Carmel and Bashan <u>24\_JER\_50\_19</u> # And I will bring Israel again to his habitation, and he shall feed on Carmel and Bashan, and his soul shall be satisfied upon mount Ephraim and Gilead.

Carmel and behold <u>09\_1SA\_15\_12</u># And when Samuel rose early to meet Saul in the morning, it was told Samuel, saying, Saul came to Carmel, and, behold, he set him up a place, and is gone about, and passed on, and gone down to Gilgal.

Carmel and from 12\_2KI\_02\_25# And he went from thence to mount Carmel, and from thence he returned to Samaria.

Carmel and go <u>09\_1SA\_25\_05</u># And David sent out ten young men, and David said unto the young men, Get you up to Carmel, and go to Nabal, and greet him in my name:

Carmel and he <u>11\_1KI\_18\_42</u># So Ahab went up to eat and to drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; and he cast himself down upon the earth, and put his face between his knees,

Carmel and Ziph 06\_JOS\_15\_55 # Maon, Carmel, and Ziph, and Juttah,

Carmel by the 24\_JER\_46\_18 # [As] I live, saith the King, whose name [is] the LORD of hosts, Surely as Tabor [is] among the mountains, and as Carmel by the sea, [so] shall he come.

Carmel for he <u>14\_2CH\_26\_10</u> # Also he built towers in the desert, and digged many wells: for he had much cattle, both in the low country, and in the plains: husbandmen [also], and vine dressers in the mountains, and in Carmel: for he loved husbandry.

Carmel shall wither 30\_AMO\_01\_02 # And he said, The LORD will roar from Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the habitations of the shepherds shall mourn, and the top of Carmel shall wither.
