chains about thy <u>20_PRO_01_09</u> # For they [shall be] an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck.

chains among all <u>24_JER_40_01</u> # The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, after that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had let him go from Ramah, when he had taken him being bound in chains among all that were carried away captive of Jerusalem and Judah, which were carried away captive unto Babylon.

chains and bracelets <u>04_NUM_31_50</u> # We have therefore brought an oblation for the LORD, what every man hath gotten, of jewels of gold, chains, and bracelets, rings, earrings, and tablets, to make an atonement for our souls before the LORD.

chains and brought <u>26_EZE_19_09</u># And they put him in ward in chains, and brought him to the king of Babylon: they brought him into holds, that his voice should no more be heard upon the mountains of Israel.

chains and carried <u>24_JER_52_11</u># Then he put out the eyes of Zedekiah; and the king of Babylon bound him in chains, and carried him to Babylon, and put him in prison till the day of his death.

chains and demanded <u>44_ACT_21_33</u> # Then the chief captain came near, and took him, and commanded [him] to be bound with two chains; and demanded who he was, and what he had done.

chains and in <u>42_LUK_08_29</u> # [For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.]

chains and the <u>44_ACT_12_06</u> # And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison.

chains and the <u>23_ISA_03_19</u> # The chains, and the bracelets, and the mufflers,

chains and the <u>41_MAR_05_04</u> # Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any [man] tame him.

chains and their <u>19_PSA_149_08</u># To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron;

chains as in <u>14_2CH_03_16</u> # And he made chains, [as] in the oracle, and put [them] on the heads of the pillars; and made an hundred pomegranates, and put [them] on the chains.

chains at the <u>02_EXO_28_22</u> # And thou shalt make upon the breastplate chains at the ends [of] wreathen work [of] pure gold.

chains at the <u>02_EXO_39_15</u># And they made upon the breastplate chains at the ends, [of] wreathen work [of] pure gold.

chains but the <u>19_PSA_68_06</u># God setteth the solitary in families: he bringeth out those which are bound with chains: but the rebellious dwell in a dry [land].

chains fell off <u>44_ACT_12_07</u> # And, behold, the angel of the Lord came upon [him], and a light shined in the prison: and he smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from [his] hands.

chains had been <u>41_MAR_05_04</u># Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any [man] tame him.

chains of darkness <u>61_2PE_02_04</u> # For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast [them] down to hell, and delivered [them] into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

chains of gold <u>11_1KI_06_21</u># So Solomon overlaid the house within with pure gold: and he made a partition by the chains of gold before the oracle; and he overlaid it with gold.

chains of gold <u>02_EXO_28_24</u> # And thou shalt put the two wreathen [chains] of gold in the two rings [which are] on the ends of the breastplate.

chains of gold <u>02_EXO_39_17</u># And they put the two wreathen chains of gold in the two rings on the ends of the breastplate.

chains of gold <u>22_SON_01_10</u># Thy cheeks are comely with rows [of jewels], thy neck with chains [of gold].

chains of pure <u>02_EXO_28_14</u> # And two chains [of] pure gold at the ends; [of] wreathen work shalt thou make them, and fasten the wreathen chains to the ouches.

chains that were <u>07_JUD_08_26</u># And the weight of the golden earrings that he requested was a thousand and seven hundred [shekels] of gold; beside ornaments, and collars, and purple raiment that [was] on the kings of Midian, and beside the chains that [were] about their camels' necks.

chains they fastened <u>02_EXO_39_18</u># And the two ends of the two wreathen chains they fastened in the two ouches, and put them on the shoulderpieces of the ephod, before it.

chains they shall <u>23_ISA_45_14</u> # Thus saith the LORD, The labour of Egypt, and merchandise of Ethiopia and of the Sabeans, men of stature, shall come over unto thee, and they shall be thine: they shall come after thee; in chains they shall come over, and they shall fall down unto thee, they shall make supplication unto thee, [saying], Surely God [is] in thee; and [there is] none else, [there is] no God.

chains thou shalt <u>02_EXO_28_25</u> # And [the other] two ends of the two wreathen [chains] thou shalt fasten in the two ouches, and put [them] on the shoulder pieces of the ephod before it.

chains to carry <u>24_JER_39_07</u> # Moreover he put out Zedekiah's eyes, and bound him with chains, to carry him to Babylon.

chains to the <u>02_EXO_28_14</u> # And two chains [of] pure gold at the ends; [of] wreathen work shalt thou make them, and fasten the wreathen chains to the ouches.

chains under darkness <u>65_JDE_01_06</u> # And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

chains unto the <u>26_EZE_19_04</u># The nations also heard of him; he was taken in their pit, and they brought him with chains unto the land of Egypt.

chains which were <u>24_JER_40_04</u> # And now, behold, I loose thee this day from the chains which [were] upon thine hand. If it seem good unto thee to come with me into Babylon, come; and I will look well unto thee: but if it seem ill unto thee to come with me into Babylon, forbear: behold, all the land [is] before thee:

whither it seemeth good and convenient for thee to go, thither go.

chains <u>14_2CH_03_05</u> # And the greater house he ceiled with fir tree, which he overlaid with fine gold, and set thereon palm trees and chains.

chains <u>14_2CH_03_16</u># And he made chains, [as] in the oracle, and put [them] on the heads of the pillars; and made an hundred pomegranates, and put [them] on the chains.

chains <u>23_ISA_40_19</u># The workman melteth a graven image, and the goldsmith spreadeth it over with gold, and casteth silver chains.

chains <u>41_MAR_05_03</u># Who had [his] dwelling among the tombs; and no man could bind him, no, not with chains:

chains <u>34_NAH_03_10</u> # Yet [was] she carried away, she went into captivity: her young children also were dashed in pieces at the top of all the streets: and they cast lots for her honourable men, and all her great men were bound in chains.
