the parents for the children.

burdensome unto you [47_2CO_11_09](#) # And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the brethren which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all [things] I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and [so] will I keep [myself].
