bury Gog and <u>26\_EZE\_39\_11</u># And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] I will give unto Gog a place there of graves in Israel, the valley of the passengers on the east of the sea: and it shall stop the [noses] of the passengers: and there shall they bury Gog and all his multitude: and they shall call [it] The valley of Hamongog.

bury her And <u>12\_2KI\_09\_10</u> # And the dogs shall eat Jezebel in the portion of Jezreel, and [there shall be] none to bury [her]. And he opened the door, and fled.

bury her but <u>12\_2KI\_09\_35</u># And they went to bury her: but they found no more of her than the skull, and the feet, and the palms of [her] hands.

bury her for <u>12\_2KI\_09\_34</u> # And when he was come in, he did eat and drink, and said, Go, see now this cursed [woman], and bury her: for she [is] a king's daughter.

bury him for <u>11\_1KI\_14\_13</u># And all Israel shall mourn for him, and bury him: for he only of Jeroboam shall come to the grave, because in him there is found [some] good thing toward the LORD God of Israel in the house of Jeroboam.

bury him that <u>11\_1KI\_02\_31</u># And the king said unto him, Do as he hath said, and fall upon him, and bury him; that thou mayest take away the innocent blood, which Joab shed, from me, and from the house of my father.

bury him that <u>05\_DEU\_21\_23</u># His body shall not remain all night upon the tree, but thou shalt in any wise bury him that day; [for he that is hanged [is] accursed of God;] that thy land be not defiled, which the LORD thy God giveth thee [for] an inheritance.

bury him <u>11\_1KI\_13\_29</u># And the prophet took up the carcase of the man of God, and laid it upon the ass, and brought it back: and the old prophet came to the city, to mourn and to bury him.

bury his father <u>01\_GEN\_50\_07</u> # And Joseph went up to bury his father: and with him went up all the servants of Pharaoh, the elders of his house, and all the elders of the land of Egypt,

bury his father <u>01\_GEN\_50\_14</u> # And Joseph returned into Egypt, he, and his brethren, and all that went up with him to bury his father, after he had buried his father.

bury in Tophet <u>24\_JER\_07\_32</u> # Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that it shall no more be called Tophet, nor the valley of the son of Hinnom, but the valley of slaughter: for they shall bury in Tophet, till there be no place.

bury me in <u>11\_1KI\_13\_31</u># And it came to pass, after he had buried him, that he spake to his sons, saying, When I am dead, then bury me in the sepulchre wherein the man of God [is] buried; lay my bones beside his bones:

bury strangers in <u>40\_MAT\_27\_07</u># And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.

bury the slain <u>11\_1KI\_11\_15</u># For it came to pass, when David was in Edom, and Joab the captain of the host was gone up to bury the slain, after he had smitten every male in Edom;

bury their dead <u>42\_LUK\_09\_60</u># Jesus said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of God.

bury their dead <u>40\_MAT\_08\_22</u># But Jesus said unto him, Follow me; and let the dead bury their dead.

bury them and <u>26\_EZE\_39\_13</u> # Yea, all the people of the land shall bury [them]; and it shall be to them a renown the day that I shall be glorified, saith the Lord GOD.

bury them in 24\_JER\_19\_11 # And shalt say unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Even so will I break this people and this city, as [one] breaketh a potter's vessel, that cannot be made whole again: and they shall bury [them] in Tophet, till [there be] no place to bury.

bury <u>24\_JER\_19\_11</u># And shalt say unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Even so will I break this people and this city, as [one] breaketh a potter's vessel, that cannot be made whole again: and they shall bury [them] in Tophet, till [there be] no place to bury.

bury <u>43\_JOH\_19\_40</u> # Then took they the body of Jesus, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices, as the manner of the Jews is to bury.

burying a man <u>12\_2KI\_13\_21</u> # And it came to pass, as they were burying a man, that, behold, they spied a band [of men]; and they cast the man into the sepulchre of Elisha: and when the man was let down, and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood up on his feet.

burying hath she <u>43\_JOH\_12\_07</u> # Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.

burying of them <u>26\_EZE\_39\_12</u># And seven months shall the house of Israel be burying of them, that they may cleanse the land.

burying <u>41\_MAR\_14\_08</u># She hath done what she could: she is come aforehand to anoint my body to the burying.

buryingplace amongst you <u>01\_GEN\_23\_09</u># That he may give me the cave of Machpelah, which he hath, which [is] in the end of his field; for as much money as it is worth he shall give it me for a possession of a buryingplace amongst you.

buryingplace And he <u>01\_GEN\_47\_30</u># But I will lie with my fathers, and thou shalt carry me out of Egypt, and bury me in their buryingplace. And he said, I will do as thou hast said.

buryingplace by the <u>01\_GEN\_23\_20</u># And the field, and the cave that [is] therein, were made sure unto Abraham for a possession of a buryingplace by the sons of Heth.

buryingplace of Ephron <u>01\_GEN\_50\_13</u># For his sons carried him into the land of Canaan, and buried

him in the cave of the field of Machpelah, which Abraham bought with the field for a possession of a buryingplace of Ephron the Hittite, before Mamre.

buryingplace of Manoah <u>07\_JUD\_16\_31</u># Then his brethren and all the house of his father came down, and took him, and brought [him] up, and buried him between Zorah and Eshtaol in the buryingplace of Manoah his father. And he judged Israel twenty years.

buryingplace with you <u>01\_GEN\_23\_04</u> # I [am] a stranger and a sojourner with you: give me a possession of a buryingplace with you, that I may bury my dead out of my sight.

buryingplace <u>01\_GEN\_49\_30</u> # In the cave that [is] in the field of Machpelah, which [is] before Mamre, in the land of Canaan, which Abraham bought with the field of Ephron the Hittite for a possession of a buryingplace.
