

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

becamest mine <u>26_EZE_16_08</u># Now when I passed by thee, and looked upon thee, behold, thy time [was] the time of love; and I spread my skirt over thee, and covered thy nakedness: yea, I sware unto thee, and entered into a covenant with thee, saith the Lord GOD, and thou becamest mine.

becamest their God 13_1CH_17_22 # For thy people Israel didst thou make thine own people for ever; and thou, LORD, becamest their God.

camest and have <u>01_GEN_27_33</u># And Isaac trembled very exceedingly, and said, Who? where [is] he that hath taken venison, and brought [it] me, and I have eaten of all before thou camest, and have blessed him? yea, [and] he shall be blessed.

camest back and <u>11_1KI_13_22</u># But camest back, and hast eaten bread and drunk water in the place, of the which [the LORD] did say to thee, Eat no bread, and drink no water; thy carcase shall not come unto the sepulchre of thy fathers.

camest but yesterday <u>10_2SA_15_20</u># Whereas thou camest [but] yesterday, should I this day make thee go up and down with us? seeing I go whither I may, return thou, and take back thy brethren: mercy and truth [be] with thee.

camest down also <u>16_NEH_09_13</u># Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments:

camest down the <u>23_ISA_64_03</u># When thou didst terrible things [which] we looked not for, thou camest down, the mountains flowed down at thy presence.

camest forth from 43_JOH_16_30 # Now are we sure that thou knowest all things, and needest not that any man should ask thee: but this we believe that thou camest forth from God.

camest forth out <u>05_DEU_16_03</u># Thou shalt eat no leavened bread with it; seven days shalt thou eat unleavened bread therewith, [even] the bread of affliction: for thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt in haste: that thou mayest remember the day when thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt all the days of thy life.

camest forth out <u>05_DEU_16_03</u># Thou shalt eat no leavened bread with it; seven days shalt thou eat unleavened bread therewith, [even] the bread of affliction: for thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt in haste: that thou mayest remember the day when thou camest forth out of the land of Egypt all the days of thy life.

camest forth out <u>05_DEU_16_06</u># But at the place which the LORD thy God shall choose to place his name in, there thou shalt sacrifice the passover at even, at the going down of the sun, at the season that thou camest forth out of Egypt.

camest forth out <u>24_JER_01_05</u># Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, [and] I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.

camest forth with <u>26_EZE_32_02</u> # Son of man, take up a lamentation for Pharaoh king of Egypt, and say unto him, Thou art like a young lion of the nations, and thou [art] as a whale in the seas: and thou camest forth with thy rivers, and troubledst the waters with thy feet, and fouledst their rivers.

camest from Judah 11_1KI_13_14# And went after the man of God, and found him sitting under an oak: and he said unto him, [Art] thou the man of God that camest from Judah? And he said, I [am].

camest hath sent <u>44_ACT_09_17</u> # And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, [even] Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost.

camest not nor <u>05_DEU_02_37</u># Only unto the land of the children of Ammon thou camest not, [nor] unto any place of the river Jabbok, nor unto the cities in the mountains, nor unto whatsoever the LORD our God forbad us.

camest not within <u>09_1SA_13_11</u># And Samuel said, What hast thou done? And Saul said, Because I saw that the people were scattered from me, and [that] thou camest not within the days appointed, and [that] the Philistines gathered themselves together at Michmash;

camest out from <u>02_EXO_23_15</u> # Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread: [thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib; for in it thou camest out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty:]

camest out from <u>02_EXO_34_18</u># The feast of unleavened bread shalt thou keep. Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, as I commanded thee, in the time of the month Abib: for in the month Abib thou camest out from Egypt.

camest thou and <u>01_GEN_16_08</u> # And he said, Hagar, Sarai's maid, whence camest thou? and whither wilt thou go? And she said, I flee from the face of my mistress Sarai.

camest thou down <u>09_1SA_17_28</u> # And Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why camest thou down hither? and with whom hast thou left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know thy pride, and the naughtiness of thine heart; for thou art come down that thou mightest see the battle.

camest thou hither <u>43_JOH_06_25</u> # And when they had found him on the other side of the sea, they said unto him, Rabbi, when camest thou hither?

camest thou in <u>40_MAT_22_12</u># And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless.

Camest thou not <u>10_2SA_11_10</u># And when they had told David, saying, Uriah went not down unto his house, David said unto Uriah, Camest thou not from [thy] journey? why [then] didst thou not go down unto thine house?

camest thou not <u>04_NUM_22_37</u># And Balak said unto Balaam, Did I not earnestly send unto thee to call thee? wherefore camest thou not unto me? am I not able indeed to promote thee to honour?

camest <u>11_1KI_13_09</u># For so was it charged me by the word of the LORD, saying, Eat no bread, nor drink water, nor turn again by the same way that thou camest.

camest 11_1KI_13_17 # For it was said to me by the word of the LORD, Thou shalt eat no bread nor drink water there, nor turn again to go by the way that thou camest.

camest 12 2KI 19 28 # Because thy rage against me and thy tumult is come up into mine ears, therefore I will put my hook in thy nose, and my bridle in thy lips, and I will turn thee back by the way by which thou camest.

camest <u>01_GEN_24_05</u> # And the servant said unto him, Peradventure the woman will not be willing to follow me unto this land: must I needs bring thy son again unto the land from whence thou camest?

camest 23 ISA 37 29 # Because thy rage against me, and thy tumult, is come up into mine ears, therefore will I put my hook in thy nose, and my bridle in thy lips, and I will turn thee back by the way by which thou camest.
