

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Cornelius a centurion <u>44\_ACT\_10\_01</u># There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of the band called the Italian [band],

Cornelius and said <u>44\_ACT\_10\_21</u> # Then Peter went down to the men which were sent unto him from Cornelius; and said, Behold, I am he whom ye seek: what [is] the cause wherefore ye are come?

Cornelius had made <u>44\_ACT\_10\_17</u> # Now while Peter doubted in himself what this vision which he had seen should mean, behold, the men which were sent from Cornelius had made inquiry for Simon's house, and stood before the gate,

Cornelius met him <u>44\_ACT\_10\_25</u> # And as Peter was coming in, Cornelius met him, and fell down at his feet, and worshipped [him].

Cornelius said Four <u>44\_ACT\_10\_30</u># And Cornelius said, Four days ago I was fasting until this hour; and at the ninth hour I prayed in my house, and, behold, a man stood before me in bright clothing,

Cornelius the centurion <u>44\_ACT\_10\_22</u> # And they said, Cornelius the centurion, a just man, and one that feareth God, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, was warned from God by an holy angel to send for thee into his house, and to hear words of thee.

Cornelius thy prayer <u>44\_ACT\_10\_31</u># And said, Cornelius, thy prayer is heard, and thine alms are had in remembrance in the sight of God.

Cornelius waited for <u>44\_ACT\_10\_24</u> # And the morrow after they entered into Caesarea. And Cornelius waited for them, and had called together his kinsmen and near friends.

Cornelius was departed <u>44\_ACT\_10\_07</u> # And when the angel which spake unto Cornelius was departed, he called two of his household servants, and a devout soldier of them that waited on him continually;

Cornelius <u>44\_ACT\_10\_03</u># He saw in a vision evidently about the ninth hour of the day an angel of God coming in to him, and saying unto him, Cornelius.
