cast a bank <u>12\_2KI\_19\_32</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the king of Assyria, He shall not come into this city, nor shoot an arrow there, nor come before it with shield, nor cast a bank against it.

cast a bank <u>23\_ISA\_37\_33</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the king of Assyria, He shall not come into this city, nor shoot an arrow there, nor come before it with shields, nor cast a bank against it.

cast a cloth <u>10\_2SA\_20\_12</u> # And Amasa wallowed in blood in the midst of the highway. And when the man saw that all the people stood still, he removed Amasa out of the highway into the field, and cast a cloth upon him, when he saw that every one that came by him stood still.

cast a cord <u>33\_MIC\_02\_05</u># Therefore thou shalt have none that shall cast a cord by lot in the congregation of the LORD.

cast a javelin <u>09\_1SA\_20\_33</u> # And Saul cast a javelin at him to smite him: whereby Jonathan knew that it was determined of his father to slay David.

cast a mount <u>26\_EZE\_04\_02</u># And lay siege against it, and build a fort against it, and cast a mount against it; set the camp also against it, and set [battering] rams against it round about.

cast a mount <u>26\_EZE\_21\_22</u> # At his right hand was the divination for Jerusalem, to appoint captains, to open the mouth in the slaughter, to lift up the voice with shouting, to appoint [battering] rams against the gates, to cast a mount, [and] to build a fort.

cast a mount <u>26\_EZE\_26\_08</u># He shall slay with the sword thy daughters in the field: and he shall make a fort against thee, and cast a mount against thee, and lift up the buckler against thee.

cast a mount <u>24\_JER\_06\_06</u># For thus hath the LORD of hosts said, Hew ye down trees, and cast a mount against Jerusalem: this [is] the city to be visited; she [is] wholly oppression in the midst of her.

cast a piece <u>10\_2SA\_11\_21</u># Who smote Abimelech the son of Jerubbesheth? did not a woman cast a piece of a millstone upon him from the wall, that he died in Thebez? why went ye nigh the wall? then say thou, Thy servant Uriah the Hittite is dead also.

cast a piece <u>07\_JUD\_09\_53</u># And a certain woman cast a piece of a millstone upon Abimelech's head, and all to brake his skull.

cast a snare <u>46\_1CO\_07\_35</u> # And this I speak for your own profit; not that I may cast a snare upon you, but for that which is comely, and that ye may attend upon the Lord without distraction.

cast a stone <u>43\_JOH\_08\_07</u> # So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.

cast a stone <u>25\_LAM\_03\_53</u># They have cut off my life in the dungeon, and cast a stone upon me.

cast a stumblingblock <u>66\_REV\_02\_14</u> # But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.

cast a trench <u>42\_LUK\_19\_43</u> # For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side,

cast abominable filth <u>34\_NAH\_03\_06</u># And I will cast abominable filth upon thee, and make thee vile, and will set thee as a gazingstock.

cast about and <u>24\_JER\_41\_14</u> # So all the people that Ishmael had carried away captive from Mizpah cast about and returned, and went unto Johanan the son of Kareah.

cast about his <u>41\_MAR\_14\_51</u> # And there followed him a certain young man, having a linen cloth cast about [his] naked [body]; and the young men laid hold on him:

cast abroad the <u>23\_ISA\_28\_25</u> # When he hath made plain the face thereof, doth he not cast abroad the fitches, and scatter the cummin, and cast in the principal wheat and the appointed barley and the rie in their place?

Cast abroad the <u>18\_JOB\_40\_11</u># Cast abroad the rage of thy wrath: and behold every one [that is] proud, and abase him.

cast alive into <u>66\_REV\_19\_20</u># And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

cast all my <u>23\_ISA\_38\_17</u># Behold, for peace I had great bitterness: but thou hast in love to my soul [delivered it] from the pit of corruption: for thou hast cast all my sins behind thy back.

cast all the <u>24\_JER\_41\_09</u> # Now the pit wherein Ishmael had cast all the dead bodies of the men, whom he had slain because of Gedaliah, [was] it which Asa the king had made for fear of Baasha king of Israel: [and] Ishmael the son of Nethaniah filled it with [them that were] slain.

cast all their <u>33\_MIC\_07\_19</u># He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.

cast an hook <u>40\_MAT\_17\_27</u># Notwithstanding, lest we should offend them, go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of money: that take, and give unto them for me and thee.

cast anchors out <u>44\_ACT\_27\_30</u> # And as the shipmen were about to flee out of the ship, when they had let down the boat into the sea, under colour as though they would have cast anchors out of the foreship,

cast and kneeled <u>42\_LUK\_22\_41</u> # And he was withdrawn from them about a stone's cast, and kneeled down, and prayed,

cast angle into <u>23\_ISA\_19\_08</u># The fishers also shall mourn, and all they that cast angle into the brooks shall lament, and they that spread nets upon the waters shall languish.

cast at him <u>43\_JOH\_08\_59</u># Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

cast away a <u>18\_JOB\_08\_20</u># Behold, God will not cast away a perfect [man], neither will he help the evil doers:

Cast away from <u>26\_EZE\_18\_31</u># Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a new heart and a new spirit: for why will ye die, O house of Israel?

cast away his <u>23 ISA 31\_07</u># For in that day every man shall cast away his idols of silver, and his idols of gold, which your own hands have made unto you [for] a sin.

cast away his <u>45\_ROM\_11\_01</u># I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, [of] the tribe of Benjamin.

cast away his <u>45\_ROM\_11\_02</u># God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying,

cast away in <u>14\_2CH\_29\_19</u> # Moreover all the vessels, which king Ahaz in his reign did cast away in his transgression, have we prepared and sanctified, and, behold, they [are] before the altar of the LORD.

cast away in <u>12\_2KI\_07\_15</u># And they went after them unto Jordan: and, lo, all the way [was] full of garments and vessels, which the Syrians had cast away in their haste. And the messengers returned, and told the king.

cast away stones <u>21\_ECC\_03\_05</u># A time to cast away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing;

cast away the <u>10\_2SA\_01\_21</u> # Ye mountains of Gilboa, [let there be] no dew, neither [let there be] rain, upon you, nor fields of offerings: for there the shield of the mighty is vilely cast away, the shield of Saul, [as though he had] not [been] anointed with oil.

cast away the <u>26\_EZE\_20\_08</u> # But they rebelled against me, and would not hearken unto me: they did not every man cast away the abominations of their eyes, neither did they forsake the idols of Egypt: then I said, I will pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the midst of the land of Egypt.

cast away the <u>23\_ISA\_05\_24</u> # Therefore as the fire devoureth the stubble, and the flame consumeth the chaff, [so] their root shall be as rottenness, and their blossom shall go up as dust: because they have cast away the law of the LORD of hosts, and despised the word of the Holy One of Israel.

cast away <u>21\_ECC\_03\_06</u># A time to get, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to cast away;

cast away <u>42\_LUK\_09\_25</u> # For what is a man advantaged, if he gain the whole world, and lose himself, or be cast away?

cast betwixt me <u>01\_GEN\_31\_51</u># And Laban said to Jacob, Behold this heap, and behold [this] pillar, which I have cast betwixt me and thee;

cast clouts and <u>24\_JER\_38\_11</u># So Ebedmelech took the men with him, and went into the house of the king under the treasury, and took thence old cast clouts and old rotten rags, and let them down by cords into the dungeon to Jeremiah.

cast clouts and <u>24\_JER\_38\_12</u> # And Ebedmelech the Ethiopian said unto Jeremiah, Put now [these] old cast clouts and rotten rags under thine armholes under the cords. And Jeremiah did so.

cast down and <u>27\_DAN\_07\_09</u> # I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment [was] white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne [was like] the fiery flame, [and] his wheels [as] burning fire.

cast down and <u>07\_JUD\_06\_28</u># And when the men of the city arose early in the morning, behold, the altar of Baal was cast down, and the grove was cut down that [was] by it, and the second bullock was offered upon the altar [that was] built.

cast down and <u>19\_PSA\_36\_12</u># There are the workers of iniquity fallen: they are cast down, and shall not be able to rise.

cast down but <u>47\_2CO\_04\_09</u> # Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed;

cast down comforted <u>47\_2CO\_07\_06</u> # Nevertheless God, that comforteth those that are cast down, comforted us by the coming of Titus;

cast down even <u>18\_JOB\_41\_09</u># Behold, the hope of him is in vain: shall not [one] be cast down even at the sight of him?

cast down every <u>02\_EXO\_07\_12</u># For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods.

cast down for <u>19\_PSA\_37\_24</u># Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholdeth [him with] his hand.

cast down from <u>25\_LAM\_02\_01</u># How hath the Lord covered the daughter of Zion with a cloud in his anger, [and] cast down from heaven unto the earth the beauty of Israel, and remembered not his footstool in the day of his anger!

cast down great <u>06\_JOS\_10\_11</u># And it came to pass, as they fled from before Israel, [and] were in the going down to Bethhoron, that the LORD cast down great stones from heaven upon them unto Azekah, and they died: [they were] more which died with hailstones than [they] whom the children of Israel slew with the sword.

cast down his <u>02\_EXO\_07\_10</u> # And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent.

cast down his <u>07\_JUD\_06\_31</u># And Joash said unto all that stood against him, Will ye plead for Baal? will ye save him? he that will plead for him, let him be put to death whilst [it is yet] morning: if he [be] a god, let him plead for himself, because [one] hath cast down his altar.

cast down in <u>16\_NEH\_06\_16</u># And it came to pass, that when all our enemies heard [thereof], and all the heathen that [were] about us saw [these things], they were much cast down in their own eyes: for they perceived that this work was wrought of our God.

cast down many <u>27\_DAN\_11\_12</u> # [And] when he hath taken away the multitude, his heart shall be lifted up; and he shall cast down [many] ten thousands: but he shall not be strengthened [by it].

cast down many <u>20\_PRO\_07\_26</u># For she hath cast down many wounded: yea, many strong [men] have been slain by her.

cast down O <u>19\_PSA\_42\_05</u># Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and [why] art thou disquieted in me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him [for] the help of his countenance.

cast down O <u>19\_PSA\_42\_11</u># Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him, [who is] the health of my countenance, and my God.

cast down O <u>19\_PSA\_43\_05</u> # Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope in God: for I shall yet praise him, [who is] the health of my countenance, and my God.

cast down saith <u>24\_JER\_06\_15</u># Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? nay, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush: therefore they shall fall among them that fall: at the time [that] I visit them they shall be cast down, saith the LORD.

cast down saith <u>24\_JER\_08\_12</u># Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? nay, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush: therefore shall they fall among them that fall: in the time of their visitation they shall be cast down, saith the LORD.

cast down some <u>27\_DAN\_08\_10</u># And it waxed great, [even] to the host of heaven; and it cast down [some] of the host and of the stars to the ground, and stamped upon them.

cast down the <u>27\_DAN\_08\_12</u> # And an host was given [him] against the daily [sacrifice] by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practiced, and prospered.

cast down the <u>07\_JUD\_06\_30</u> # Then the men of the city said unto Joash, Bring out thy son, that he may die: because he hath cast down the altar of Baal, and because he hath cut down the grove that [was] by it.

cast down the <u>40\_MAT\_27\_05</u># And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself.

cast down the <u>19\_PSA\_37\_14</u># The wicked have drawn out the sword, and have bent their bow, to cast down the poor and needy, [and] to slay such as be of upright conversation.

cast down the <u>19\_PSA\_56\_07</u># Shall they escape by iniquity? in [thine] anger cast down the people, O God.

cast down then <u>18\_JOB\_22\_29</u> # When [men] are cast down, then thou shalt say, [There is] lifting up; and he shall save the humble person.

cast down to <u>26\_EZE\_19\_12</u># But she was plucked up in fury, she was cast down to the ground, and the east wind dried up her fruit: her strong rods were broken and withered; the fire consumed them.

cast down to <u>23\_ISA\_28\_02</u> # Behold, the Lord hath a mighty and strong one, [which] as a tempest of hail [and] a destroying storm, as a flood of mighty waters overflowing, shall cast down to the earth with the hand.

cast down which <u>66\_REV\_12\_10</u> # And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

cast down within <u>19\_PSA\_42\_06</u> # O my God, my soul is cast down within me: therefore will I remember thee from the land of Jordan, and of the Hermonites, from the hill Mizar.

cast down your <u>26\_EZE\_06\_04</u> # And your altars shall be desolate, and your images shall be broken: and I will cast down your slain [men] before your idols.

cast down <u>14\_2CH\_25\_08</u># But if thou wilt go, do [it], be strong for the battle: God shall make thee fall before the enemy: for God hath power to help, and to cast down.

cast down 27\_DAN\_08\_11 # Yea, he magnified [himself] even to the prince of the host, and by him the daily

[sacrifice] was taken away, and the place of his sanctuary was cast down.

cast dust on <u>66\_REV\_18\_19</u># And they cast dust on their heads, and cried, weeping and wailing, saying, Alas, alas, that great city, wherein were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness! for in one hour is she made desolate.

cast dust <u>10\_2SA\_16\_13</u># And as David and his men went by the way, Shimei went along on the hill's side over against him, and cursed as he went, and threw stones at him, and cast dust.

cast every man <u>12\_2KI\_03\_25</u># And they beat down the cities, and on every good piece of land cast every man his stone, and filled it; and they stopped all the wells of water, and felled all the good trees: only in Kirharaseth left they the stones thereof; howbeit the slingers went about [it], and smote it.

cast far off <u>33\_MIC\_04\_07</u># And I will make her that halted a remnant, and her that was cast far off a strong nation: and the LORD shall reign over them in mount Zion from henceforth, even for ever.

cast fire into <u>19\_PSA\_74\_07</u># They have cast fire into thy sanctuary, they have defiled [by casting down] the dwelling place of thy name to the ground.

cast five sockets <u>02\_EXO\_26\_37</u> # And thou shalt make for the hanging five pillars [of] shittim [wood], and overlay them with gold, [and] their hooks [shall be of] gold: and thou shalt cast five sockets of brass for them.

cast for it <u>02\_EXO\_37\_03</u># And he cast for it four rings of gold, [to be set] by the four corners of it; even two rings upon the one side of it, and two rings upon the other side of it.

cast for it <u>02\_EXO\_37\_13</u># And he cast for it four rings of gold, and put the rings upon the four corners that [were] in the four feet thereof.

cast for them <u>02\_EXO\_36\_36</u># And he made thereunto four pillars [of] shittim [wood], and overlaid them with gold: their hooks [were of] gold; and he cast for them four sockets of silver.

cast forth all <u>16\_NEH\_13\_08</u># And it grieved me sore: therefore I cast forth all the household stuff of Tobiah out of the chamber.

cast forth as <u>43\_JOH\_15\_06</u># If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast [them] into the fire, and they are burned.

cast forth beyond <u>24\_JER\_22\_19</u># He shall be buried with the burial of an ass, drawn and cast forth beyond the gates of Jerusalem.

cast forth his <u>28\_HOS\_14\_05</u># I will be as the dew unto Israel: he shall grow as the lily, and cast forth his roots as Lebanon.

Cast forth lightning <u>19\_PSA\_144\_06</u># Cast forth lightning, and scatter them: shoot out thine arrows, and destroy them.

cast forth the <u>32\_JON\_01\_05</u># Then the mariners were afraid, and cried every man unto his god, and cast forth the wares that [were] in the ship into the sea, to lighten [it] of them. But Jonah was gone down into the sides of the ship; and he lay, and was fast asleep.

cast forth the <u>41\_MAR\_07\_26</u># The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would cast forth the devil out of her daughter.

cast four anchors <u>44\_ACT\_27\_29</u> # Then fearing lest we should have fallen upon rocks, they cast four

anchors out of the stern, and wished for the day.

cast four rings <u>02\_EXO\_25\_12</u> # And thou shalt cast four rings of gold for it, and put [them] in the four corners thereof; and two rings [shall be] in the one side of it, and two rings in the other side of it.

cast four rings <u>02\_EXO\_38\_05</u> # And he cast four rings for the four ends of the grate of brass, [to be] places for the staves.

cast he them <u>12\_2KI\_13\_23</u># And the LORD was gracious unto them, and had compassion on them, and had respect unto them, because of his covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not destroy them, neither cast he them from his presence as yet.

cast her eyes <u>01\_GEN\_39\_07</u> # And it came to pass after these things, that his master's wife cast her eyes upon Joseph; and she said, Lie with me.

cast her fruit <u>39\_MAL\_03\_11</u># And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.

cast her into <u>66\_REV\_02\_22</u> # Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.

cast her out <u>38\_ZEC\_09\_04</u># Behold, the Lord will cast her out, and he will smite her power in the sea; and she shall be devoured with fire.

cast her up <u>24\_JER\_50\_26</u># Come against her from the utmost border, open her storehouses: cast her up as heaps, and destroy her utterly: let nothing of her be left.

cast him down 27\_DAN\_08\_07 # And I saw him come close unto the ram, and he was moved with choler against him, and smote the ram, and brake his two horns: and there was no power in the ram to stand before him, but he cast him down to the ground, and stamped upon him: and there was none that could deliver the ram out of his hand.

cast him down <u>26\_EZE\_31\_16</u># I made the nations to shake at the sound of his fall, when I cast him down to hell with them that descend into the pit: and all the trees of Eden, the choice and best of Lebanon, all that drink water, shall be comforted in the nether parts of the earth.

cast him down <u>18\_JOB\_18\_07</u># The steps of his strength shall be straitened, and his own counsel shall cast him down.

cast him down <u>42\_LUK\_04\_29</u># And rose up, and thrust him out of the city, and led him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast him down headlong.

cast him down <u>19\_PSA\_17\_13</u># Arise, O LORD, disappoint him, cast him down: deliver my soul from the wicked, [which is] thy sword:

cast him down <u>19\_PSA\_62\_04</u> # They only consult to cast [him] down from his excellency: they delight in lies: they bless with their mouth, but they curse inwardly. Selah.

cast him forth <u>32\_JON\_01\_15</u># So they took up Jonah, and cast him forth into the sea: and the sea ceased from her raging.

cast him in <u>12\_2KI\_09\_25</u> # Then said [Jehu] to Bidkar his captain, Take up, [and] cast him in the portion of the field of Naboth the Jezreelite: for remember how that, when I and thou rode together after Ahab his father, the LORD laid this burden upon him;

cast him into <u>12\_2KI\_09\_26</u># Surely I have seen yesterday the blood of Naboth, and the blood of his sons, saith the LORD; and I will requite thee in this plat, saith the LORD. Now therefore take [and] cast him into the plat [of ground], according to the word of the LORD.

cast him into <u>10\_2SA\_18\_17</u># And they took Absalom, and cast him into a great pit in the wood, and laid a very great heap of stones upon him: and all Israel fled every one to his tent.

cast him into <u>27\_DAN\_06\_16</u># Then the king commanded, and they brought Daniel, and cast [him] into the den of lions. [Now] the king spake and said unto Daniel, Thy God whom thou servest continually, he will deliver thee.

cast him into <u>01\_GEN\_37\_20</u># Come now therefore, and let us slay him, and cast him into some pit, and we will say, Some evil beast hath devoured him: and we shall see what will become of his dreams.

cast him into <u>01\_GEN\_37\_22</u> # And Reuben said unto them, Shed no blood, [but] cast him into this pit that [is] in the wilderness, and lay no hand upon him; that he might rid him out of their hands, to deliver him to his father again.

cast him into <u>01\_GEN\_37\_24</u># And they took him, and cast him into a pit: and the pit [was] empty, [there was] no water in it.

cast him into 24\_JER\_38\_06 # Then took they Jeremiah, and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah the son of Hammelech, that [was] in the court of the prison: and they let down Jeremiah with cords. And in the dungeon [there was] no water, but mire: so Jeremiah sunk in the mire.

cast him into <u>41\_MAR\_09\_22</u> # And ofttimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us.

cast him into <u>40\_MAT\_18\_30</u># And he would not: but went and cast him into prison, till he should pay the debt.

cast him into <u>40\_MAT\_22\_13</u># Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast [him] into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

cast him into <u>66\_REV\_20\_03</u># And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

cast him out <u>44\_ACT\_07\_58</u> # And cast [him] out of the city, and stoned [him]: and the witnesses laid down their clothes at a young man's feet, whose name was Saul.

cast him out <u>43\_JOH\_09\_34</u> # They answered and said unto him, Thou wast altogether born in sins, and dost thou teach us? And they cast him out.

cast him out <u>43\_JOH\_09\_35</u> # Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the Son of God?

cast him out <u>42\_LUK\_09\_40</u> # And I besought thy disciples to cast him out; and they could not.

cast him out <u>42\_LUK\_20\_12</u> # And again he sent a third: and they wounded him also, and cast [him] out.

cast him out <u>42\_LUK\_20\_15</u> # So they cast him out of the vineyard, and killed [him]. What therefore shall the lord of the vineyard do unto them?

castle and told <u>44\_ACT\_23\_16</u> # And when Paul's sister's son heard of their lying in wait, he went and

entered into the castle, and told Paul.

castle of Zion <u>13\_1CH\_11\_05</u># And the inhabitants of Jebus said to David, Thou shalt not come hither. Nevertheless David took the castle of Zion, which [is] the city of David.

castle therefore they <u>13\_1CH\_11\_07</u># And David dwelt in the castle; therefore they called it the city of David.

castle <u>44\_ACT\_21\_34</u> # And some cried one thing, some another, among the multitude: and when he could not know the certainty for the tumult, he commanded him to be carried into the castle.

castle <u>44\_ACT\_23\_10</u># And when there arose a great dissension, the chief captain, fearing lest Paul should have been pulled in pieces of them, commanded the soldiers to go down, and to take him by force from among them, and to bring [him] into the castle.

castle <u>44\_ACT\_23\_32</u> # On the morrow they left the horsemen to go with him, and returned to the castle:

castle <u>20\_PRO\_18\_19</u># A brother offended [is harder to be won] than a strong city: and [their] contentions [are] like the bars of a castle.

castles and cities <u>14\_2CH\_17\_12</u># And Jehoshaphat waxed great exceedingly; and he built in Judah castles, and cities of store.

castles and towers <u>14\_2CH\_27\_04</u> # Moreover he built cities in the mountains of Judah, and in the forests he built castles and towers.

castles in their <u>13\_1CH\_06\_54</u> # Now these [are] their dwelling places throughout their castles in their coasts, of the sons of Aaron, of the families of the Kohathites: for theirs was the lot.

castles twelve princes <u>01\_GEN\_25\_16</u> # These [are] the sons of Ishmael, and these [are] their names, by their towns, and by their castles; twelve princes according to their nations.

castles was Jehonathan <u>13\_1CH\_27\_25</u> # And over the king's treasures [was] Azmaveth the son of Adiel: and over the storehouses in the fields, in the cities, and in the villages, and in the castles, [was] Jehonathan the son of Uzziah:

castles with fire <u>04\_NUM\_31\_10</u> # And they burnt all their cities wherein they dwelt, and all their goodly castles, with fire.

Castor and Pollux <u>44\_ACT\_28\_11</u># And after three months we departed in a ship of Alexandria, which had wintered in the isle, whose sign was Castor and Pollux.

forecast devices against <u>27\_DAN\_11\_25</u> # And he shall stir up his power and his courage against the king of the south with a great army; and the king of the south shall be stirred up to battle with a very great and mighty army; but he shall not stand: for they shall forecast devices against him.

forecast his devices <u>27\_DAN\_11\_24</u> # He shall enter peaceably even upon the fattest places of the province; and he shall do [that] which his fathers have not done, nor his fathers' fathers; he shall scatter among them the prey, and spoil, and riches: [yea], and he shall forecast his devices against the strong holds, even for a time.

Outcast saying This <u>24\_JER\_30\_17</u># For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds,

saith the LORD; because they called thee an Outcast, [saying], This [is] Zion, whom no man seeketh after.

outcasts bewray not <u>23 ISA 16 03</u> # Take counsel, execute judgment; make thy shadow as the night in the midst of the noonday; hide the outcasts; bewray not him that wandereth.

outcasts dwell with <u>23 ISA 16 04</u> # Let mine outcasts dwell with thee, Moab; be thou a covert to them from the face of the spoiler: for the extortioner is at an end, the spoiler ceaseth, the oppressors are consumed out of the land.

outcasts in the <u>23\_ISA\_27\_13</u> # And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] the great trumpet shall be blown, and they shall come which were ready to perish in the land of Assyria, and the outcasts in the land of Egypt, and shall worship the LORD in the holy mount at Jerusalem.

outcasts of Elam <u>24\_JER\_49\_36</u># And upon Elam will I bring the four winds from the four quarters of heaven, and will scatter them toward all those winds; and there shall be no nation whither the outcasts of Elam shall not come.

outcasts of Israel <u>23\_ISA\_11\_12</u># And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

outcasts of Israel <u>23\_ISA\_56\_08</u> # The Lord GOD which gathereth the outcasts of Israel saith, Yet will I gather [others] to him, beside those that are gathered unto him.

outcasts of Israel <u>19\_PSA\_147\_02</u> # The LORD doth build up Jerusalem: he gathereth together the outcasts of Israel.
