carry about in <u>41\_MAR\_06\_55</u> # And ran through that whole region round about, and began to carry about in beds those that were sick, where they heard he was.

carry and put <u>01\_GEN\_44\_01</u> # And he commanded the steward of his house, saying, Fill the men's sacks [with] food, as much as they can carry, and put every man's money in his sack's mouth.

carry and will <u>23\_ISA\_46\_04</u> # And [even] to [your] old age I [am] he; and [even] to hoar hairs will I carry [you]: I have made, and I will bear; even I will carry, and will deliver [you].
