captain against her <u>24\_JER\_51\_27</u># Set ye up a standard in the land, blow the trumpet among the nations, prepare the nations against her, call together against her the kingdoms of Ararat, Minni, and Ashchenaz; appoint a captain against her; cause the horses to come up as the rough caterpillars.

captain also was <u>44\_ACT\_22\_29</u> # Then straightway they departed from him which should have examined him: and the chief captain also was afraid, after he knew that he was a Roman, and because he had bound him.

captain and his <u>14\_2CH\_13\_12</u># And, behold, God himself [is] with us for [our] captain, and his priests with sounding trumpets to cry alarm against you. O children of Israel, fight ye not against the LORD God of your fathers; for ye shall not prosper.

captain And Jehu <u>12\_2KI\_09\_05</u> # And when he came, behold, the captains of the host [were] sitting; and he said, I have an errand to thee, O captain. And Jehu said, Unto which of all us? And he said, To thee, O captain.

captain and let <u>04\_NUM\_14\_04</u># And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt.

captain and officers <u>43\_JOH\_18\_12</u> # Then the band and the captain and officers of the Jews took Jesus, and bound him,

captain and said <u>44\_ACT\_23\_18</u> # So he took him, and brought [him] to the chief captain, and said, Paul the prisoner called me unto [him], and prayed me to bring this young man unto thee, who hath something to say unto thee.

captain and the <u>44\_ACT\_21\_32</u> # Who immediately took soldiers and centurions, and ran down unto them: and when they saw the chief captain and the soldiers, they left beating of Paul.

captain and with <u>14\_2CH\_17\_15</u># And next to him [was] Jehohanan the captain, and with him two hundred and fourscore thousand.

captain answered With <u>44\_ACT\_22\_28</u> # And the chief captain answered, With a great sum obtained I this freedom. And Paul said, But I was [free] born.

captain came and <u>44\_ACT\_22\_27</u># Then the chief captain came, and said unto him, Tell me, art thou a Roman? He said, Yea.

captain came near <u>44\_ACT\_21\_33</u> # Then the chief captain came near, and took him, and commanded [him] to be bound with two chains; and demanded who he was, and what he had done.

captain commanded him <u>44\_ACT\_22\_24</u> # The chief captain commanded him to be brought into the castle, and bade that he should be examined by scourging; that he might know wherefore they cried so against him.

captain fearing lest <u>44\_ACT\_23\_10</u> # And when there arose a great dissension, the chief captain, fearing lest Paul should have been pulled in pieces of them, commanded the soldiers to go down, and to take him by force from among them, and to bring [him] into the castle.

captain for he <u>44\_ACT\_23\_17</u># Then Paul called one of the centurions unto [him], and said, Bring this young man unto the chief captain: for he hath a certain thing to tell him.

captain for the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_07</u> # The fourth [captain] for the fourth month [was] Asahel the brother of Joab, and Zebadiah his son after him: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

captain for the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_08</u># The fifth captain for the fifth month [was] Shamhuth the Izrahite: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

captain for the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_09</u># The sixth [captain] for the sixth month [was] Ira the son of Ikkesh the Tekoite: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

captain for the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_10</u># The seventh [captain] for the seventh month [was] Helez the Pelonite, of the children of Ephraim: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

captain for the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_11</u># The eighth [captain] for the eighth month [was] Sibbecai the Hushathite, of the Zarhites: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

captain for the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_12</u> # The ninth [captain] for the ninth month [was] Abiezer the Anetothite, of the Benjamites: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

captain for the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_13</u># The tenth [captain] for the tenth month [was] Maharai the Netophathite, of the Zarhites: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

captain for the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_14</u> # The eleventh [captain] for the eleventh month [was] Benaiah the Pirathonite, of the children of Ephraim: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

captain for the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_15</u># The twelfth [captain] for the twelfth month [was] Heldai the Netophathite, of Othniel: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

captain howbeit he <u>13\_1CH\_11\_21</u># Of the three, he was more honourable than the two; for he was their captain: howbeit he attained not to the [first] three.

captain howbeit he <u>10\_2SA\_23\_19</u> # Was he not most honourable of three? therefore he was their captain: howbeit he attained not unto the [first] three.

captain Lysias came <u>44\_ACT\_24\_07</u> # But the chief captain Lysias came [upon us], and with great violence took [him] away out of our hands,

captain May I <u>44\_ACT\_21\_37</u> # And as Paul was to be led into the castle, he said unto the chief captain, May I speak unto thee? Who said, Canst thou speak Greek?

captain of fifty <u>12\_2KI\_01\_09</u> # Then the king sent unto him a captain of fifty with his fifty. And he went up to him: and, behold, he sat on the top of an hill. And he spake unto him, Thou man of God, the king hath said, Come down.

captain of fifty <u>12\_2KI\_01\_10</u># And Elijah answered and said to the captain of fifty, If I [be] a man of God, then let fire come down from heaven, and consume thee and thy fifty. And there came down fire from heaven, and consumed him and his fifty.

captain of fifty <u>12\_2KI\_01\_11</u># Again also he sent unto him another captain of fifty with his fifty. And he answered and said unto him, O man of God, thus hath the king said, Come down quickly.

captain of fifty <u>12\_2KI\_01\_13</u># And he sent again a captain of the third fifty with his fifty. And the third

captain of fifty <u>23\_ISA\_03\_03</u># The captain of fifty, and the honourable man, and the counsellor, and the cunning artificer, and the eloquent orator.

captain of half <u>11\_1KI\_16\_09</u># And his servant Zimri, captain of half [his] chariots, conspired against him, as he was in Tirzah, drinking himself drunk in the house of Arza steward of [his] house in Tirzah.

captain of his <u>09\_1SA\_14\_50</u># And the name of Saul's wife [was] Ahinoam, the daughter of Ahimaaz: and the name of the captain of his host [was] Abner, the son of Ner, Saul's uncle.

captain of his <u>09\_1SA\_26\_05</u># And David arose, and came to the place where Saul had pitched: and David beheld the place where Saul lay, and Abner the son of Ner, the captain of his host: and Saul lay in the trench, and the people pitched round about him.

captain of his <u>12\_2KI\_15\_25</u> # But Pekah the son of Remaliah, a captain of his, conspired against him, and smote him in Samaria, in the palace of the king's house, with Argob and Arieh, and with him fifty men of the Gileadites: and he killed him, and reigned in his room.

captain of his <u>01\_GEN\_21\_22</u># And it came to pass at that time, that Abimelech and Phichol the chief captain of his host spake unto Abraham, saying, God [is] with thee in all that thou doest:

captain of his <u>01\_GEN\_21\_32</u># Thus they made a covenant at Beersheba: then Abimelech rose up, and Phichol the chief captain of his host, and they returned into the land of the Philistines.

captain of his <u>01\_GEN\_26\_26</u># Then Abimelech went to him from Gerar, and Ahuzzath one of his friends, and Phichol the chief captain of his army.

captain of Jabin's <u>07\_JUD\_04\_07</u> # And I will draw unto thee to the river Kishon Sisera, the captain of Jabin's army, with his chariots and his multitude; and I will deliver him into thine hand.

captain of my <u>12\_2KI\_20\_05</u> # Turn again, and tell Hezekiah the captain of my people, Thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will heal thee: on the third day thou shalt go up unto the house of the LORD.

captain of Saul's <u>10\_2SA\_02\_08</u># But Abner the son of Ner, captain of Saul's host, took Ishbosheth the son of Saul, and brought him over to Mahanaim;

captain of the <u>13\_1CH\_11\_42</u># Adina the son of Shiza the Reubenite, a captain of the Reubenites, and thirty with him,

captain of the <u>13\_1CH\_11\_42</u># Adina the son of Shiza the Reubenite, a captain of the Reubenites, and thirty with him,

captain of the <u>13\_1CH\_19\_16</u># And when the Syrians saw that they were put to the worse before Israel, they sent messengers, and drew forth the Syrians that [were] beyond the river: and Shophach the captain of the host of Hadarezer [went] before them.

captain of the <u>13\_1CH\_19\_18</u> # But the Syrians fled before Israel; and David slew of the Syrians seven thousand [men which fought in] chariots, and forty thousand footmen, and killed Shophach the captain of the host.

captain of the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_05</u> # The third captain of the host for the third month [was] Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, a chief priest: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

captain of the <u>11\_1KI\_01\_19</u># And he hath slain oxen and fat cattle and sheep in abundance, and hath called all the sons of the king, and Abiathar the priest, and Joab the captain of the host: but Solomon thy servant hath he not called.

captain of the <u>11\_1KI\_02\_32</u># And the LORD shall return his blood upon his own head, who fell upon two men more righteous and better than he, and slew them with the sword, my father David not knowing [thereof, to wit], Abner the son of Ner, captain of the host of Israel, and Amasa the son of Jether, captain of the host of Judah.

captain of the <u>11\_1KI\_02\_32</u># And the LORD shall return his blood upon his own head, who fell upon two men more righteous and better than he, and slew them with the sword, my father David not knowing [thereof, to wit], Abner the son of Ner, captain of the host of Israel, and Amasa the son of Jether, captain of the host of Judah.

captain of the <u>11\_1KI\_11\_15</u># For it came to pass, when David was in Edom, and Joab the captain of the host was gone up to bury the slain, after he had smitten every male in Edom;

captain of the <u>11\_1KI\_11\_21</u># And when Hadad heard in Egypt that David slept with his fathers, and that Joab the captain of the host was dead, Hadad said to Pharaoh, Let me depart, that I may go to mine own country.

captain of the <u>11\_1KI\_16\_16</u># And the people [that were] encamped heard say, Zimri hath conspired, and hath also slain the king: wherefore all Israel made Omri, the captain of the host, king over Israel that day in the camp.

captain of the <u>09\_1SA\_12\_09</u># And when they forgat the LORD their God, he sold them into the hand of Sisera, captain of the host of Hazor, and into the hand of the Philistines, and into the hand of the king of Moab, and they fought against them.

captain of the <u>09\_1SA\_17\_55</u># And when Saul saw David go forth against the Philistine, he said unto Abner, the captain of the host, Abner, whose son [is] this youth? And Abner said, [As] thy soul liveth, O king, I cannot tell.

captain of the <u>12\_2KI\_01\_13</u> # And he sent again a captain of the third fifty with his fifty. And the third captain of fifty went up, and came and fell on his knees before Elijah, and besought him, and said unto him, O man of God, I pray thee, let my life, and the life of these fifty thy servants, be precious in thy sight.

captain of the <u>12\_2KI\_04\_13</u># And he said unto him, Say now unto her, Behold, thou hast been careful for us with all this care; what [is] to be done for thee? wouldest thou be spoken for to the king, or to the captain of the host? And she answered, I dwell among mine own people.

captain of the <u>12\_2KI\_05\_01</u># Now Naaman, captain of the host of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and honourable, because by him the LORD had given deliverance unto Syria: he was also a mighty man in valour, [but he was] a leper.

captain of the <u>12\_2KI\_18\_24</u> # How then wilt thou turn away the face of one captain of the least of my master's servants, and put thy trust on Egypt for chariots and for horsemen?

captain of the <u>12\_2KI\_25\_08</u># And in the fifth month, on the seventh [day] of the month, which [is] the nineteenth year of king Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, a servant of the king of Babylon, unto Jerusalem:

captain of the <u>12\_2KI\_25\_10</u># And all the army of the Chaldees, that [were with] the captain of the guard, brake down the walls of Jerusalem round about.

captain of the <u>12\_2KI\_25\_11</u># Now the rest of the people [that were] left in the city, and the fugitives that fell away to the king of Babylon, with the remnant of the multitude, did Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carry away.

captain of the <u>12\_2KI\_25\_12</u># But the captain of the guard left of the poor of the land [to be] vinedressers and husbandmen.

captain of the <u>12\_2KI\_25\_15</u># And the firepans, and the bowls, [and] such things as [were] of gold, [in] gold, and of silver, [in] silver, the captain of the guard took away.

captain of the <u>12\_2KI\_25\_18</u># And the captain of the guard took Seraiah the chief priest, and Zephaniah the second priest, and the three keepers of the door:

captain of the <u>12\_2KI\_25\_20</u># And Nebuzaradan captain of the guard took these, and brought them to the king of Babylon to Riblah:

captain of the <u>10\_2SA\_10\_16</u> # And Hadarezer sent, and brought out the Syrians that [were] beyond the river: and they came to Helam; and Shobach the captain of the host of Hadarezer [went] before them.

captain of the <u>10\_2SA\_17\_25</u> # And Absalom made Amasa captain of the host instead of Joab: which Amasa [was] a man's son, whose name [was] Ithra an Israelite, that went in to Abigail the daughter of Nahash, sister to Zeruiah Joab's mother.

captain of the <u>10\_2SA\_19\_13</u># And say ye to Amasa, [Art] thou not of my bone, and of my flesh? God do so to me, and more also, if thou be not captain of the host before me continually in the room of Joab.

captain of the <u>10\_2SA\_24\_02</u> # For the king said to Joab the captain of the host, which [was] with him, Go now through all the tribes of Israel, from Dan even to Beersheba, and number ye the people, that I may know the number of the people.

captain of the <u>44\_ACT\_04\_01</u> # And as they spake unto the people, the priests, and the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees, came upon them,

captain of the <u>44\_ACT\_05\_24</u> # Now when the high priest and the captain of the temple and the chief priests heard these things, they doubted of them whereunto this would grow.

captain of the <u>44\_ACT\_21\_31</u> # And as they went about to kill him, tidings came unto the chief captain of the band, that all Jerusalem was in an uproar.

captain of the <u>44\_ACT\_28\_16</u># And when we came to Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners to the captain of the guard: but Paul was suffered to dwell by himself with a soldier that kept him.

captain of the <u>27\_DAN\_02\_14</u># Then Daniel answered with counsel and wisdom to Arioch the captain of the king's guard, which was gone forth to slay the wise [men] of Babylon:

captain of the <u>01\_GEN\_37\_36</u># And the Midianites sold him into Egypt unto Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh's, [and] captain of the guard.

captain of the <u>01\_GEN\_39\_01</u># And Joseph was brought down to Egypt; and Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh, captain of the guard, an Egyptian, bought him of the hands of the Ishmeelites, which had brought him down thither.

captain of the <u>01\_GEN\_40\_03</u> # And he put them in ward in the house of the captain of the guard, into the prison, the place where Joseph [was] bound.

captain of the <u>01\_GEN\_40\_04</u># And the captain of the guard charged Joseph with them, and he served them: and they continued a season in ward.

captain of the <u>01\_GEN\_41\_10</u># Pharaoh was wroth with his servants, and put me in ward in the captain of the guard's house, [both] me and the chief baker:

captain of the <u>01\_GEN\_41\_12</u># And [there was] there with us a young man, an Hebrew, servant to the captain of the guard; and we told him, and he interpreted to us our dreams; to each man according to his dream he did interpret.

captain of the <u>23\_ISA\_36\_09</u> # How then wilt thou turn away the face of one captain of the least of my master's servants, and put thy trust on Egypt for chariots and for horsemen?

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_37\_13</u># And when he was in the gate of Benjamin, a captain of the ward [was] there, whose name [was] Irijah, the son of Shelemiah, the son of Hananiah; and he took Jeremiah the prophet, saying, Thou fallest away to the Chaldeans.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_39\_09</u> # Then Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive into Babylon the remnant of the people that remained in the city, and those that fell away, that fell to him, with the rest of the people that remained.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_39\_10</u> # But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left of the poor of the people, which had nothing, in the land of Judah, and gave them vineyards and fields at the same time.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_39\_11</u># Now Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon gave charge concerning Jeremiah to Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard, saying,

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_39\_13</u> # So Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard sent, and Nebushasban, Rabsaris, and Nergalsharezer, Rabmag, and all the king of Babylon's princes;

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_40\_01</u> # The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, after that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had let him go from Ramah, when he had taken him being bound in chains among all that were carried away captive of Jerusalem and Judah, which were carried away captive unto Babylon.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_40\_02</u> # And the captain of the guard took Jeremiah, and said unto him, The LORD thy God hath pronounced this evil upon this place.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_40\_05</u> # Now while he was not yet gone back, [he said], Go back also to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, whom the king of Babylon hath made governor over the cities of Judah, and dwell with him among the people: or go wheresoever it seemeth convenient unto thee to go. So the captain of the guard gave him victuals and a reward, and let him go.

captain of the 24\_JER\_41\_10 # Then Ishmael carried away captive all the residue of the people that [were] in Mizpah, [even] the king's daughters, and all the people that remained in Mizpah, whom Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had committed to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam: and Ishmael the son of Nethaniah carried them away captive, and departed to go over to the Ammonites.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_43\_06</u> # [Even] men, and women, and children, and the king's daughters, and every person that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had left with Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet, and Baruch the son of Neriah.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_52\_12</u> # Now in the fifth month, in the tenth [day] of the month, which [was] the nineteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, [which] served the king of Babylon, into Jerusalem,

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_52\_14</u> # And all the army of the Chaldeans, that [were] with the captain of the guard, brake down all the walls of Jerusalem round about.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_52\_15</u># Then Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive [certain] of the poor of the people, and the residue of the people that remained in the city, and those that fell away, that fell to the king of Babylon, and the rest of the multitude.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_52\_16</u># But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left [certain] of the poor of the land for vinedressers and for husbandmen.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_52\_19</u># And the basins, and the firepans, and the bowls, and the caldrons, and the candlesticks, and the spoons, and the cups; [that] which [was] of gold [in] gold, and [that] which [was] of silver [in] silver, took the captain of the guard away.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_52\_24</u># And the captain of the guard took Seraiah the chief priest, and Zephaniah the second priest, and the three keepers of the door:

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_52\_26</u># So Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard took them, and brought them to the king of Babylon to Riblah.

captain of the <u>24\_JER\_52\_30</u> # In the three and twentieth year of Nebuchadrezzar Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive of the Jews seven hundred forty and five persons: all the persons [were] four thousand and six hundred.

captain of the <u>06\_JOS\_05\_14</u># And he said, Nay; but [as] captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said unto him, What saith my lord unto his servant?

captain of the <u>06\_JOS\_05\_15</u># And the captain of the LORD'S host said unto Joshua, Loose thy shoe from off thy foot; for the place whereon thou standest [is] holy. And Joshua did so.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_03</u> # And on the east side toward the rising of the sun shall they of the standard of the camp of Judah pitch throughout their armies: and Nahshon the son of Amminadab [shall be] captain of the children of Judah.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_05</u># And those that do pitch next unto him [shall be] the tribe of Issachar: and Nethaneel the son of Zuar [shall be] captain of the children of Issachar.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_07</u># [Then] the tribe of Zebulun: and Eliab the son of Helon [shall be] captain of the children of Zebulun.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_10</u> # On the south side [shall be] the standard of the camp of Reuben according to their armies: and the captain of the children of Reuben [shall be] Elizur the son of Shedeur.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_12</u> # And those which pitch by him [shall be] the tribe of Simeon: and the captain of the children of Simeon [shall be] Shelumiel the son of Zurishaddai.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_14</u># Then the tribe of Gad: and the captain of the sons of Gad [shall be] Eliasaph the son of Reuel.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_18</u> # On the west side [shall be] the standard of the camp of Ephraim according to their armies: and the captain of the sons of Ephraim [shall be] Elishama the son of Ammihud.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_20</u> # And by him [shall be] the tribe of Manasseh: and the captain of the

children of Manasseh [shall be] Gamaliel the son of Pedahzur.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_22</u> # Then the tribe of Benjamin: and the captain of the sons of Benjamin [shall be] Abidan the son of Gideoni.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_25</u># The standard of the camp of Dan [shall be] on the north side by their armies: and the captain of the children of Dan [shall be] Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_27</u> # And those that encamp by him [shall be] the tribe of Asher: and the captain of the children of Asher [shall be] Pagiel the son of Ocran.

captain of the <u>04\_NUM\_02\_29</u> # Then the tribe of Naphtali: and the captain of the children of Naphtali [shall be] Ahira the son of Enan.

captain of their <u>09\_1SA\_17\_18</u># And carry these ten cheeses unto the captain of [their] thousand, and look how thy brethren fare, and take their pledge.

captain of their <u>10\_2SA\_10\_18</u># And the Syrians fled before Israel; and David slew [the men of] seven hundred chariots of the Syrians, and forty thousand horsemen, and smote Shobach the captain of their host, who died there.

captain of their <u>58\_HEB\_02\_10</u># For it became him, for whom [are] all things, and by whom [are] all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

captain of whose <u>07\_JUD\_04\_02</u> # And the LORD sold them into the hand of Jabin king of Canaan, that reigned in Hazor; the captain of whose host [was] Sisera, which dwelt in Harosheth of the Gentiles.

captain over a <u>11\_1KI\_11\_24</u># And he gathered men unto him, and became captain over a band, when David slew them [of Zobah]: and they went to Damascus, and dwelt therein, and reigned in Damascus.

captain over a <u>09\_1SA\_18\_13</u># Therefore Saul removed him from him, and made him his captain over a thousand; and he went out and came in before the people.

captain over his <u>09\_1SA\_10\_01</u># Then Samuel took a vial of oil, and poured [it] upon his head, and kissed him, and said, [Is it] not because the LORD hath anointed thee [to be] captain over his inheritance?

captain over his <u>09\_1SA\_13\_14</u> # But now thy kingdom shall not continue: the LORD hath sought him a man after his own heart, and the LORD hath commanded him [to be] captain over his people, because thou hast not kept [that] which the LORD commanded thee.

captain over Israel <u>10\_2SA\_05\_02</u># Also in time past, when Saul was king over us, thou wast he that leddest out and broughtest in Israel: and the LORD said to thee, Thou shalt feed my people Israel, and thou shalt be a captain over Israel.
