captains also are <u>02\_EXO\_15\_04</u> # Pharaoh's chariots and his host hath he cast into the sea: his chosen captains also are drowned in the Red sea.

captains and as <u>24\_JER\_13\_21</u> # What wilt thou say when he shall punish thee? for thou hast taught them [to be] captains, [and] as chief over thee: shall not sorrows take thee, as a woman in travail?

captains and captains <u>14\_2CH\_08\_09</u> # But of the children of Israel did Solomon make no servants for his work; but they [were] men of war, and chief of his captains, and captains of his chariots and horsemen.

captains and chief <u>41\_MAR\_06\_21</u> # And when a convenient day was come, that Herod on his birthday made a supper to his lords, high captains, and chief [estates] of Galilee;

captains and he <u>13\_1CH\_12\_18</u> # Then the spirit came upon Amasai, [who was] chief of the captains, [and he said], Thine [are we], David, and on thy side, thou son of Jesse: peace, peace [be] unto thee, and peace [be] to thine helpers; for thy God helpeth thee. captains and principal <u>44\_ACT\_25\_23</u> # And on the morrow, when Agrippa was come, and Bernice, with great pomp, and was entered into the place of hearing, with the chief captains, and principal men of the city, at Festus' commandment Paul was brought forth.

captains and rulers <u>11\_1KI\_09\_22</u># But of the children of Israel did Solomon make no bondmen: but they [were] men of war, and his servants, and his princes, and his captains, and rulers of his chariots, and his horsemen.

captains the judges <u>27\_DAN\_03\_02</u> # Then Nebuchadnezzar the king sent to gather together the princes, the governors, and the captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, to come to the dedication of the image which Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.

captains the judges <u>27\_DAN\_03\_03</u> # Then the princes, the governors, and captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, were gathered together unto the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.

captains the same <u>10\_2SA\_23\_08</u># These [be] the names of the mighty men whom David had: The Tachmonite that sat in the seat, chief among the captains; the same [was] Adino the Eznite: [he lift up his spear] against eight hundred, whom he slew at one time.

captains thereof and <u>24\_JER\_51\_28</u> # Prepare against her the nations with the kings of the Medes, the

captains thereof, and all the rulers thereof, and all the land of his dominion.

captains to open <u>26\_EZE\_21\_22</u> # At his right hand was the divination for Jerusalem, to appoint captains, to open the mouth in the slaughter, to lift up the voice with shouting, to appoint [battering] rams against the gates, to cast a mount, [and] to build a fort.

captains went down <u>13\_1CH\_11\_15</u># Now three of the thirty captains went down to the rock to David, into the cave of Adullam; and the host of the Philistines encamped in the valley of Rephaim.

captains <u>13\_1CH\_12\_28</u> # And Zadok, a young man mighty of valour, and of his father's house twenty and two captains.
