burying a man 12 2KI 13 21 # And it came to pass, as they were burying a man, that, behold, they spied a band [of men]; and they cast the man into the sepulchre of Elisha: and when the man was let down, and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood up on his feet.

burying hath she <u>43_JOH_12_07</u># Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.

burying of them <u>26_EZE_39_12</u># And seven months shall the house of Israel be burying of them, that they may cleanse the land.

burying <u>41_MAR_14_08</u># She hath done what she could: she is come aforehand to anoint my body to the burying.

buryingplace amongst you <u>01_GEN_23_09</u># That he may give me the cave of Machpelah, which he hath, which [is] in the end of his field; for as much money as it is worth he shall give it me for a possession of a buryingplace amongst you.

buryingplace And he <u>01_GEN_47_30</u># But I will lie with my fathers, and thou shalt carry me out of Egypt, and bury me in their buryingplace. And he said, I will do as thou hast said.

buryingplace by the <u>01_GEN_23_20</u> # And the field, and the cave that [is] therein, were made sure unto Abraham for a possession of a buryingplace by the sons of Heth.

buryingplace of Ephron <u>01_GEN_50_13</u># For his sons carried him into the land of Canaan, and buried him in the cave of the field of Machpelah, which Abraham bought with the field for a possession of a buryingplace of Ephron the Hittite, before Mamre.

buryingplace of Manoah <u>07_JUD_16_31</u> # Then his brethren and all the house of his father came down, and took him, and brought [him] up, and buried him between Zorah and Eshtaol in the buryingplace of Manoah his father. And he judged Israel twenty years.

buryingplace with you <u>01_GEN_23_04</u> # I [am] a stranger and a sojourner with you: give me a possession of a buryingplace with you, that I may bury my dead out of my sight.

buryingplace <u>01_GEN_49_30</u># In the cave that [is] in the field of Machpelah, which [is] before Mamre, in the land of Canaan, which Abraham bought with the field of Ephron the Hittite for a possession of a buryingplace.
